Obloženi korupcije

Zvezna velika porota je sprejela otožnico proti 18 uslužencem GSA — General Services Administration.

BALTIMORE, Md. — Velika zvezna porota je pretekli petek sprejela otožnico 18 uslužencem General Services Administration, ki je odgovorna za vzdrževanje vseh poslopij in vseh vrst potrebitčin zvezne vlade in njenih agencij. V zadnjih letih je bilo ponovno slišati o velikih in številnih zlorabah in korupciji v tej upravi.

V teku so preiskave že več mesecov in vedno znova so napovedovali, da bodo objavljene prve otožbe. Pretekli petek so končno objavili prvih 18 upravnikov raznih trgovin in skladnič GSA, ki so otožne sprejemajo podkupnine in nagrad za "usluge" in dela, ki jih ni nihče opravil.

Najavili so, kako so podjetja predlagala račune za pleskanja, ki jih niso izvršila, napihnjene račune za razne druge usluge in dela, pa tudi dobave, kar je bilo vse palčano proti primeri nagrađi za tiste, ki so bili odgovorni za ta izplačila.

Posebni svetovalec GSA V. Alto je dejal da sedanja preiskava ugotovi največji dearnesski skandal v zvezni vladi in njenih ustanovah. Letna izguba bi po njegovem mogla dosegati okoli 68 milijonov dolarjev, drugi pa trdijo, da tudi desetkrat toliko.

Preiskava je nekam počasna in težava, ker jo vsi prizadeti skušajo na vse načine zavirati in preprečevati.

Sovjetska zveza bo gradila jedrsko elektrarno v Libiji

PARIZ, Fr. — Sovjetska zveza je objavila, da je podpisala dogovor z Libijo o gradnji jedrskih elektrarn v Libiji z močjo 300 megavatov.

Predsednik Sovjetske Atomske komisije Andronik Petrisjan, ki je prišel v Pariz s sovjetsko trgovinsko delegacijo, je razkričil tudi, da sta se Sovjetska zveza in Francija sporazumeli o sodelovanju pri razvijanju reaktorjev, ki producirajo več jedrskega goriva, kot pa porabijo.

Priznali goljufanje

BALTIMORE, Md. — Štirje bivši usluženci General Services Administration so priznali, da so to zvezno ustanovo goljufali in pristali na pričanje proti drugim ob otožbi manjše kazni za sebe.

Omenjeni so izmed skupine 18, ki je bila otožena goljufanja ZDA v okviru GSA. Napovedujejo, da bodo otoženi tudi oni bližu vrha te uprave, ki so bili soudeleženi pri goljufjah.

Kubanski Amerikanci odpotovali v ZDA

HAVANA, Kuba. — Ameriški državljanji na Kubi, skupno 31, in člani njihovih družin, skupno 106, so na temelju sporazuma med vladama obeh držav ta teden zapustili Kubo in odpotovali v ZDA.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Predstavnemu domu včeraj ni uspelo preglasovati predsedniškega veta v Kongresu izglasovanega zakonskega predloga o javnih delih. Veto, ki ga je predsednik izrekel v prepričanju, da bi uzakonitev tega predloga pospešila inflacijo, je tako obveljal.

NIKOZIA, Ciper. — Po sem došlih vesteh je prišlo v Meki v Savdski Arabiji do izgredov in spopadov, ko so oblasti 17. septembra trdo nastopile proti islamskim "romarjem" iz afriških držav, ki so hoteli ostati v Savdski Arabiji in se tam zaposliti. V spopadih naj bi bilo do 300 oseb ranjenih.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Senat je včeraj z 86:3 glasovom odobril 116,5 bilijonov dolarjev za potrebe narodne obrambe v proračunskem letu, ki se je začelo preteklo nedeljo, 1. oktobra.

OSLO, Nor. — Letošnjo Nobelovo nagrado za literaturo je dobil 74 let star Isaac Singer, eden od zadnjih velikih pisateljev v jeziku Judov "yiddish". Singer je bil rojen in je živel na Poljskem, pa se leta 1935 preselil v ZDA.

Gospodarska pomoč ZDA Siriji pogojava

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Kongresna konferanca je odobrila 30 milijonov dolarjev pomoči Siriji, toda le v slučaju, če predsednik ZDA ugotovi, da "bo to v korist napora za doseg o miru na Srednjem vzhodu".

