

Vladni krogi pozdravljajo obnovitev pogajanj

ISKANJE PETEGA POSREDOVALCA

Addis Ababa, 6. avg. — Nihče ni pokazal zadovoljstva, ko je dospelo besedilo resolucije glede italijansko-abesinskega konflikta, ki jo je sprejel svet Lige narodov, v Addis Ababo. Na drugi strani pa so abesinski vladni krogi hvaležni, ker so dobili zagotovilo, da bo arbitražna komisija obnovila pogajanja in skušala poravnati spor na miren način.

Tu so prepričani, da bo komisija podprla stališče Abesinije, da slednja lastuje Uual, pozorišče glavnega obmejnega incidenta, ki je izzval konflikt med Italijo in afriško državo. Abesinska vlada je uverjena, da njeni delegati ne bodo imeli težkoč in da bodo lahko dokazali lastništvo Uualu. Celo v slučaju, da bi komisija odločila, da so Abesinci otvorili ogenj na italijanske čete, kar seveda zanikajo, bo morala komisija upoštevati olajševalne okoliščnosti, ker so postopali tako kakor bi vsak drugi, če bi bil napaden.

Uradni komunike, ki je bil včeraj objavljen, izraža zadovoljstvo, ker je Liga narodov obljubila, da bo preiskala vse detaile spora med Italijo in Abesinijo na prihodnjem zasedanju, ki se otvori 4. septembra.

Abesinija sedaj čaka, kaj bodo storile Velika Britanija, Francija in Italija, kadar bodo otvorile privatna pogajanja na podlagi pogodbe iz l. 1906. To je pogodba, ki je razdelila Abesinijo v cone angleškega, francoskega in italijanskega vpliva.

Poleg tega sta Francija in Anglija obljubili Italiji, da ji bosta pomagali, da izvojuje koncesije, ki bi ji omogočila gradnjo železnice, ki bi zvezala Eritrejo in italijansko Somalijo zapadno od Addis Ababe. Abešinci se boje, da bodo Italijani dobili novo podporo od Francije, ki bi jim pozneje omogočila popolno kontrolo afriške države. Druga stvar, ki vznemirja Abešinjce, je neuspeh Velike Britanije v poskusu, da dobi od Musliminija zagotovilo, da ne bo pošiljal nadaljnjih čet in vojnega materiala v italijanske kolonije v vzhodni Afriki.

Zeneva, 6. avg. — Imena treh juristov so bila omenjena, od katerih naj bi eden zasedel izpraznjeno mesto v arbitražni komisiji, ki se bo bavila z italijansko-abisinskim sporom. Med temi so Nicholas Politis, grški državnik; Max Huber iz Švice, bivši predsednik mednarodnega sodišča, in dr. K. H. Hamarskjöld, bivši švedski premier.

Štirje člani komisije se še niso odločili, kdaj bodo obnovili pogajanja glede italijansko-abe-sinske krize. Nedavni razgovori na Holandskem so se izjalovili, toda akcija Lige narodov preteklo soboto je ustvarila podlago za obnovev pogajanj.

Stvar se je hitro pojasnila. Vlak ponoči, razen v določenem poletnem času, ne vozi, to pa zato, ker gre ponoči čez progo polno živih in ker se pri silno pogostih naliivih dogaja, da prestopijo reke svoje bregove v času komaj ene ure, poskodujejo železniški nasip in utegnejo zrasti tudi mostove. V dobi, ko vozi vlak tudi ponoči, pa mu je treba priznati, da nekaj zmore. Torej jo privozi iz Džibutija v Addis Abebo v skopih 24 urah.

Organizacije je manjkalo, to je vse. Organizacije, kateri bi bili vsaj toliko zaupali kolikor smo v veliki večini zaupali privatnim bankirjem in korporacijam.

In v bodočnosti ne bo nič bolje — še slabše bo za delavca in malega farmarja! — če se delavci in mali farmarji v splošnem ne organizirajo na vsej črti: ekonomsko, strokovno, politično in kulturno.

Res je — vsi do zadnjega ne bodo nikdar organizirani. Nekateri ljudje so pač tako rojeni, da zaupajo vsem sleparjem, le sebi in svojim ne. Da le nadpolovična večina delavcev in malih farmarjev spozna potrebo organizacije! Tedaj bo preobrat zagotovljen.

