Sovjetija je odobrila
moskovski sporazum

S tem so vse tri podpisnice dogovora o končanju prekušanja jedrskega orožja končale postopek za njegovo odobritev.

MOSKVA, ZSSR. — Predsedstvo Vrhovnega sovjeta, ki opravlja v imenu tega njegove načuge, kadar ta ne zboruje, je v sredo odobrilo soglasno v Moskvi sklenjeno in podpisano pogodbo o končanju prekušanja jedrskega orožja v ozračju, v vodi in v vesolju. Namestnik zunanjega ministra Vasilij V. Kuznečov je predsedništvo, ki je zborovalo pod predsedstvom Leonida Brežnjeva, zatrjeval, da dogovor ne daje nobene enotanske prednosti Združenim državam in čuva koristi Sovjetske zvezde.

Predsednik Brežnjev je tukaj debate govoril o možnosti mirne rešitve nemškega vprašanja, o sklenitvi nenapadalne pogodbe med NATO in Varšavsko vojaško zvezo, o vzpostaviti vi brezatomskih področij in drugih ukrepih, ki naj bi utrdili svetovni mir, ko bo enkrat stopil v veljavno dogovor o končanju prekušanja atomskega orožja.

Z odobritvijo dogovora v Sovjetski zvezzi je postopek za ustanovitev dogovora v vseh treh državah, ki so dogovor sklenile in prve podpisale, končan in bo v nekaj tednih stopil v veljavno. Angleška kraljica je dogovor podpisala prve dni septembra. Senat ZDA ga je potrdil v torek in predsednik ga bo podpisal, ko se vrne s svoje poti po Združenim državah.

Da bi omejili napore za prisvojitev lastnega atomskega orožja, predlagajo nekateri, naj bi tri podpisnice dogovora obljubile zaščito proti vsakemu napadu z atomskim orožjem tistim državam, ki se prostovoljno odpovede temu orožju. Malo verjetno je, da bi taka obljuba pripravila Francijo in rdečo Kitajsko do tega, da bi ustavili napore za svoje lastno atomske orodje.

Češka in Jugoslavija napadli v ZN kitajske komuniste

ZDRUŽENI NARODI, N.Y. — Za kitajske komuniste so se časi čudno spremenili. Ni še dolgo od tega, ko so vse članice komunističnega bloka kar tekmovali, kakor bodo zagovarjale rdečo Kitajsko. Danes jo zagovarja le še mala Albanija. Zato sta jo pa sedaj napadli Češka in Jugoslavija.

Posebno živahan je bil govor jugoslovanskega zunanjega ministra Popovića, ki je zato žel posebno pohvalo in priznanje s strani ruskega zunanjega ministra Gromnika. Popović je seveda zagovarjal tudi vse, kar sta se Tito in Hruščev dogovorila na Brijonih. Govor češkega delegata je bil strogo na liniji. Slišal se je tako, kot bi ga bili napisali v Moskvi. Pogodbo o končanju prekušanja je do sedaj podpisalo nad 100 držav

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Po-

dogbo o končanju prekušanja atomskega streliva je do sedaj podpisalo že toliko držav, da je ažje našeti tiste, ki jo še niso podpisale. Med njimi so Frančija, Albanija, rdeča Kitajska, Severna Koreja in Severni Vietnam.

Računajo, da bo kakih 9 držav še pristopilo k pogodbi.

V Rusiji suša prizadela vse pridelke, ne le žito

MOSKVA, ZSSR. — Cene na "kmetskem trgu" pričajo, da je v Rusiji suša močno škodovala tudi sadju, zelenjavni in sočivju. Za vse te pridelke so cene zelo poskočile, so povrečno celo višje od naših v Ameriki. Podražila sta se tudi krompir in zelje, ki igrata v ruski prehrani večjo vlogo kot pri nas.

V moskovskih trgovinah primanjkuje moke, pekarne jo imajo pa še dovolj, kajti kruha še ne primanjkuje. Mesarje so slabo zalcene s svežimi in konserviranimi vrstami mesa, vse po vrsti so pa dvignile cene. Vse to ima za posledico višje cene v gostilnah in hotelih.

