PETER AND PAUL**

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KDO JE JEZUS ZATE?

Ob slavju svetih Petra in Pavla nam Cerkev v treh mašnih berilih govori o dveh velikih apostolih. Evangeljski odlomek, ki ga beremo, je osnova celotni evangeljski pripovedi sinoptikov. V prvem delu Jezus razoveda samega sebe s svojim učenjem, s čudeži in svojim usmiljenjem kasneje bo začel govoriti o svojem trpljenju in se vzpenjati proti Jeruzalemu.

Potem ko je Jezus naredil toliko čudežev in ljudje o njem veliko govori, Jezus vpraša učence: »Kaj pravijo ljudje, kdo je Sin človekov?« Izraz »Sin človekov« je Jezus uporabljal, da je označil samega sebe. Učenci takoj razumejo in odgovarjajo: nekateri mistijo, da je Sin človekov Janez Krstnik, ki je oživel; drugi, da je Elija, izjemen prerok, ki je živel precej stoljetij prej; spet drugi, da Jeremija, prerok iz časa narodne katastrofe; in končno nekateri, da je eden izmed prerokov. Vse te domneve poudarjajo Jezusovo pomembnost, nimajo pa pravega temelja. Jezus namreč ni ne Janez Krstnik ne Elija ne Jeremija ne eden izmed starih prerokov.

Zdaj Jezus vpraša učence: »Kaj pa vi pravite, kdo sem?« Simon Peter po navdihnjenu odgovori: »Ti si Kristus, Sin živega Boga.«

To je natančno, popolno poimenovanje Jezusa. Jezus ni samo prerok, pa čeprav bi bil največji izmed njih, ampak je Mesija, od Boga poslani kralj, da bi prinesel Izraelu odrešenje in postal luč narodom. Petrov odgovor vsebuje tudi natančnejše pojasnilo: »Sin živega Boga.« V Natanovem izreku, v katerem so prepoznavali napoved Mesija, je rečeno, da bo Bog za Mesijo oče in da bo Mesija za Boga sin. Ta Petrova trditev torej odgovarja Svetemu pismu.

Jezus dá Petru spoznati, da ga je za ta njegov odgovor v resnici navdihnil Bog: »Blagor ti, Simon, Jonov sin, kajti tega ti nista razodela meso in kri (tvoja človeška narava), ampak moj Oče, ki je v nebesih.« Zavedati se moramo, da je naša vera Božji dar. Človeško sklepanje ne more povzročiti resnične vere. Vera je nekaj globljega in višjega. Je Božji dar, ker gre za spoznanje Božjega Sina pod zunanjostjo človeka.

Nato Jezus pravi Petru: »Jaz pa ti povem: 'Ti si Peter in na tej skali bom sezidal svojo Cerkev.'« Iz dejstva, da je Oče Petru razodel Jezusovo mesijanstvo in božje sinovstvo, Jezus sklepa, da je Bog Petra tudi izbral, naj bo temeljni kamen Cerkve.

V aramejščini je Jezus uporabil izraz »Kefa«, kar pomeni »skala«. Dejal je: »Ti si skala in na to skalo bom sezidal svojo Cerkev.« Cerkev ni sezidana na pesku, ampak na skali oziroma na Petru, ki sta ga Božje razodetje in njegova vera v to razodetje spremenila v skalo. Jezus nato dostavi: »Dal ti bom ključe nebeškega kraljestva; in kar koli boš zavezal na zemlji, bo vezano v nebesih; in kar koli boš razvezal na zemlji, bo razvezano v nebesih.« Noben drug človek ni dobil takega poslanstva in take oblasti.

Petrovo poslanstvo se je moralno izpolniti preko mnogih težav in ovir. Kralj Herod se odloči in ga da prijeti, da bi naredil nekaj, kar je všeč Judom, ki so postali sovražni krščanski skupnosti. Zdi se, da mora njegovo poslanstvo spodleteti, a Božja previdnost bedi in bedi tudi Cerkev, saj je »Cerkev zanj vztrajno molila k Bogu.«

Božja previdnost bedi in poskrbi za osvoboditev, o kateri Luka pripoveduje na zelo zanimiv način. Peter se zave, da ne sanja, ampak da je v resnici prišel iz ječe in je svoboden, da nadaljuje svoje poslanstvo: »Zdaj vem, da je res! Gospod je poslal svojega angela in me rešil iz Herodove roke in pred vsemi nakanami judovskega ljudstva.« Peter bo dovršil svoje poslanstvo v Rimu z mučeništvtvom.

