Kongres bi se rad izognil povabilu Hruščeva na skupni način obih zbornic, pa sodijo, da bo to težko storil, ker ne more svojega zasedanja pred tem končati. Ce bi zasedanje namerno prekinil za čas obiska, bi Hruščev to lahko smatral za "zalitev," trdijo oni, ki ga že považajo pred Kongres.

Po naše bo žalitev za kongres in vso svobodoljubno našo deželo, če bo sovjetski oblastnik v resnicu povabljen v Kongres in bo tam tudi govoril.

Krishna Menon je znan komunistični sotopnik.

TOKIO, Jap. — Japonski diplomati proučujejo ozadje kitajskega vpada v Laos in Indijo. Pri tem so prišli do zaključka, da Peipingu nemara sploh ni do sprejema v Združene narode, za kar se javno zavzemajo že vseh deset let.

Kot nečlanici se rdeči Kitajski niti ni treba pretvarjati, da se drži načel te mednarodne ustanove, kot delajo to Sovjeti in ostale komunistične države.

## Vedno na "lovu"

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Ameriško vojno ladjevje je stalno za petami sovjetskim podmornicam, ki zaidejo v Atlantik. Sovjetske podmornice to zasledovanje lahko ugotovijo s svojimi napravami in morajo računati s tem, da se bo pojavilo nad njimi ameriško letalo, kakor hitro se prikazajo nad vodo površino.

Mornarica trdi, da imajo Sovjeti podmornice z vodljivimi izstrelki podobnimi naši "Polaris," drugi to zanikalajo, sodijo pa, da ima sovjetska mornarica podmornice oborožene z raketa mi s trdnim gorivom, katerih domet naj bi bil približno 100 do 200 milij.

Sovjeti je nedavno trdila, da so njene podmornice sposobne zasuti z atomskimi in vodikovimi bombami večino sredine severno-ameriškega kontinenta izpod ledu Arktičnega morja (Hudsonov zaliv).

## Novi razgovori med Pakistanom in Indijo

NEW DELHI, Ind. — Pakistanski predsednik Ayub Khan se je na svoji poti v vzhodni del Fakistana ustavil tudi na letališču v New Delhi. Tja ga je prisel pozdravil ministrski predsednik Nehru. Oba indijska državnika sta se pogovarjala nad eno uro. Je to prvi sestanek med Pakistanom in Indijo na takov visokih ravni.

Mislimo, da je to edina svetla točka v turističnem programu tovariša Hruščeva. Speljal bo ameriško radovednost na čisto novi tir, še njegovih pogovorov z Eisenhowerjem ne bodo tako vestno opisani kot to, kaj bo delala tudi družina tovariša Hruščeva, posebno njen ženski del, ki bo štel kar tri glave: ženo in obe hčerki. Upajmo, da bodo vsaj njim pokazali to, kar zanima vsekako žensko v Ameriki: izložbena okna v trgoviščih na Peti aveniji v New Yorku, velike konfekcijske trgovine, veletrgovine kot so Macy, Gimbels, ameriške šole, otroška igrišča in podobne stvari, ki zanimajo ženski spol, da ne omenjam salonov za lepoto.

Razume se samo posebi, da sta govorila tudi o komunistični nevarnosti, kajti na to cikajo besede Pakistanca: "Ako se bomo grizli v podrobnostih, potem bomo tudi potolčeni v podrobnosti, kajti take vrste so vdori v naša narodna ozemlja."

Rakete stojijo že na svojih vzletiščih, pa bodo počakale na odlet, dokler ne bo Hruščev končal svojega obiska.

Državno tajništvo je sporočilo, da Združene države ne "mislijo rožljati s svojimi raketami."

### "Atlas" nevarno točen

Zadnji preskus Atlasa so pokazali, da je ta sorazmerno zelo točen, saj je njegov nos padel komaj eno milijo od središča znamovanega cilja v južnem Atlantiku.

Vojški strokovnjaki so bili uspeha veseli, istočasno pa so se audi zamisli: Ce so naše rakete tako točne, so lahko, oziroma bodo prej ali slej tudi sovjetske.

Tako so se odločili, da Združene države ne bodo gradile nobenih stalnih oporišč za medcelinske rakete, ampak jih bodo postavile na posebne zelenčiske vozove in jih premikale po deželi ali pa na adje, ki bodo plute po Velikih jezerih, rekah in prekopih. Le na ta način se jim bo mogelo izogniti sovražnikovemu unčenju.



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## Priznanje delu in delavstvu!

