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Več posebnih sil ZDA bo moralo v Vietnam

Trenutno je okoli eno petino vseh "posebnih sil" ZDA v Južnem Vietnamu, pa jih bo poslanih tja še več.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — V zadnjih letih so Združene države ustanovile v okviru armade poseben oddelek, ki posveča vso svojo pažnjo gverilski vojni in boju proti njej. To so posebne sile, ki imajo tudi svojo lastno uniformo z zeleno baretko. To je elitna enota, katere vsak član je izvezban v rabi vseh vrst oružja, v organizaciji gverilskih oddelkov, pa tudi obrambe pred njimi z najosnovnejšimi sredstvi, ki so kod na razpolago.

Pripadniki posebnih sil so izučeni v skrivjanju ob uporabi treha, v življenju od zemlje, to se pravi, od hrane, ki jo morejo dobiti na samem ozemu, kjer se nahajajo. To jim naj bi dalo boljše možnosti za ohranitev v izredno težkem gverilskem vojskovjanju. Ti strokovnjaki so povezani v male skupine, ki jim je izročena naloga organiziranja odpora domačinov v "taboričnih posebnih sil", kot je ono pri Plei Me, kadar so se v preteklem oktobru in novembra vršili najbolj krvavi boji v sedanji vietnamski vojni.

Trenutno je v Vietnamu okoli 1,600 pripadnikov ameriških posebnih sil, ki delujejo največ kot svetovalci kakim 3,000 vietnamskim pripadnikom posebnih sil ter kot svetovalci krajevnih poveljnikov domačih sil, pa naj bo že to milica ali pokrajinske oborožene sile. Potreba po teh strokovnjakih gverilске vojne je kljub vsemu v Vietnamu še vedno izredna. Tako bo šlo v prihodnjih par mesecih tja iz Združenih držav še okoli 30 skupin posebnih sil, od 300 do 400 mož, da prevzamejo organizacijo in vodstvo domačinov v boju proti rdečim.

Rodezija omejila poslušanje tujega radija

LONDON, Ang. — Diktatura so si podobne po vsem svetu, naj pridejo z leve ali desne strani. To, kar so delali Stalin, Hitler in Mussolini, dela tudi rodezijski predsednik Ian Smith. Prepovedal je namreč vse "javne" radijske oddaje, ki bi lahko ogrožale mir in red v deželi.

S takimi za Smitha nevarnimi posli se trenutno pečata le dve radijski družbi: BBC v Londonu in ZBC v Zambiji. Zam濶jska radijska postaja je bolj odločna, res ostro kritizira vladu bele manjšine v Rodeziji. Londonska BBC je zmerna v svoji kritiki.

V Rodeziji se ljudje le malo menjajo o režimski prepovedi; kadar hočejo kaj izvedeti, gredo domov in poslušajo tam novice, ki jih zanimajo. Poslušanja v zaprtih prostorih namreč Smith še ni prepovedal.

Erhardom. Johnson se bo že v nedeljo vrnil v Belo hišo. Kako dolgo bo tam ostal, še ni dogovorjeno, rad bi se pa cim preje vrnil v Texas.

Republikanci bodo skromnejši. Imeli bodo začetkom tedna le sejo glavnega koordinacijskega odbora, ki bo med drugim obnoviti predsednikom Wilsonom, Ford pa nimata večine v Kongresu.

Hanoj zanika, da bi bil za mirovna pogajanja

INDIJA SE BO V 6 LETIH SAMA PREHRANJEVALA?

Indijski parlament je sklenil dati prednost poljedelstvu v novi gospodarski petletki, da bi omogočil deželi samoprehrano. Izredno slaba letošnja letina grozi deželi z lakoto.

NEW DELHI, Ind. — Indijski poljedelstvo je eno najbolj zaostalih na svetu, zato tudi najmanj donosno. Kljub temu je Indija po dosegi svoje neodvisnosti 1. 1948 posvetila vso svojo pažnjo razvoju industrije, posabno težke. Tako se je položaj narodne prehrane slabšal iz leta v leto. Poljedelstvo in domača živinoreja nista sposobna oskrbeti naglo rastoče milijone Indijcev s potrebnim hrano. Tako je moral Amerika iz leta v letu pomagati s svojimi viški deželnih pridelkov.