Komunistični režim se je začel batiti tudi za prihodnjo žetev. Porocila z dežele namreč pravijo, da se je površina za jesenske poseve zmanjšala za okoli pet milijonov akrov, kar pomeni 10% manj. Čutijo se tudi prvi pojavi črne borze, rezimski organi so že začeli tožiti o "špekulantih in zakotnih trgovcih". Jesenski posevi so posebno močno zaostali v Sibiriji, za Kavkazom in Volgo, pa tudi v Srednjem Aziji.

Kubanski begunci postali nadlega za vlade Srednje Amerike

ZDRUŽENI NARODI, N.Y. — Vseh pet republik v Srednji Ameriki želi, da se kubanski begunci ne ponosačajo tako, kot se spodobi. Begunci so namreč zmeraj razbiti v razne skupine; med njimi je dosti pristašev svobodne demokracije, ne manjka pa še prijateljev diktature, poseljene v bivšem diktatorju Batisti.

V republikah Honduras in Kostarika se na primer begunci ne pripravljajo samo na to, kako bi strmoglavili Castra, ne marajo tudi demokratskih vlad v Srednji Ameriki in so pripravljeni sodelovati pri raznih uporih in revolucionih. V republikah Nikaragua in Gvatemaša so se nabrali v glavnem pristaši diktatorja Batista.

KENNEDY: POV RATEK V STARE ČASE NI MOGOC!

Predsednik Združenih držav je v govoru v Salt Lake City, sredi najbolj konservativnega predele dežele, poudaril, da povratka v "stare čase", ko se Združenim državam ni bilo treba veliko meniti za tuji svet, ni več, če nočemo škodovati svoji lastni deželi in njeni varnosti.

SALT LAKE CITY, Utah. — Predsednik John F. Kennedy se je na svoji poti po Združenih državah, tekom katere bo skupno obiskal 11 držav, včeraj ustavil tu in imel pomemben govor o zunanjosti politiki Združenih držav. Dejal je, da popolnoma razume one, ki se s hrenenjem spominjajo starih, lepih časov, toda povratka tja ni, izolacionizem kot zunanjja politika Združenih držav se je preživel in je danes nemogoč, če nočemo spravljati v resno nevarnost ne le ostalega svobodnega sveta, ampak tudi svoje lastne koriste, svoje lastno blagostanje.

"Politika umika bi bila nesmetna, če bi bili mi počisnjeni ob zid, gotovo je še nesmetnejša v času, ko morejo bolj odgovorne politične smeri dosegati take uspehe," je trdil predsednik Združenih držav poslušalcem v enem najbolj konservativnih predelov dežele, nato pa je dejal, da je največja značilnost položaja v svetu leta 1963, da se je tok zgodovine obrnil v smer svobode, našo smer.

Dve svetovni vojni sta pokazali, da Združene države ne morejo obrniti hrbita ostalemu svetu, če nočemo spravljati v nevarnost lastnega gospodarskega blagostanja in lastne varnosti. Pri presojanju sveta in naših odnosov do njega moramo po besedah predsednika J. Kennedyja vedno upoštevati, da sveta ne moremo enostavno preurejati po svojih ukazih, moramo priznati, da vsaka država določa svojo politiko na temeljih lastnih koristi ter da v današnjem času ni mogoče zunanje politike voditi na enostavnem načelu izbiranja "črno-belo", izbiranja med dobrimi in slabimi državami, cizromi državnimi sistemih.

"Če bi vzdrževali diplomatske stike samo z onimi državami, ki jih imamo radi," je dejal predsednik ZDA, "bi se v kratkem znašli skoraj čisto sami!"

Ura laikov

Sv. oče Pavel VI. je v preteklih dneh imel dvoje važnih govorov, prvega v Frascatiju, kamor je šel počastiti relikvije sv. Vincenc Pallottija v tamkajšnji katedrali, drugega pa na udeležence kongresa Zvezne ital. katoliških visokošolcev (FUCIS). V obeh je poudaril vlogo, ki jo imajo danes laiki v Cerkvi. V Frascatiju je dejal:

Sv. Vincenc Pallotti, ki je živel v časih po francoski revoluciji, je razumel, da so bile besede "bratstvo, svoboda, enakost" krščanske, a da so jih postavili pod protikrščansko, laicistično zastavo. Tedaj je svetnik tudi razumel, da je treba znova sestaviti krščansko družbo, jo združiti, ker nosimo odgovornost.