Ameriški delavec je dosegel življensko raven, kot jo drugod po svetu ne pozna, njegovi voditelji imajo velik vpliv na javno življenje in njihova beseda pomeni dosti tudi pri vodstvu posameznih držav, v Kongresu in zvezni vladi. Nekdaj to ni bilo tako, delavec in delavstvo kot celota sta bila zapostavljana in izkorisčana.

Poganski svet na splošno telesnega dela ni spoštoval, zanj je bilo to opravilo, ki je pristojalo samo sužnjem. Krščanstvo je telesnemu delu vrnilo čast, saj je sam Kristus prišel na svet v delavski družini, sij z rokami služil vsakdanji kruh. Krščanstvo je tudi omililo položaj telesnih delavcev in do neke mere zmanjšalo njihovo izrabljjanje od strani gospodarjev.

Fevdalni srednji in zgodnji novi vek telesnega delavca še dolgo ni tako izrabljali, kot bi nekateri "zgodovinarji" radi dokazali. Srednjeveški grščak je bil, v kolikor je imel vsaj malo krščanskega duha, s svojimi posli in tlačanji dober; do poslabšanja položaja teh je prišlo še z uvedbo denarnega gospodarstva koncem srednjega veka.

Sorazmerno zaščiten je bil v srednjem veku tudi obrtnik v svojih cehih. Obrtni stan je prišel v mestih do važne besede, političnega pomena in gospodarske moči.

Z industrijsko revolucijo koncem 18. in v 19. stoletju se je položaj telesnih delavcev na splošno poslabšal. Ko so prišli v uporabo stroji, so hoteli njihovi lastniki, da bi bili ti vedno v obratu. Tedaj je prišlo marsikod v navado tudi 16 ur dnevnega dela. Gospodarji so trdili, da je to nujno, če hočejo vzdržati tekmo s konkurenči, na drugi strani pa so začeli trditi, da bi "počitek utegnil povzročiti med delavci nezadovoljstvo in celo nemire."

Prvi zakon o omejitvi delovnega časa je bil izdan na Angleškem l. 1833. Tedaj je bilo določeno, da rudarji ne smejo delati več kot 12 ur na dan, otroci stari izpod 13 let pa ne več kot 8 ur na dan. Leta 1848 je bil uzakonjen 10-urni delavnik, ki se je nato postopno skrajševal. V Združenih državah je bil l. 1912 že splošno uveden in priznan 8-urni delovni dan, l. 1938 pa 40-urni delavni teden.

Delavske unije so postale na Angleškem zakonite sicer že l. 1825, toda združevanje na temelju skupnega zahtevanja za izboljšanje delovnih pogojev in plač so smatrali za kaznivo vse do l. 1871.

V Združenih državah je bilo vmešavanje sodišč v spore med delavci in podjetji omejeno l. 1932 z Norris-La Guardia zakonom. Wagnerjev zakon je nato prisilil poslodavce, da morajo pristati na skupna kolektivna pogajanja. Tri leta kasneje (1938) je izšel zakon, ki je določil minimalne plače in uredil delovne pogoje v osnovnih industrijskih panogah. Taft-Hartleyev zakon l. 1947 je precej spremenil delavsko zakonodajo iz dobe predsednika F. D. Roosevelta. Spremembe in dopolnitve tega zakona so prav te dni pred končno obravnavo v Kongresu.

Delavsko tajništvo v naši zvezni vladi je bilo ustanovljeno l. 1913 na temelju sklepa Kongresa, med tem ko je od l. 1884 obstajalo kot poseben oddelek v notranjem tajništvu.

Gospodarski položaj povprečnega ameriškega delavca je brez dvoma veliko boljši od položaja povprečnega evropskega delavca, drugače pa je v pogledu njegove socialne varnosti.

Evrpske države so spoznale že zelo zgodaj, da je v njihovem interesu, če je delavstvo primerno plačano in zavarovano za slučaj nežgode, bolezni in za starost. Železni kancler Bismarck je v Nemčiji na primer še pred koncem preteklosti stoljetja uvedel socialno zakonodajo, kot jo v naši dejeli še danes nismo dosegli.

Socialno zakonodajo so po drugi svetovni vojni izpolnili zlasti v Veliki Britaniji in skandinavskih deželah. Nekateri trdijo, da je ta šla v posameznih stvareh že tako daleč, da cvira razvoj gospodarstva, ker da v človeku ubija smisel za podjetnost in delovno vnemo, če se ta čuti socialno in gospodarsko preveč varnega. Klub vsej kritiki je treba priznati, da so te države vendar dosegle velik gospodarski napredok.