Letos je Indijo zadebla izredna suša. Med tem ko so lani imeli izredno dobro letino in pridelali nad 88 milijonov ton žita, bo tega letos kvečjemu okoli 80 milijonov. Indiji primanjkuje zato najmanj 10 milijonov ton pšenice in riža za najnujnejše potrebe prehrane. Združene države so v času pakistansko-indijske vojne zaradi Kašmira omemile pomoč od meseca do meseca. Sedaj se je indijska vlada obrnila znova na Washington s prošnjo za obsežno pomoč v hrani, ker je dežela v "resni nevarnosti hude lakote". Tudi Kanada je bila zaprosena za pomoč in utegne datu Indiji do milijonov ton pšenice.

V parlamentu je poljedelski minister Subramiam, ki je tudi minister za prehrano, povedal naravnost, da mora Indija posvetiti vse svoje napore pozvaditi poljedelstva ali pa se izpostaviti nevarnosti stalne lakote. Kljub odporu finančnega ministra Krišnamacarija se je parlament odločil za predlog, naj v novem petletnem načrtu dobi poljedelstvo prednost pred industrijo. Predsednik vlade Šastri je bil izvoljen Nikolaj Podgorny, 62 let stari član prezidija Komunistične partije, ki se je v času Hruščeva povzpel podobno kot Brežnev na vodilno mesto v državni upravi in partiji. A. Šelevip je bil razrešen podpredsednik državnega vladnega zaravnatelja Kašmira, omejile pomoč od meseca do meseca. AUSTIN, Tex. — Predsednik Johnson je včeraj odredil, naj se pospeši pošiljatev 1.5 milijona ton žita Indiji, ki je grozil očitna lakota, in ji dal še 50 milijonov dollarjev posojila za nabavo umetnih gnojil.

CLEVELAND, O. — Ognjenja krogla, ki jo je včeraj popoldne okoli 4.40 videlo na tisoče ljudi v Michiganu, Indiana, Ohiu in kanadskem Ontario, je bila po vsej verjetnosti velik meteor. Angleška diplomacija napada ruske komuniste

Za dokaz navaja poročilo laško kontrolne komisije, ki ga je London razposlal kar na svojo roko, ker tega ni hotela storiti tudi Moskva, kar bi moral, ker tudi predseduje znani komisija za Indokitajsko.

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

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

Cranberries For Christmas



This Cranberry Christmas Mold will make a perfect centerpiece for the festive table for it positively glitters! The mold is a soft pink while the decorations of green Christmas trees and dried gelatin on the top are made of lime gelatin. Best yet, the flavor is wonderful for it has fresh cranberries, bananas and applesauce in it. Here's a perfect centerpiece and dessert... all in one!

CRANBERRY CHRISTMAS TINSEL MOLD (Makes 1 2-quart mold)

2 cups fresh Ocean Spray cranberries, rinsed and drained	2 cups sour cream
1 cup water	2 egg whites
2 packages (3 ounces each) orange-pineapple gelatin	1/4 cup sugar
2 bananas, diced	1 1/2 cups water
1 cup applesauce	1 package (3 ounces) lime gelatin

Cook cranberries with water in saucepan until cranberries are tender, about 10 minutes; add orange-pineapple gelatin and stir until dissolved. Cool. Add bananas, applesauce and sour cream. Beat egg whites until stiff; gradually beat in sugar, 1 tablespoon at a time. Fold egg whites into cranberry mixture; pour into a 2-quart mold and chill until firm. Heat 1 1/2 cups water to boiling; add lime gelatin and stir to dissolve. Pour mixture into a 9-inch-square pan; chill until firm. Unmold. With a cookie cutter or sharp knife, cut holly leaves from the lime gelatin to decorate cranberry mold. Serve with sweetened whipped cream for dessert or with salad greens and mayonnaise as a salad.

THE DANGER SIGNS

Director J. Edgar Hoover of the Federal Bureau of Investigation recently said: "Is America as a Nation being swept by an epidemic of spiritual malnutrition? I fervently hope not; but the danger signs are all too clear. I fear that the public may be coming to accept widespread lawlessness as an unavoidable adjunct to our way of life."