Sirija je med državami, ki naprotujejo Sadatovemu iskanju miru, in je odklonila sporazume, dosežene v Camp David.

Izrael bo ustanovil 20 novih naselij ob meji v puščavi Negev

TEL AVIV, Izr. — Poljedelski minister Ariel Sharon, ki je odgovoren za ustanavljanje novih naselij, je dejal prebivalcem izraelskih naselij na Sinajskem polotoku, ki jih je Izrael oblikoval ukiniti, da bodo ustanovili 20 novih naselij v puščavi Negev, v bližini Egipta, in vanje preselili ene Izraelce, ki so sedaj v naseljih na Sinajskem polotoku, ki bo vrnjen Egiptu.

Sharon je pozval prebivalce izraelskih naselij na Sinaju, naj mirno opravljajo svoja dela in gredo po svojem vsakdanjem poslu, dokler ne bo prišel čas za ukinitve njihovih naselij.

Nova naselja v puščavi Negev bodo pripravljena za vselitev po izjavi Ariela Sharona v nekako treh letih. Po vsem sodeč misli, da dotlej sedanja izraelska naselja na Sinajskem polotoku ne bodo ukiniti.

Somoza zavrača novo vlado

MANAGU, Nik. — Predsednik republike Anastasio Somoza je dejal, da naj se poseben odbor OAD za posredovanje v Nikaragui, loti izdelave okvira za nove državne volitve leta 1981, opusti pa naj misel na sestavo kake nove vlade.

Somoza je odločen ostati na vladu do konca svoje sedanje poslovne dobe. Kljub gospodarskim težavam, v katerih se nahaja Nikaragua zaradi tritedenske državljanske vojne, ki so jo začeli levičarski gverilci Sandinisti, mu bo to verjetno uspelo, ker mu je vojska ostala zvesta.

Indira Gandhi obišče Veliko Britanijo

NEW DELHI, Ind. — Vlada je dovolila bivši predsednici vlade Indiri Gandhi, da gre na proslavo rojstnega dne svojega pokojnega očeta Nehruja v Veliko Britanijo, četudi je v sodni preiskavi.

Kulturna dejavnost med nami peša, vedno manj je požrtvovalnosti, vedno težje je dobiti igralce in igralke, manjka pa tudi sposobnih režiserjev.

Discussion between Krakowski and Brown centered on recent developments in Small Claims Court. The State legislature on June 30, 1978 raised the maximum claim from \$300 to \$500, thereby enabling Small Claims Courts to handle many more cases than previously.

SLOVENE PRESENCE AT SLAVIC CONVENTION

The Tenth National Convention of the American Association for the Advancement of Slavic Studies (AAASS) will take place in Columbus, Ohio from October 12 to October 15, 1978.

The Society for Slovene Studies, the only Slovene academic organization formally affiliated with the AAASS, will have two sessions at this Convention. Amerika Domovina readers and others in the Columbus area are encouraged to attend and to participate.

An especially important and timely panel will be chaired by Metod M. Milac of Syracuse University on Sunday, October 15, 11:15-1:15 p.m. It is entitled THE MINORITIES OF CENTRAL EUROPE: THE CASE OF CARINTHIA. Papers will be presented by the following scholars: Rudolf P. Cujes of St. Francis Xavier University will discuss "Minorities Methodological Questions in Relation to Slovanes of Carinthia"; Thomas M. Barker of the State University of New York at Albany—whose book *The Slovenes of Carinthia* is known to many—will offer "The Carinthian Slovene Intelligentsia since World War Two"; Andreas Moritsch of the University of Vienna, Austria will present "Economic Prospects of Southern Carinthia: Is Regionalism Possible?". The discussant for these papers will be Stephan M. Horak of Eastern Illinois University. Time permitting of course, as is customary at such gatherings, members of the audience will have the right to ask questions and take part in the debate.

In short, the AAASS Convention will be held at the Neil House, which is a hotel in downtown Columbus directly across the street from the Ohio State Capitol Building. In addition to the Slovene papers and panels, of course, there will be a very broad spectrum of scholarship represented. Among the events, for example, will be a session involving the Yugoslav dissident, Mihajlo Mihailov, which should be fascinating to all those interested in the present and future of Yugoslavia. This session will begin at 9:00 p.m. on Thursday evening, October 12.