Socialna pravčnost je postala važen pojem v moderni družbi. Njena osnova zahteva je, da naj dobi vsak stan pravice, ki mu gredo z ozirom na njegov položaj in pomen v družbi, pri tem so seveda upoštete tudi gospodarske koristi.

Evrpsko delavstvo je vodilo do druge svetovne vojne in delno še tudi po njej takozvano načelno politiko, ki se je v praktičnih vprašanjih često pokazala neprožna. Ameriško delavstvo s svojimi unijami na čelu je ubralo drugo pot: skušalo je postopno izboljšati delovne pogoje in zaslužek. To se mu je skoraj redno posrečilo, v kolikor niso njegovih zahtev ovirale posebne politične ali gospodarske razmere. Svoje zahteve je skušalo spraviti v programata obeh glavnih političnih strank, namesto da bi po vzgledu svojih evropskih tovarisišč ustanovilo svojo lastno stranko.

Skušnje, ki jih je organizirano delavstvo doživelovalo v zadnjih mesecih, so med nekaterimi delavskimi voditelji sprožile

razgovore o možnosti ustanovitve posebne delavske stranke, toda zdi se, da je namen teh govorov preje ustvariti boljše pogoje za sprejem delavskih zahtev v programata obeh glavnih strank kot pa ustanovitev lastne stranke, pa naj se delavstvo trenutno tudi čuti v še takoj neugodnem položaju.

Glavni predsednik AFL-CIO George Meany je pozval delavstvo, naj letošnji Delavski dan smatra za Dan jeklarskih delavcev, ki se prav sedaj trdo bore za svoje pravice.



**A NOTE FROM THE STAFF:**  
As this letter goes to the printer we are waiting for word from Congressman Bolton about her visit to the American National Exhibition in Moscow. Anticipating the possibility of a delay in communications from abroad, the following items were prepared before her departure.

**VISA PROCESS SPEEDED FOR VISITORS TO U. S.** New regulations designed to speed up the issuance of non-immigrant visas for people wishing to visit the United States will soon go into effect, according to a recent announcement by the Bureau of Security and Consular Affairs, Department of State. Among other things the new regulations provide for a simplified visa stamp, and improved procedures for revalidating and transferring visas. Consistent with the 1954 Presidential directive calling for encouragement of tourism and travel among all countries, the revised regulations will support President Eisenhower's designation of 1960 as "Visit the United States of America Year."

Earlier steps taken by the Department to expedite the issuance of tourist visas and to encourage travel to the U. S. include the adoption of a greatly shortened and simplified application form, and free tourist visas valid for any number of visits within a period of four years. Preliminary figures for the year just ended show that more than one-half million non-immigrant visas were issued to tourists and others coming to the United States temporarily. Surely the Department is to be commended for its efficient handling of these many applications!

**CLEVELAND WORLD POLITICS PROGRAM**  
Persons interested in free and open discussion of national and international affairs will be happy to

learn that once again the Cleveland World Politics Program has scheduled discussion groups for the fall, beginning the week of September 28. Presented by Western Reserve University, the Cleveland Public Library, and the Council on World Affairs, the Program offers a wide variety of discussion on political affairs, ranging from the basic series on World Politics to the more specific subjects such as Russian Foreign Policy and Case Studies in American Politics. Readings for each group include a cross-section of expert opinion, and provide the basis for discussions led by trained people.

In these days when more far-reaching decisions must be made than ever before, it is gratifying to note that a growing number of Cleveland residents are availing themselves of the opportunities offered by World Politics to clarify their thinking and form intelligent opinions on public policy. **CZECHOSLOVAKIAN CLAIMS DEADLINE EXTENDED**

The Chairman of the Foreign Claims Settlement Commission, Whitney Gilliland, has announced that the deadline for filing claims by United States citizens for the nationalization or other taking of their property by the Czechoslovakian Government has been extended to September 15, 1959. He urges all potential claimants to take advantage of this extension of time for filing their claims. If you lost property as a result of the program of expropriation of property and industry embarked upon by the Government of Czechoslovakia in 1945, you should write immediately to the Foreign Claims Settlement Commission, Washington 25, D. C. for application forms.

**New Volunteer Service at Red Cross**

Warren H. Chase, vice president of Ohio Bell Telephone Co. and chairman of the Greater Cleveland Red Cross, announced the creation of a new volunteer service with the Red Cross Blood Program here.

"This new volunteer post," Chase said, "will be that of Blood Program Aide." He pointed out that recruitment of women to serve in the new volunteer capacity is currently underway.

"In the past year the full burden of the volunteer work in the Blood Program in Greater Cleveland has fallen on the shoulders of only 339 women, who devoted 40,000 hours to its vital service," Chase said.