Dobra organizacija je najboljša šola za popularno izobrazbo, za materialni uspeh in napredek, za ekonomsko, politično, kulturno in socialno demokracijo! Brez takšne masne organizacije z jasnim smotrom in energičnim vodstvom je vsak miren preobrat iz današnjih gnilih razmer nemogoč. In tak preobrat mi hočemo!

Davčni zakon sprejet v nižji zbornici

Prvotni davčni načrt precej spremenjen

Washington, D. C. — Nižja kongresna zbornica je 5. avgusta sprejela Rooseveltov davčni zakon za "razdelitev bogastva" z 282 glasovi proti 96. Osemnajst demokratov in 78 republikancev je glasovalo proti. Originalni davčni načrt je precej spremenjen; to pomeni, da so mnoge davčne postavke znižane. Novi zakon prinese le 250 milijonov dolarjev več letno, nihče pa ne ve, kaj bodo z zakonom naredili v senatu.

Po tem zakonu, kakršen je zdaj, bodo visoke dedščine prinesle le 86 milijonov dolarjev letno. Ta davek je zvišan pri vsoti \$50,000 in naraste na 75% pri desetih milijonih. Davek na darila prinese 24 milijonov. Davek na visoke osebné dohodke, ki bo prizadel okrog 8000 oseb in ki je zvišan na 31% od \$50,000 dohodkov in naraste na 75% pri petih milijonih in več, bo dal 50 milijonov.

Senat bo preiskal

"šušljajočo kampanjo"

Washington, D. C. — Senatni odsek, ki preiskuje lobijo elektrarskih magnatov, se še te dni loti "šušljajoče kampanje" proti predsedniku Rooseveltu. Organizator in vodja te kampanje, kakor je odkrila preiskava, je neki E. P. Cramer, oglaševalni agent elektrarske družbe v New Jerseyju; on je prvi raznesel šepetajočo govorico, da je Roosevelt bolan na — možganih.

Mali farmarji izginjajo

Des Moines, Ia. — Celo v Iowa, najrodovitejši poljedelski državi, se brezobziren proces, ki ustvarja iz malih farmarjev namenjike, nadaljuje. To kaže poročilo državnega poljedelskega departamenta, ki je bilo pravkar objavljeno. Na podlagi številnih davčnih cenilcev poljedelski departament sodi, da je število namenjinskih farmarjev poskočilo devet odstotkov v preteklem letu v primeri z l. 1933.

Skrivnostni smrtni žarki

Pred nedavnim smo poročali, da je "izumitelj" smrtnih žarkov, angleški raziskovalec Grindell Matthews, v razgovoru z nekim nikarjem povedal, da pripravlja nove, prenetljive stvari. Sicer je treba omeniti, da govori poskusi s smrtnimi žarki, kakor jih krstil on sam, v prvih letih po vojni niso kazali nobenih posebnih uspehov in je izumitelj potem za celo desetletje izginil s prizemlja.

Grindell Matthews si je s pomočjo mnogih izumov, ki so mu šli v denar, zgradil na samem kraju v južnem Walesu velik laboratorij, ki je pred nepoklicanimi obiskovalci zaščit s pasom infrardečih žarkov in celo vrsto trčnih svarilnih priprav. Pravijo, da je v zadnjih mesecih uspel, da je s smrtnimi žarki spravljal modelna letala iz znatne daljave na tla. Poleg tega pa je opremil neko ladjo angleške mornarice z napravo, ki mu omogočila, da je to ladjo z brezžičnimi valovi iz svojega doma in jo spravil v pristanišče, ne da bi bila niti ena živa duša na ladji.

Veliko govore tudi o njegovih poskusih z letali, ki bodo baje sposobne, dvigniti se in pol sekunde 10,000 m visoko in s svojo plozjo uničiti vsa letala v svoji okolici. Najdalji izum bi bil aparat, ki bo ladjam nagnjal avtomatično bližanje podmornic, tudi bodo 30 milj daleč.

