Premogarji v francoski Loreni klijub pojavljajoči se stiski ne marajo odstopiti od svojih zahtev. Vlada jim je v dobrini polovici ustreza, dalje pa trenutno tudi ne gre.

PARIZ, Fr. — Ta teden je prišlo do prvih izgredov in spadov med štrajkujočimi premogarji v Loreni in žandarmijo, ko so prvi skušali preprečiti vstop v rudnik v Carlingu administrativnemu osoboju. Pri spadu je bilo več ruderjev in njihovih žena ranjenih.

Spadop je pripravil vodnike unije premogarjev do poziva štrajkujočim, naj ohranijo disciplino in ne povzročajo nobenim izgredov, ker bi to njihovi stvari v javnosti le škodovalo. Javnost jih je doslej podpirala, čeprav je štrajk povzročil pomanjkanje premoga in posredno ogroža oskrbo s plinom in elektriko.

Vladi se je posrečilo pripraviti delavce v industriji plina, da so se vrnili na delo, ko jim je bilo obljubljeno, da bodo deležni vseh ugodnosti, ki jih bodo dobili stavkujoči premogarji. Ti so zavrnili zadnjino vladnega ponudba in vztrajajo pri svojih zahtehah. Vlada trenutno ne kaže volje do novega popuščanja zahteve premogarjev, ker se boji, da bi to utegnilo sprožiti nove zahteve tudi v drugih industrijah.

Celo področje Lorene, kjer so premogarji na štrajku, je začelo čutiti v poslednjih dneh posledice ustavitev dela in zaslužka. Premogarjem prede trda, vendar izjavljajo, da ne bodo popustili od svojih zahtev. Štrajka jih blizu četr milijona.

Da združitve železnic C&O in B&O ne bo prišlo

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Obe železnici C&O in B&O sta dobro znani v naši državi, saj imata tu precej veliko omrežje in sta svoje dni igrali veliko gospodarsko vlogo. Danes se lahko shaja samo C&O, dočim je B&O v vedno večjih gospodarskih stiskah. To je dalo povod, da sta obe železnici hoteli združiti svoje prometne mreže v eno celoto.

Temu so se uprle železničarske unije in se proti nameram obeh železnic borile pred sodnijo in pred federalno administracijo. Zaenkrat se jim je posrečilo, da so preprečile unifikacijo, radi česar nekaj tisoč železničarjev ne bo prišlo v nevarnost, da pridejo ob zaposlitvijo. Kaj bo pa napravila železničnica B&O, še ni jasno, vedno bolj ji grozi vsaj prisilna uprava, ako že ne kaj hujšega. Obe železnici sta že davno omejili osebni promet na svojih progah na minimum.

Najmanj sto ruskih podmornic v Pacifiku

CANBERRA, Avstral. — Sovjetska zveza vzdržuje v Pacifiku najmanj sto podmornic, med njimi tudi nekaj atomskih, je dejal adm. J. S. Thach, poveljnik protipodmorniškega oddelka pomorskih sil Združenih držav na Pacifiku.

Ameriški admiral je prišel sem na posvet s poveljniki avstralskih pomorskih sil. Po njegovih podatkih vzdržuje Sovjetska zveza v Pacifiku od korejske vojne sem nekako enako število podmornic in drugih vojnih ladij, le da je od tedaj te izboljšala in jih tako napravila učinkovitejše. Večje število od njih je opremljenih z rakетami.

K sovjetskim podmornicam je treba dodati še kitajske, katerih število tudi ni ravno majhno. Adm. Thach smatra, da je rdeča Kitajska glede števila podmornic takoj za Sovjetsko zvezo, Združenimi državami in Vel. Britanijo.

Evropski strokovnjaki ne kritizirajo atomske ladje Savannah

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Federalna atomska komisija je objavila dve poročili evropskih atomske strokovnjakov, ki trdita, da nima atomska tovorna ladj Savannah toliko napak, kot jih ji navadno pripisujejo, da bi z radioaktivnostjo zastreljala zrak ali vojo. Ena poročila je prišlo iz Pariza, drugo pa iz Bonna.

Ladja Savannah je trenutno v Galvestonu, Tex., kjer zbljušuje nekaj njenih naprav. Potem bo zopet šla na obisk raznih domačih in tujih lukah.

Demonstracije proti ženski volivni pravici v Iranu

TEHERAN, Iran. — V verskem središču Oum, kakih 90 milj. od tod, so priredili nasprotiniki vlade demonstracije proti agrarni reformi, ki jo izvaja šahova vlada, in proti volivni pravici žensk.