"What has happened to the civic pride, the righteous indignation, of otherwise respectable citizens who turn their backs on helpless victims of beatings, robberies and sex crimes? The incredibly indifferent attitude of these people is exacting a heavy toll. It has helped to turn the streets and parks of many cities into virtual jungles of fear — where, according to a recent survey, nearly one half of the residents are afraid to walk alone at night."

"Despite the continuing efforts of some self-professed 'experts' to minimize the crime problem, the undeniable fact remains that crime is increasing — in both numbers and intensity — at an alarming rate. It is growing six times as fast as our expanding population."

Mr. Hoover quotes President Johnson's declaration that "The control of crime is a major target of this administration." It should and must be. But that is not enough. It must be a major target of governments at all levels — and of law-abiding citizens everywhere.



A Golfing Mascot For Dad

The traditional gift of socks for Father can be made doubly welcome by presenting them as an amusing mascot. Take a pair of socks of Greslan acrylic fiber, which are particularly soft and comfortable. Stuff the toe of one sock (Diagram A) and secure with a rubber band halfway up the foot. Turn the cuff up over the toe — just below the head. Wind a long pipe cleaner over the elastic, and...



let the ends hang down for arms (see Diagram B). Turn cuff back over neck for a turtle neck effect. Use the second sock to form the legs. Pin down the center of the leg to about 4" from the cuff. Insert a cylinder of heavy paper into each section to form legs. Roll up the remainder of the second sock, and stuff into the opening of the first sock, to form the body. Let the legs dangle.

Finish by pinning or pasting on pieces of felt cut out to make the hat, eyes, and mouth.

SUMMER EMPLOYMENT. The Civil Service Commission has announced that a nationwide competitive examination will be given in various cities (including Cleveland) on a Saturday in late January or early February of 1966 for temporary summer employment in the Federal Government for students. Included would be temporary employment as clerk, stenographer, typist, office machine operator, student assistant, physical science aid and mathematics aid.

Candidates for the examination should obtain a Civil Service Form 5000-AB, which is available at most post offices, at U.S. Civil Service Commission offices, and at Boards of U.S. Civil Service Examiners. The completed form should be mailed to the Civil Service Commission, Washington, D.C. 20415, before January 3, 1966. The test, which is to be given only once, is designed to measure clerical skills, vocabulary, reading comprehension, abstract reasoning, and table and chart interpretation.

Throughout the Nation, the names of applicants who pass the test and send their notices of eligibility to Federal agencies along with their applications for employment will be entered on agency rosters in ranked categories determined by their test scores. For example, those who score 95 and above will be in the top group, those scoring 90 to 94 in the second group, and so on. Consideration will be given to those in the highest category. All students interested in obtaining summer employment in the Federal Government should plan to take this examination as it will be the first step.

STUDENT DRAFT DEFERMENTS. Many young men in college or the senior year of high school have been asking, "Will I be able to finish my education before being drafted for military service?"

Here is the answer from selective service officials: In general, a full-time student who is making normal progress in his studies can count on being deferred from military service until he completes his college work, including a graduate degree. This is based on the present outlook, and an assumption that the United States will not go into full mobilization. There will be exceptions, mostly in cases of "marginal" students or those believed by their draft boards to be trying to stretch out college work solely to escape the draft.

Student deferment continues to be almost routine. Nationwide aptitude tests for college students as a basis of deferment have been discontinued. Class standings also have been dropped as a guide. Regulations still provide that a student's study must be found "to be necessary to the maintenance of the national health, safety, or interest", but that is interpreted literally to apply to practically all students carrying full courses of studies and making passing grades. Selective Service officials say they expect draft calls to level off and possibly go down from the December level of 40,200. This would lessen pressure on local boards to draft students to meet their quotas.

If a student should be reclassified as 1-A, and he feels his local board has not given proper consideration to all the facts in his case, he has the right to appeal within 10 days, but must do so in writing.

What Every Dog Should Know

Chicago, Ill. — When you walk your dog, does he lunge on the leash or drag like an anchor? When you say "Come," does he decide to play tag instead? Does he bark at the mailman and jump on your guests?

