## Manj bo vlakov, ker ni premoga

**Hitler je napadel  
Poljsko popolnoma  
brez povoda**

Feldmarschal Keitel priča,  
da niso dali Poljaki  
nobenega povoda za napad

Nuernbeag. — Feldmarschal Wilhelm Keitel je pred zavezniškim sodnim tribunalom včeraj izpovedal, da je Hitler napadel Poljsko brez vsakega povoda, da ni bilo na meji nobenega incinta, ki bi dajal nacijem povod za napad, kar je bil potem začetek druge svetovne vojne.

Keitel je tudi izpovedal, da so imeli naciji v načrtu okupirati vso Češko tri tedne po pogodbi v Monakovem.

"Hitler nam je ukazal v aprili 1939, naj se pripravimo za udar na Poljsko, ki naj se izvrši v oktobru," je povedal Keitel. "Hitler je tudi rekel, da ne verjam, da bi se zapadne države zanimalo za to, kaj počne Nemčija na vzhodu," je dalje pričal Keitel.

"Mi smo bili proti vojni s Poljsko, ker smo se bali, da bomo radi tega napadeni od Francije in Anglije. Čutili smo, da nismo se dovolj močni, toda ukaže smo vseeno izvedli," je rekel feldmarschal.

"Hitler nam je tudi že v avgustu 1939 povedal, da nam bo dala pogodba z Rusijo dovolj časa, da se pripravimo za vojno proti nji," je zaključil Keitel.

Toda mati je kmalu izvohala, kam jo je ubral ljubljeni sinček in takoj je obvestila taborišče, naj mu pošljejo sina domov, kjer bo še par let pil mleko, predno bo zrel za vojaško suknjo.

**Vsled premogarske stavke in ker se zaloge premoga vidno manjšajo, so bile železniške družbe prisiljene, da so ukinile nekaj vlakov na vsaki progi. Jeklarne iz istega vzroka odpuščajo delavce.**

Washington. — Železniške družbe, ki kurijo lokomotive s premogom, so že začele krčiti število vlakov na raznih progah. Vzrok je, ker se vrši stavka premogarjev, dočim se zaloge premoga, ki ga imajo železnice na razpolago, z vsakim dnem bolj krčijo. Jeklarne tudi poročajo, da so že začele odpuščati delavce, ker bodo zmanjšale obrat zaradi pomanjkanja premoga.

Premogarske družbe izjavljajo, da bodo prisilile John L. Lewis, predsednika unionskih premogarjev, da bo moral priti na dan z zahtevno radi mezde in delovnih ur. John Lewis ni namreč v vseh treh tednih, kar so se vršila pogajanja niti enkrat omenil, koliko poviška zahteva pri mezdi za premogarje, niti ni določno povedal, koliko ur najpremogarji delajo na teden. Kar je Lewis zahteval je bilo samo to, da premogarske družbe plačajo po 10 centov od vsake tone premoga v poseben sklad v krovit ponesrečenim in drugače potrebnim premogarjem in da v rovih izboljšajo varnost.

Carnegie-Illinois Steel Corp. je del U. S. Steel Corp. nazznanja, da je 5.000 delavcev brez dela, ker podjetje ne more obravnavati s polno paro, da varčuje s premogom. Iz Gary, Indiana, se poroča, da bo kmalu brez dela na deset tisoč delavcev pri Carnegie-Illinois Co. Enako tudi delavci v South Chicagu. Jeklarne pravijo, da morajo takoj rabiti 50% premoga manj, da se ga prehitro ne porabi.

Železniški uslužbenci na vlakih, ki so vozili premog od rudnikov, so že brez dela, ker premoga nihče ne koplje.

J. A. Krug, tajnik nočnarih zadev poroča, da je bilo 1. marca v rokah odjemelcu do 51. 182.000 ton mehkega premoga, kar normalno zadostuje za 31. dnevi.

Sla sva pri zadnjih vratih iz hiše, zavila okoli oglja. Pa me je kar vrglo nazaj. Ravno proti hiši je stopal dol po cesti mož srednjih let, temnega obraza, s sršastimi črnimi brki. Ko me je zagledal, sem videl, da je kar ostromel; malo da ni obstal sredi ceste. Nisem ga poznal, on mene, kakor je kažalo njegovo začudenje, je. Hodil sem sicer čestokrat tam mimo, a za imena posameznih posestnikov se nisem pobrigal. Zdaj bi mi to dobro služilo. V začetku vasi stojita namreč dve hiši skorostrič. V kateri? Ko sva to ugibala in se počasi bližala, stopi iz ene kaka osemletna deklica — hčerka najnih blagih pomočnikov — in narašča proti pomigava, naj greva tja.