Drugo berilo nam vzporedno predstavi Pavlovo usodo in njegovo prepričanost, da bo rešen: »Jaz se namreč že izlivam kot pitna daritev.« V starodavnih daritvah so vzeli kri, da so jo zlili na žgalno žrtev. »Dober boj sem izbojeval, tek dokončal. Odslej je zame pripravljen venec pravičnosti, ki mi ga bo dal Gospod, pravični sodnik.« Pavel ve, da se bo njegovo poslanstvo končalo z mučeništvtvom, kar ni poraz, ampak zmago-slaven vrh izredno rodovitnega poslanstva.

Praznik nam daje veselje in zaupanje, da Gospod bedi nad nami in Cerkvijo. Kljub težavam in nevarnostim gre Cerkev naprej po svoji poti.

Saints Peter and Paul

FIRST READING: *Acts 12.1-11*

The Lord sends his angel to free Peter from imprisonment.

RESPONSORIAL PSALM 34

The Lord set me free from all my fears.

SECOND READING: *2 Timothy 4,6-8,17-18*

The Lord stands by Paul and gives him the power to proclaim the Gospel.

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION: *Matthew 16.18*

Alleluia - You are Peter, and on this rock I will build my Church, and the gates of Hades will not prevail against it. - Alleluia.

GOSPEL: *Matthew 16.13-19*

Jesus' Father in heaven reveals to Peter the truth of Jesus' identity. Nothing human has revealed this to him.

When we recite the Apostles' Creed, we declare that we believe in the "Communion of Saints". By this title, we are not just declaring a belief in all the canonised or proclaimed saints in heaven. We are stating a belief in the calling of all Christians, alive or dead, to see ourselves as linked to each other in our acceptance of Christ as the author of our salvation. A consequence of this is that we try to treat each other as we would treat Christ or, more importantly, as he treats us. This is not as easy as it seems, and it is no wonder we are at times happier to leave the call to holiness to the saints in heaven or to those who pursue the religious life. No such distinction is made in the Creed. We are all called to holiness because we are holy already, the beloved of Christ. St Paul tells us: "You are holy. Therefore, be holy". The next question is inevitably: "What


does it mean to be holy?" Does it mean being always in church or on our knees? That is not possible if we are holding down a job and looking after our family. Our holiness lies in how we live out the reality of our lives, how we treat each other, our honesty and integrity, our openness to loving and being loved. Prayer and our gathering as a community in church, especially to celebrate the Eucharist, help and support these aims, but the measure of our holiness lies in our daily challenges at home and abroad, "among the pots and pans", as St Teresa of Avila would say.

Gospel teaching

What then helps us to be holy? The lives of the saints model for us the challenges, the failures and the way forward in the pursuit of holiness. The fascination of both St Peter and St Paul, the Church's founding apostles, is how human they were. Peter is impulsive by nature. He gets things wrong as much as he gets things right.

In today's Gospel, Jesus congratulates Peter for recognising him as the Christ, the Son of the living God. Immediately afterwards, Jesus calls Peter "Satan" because he tries to persuade Jesus that he must not pursue his appointed pathway of suffering and death. Elsewhere, Peter's great moment of failure is his threefold denial of Jesus.

St Paul first appears as Saul, fully approving the stoning of St Stephen and aiming to persecute the Christians in Damascus. It takes a blinding fit and the direct intervention of God to change the direction of his life. He dedicates himself to taking the Gospel to the pagans, but we find him often recounting the troubles in life and his own failure to carry out his best intentions. Amid their very human confusion,



their way forward is identical: the person of Jesus Christ. It is Jesus who drags Peter out of the water, and his angel who frees Peter from prison in our first reading. When Paul is overcome by the way he is treated and the struggle to convey the message of the Gospel, he loudly exclaims: "Thanks be to God for Jesus Christ!"

Application

We are not likely to find ourselves in the dramatic encounters that we see in the lives of Ss Peter and Paul, but we will find ourselves with occasions when we have to resolve tensions and make difficult decisions. The Church's teaching may help us at such moments, but it can also make demands that add to the difficulty. The answer, as for St Paul, lies in the person of Jesus Christ and our relationship with him. Books are written on this, but in the light of today's

reflection, two pointers may help. Firstly, we tend to consecrate our own whims and prejudices as God's will. It can be difficult to accept that this is what we are doing. However, if our opinions mean the condemnation and judgement of others and any use of force to implement such opinions, then we are probably on the wrong track. The way of Christ, as illustrated by his own life, is a way of vulnerability and peace. Which brings us to our second pointer. Padre Pio says that God sculpts us, chipping pieces away in order to mould us as he would wish. He insists that we learn more from our failures and sufferings than we do from our successes and consolations. Neither is an easy step to take, which is why cultivating a habit of talking it through – or even arguing – with Christ keeps us heading in the right direction.