Lovely though he may be, your dog needs to learn the basics of doggy deportment. Teach him to obey just five words — Heel, Sit, Down, Stay, and Come — and turn your canine cup-up into a well mannered pet you not only love, but are proud to own.

You don't have to be an expert to train a dog. Even a youngster can do it. Keys to success are patience and consistent training methods. Your backyard, family room, or a nearby park makes a fine do-it-yourself classroom. Choose the time and place you and your dog can work without distractions ten of fifteen minutes once or twice a day.

Equipment for dog obedience training is simple and inexpensive to acquire. You need a six foot leash with a snap fastener and hand loop, a twenty-five foot leash or length of clothes-line equipped with a fastener and loop, and a slip or "choke" chain collar.

This type of collar differs from a buckle-on collar in that it tightens around the dog's neck when the leash is pulled. The collar loosens immediately when the tension is relaxed. Properly used, it will not hurt your dog; it does allow you to control him effectively, and is approved by humane groups.

Now here are the techniques used by professional trainers to teach the basic dog obedience commands.

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The mighty Swedish man-of-war, built for the Navy of King Gustavus II set sail on her maiden voy-

age, August 10, 1628. The proud ship sank that same day off the Island of Beckholmen, less than a mile from its launching quay, resulting in the loss of nearly 50 lives. The Vasa rested on the bottom of Stockholm Harbor for 333 years, from which it was raised in 1961. Now undergoing restoration, it has become a major tourist attraction.

Also on view in the Main Library's second floor exhibit cases are 212 pieces of contemporary Swedish glassware by the Orrefors factory. Direct from the Swedish Pavilion of the New York World's Fair, the Orrefors collection features both utilitarian and decorative examples of the glassmakers

art.

Heel. This lesson teaches your dog to walk quietly at your side without pulling or dragging on his leash. To begin, put on his collar and six-foot leash. Place him on your left side. Hold the end of the leash in your right hand with the excess length looped neatly. Stand straight and grasp the leash lightly near the collar with your left hand. Start walking at a normal pace, keeping your dog trotting at your side with short, firm tugs on the leash with your left hand only. Each time you tug, say "Heel!" Let the leash and collar go slack when he heels properly. Tighten it only when he tries to charge ahead or lag behind. As he walks along with you, praise him for good behavior.

Sit. Begin this lesson as you did the heeling lesson with your dog standing on your left. Hold his head up with the leash in your right hand. With your left hand, push down on his hindquarters and say "Sit." After a few tries, alternate heeling and sitting, so he'll learn to sit on command each time you stop.

Down. Many dogs don't like this lesson — they think it's undignified. Work until he obeys. Start by commanding him to sit. Kneel beside him, grip the leash close to the collar with your left hand, and tug downward sharply. Say "Down... Down... Down" in a firm friendly tone. Repeat the word until he lies down. Say "Down" again while he stays down and praise him lavishly after you allow him to get up.

Stay. Give your dog the command to sit. Holding the leash slack, walk away from him. If he starts to follow, say "No, Sit... Stay." Practice walking to the side, front and back. When he will stay on the short leash, work with the long leash. Walk as far as you can and still hold him in position with the word "Stay."

Come. Get your dog ready with the training collar and the long leash. Command him to stay in a sit or down position. You walk to the end of the leash, face him, and tell him to come. Like this: "Duke, Come! Pull him toward you

with easy, hand-over-hand tugs on the leash. Always insist that he comes when he is called. If he runs the other way, never chase him. Teach him that he must come to you for petting or praise and that running away wins nothing but a disapproving "no."

Training Tips. How quickly your dog learns each command will depend on his individual personality, coordination, intelligence, and sensitivity. Your ability to stick with it and be patient are important too. As you work, keep these tips in mind:

1. Short training sessions every day accomplish more than long lessons only now and then.
2. Give your dog exercise and an opportunity to relieve himself before the lesson begins and time to play afterward.

3. Never shout or show impatience. Give one or two word commands in a firm voice that shows you mean business.

4. Be generous with praise. Let your approval and affection be the rewards your dog works for.

5. Be sure your dog knows each command before going on to the next. If you begin and each lesson by running through the commands he does well, it makes learning more fun.