"Strašna beseda," pravi sv. oče, "in kdor jo razume, ne more ostati brezbržen, čuti, da ta beseda nemalo spremeni program njegovega življenja, morda malenkostnega in mameščanskoga. Odgovorni smo za naš čas, za življenje naših bratov; odgovorni smo pred našo krščansko vestjo; odgovorni smo pred Kristusom, pred Cerkvio in pred zgodovino; pred Bogom. To je torej beseda, ki more na poseben način vzbuditi dinamizem v duši tistih, ki jo razumejo."

Sv. Vincenc Pallotti je to odgovornost razumel in se je obrnil na duhovnike. Toda imel je še posebno genialno idejo: svetnik je spoznal, da morejo tudi laiki postati aktiven element, da imajo tudi oni odgovornost v Cerkvi. Nato pravi sv. oče, da je to spoznanje postal ena glavnih sestavin modernega gibanja katol. akcije. Vendar se to še pre malo poudarja in zlasti se premalo umeva. Potrebo je, da se laiki tega zavedajo. Vendar ne gre tu samo za to, da bi laiki pomagali duhovniku tam, kamor on ne more seći, tem več izvira ta odgovornost laikov iz globljih razlogov, in sicer iz dejstva, da je tudi laik kristjan. "Iz globin njegove vesti zveni glas: "Če sem kristjan, moram izpovedati to svojo srečo in ta svoj poklic. Če sem kristjan, ne smem biti negativen, pasiven in neutralni ali morda celo nasprotn valovom duhovnosti, s katerimi krščanstvo preplavlja duše. Tudi jaz moram vstopiti, dejal bi skočiti v krogotok milosti..."

Nato je sv. oče opozoril, kako je bilo v preteklosti. Cerkvena hierarhija je smatrala, da je apostolat in delo posvečenja duš izključno njena zadeva; laiki so bili le poslušavci. Toda danes je drugače: tudi laiki so se zbudili in se zavedli pravic in dolžnosti v Cerkvi in v kraljestvu Kristusovem.

V zadnjih desetletjih smo doživeli nov, neverjeten pojav: cerkvena hierarhija sama danes kliče laike na pomoč, na sodelovanje z njo. Pridite, pravi, in si razdelimo delo, prežeti z istimi ideali in stremeči za istimi cilji. Hierarhija kliče laike in jih spominja: Ura je odibila, ura laikov! Prišla je ura duš, ki so razumeli, da biti kristjan pomeni srečo, a pomeni tudi odgovornost za druge. Treba je skupaj z duhovščino ponesti križ Kristusov med današnjim družbo in oznanjati Kristusa sredi družbe, ki mu je nasprotna.

Tako danes kliče in poziva Cerkev k novemu aktivizmu in je to omogočila prav vsem, otrokom, ženam, moškim, izobražencem, delavcem. Zato se sv. oče obrača na laike in jim pravi: "Tudi vi, verniki, tudi vi, laiki, pridite in pomagajte Cerkvi. Pridite na pomoč duhovščini, ki jo je tako malo za obširno apostolsko delo..." In sicer je treba delati danes in takoj, nadaljuje sv. oče, "to je ukaz časa in potreb, ki so tako velike. Treba je delati danes, kajti jutri bi lahko postalo prepozno. Časi so težki in morda odločilni."

"Katoliški glas", slovenski tednik, ki ga v Gorici izdaja slovenski duhovniki goriške škofije, po katerem tudi posnemamo tale članek, pripominja ob koncu:

Beseda sv. očeta so jasne in istočasno zaskrbljene: Potrebe časa so velike, hierarhija in duhovščina jim ni več kos; potrebujemo laikov, ki naj zavzamejo v kraljestvu božjem mesto, ki jim gre. Beseda sv. očeta pa veljajo vsem, tudi nam slovenskim katoličanom. Če so kje zanemarili, oziroma pozabili na vlogo laikov v Cerkvi, smo to storili pri nas na Primorskem, kjer smo do danes držali laike le preveč v zakristiji, daleč od oltarja. Tu pa vidimo nove smernice v Cerkvi. Ob njih se moramo zamisliti najprej mi duhovniki, da bomo razumeli, kolikšna vloga gre danes laikom v cerkvenem apostolatu in poslanstvu; pa tudi laiki se morajo zamisliti ob novih nalogah, na katere jih Cerkev spominja in ki izvirajo iz dejstva, da so tudi oni krisjani v posesti milosti in resnice.