Podrobnosti o vseh teh izumih, ki so na njeni vojaškemu področju, v javnost seveda prihajajo. Pač pa poročajo obširneje o uporabi smrtnih žarkov v obliki zdravilnih žarkov. Izumitelj hoče z njimi zatirati boleče v kali. V neki deški šoli v Birminghamu napravili poskus s temi žarki in uspeh je bil, da so med šolskim letom oboleli samo štiri dečki za običajnimi otroškimi boleznimi, drugi so bili pa vse leto zdravi kakor ribi vodi.

Sonce dogoreva

V notranjosti sonca vladajo temperature 50,000,000 stopinj. Pri tako visokih temperaturah materija ne more več obstati v obliki kakršni jo poznamo. Tu ni več "prvin", to samo še njih prvotni delci: elektroni, protoni, ki letijo z ogromno energijo naokrog notranjosti sonca materija torej razpada, sminja se v žarenje. Materijo moramo smatirati za obliko energije. V obliki izžarevanja svetovni prostor izgublja sonca neprestano materijo in energijo.

Izračunali so, da postane naše sonce z 4 milj našim srčnim utripom za okrog 4 milijone ton lažje. Tudi sonca se tedaj v izmed dolgih dobah izgorijo in izrabijo. V tem gledu lahko govorimo o mladih in starih časih. Pri mladih, vročih soncih je poraba energije in energije mnogo večja nego pri starih, ki so se že postarala. 5. Puško, municijo in opremo so ti zaupali, da bi jih kvaril in trošil brez potrebe. Več zato, da jih imaš pripravljene za vojno.
6. Ne reci, da plača itak vlada, kajti ti ki plačuješ, in vlada je le tista, ki si si jo želi in ki nosiš zanjo uniformo.
7. Disciplina je sonce vojaka, brez nje je vojakov, temveč je samo zmešnjava.
8. Mussolini ima vedno prav.
9. Za fašističnega prostovoljnega vojaka nikoli olajševalnih okoliščin, če ne posluša.
10. Nekaj ti mora biti nad vsem drugim življenje duceja.

V prisegi, ki jo mora položiti kandidat fašističnega milico, je zanimivo to, da obljubi pokornost samo ducejevemu ukazom, medtem ko prisegajo vojaki redne armade zvestost kralju, Mussoliniju in vladi.

Stratosfera nad tropskim pasom

Kakor poročajo iz Batavije, so spustili te dni beležni balon, ki je dosegel v višino 2000 m. Dočim so v stratosferi nad Evrope ugotovili temperaturo 55 stop. pod ničlo, nad Batavijo zabeležili minus 78 stop. Stratosfera se v tropskih krajih pričinja tudi nekoliko višje nego pri nas: nad Evropo v višini 11,000 m. nad tropskim pasom pa v višini 17,000 m.

Protest Against Slavery

Every American worker, employed and unemployed, should join in a protest against the \$19 to \$94 monthly wage scales set by President Roosevelt for Works Progress Administration jobs. They should lend their strength to the nationwide demonstrations which have been called by the American Workers Alliance for August 17. But that day should be merely the beginning of an attack upon the serfdom which our Democratic president proposes for the people of this nation.

Never should it be forgotten that such wages are not only insulting but unnecessary. This is a wealthy nation. We have everything which a people needs to supply abundance (more than \$4,000 per year at present price levels) to every American family.

The only reason we don't use those resources and enjoy a \$4,000 income is because a few people, who claim ownership to them, can not find private profit and advantage in permitting us to do so.

However, the welfare of millions should not be slighted for the profit of a few. Nor is it enough to protest against the evils of a plan to serve profits first.

In addition to protesting, American workers should organize. Their objective should be: Not merely higher wages, but the abolition of the wage and private profit system.

The time has come for workers to demand that the mills and mines and railroads and banks and every natural and mechanical device shall be dedicated to the welfare of all the people. Such a demand will be the only effective protest against the starvation levels and serf rules which the Roosevelt administration offers to workers who can not be used by private industry.

Socialists have the objective and the plan for reaching it. Let the nation own the industries. Produce for use instead of for profit.

To the people of the nation we offer the Socialist program. Prosperity and security can be achieved when the workers organize industrially and politically to end the profit system.

Above All, Action

Many legal authorities believe a constitutional amendment is unnecessary to provide Congress with power with which to enact social legislation. In this position they are at odds with President Roosevelt.

While admitting that the issue "Amend the Constitution" would be a humdinger for the President's campaign for re-election, the welfare of the nation's workers must not be sacrificed, nor even delayed, just to furnish a president with a campaign issue.