V srcu me je ganilo, kako naju je sprejela, stara mati: kakor da sta se ji sina vrnila iz vojne ali iz Amerike. Po progi je vozil skoro vsako uro kratek vlak. Vsakikrat, ko sem ga zagledal gori ob Štebnu, mi je postalno neprijetno pri srcu. Vedel sem, da vozi vojaštvo in mucijo zoper naše stražarje in branitelje. Municije je bilo v Beljaku nakopice ogromno. Ob razsuljosti prve dni novembra, je prihajal vlak za vlagom z živili in z municijo, in so marsikaterega obdržali kratkomalo v Bel-

Draga sestrična Mici!

Zelo smo bili veseli, ko smo prejeli Tvoj naslov, katerega si Ti dala in smo videli, da se zanimaš za nas Otavčane, ki smo tako nesrečni, da smo morali zapustiti svoje domove. Tukaj smo trije: Janez, Jože in jaz France, Petrov Janez Štefan, Polde, Klun Jože, Mraše France, Štenarjev Štefan, Andrejev Jože, Matevž Janez, Tomažič Polde. V Italiji pa so: Makarjev France, Tomažev Jože in Petrov France.

Mi smo bili civilisti. Pri vojakih pa so bili Lovšinov Jože in Vinko, Andrejev France, Bojcev Lož, Grigarjev Vinko, Škrbčev Jože, kateremu je granata odbila roko v zapestju, ki je ostal v Ljubljani. Vojaki so moralni iti od tukaj vsi domov, od tukaj — seveda, ko smo prišli sem. Vojaki so se borili proti komunistom in ko bi Ti mogel vse popisati, vem, da bi se zjokala. Mislimi smo si, da gremo samo za 14 dni in potem pa bomo šli domov, pa smo še vedno tukaj. Tukaj je več tisoč ljudi. Od doma ne dobimo nobene pošte. Zelo nas skrbi, katero je doma. Vas Otavice so še cele, a okoliške vasi pa so zelo požgane. Otavčanje smo se bili že leta 1942 dogovorili, da v ta namen postavimo cerkev. Torej si lahko misliš, kako je bilo hudo. Pri Boštjanovih so oče umrli leta 1942 in mati pa 1945. Škrbčev Korel je tudi umrl januarja 1945, Petrov oče pa maja 1945.

Zelo rad bi Ti bolj obširno popisal, kaj in kako je bilo in kaj vse smo doživel v tem vojnom času. Veliko se je napravilo molitve za skorajšnji mir in nazadnje je prišlo pa tako. V Boga moramo zaupati in proti za pravi red. Vas vse skušaj pozdravljamo vsi begunci iz Otavic. — France.

V Kotu je precej predružačeno, vas vsa in tudi pri nas je požgano. Polede je bil ubit na Jesenicah, Jože je bil pa pri domobrancih podčastnik in je čisto gotovo padel v Kočevskem rogu, ko je

Slika nam predstavlja domačine, ki nosijo svojo lastnino na ladjo, ki jih bo odpeljala na drugi otok, kjer bodo na varnem in sicer na otok Rongerik, ki je 109 milij stran od Bikini otoka.

bil s tisoči drugih vrnjen nazaj s Koroškega. Anton je bil tudi vojak v Gorici. France je ostal doma, Mica je v Ljubljani, Angela je pa tudi vdova. Njen mož je bil domobranc in je bil ubit v Kočevskem rogu. Jaz sem pa tukaj in prav nič ne vem, kaj me še čaka. Doma sem pustil ženo in ne vem nič od nje.

Vem, da vam komunistični privrženci drugače pišejo o nas, pa naj Ti še jaz malo povem resnično kot je. Znano Ti je, da je bila vojna med Jugoslavijo ter Nemčijo in Italijo končana v treh tednih. Italijani so zasedli en del Slovenije in Nemci pa drugega. Tako smo bili razdeljeni Slovenci. Pod Italijani se je eno leto še nekako shajalo. Ko pa so se pojavili komunisti, so pa začeli tudi Italijani pobirati in po hišah pobirati ljudi za talce. Tako se je začela naša Kalvarija. Samo pri nas v Dolenjevaški občini je padlo 60 ljudi.