Beseda sv. očeta veljajo tudi za našo deželo, tudi za nas. Katoliški Slovenci v Ameriki smo največkrat pre malo dejavni, pre malo odločni v obrambi katoliških in krščanskih načel. Namesto da bi Resnico branili, se rajše molče umaknemo, namesto da bi se postavili za svojo vero in svoje prepiranje, puščamo besedo njenim nasprotnikom! Po zabljamamo, da je rekel Gospod: Kdor bo mene zatajil, ga bom tudi jaz zatajil!

Zato ga je delegat iz Nigerije v imenu 32 držav iz Afrike in Azije ostro zavrnil in mu očital, da vlači v kongoško vprašanje "mednarodno politiko".

Nigerijski delegat je lahko tako odločno govoril. Vedel je, da je denar za čete ZN preskrbljen, ni pa pozabil tudi na to, da je njegova država dobila zadnjih tri leta od Anglije \$89 milijone podpore, od Moskve pa ničesar.





Time was when you could be pretty certain that kitchen flour had been milled from wheat or—more rarely—from corn, rye, barley or even rice. Today you can't be so sure.


Not long ago, the U.S. Committee for UNICEF (United Nations Children's Fund) housewarming its new national headquarters building. Guests nibbled doughnuts and cookies—and sent their compliments to the chef.

The cookies contained over 16 percent of peanut flour, a similar amount of cottonseed grits and a pinch of soybean grits. Some of the doughnuts were baked with soy flour. Others contained nearly 12 percent of

flour refined from fish fillets! But this was no gimmick. Through UNICEF, millions of undernourished children are getting healthy on just such local protein sources never previously exploited fully.

UNICEF teaches that in the absence of meat and other conventional high-nutrient foods, you get your protein where you can. Coconut flour is 19 percent protein. The percentages range upward to 57 for cottonseed flour, 62 for sesame flour and 95 for fish-fillet flour.

Part of the secret refining. Roasted peanuts, for instance, yield 23 percent protein. But when they're concentrated into a white flour, the figure zooms to 90 percent!

Slate Drawing For Kelleys Island Hunting

Columbus. — With the signing of an agreement permitting reciprocal hunting on Kelleys Island by the Kellely Sportsmen's Club and the Ohio Division of Wildlife, this 2,400-acre area will again be open during upland game season to 50 lucky Ohio hunters whose names will be selected in the annual drawing. Each will be permitted to bring a guest, says Dale E. Whitesell, division chief.

The drawing will be conducted in the Columbus division office on Monday, November 4, Ohio license holders who wish to apply should send their name, address and hunting license number, including the prefix letters, on a postcard to "Chief, Division of Wildlife, Kelleys Island Drawing, 1500 Dublin Road, Columbus, Ohio, 43212." Postcards must be postmarked or received only during October. Do not mail them ahead of this period or they will be void, Whitesell says. Persons submitting more than one application will be disqualified.

Successful applicants will be notified. Each will receive a certificate of permission allowing him and one other person of his choice to hunt on Kelleys Island during the upland game season, beginning November 15. The guest privilege is limited to one person per season and cannot be transferred.

The brilliantly uniformed and kilts members of the Black Watch first visited America in 1758 when it came to attack Fort Ticonderoga during the French and Indian War.



PRIME MOVER

A representative of a major electric utility recently appeared before its state public service commission to defend advertising and other means of public communication it regards as essential to its business and to business generally. The hearing was called as a result of an antiadvertising petition signed by a small group of citizens in the utility's service area.

He made these points: "Advertising is the prime mover of the American business system. It produces high employment, high gross national product and high standard of living. The American economy is based fundamentally on mass production which can survive only with the mass distribution of the goods and services produced. Mass distribution in turn depends on mass selling which is advertising."

It was also noted that to outlaw utility advertising would be unconstitutional, in that it would abridge freedom of speech and deprive the company of due process of law.