V mestu Taebriz, v bližini ruske meje, je prišlo pretekli petek do ostrih spopadov med ženskami, ki so slavile pridobitev volivne pravice, ter med študenti muslimanske teologije. Štiri osebe so bile pri tem mrtve, okoli 60 pa ranjenih.

Rdeči Kilajci dolžijo Indijo kršilive meje

Po kitajskih trditvah obnavljajo Indijci utrdbe na meji Sikima in Tibeta, ki so jih morali lani zapustiti.

HONG KONG. — Kitajska in Indija si medsebojno očitava vojaške priprave za morebitni novspad v himalajskih gorah. Lani so Kitajci Indijce pognali daleč v dolino, pokazali svojo vojaško premoč, pa se nato sami umaknili na stare postojanke. Po indijskih virih zbirajo sedaj nove čete in vojaške potrebščine v Tibetu, ki mora služiti za vsak pohod v Indijo.

Kitajci se pritožujejo, da Indijci ne kažejo nobene dobre volje za sporazum, da se s pomočjo Zahoda oborožujejo in pripravljajo na vojno. Hudo zamejijo Indiji, da je dovolila Dalaj lami, duhovnemu in nekdaj tudi svetemu vodniku Tibeta, da je v Indiji objavil novo ustavo za svobodni Tibet, ki ga Kitajci smatrajo za del Kitajske.

Pejpiški radio je objavil, da je Kitajska poslala Indiji noto, v kateri protestira proti krišnemu kitajskemu ozemlju od strani Indije vzdolž kitajke meje s kneževino Sikim, ki je pod indijskim protektoratom. Indijci naj bi po podatkih omenjene note obnovili in zgradili še nove obrambne postojanke na sedlu Natu, meji Sikima in Tibeta. Indijske vojaške utrobove in naprave naj bi bile na tibetanski strani prelaza. Kitajci trdijo, da so indijska letala do sedaj zahajala že 100.000 akrov orne zemlje, ki je zgubljena za zmeraj. Radi katastrofe je nastala tudi brezposelnost, bojijo se, da bo dosegla število 350.000.

Administracija govori zopet o novi konjunkturi

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Go-spodarska komisija, ki svetuje predsedniku o vseh gospodarskih vprašanjih, je zopet postala optimistična in upa, da čaka nova konjunktura kar pred vratiti. Od 16 uradnih znakov, ki napovedujejo bodočnost gospodarskega razvoja, jih kaže namreč 12 na konjunkturo. Zato pričakuje administracija, da bo bomo doživelji nobenega gospodarskega zastoja.

Obenem je toliko previdna, da ne napoveduje, kakšen vpliv bi konjunktura imela na stanje brezposelnosti. Ravnost tisti znaki, ki obravnavajo zaposlitve, so namreč precej nejasni, ne kažejo ne navzgor ne navzdol.

Vsekakor administracija ne more dočakati, da se bo z letalno krizo za agitacijo za znižanje davkov in davčne reforme.

Mehikanski predsednik Lopez na obisku v Parizu

PARIZ, Fr. — Mr. Lopez je prvi mehikanski predsednik, ki je obiskal Francijo. Razume se, da mu je De Gaulle pripravil obisk, kot se spodbodi. Tudi francosko časopisje ni zaostajalo v propagandi za visokega gosta. Da se je pri vsem tem cítila cíta ost proti naši deželi, ni bilo težko spoznati.

V svojem govoru mladincem na 7. kongresu Ljudske mlaide Jugoslavije je Josip Broz Tito poudarjal v začetku potrebo po gospodarski integraciji, ki je pogoj za integracijo v kulturi, znanosti in vsem — drugem. Priznal je, da socialistična zavest še ni v "deželi popolnoma zmagala", da se zato pri delu književnikov in umetnikov ter celo pri nekaterih voditeljih, vidnih članih partije, pojavljajo protisocialistične težnje. Te se brez dvoma kažejo najmočnejše na narodnem in gospodarskem področju, kajti Broz kaže na protislovja v "večnacionalni skupnosti", ki jih je treba odpraviti. Zavzema se za gospodarsko izenačenje gospodarsko razvitih in gospodarsko nerazvitih območij in za njihov enakomeren nadaljen razvoj. Pri tem naj bi "naraščal" seveda tudi življenjski standard razvitejših območij.