Needless to say, if a constitutional amendment is necessary, and organized labor is not yet convinced this tedious, tortuous method is the only solution to the problem in hand, the workers will be the most enthusiastic and effective supporters of, and campaigners for, such an amendment.

Furthermore, a constitutional amendment campaign should not wait upon the political dictates of the Democratic party. The summer may not be a good time to campaign, it may be better (politically speaking) to withhold fire until later, and all that, nevertheless the matter is too important to the workers battling Bourbonism and Industrial fascism TO-DAY, to permit delay.

Whatever the requirements of the situation, action and immediate action is necessary above all things.—The Hosiery Worker.

The cause of Labor has suffered greatly at the hands of an unfair and unsympathetic press. If we will make freedom of speech on the radio as sacred as freedom of speech on the platform has been, Labor will be able to present its cause fully and clearly to the people.—Dill.

'The Youth Move Forward'

Yukon, Pa.—At a time, when the war clouds gather and move over Europe which is sitting on top of a powder barrel, Italy sending troops to Ethiopia while the other nations are arming feverishly and lining up on one side or the other, the United States government is spending millions for airplanes, submarines and battleships on the one hand, while on the other preparing the nation's youth for war through the daily capitalist newspapers.

I write this article not to show my ability to write, but to try to prove to the readers of the Prosveta what is really in the air and why they should become conscious of the fact that War and Fascism can be a reality if we do not organize along proper channels. In every strike today, labor must meet the full force of the government either mediators or bayoneteers. Today, it is Terre Haute or Tacoma, tomorrow it may be your town or mine, yesterday it was Frisco and Toledo. Clubbings and shootings on the one side and the trickery of the mediators on the other side, and in the thickest of every battle for the rights of those who toil, is America's future—the Youth—those who are participating in the class war for the first time.

I dedicate this article to those young workers who were clubbed on the picket lines, to those "forgotten youth" who daily fall beneath the wheels of moving freight trains while in the search of work, bread or a future, to those who were expelled from schools and colleges, deprived of an education because they attempted

to organize their fellow students against war and fascism.

President Roosevelt announces his new \$50,000,000 National Youth Administration. To date the nation's jobless youth have been entirely neglected. \$50,000,000 for some 620,000 unemployed youth, as official figures state, for a period of one year it would mean about \$1.64 a day to earn and learn. Huge figures but small harvest.

But there is a way out, the light has been shown on July 4 at Detroit, Mich., 159 years after the memorable document of the Declaration of Independence gave way for the freedom of the 13 colonies in America. So the Declaration of Rights for Youth may free the youth of America from the vultures of Wall street. Some 1200 youth from the Labor Unions, Student, Social, Cultural and Sports groups, youth of many different religious and political opinions met, hammered and agreed to work for a program, a way out. This was the American Youth Congress under its leadership. In April, some 185,000 students in schools and colleges staged a strike against war and fascism which sent shivers down the spines of the school officials. It was the American Youth Congress that led demonstrations and parades in over forty cities on May 30, to remember the last war and to fight against the future wars with such bodies as the YMCA, YWCA, Central Labor Unions of large cities, as Seattle, taking an active part in it.

The American Youth Congress, which is a united front body of many different youth groups, was taken away from its sponsor about a year ago, Viola Lima, who attempted to build a fascist movement at that time. Today it has really become a mass movement. The American Youth Congress at its sessions in Detroit on July 4, 5, 6, 7, pledged to struggle against war and fascism, to support the A. F. of L. in a movement to organize the unorganized, and to support the movement for Social and Unemployment Insurance.

What can the Youth lodges of the SNPJ do? First of all, in my vicinity especially, they should become union conscious, buy union made products, dance and picnic posters, which many of them are not doing. Support the struggle for Social and Unemployment Insurance; editorials on its needs in the English section of the Prosveta would be of a great importance. Arrange debates and lectures on important issues facing the youth such as War and Fascism, the need of Social and Unemployment Insurance and the necessity of supporting organized labor, in or following your lodge meetings. Articles on such issues should be written continuously in the English section of the Prosveta. What is happening in Germany may become a reality in the United States. Make your organization, your newspaper a voice in the movement, weapon in the struggle for security to America's future, the Youth.