Legal aspects to one side, a utility advertises to increase its sales and load — precisely as an auto manufacturer advertises in the hope of selling more cars or a food manufacturer advertises in the hope of selling more of its canned and frozen goods, or as any other producer seeks to interest the consumer and stimulate consumption. Take away advertising — and you'd take away a force that plays an important role in just about every aspect of our daily life. Advertising and publicity are a primary cost of operation in a progressive business or industry.

NEW HOPE FOR THE MENTALLY ILL AND RETARDED. Last week the House voted favorably for a three year program, totalling \$238 million for new research, care and teacher training in the fields of mental health and the retarded. This contrasts with the Senate version (S. 1576) passed earlier this year which would set up an eight year program costing \$850 million. The largest part of the difference consisted of a \$427 million, eight year, authorization voted by the Senate for grants to pay part of the initial staffing costs for community health centers. In its unanimous report the Committee on Interstate and Foreign Commerce said, "It is the strong belief of the Committee that Federal support is necessary to assist in the creation of community mental health services but such Federal support should be so tailored as not to result in the Federal government assuming the traditional responsibility of the states, localities, and the medical profession for the care and treatment of the mentally ill". Staffing of local mental health centers is clearly a responsibility of the communities and state government.

Mental illness is one of our most serious health problems. About one-half of the hospital beds in the U. S. are occupied by mental patients and the direct cost of caring for the mentally ill is approximately \$2 billion a year. The mental retardation field offers extensive challenges for research in prevention and in care and training. The need for additional and improved facilities for the care of the retarded is well known. The bill as passed by the House would seem to be far superior to the Senate approach and we are hopeful the House version will prevail in Conference. By restricting the new program to three years, the Congress will have an opportunity to review its operation during that period and to determine whether results justify a continuation of the projects. An 8-year program is too long if results do not match costs.

FEDERAL RESEARCH EXPENDITURES

Another recent House action was the adoption by unanimous vote of

a resolution (H. Res. 504) to create a Select Committee to look into Federally-supported research programs. The President's 1964 budget includes requests for the expenditure of nearly \$15 billion for research and development. This is nearly five times greater than the amount spent ten years ago.

Through its programs the Federal government now supports over two-thirds of the research and development of the nation. This is done through contracts with private industry, by grants and contracts with universities and other non-profit institutions, and by government scientists in federal facilities. No one questions the importance and value of research. However, the rapid increase in this phase of Federal expenditures warrants an intelligent and unbiased examination by the Legislative Branch which holds the purse strings. The resolution directs the Select Committee to give special attention to: the overall total amount of annual expenditures on research programs; what departments and agencies of the government are conducting research, at what costs and with what results; the amounts being expended by the various agencies and departments in grants for research colleges, private industry and every form of student scholarships; and what facilities, if any, exist for coordinating the various and sundry research programs, including grants to colleges and universities as well as scholarship grants. Such a study should be helpful in preventing project duplication and waste in such expenditures.

SAVING BONDS

Have you any of the old "baby bonds" — United States savings bonds of series A, B, C, or D? Although they no longer pay interest, about \$14 million of those bonds still are outstanding, according to the Treasury Department. These bonds preceded the appearance of Series E savings bonds in 1941, but there was no extension of maturity, as there has been on the E bonds, and the last of the "baby bonds" stopped growing in value in 1951.

GETTING THE MOST... FROM YOUR GARDEN

CAREFUL PRUNING HELPS SHRUBS AND TREES

Pruning is an art too often neglected in home gardens, usually because it is something of a mystery to many people. They may not understand the reasons for it and its many advantages, or not be sure of what it is that needs to be done and how to go about it for the different kinds of shrubs and trees. And there are others who seem to regard the removal of boughs or branches as a sort of mutilation.

Actually, of course, nature itself after the flowering period. Those is a constant if unscientific pruner, that flower later in the summer, bearing their blooms on new wood, branches with their burden of leaves wither from shade, are broken by heavy fruiting, wind, or snow and ice — usually leaving ragged wounds through which the germs of disease and decay can enter. We can improve upon these rugged methods, though not by following such old sayings as that the time for pruning is when the saw is sharp. On the contrary, the habits and needs of each tree or shrub should be considered, so that it will be helped, not harmed, and so that it will meet our desire to have it grow more shapely.

Not much pruning is necessary as a rule, and too little is better than too much; but certainly all dead or diseased branches should be removed, and also the stragglers and the crisscrossed or crowded which need trimming and thinning.