Josip Broz Tito pravi nato:

Takšna integracija je najzanesljivejša pot za utrditev in monolitnost naše socialistične skupnosti, pot za premanjanje raznih partikularističnih in šovinističnih teženj. Taka pot razvija večnaročne socialistične skupnosti, onesmogač nacionalistične izključnosti in prispeva k vedno večji monolitnosti take skupnosti, ne da bi pri tem bile prizadete nacionalne pravice te skupnosti, oziroma v našem primeru, pravice posameznih ljudskih republik. Višja stopnja enotnosti socialistične skupnosti z več narodnostmi je tudi prav v tem, da imajo vse te narodnosti skupno naloge razvijati in dvigati socialistično družbo na višjo stopnjo socialističnih družbenih odnosov.

Zato je mnenje, da je integracija v nasprotju s koristimi posameznih republik oziroma narodnosti, prav tako napako, kot je napačno tudi pojmovanje tistih, ki menijo, da mora integracija odpraviti narodnosti in da je njen cilj ustvariti nov, enoten narod.

Ti ljudje pravzaprav mešajo narod z državo, kar je nesmisel. Nesmisel so tudi pojmovanja tistih, ki menijo, da mora vsak narod, vsaka republika v socialistični skupnosti imeti vse lastnosti države. Razumljivo je, da ima lahko tako egocentrično pojmovanje zelo škodljive posledice za razvoj socialistične skupnosti. Obstajajo celo nacionalistični elementi, ki govore, da bi vsaka republika morala imeti tudi svojo vojsko, svoj denar in še zunanjo politiko. Seveda nimajo taki ljudje nič skupnega s socialističnim pojmovanjem narodnognega vprašanja, s tem pa so tudi nasprotniki socialistične skupnosti kot celote.

Napačno je prav tako mešati lokalistične težnje z nacionalnimi odkloni, zakaj lokalizem obstaja ne samo v medrepubliških odnosih, marveč tudi znotraj posameznih republik. Pri nas so to zelo pogosti pojavi, ki so prav tako negativni, so pa posledica neenakomernega razvoja naše dežele in določenih želja po hitrejšem razvoju lastne komune, občine, okraja, republike itd. Lokalizem pozablja na koristi skupnosti kot celote. Pogosto je zelo škodljiv, zlasti zaradi težnje po kramarstvu. V tem pogledu imamo zelo slabe skušnje in smo o tem že lani veliko govorili in pisali ter vzporedno tudi ukrepali.

Na pravilen razvoj večnacionalne skupnosti lahko negativno vpliva tudi hegemonizem številnejšega naroda. V socialistični družbi utegnejo takšne tendence pripeljati do ludih posledic, ki se načudno izražajo v emancipaciji in ločevanju. Čeprav ne pride do tega, se lahko negativne tendence izražajo tudi v nezanimanju za skupnost kot celote, v zapiranju vase in podobnem. Potemtakem je treba zlasti zatirati takšne tendence, katerih korenine segajo v preteklost, v kapitalistično družbo in ki so tuje pojmovanjem odnosov v socialistični družbi.

Hegemonizem pa se lahko izraža tudi v drugih oblikah, tudi pri maloštevilnem narodu, če je na visoki stopnji gospodarskega razvoja. Tak ekonomski hegemonizem ima korenine v egoističnih pobudah, v želji, da bi izkoristili svoje prednosti v škodo slabše razvitih narodov ali področij. Tudi tak hegemonizem je velika ovira za pravilen razvoj socialistične skupnosti kot celote.

V naši državi smo rešili nacionalno vprašanje na najboljši možen način, v skladu z marksističnimi načeli. Vsi pojavi in pojmovanja, ki sem jih omenil, utegnejo pomenu ali pomenijo negativne spremljajoče pojave v našem razvoju, v razvoju naše socialistične skupnosti. Take pojave moramo seveda odločno zatirati in preprečevati, a ne sa-

mo administrativno, ampak s političnim delom, z opozarjanjem na škodljivost teh pojavorov in s pojasnjevanjem njihovih vzrokov in posledic. Zlasti je važno, da pravočasno ugotovimo in odstranimo vzroke, ki lahko pripeljejo do teh in takšnih negativnih pojavorov.

Izraelski zunani minister Golda Meir je nedavno izjavila v izraelskem parlamentu, da pomaga nekaj sto nemških strokovnjakov Egiptu pri gradnji raket, atomskega, kemičnega in bakteriološkega orožja. 



Poland's Poznan Choir Coming to Cleveland Music Hall for First Time



The internationally celebrated Poznan Choir of Poland will appear in Cleveland for the first time on Saturday evening, March 30th at 8:30 p.m. at the Music Hall under the auspices of the Cleveland Opera Association, managed by G. Bernardi. The choir has a history which dates back to the middle of the fifteenth century, and a tradition which proves that a rich culture can never be crushed despite the most devastating of wars.