Overgrown foundation plantings and shrubs or trees that are now too large for their surroundings in the garden can be checked in growth with no harm to themselves and advantage to all else. Indeed, some flowering shrubs, such as lilac, spirea, weigela and viburnum, need to have old wood cut back in the dormant season so that young growth may develop in spring. This is sometimes called rejuvenation pruning.


Magnolia, dogwood, crabapple, and other flowering trees require little more pruning than the removal of dead wood and thinning where branches may be getting in one another's way. Fruit trees, on the other hand, should be pruned to avoid a central stem, or leader, and instead to have an open structure admitting light and air freely. The best time for this operation is while they are dormant.

Shrubs that flower in spring, such as forsythia and spirea vanhouttei, bear their blooms on wood of the previous summer's growth and should therefore not be pruned until they are dormant.

NATIONALITIES SERVICES CENTER

a United Appeal agency at 1620 Prospect Ave., always keeps its door open to Cleveland's foreign born population.

Nationalities Services Center, a United Appeal agency, is widely known and respected by all Cleveland's foreign born, but some of its work involving much time and research still goes by unnoticed by the public.

For example, the center for nearly two years has been helping a Greek alien who is desperately trying to recover the custody of her four-year-old boy. To do this, NSC worked with two other UA agencies: Children's Services and International Social Services.

It all started when Mrs. X., hearing that there was a large Greek settlement in Cleveland, arrived here from New York to find a good attorney.

She first came to the United States in 1926, and settled in New York City. In 1956, she married a man from her native country. The couple had two children, a boy in 1959; and a girl in 1960. Neither party ever applied for citizenship papers. Shortly after the girl was born, the couple had marital difficulties which culminated in a separation in 1961.

Custody of the children was given to the wife. Mr. X. was allowed to visit his son each Sunday and was not permitted to take him out of the house. However, around Christmas time he begged to be alone with his son and made such a scene that his wife consented.

Mr. X. and the boy hurried to the airport and took off for Greece. Desperate, Mrs. X. then came to Cleveland. — However, attorneys would not touch the case since the separation took place in New York.

Mrs. X. then went to the Red Cross who referred her to NSC. NSC first discovered that the separation agreement was not legal. Meantime, the couple's New York attorneys suggested the case be handled by social agencies.

NSC then contacted International Social Services, a United Appeal agency which assists in personal, family and children's problems requiring service in two or more

countries. Another UA agency, Children's Services, completed the personal investigation of Mrs. X. which was then submitted to ISS.

Mr. X. refused to cooperate with the ISS branch in Greece. Relatives reported to Mrs. X. that the boy was losing weight and was being neglected.

"The only way my wife will get back the child is to come to Greece and work out a reconciliation", he said.

Mrs. X. would not hear of this. She wanted a divorce, but did not meet the residence requirements in Ohio.

NSC then contacted the American Consulate in Greece for help. The Consulate explained that Greek courts will honor a decree issued by U.S. courts concerning the custody of the child.

Mrs. X. was then referred to an American attorney who is now in the process of getting a divorce for her and has filed suit for custody of the children. If she is awarded custody, NSC will refer the case back to the American Consulate for litigation in Greek courts.

The case is expected to be completed this October, the same time that Greater Clevelanders will be helping support these United Appeal agencies that give such dedicated service to those needing help.

For example, the center for nearly two years has been helping a Greek alien who is desperately trying to recover the custody of her four-year-old boy. To do this, NSC worked with two other UA agencies: Children's Services and International Social Services.

It all started when Mrs. X., hearing that there was a large Greek settlement in Cleveland, arrived here from New York to find a good attorney.

She first came to the United States in 1926, and settled in New York City. In 1956, she married a man from her native country. The couple had two children, a boy in 1959; and a girl in 1960. Neither party ever applied for citizenship papers. Shortly after the girl was born, the couple had marital difficulties which culminated in a separation in 1961.

Custody of the children was given to the wife. Mr. X. was allowed to visit his son each Sunday and was not permitted to take him out of the house. However, around Christmas time he begged to be alone with his son and made such a scene that his wife consented.

Mr. X. and the boy hurried to the airport and took off for Greece. Desperate, Mrs. X. then came to Cleveland. — However, attorneys would not touch the case since the separation took place in New York.