Originally founded in the middle of the fifteenth century, the Poznan Choir flourished up into the eighteenth century, when women's voices took over the roles formerly assigned to boys. In 1884 the Reverend Józef Surzyński reformed the traditional boys' and men's chorus. The Poznan Choir flourished until 1939, becoming famous abroad with visits to Paris, Vienna, Frankfurt, Budapest, Prague and elsewhere. During World War II a young conductor, Stefan Stuligrosc, disregarding the risk of persecution, reformed a small choir, rehearsing in cellars and attics and performing with-

in the religious services in the only two churches allowed to the Poles. On this base at the war's end, Stuligrosc reconstructed the Choir, and in the years since has brought it back to its early eminence, renowned in Poland and throughout Europe, and a living proof of the triumph of the Polish spirit.

Its current tour of the United States is a tribute to the unconquerable spirit of its country.

The program will consist of music by the famous masters of polyphonic music of the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries, choral music of the Polish Renaissance Masters, contemporary choral music, Polish folk and national songs, and songs from Moniuszko's operas. For part of the program they will sing a capella and to the piano accompaniment of Gertruda Konatkowska.

★ Ilhavo, Portugal. — A 63-year-old Portuguese woman accused of keeping her farmer husband in a pigsty for eight years has been charged here with kidnapping, mistreatment and cruelty. Police charge that Maria de Andrade kept her husband Paulo, also 63, naked except for a shirt in the dirt of the sty. Police found him after receiving a report from a neighbor.

★ Boston, Mass. — Heart Specialist Paul Dudley White said he wouldn't take part in a 50-mile hike such as those in vogue in Washington. "I wouldn't run in a marathon either," he said. "I am all for walking, but untrained muscles wouldn't stand the strain of a long hike like that." He said it's possible to keep fit without walking 50 miles. Dr. White has long advocated bicycle riding to keep fit.

★ London, England. — Sir Broderick William Charles Elwin Hartwell, fifth baronet, has been fired from his \$28-a-week job as bartender at Ye Three Fyshes tavern. Owner Thomas Gadsen said "the trouble was that he thought being a barman was just standing behind the bar and being sociable."

★ Athens, Georgia. — Sen. Thruson B. Morton (R., Ky.) has registered two complaints against the President's youngest brother, Sen. Edward M. (Ted) Kennedy (D. Mass.). "I wish he would not keep calling me sir" said Morton. "I wish he would not keep reminding me that he went to law school with my youngest son."

★ Hackensack, N.J. — "Go climb a tree," was friendly advice here. Officials, labor leaders and businessmen from Bergen and Passaic counties discussed job retraining programs for men displaced by automation. They disclosed that one definite need in the area is more tree and pole climbers. The retraining will prepare men for jobs with utility companies, tree nursery and tree surgeon firms. Top men earn \$6,300 a year, the officials said, but many tree-climbing jobs go begging for want of trained workers. Men taking the eight-week course may do their practicing on the trees in Ridgewood. Henry Leuning, member of the Ridgewood shade tree commission, offered the use of the village's facilities.

★ New York, N.Y. — A unique auto seat belt, a combination lap and chest type that is anchored at three points instead of the usual two places, was demonstrated here recently. The three-point belt, which is standard equipment on all Swedish-made Volvo cars sold in the U.S., consists of a single band extending diagonally downward over the chest and across the hips. The band is anchored to the car on the door pillar above the shoulder on the floor below the door and on the drive shaft tunnel where the single catching device of the belt locks into place. Tests have shown the belt can withstand a force comparable to 8,000 pounds.

CHERRY BLOSSOM FESTIVAL. The annual Cherry Blossom Festival is scheduled to take place from April 2 through April 7 in our Nation's Capital. The Festival had its beginning some 51 years ago when Mrs. William Howard Taft planted the first Japanese Cherry Tree on March 27, 1912. Viscountess Chinda, wife of then Japanese Ambassador, planted a second tree as a token of friendship between the people of Japan and the United States. This ceremony marked the official acceptance of a gift of 2,000 Japanese Cherry Trees which were planted in the Tidal Basin and Potomac Park area.

The outstanding events this year will be the 2-hour parade and pageant following, which includes the crowning of the Queen on Saturday, April 6th. Spring is a delightful time to visit the nation's Capital City. The blossoms and spring flowers, grass and budding trees seem to officially ordain the most pleasant season of the year.

HONORARY CITIZENSHIP FOR SIR WINSTON CHURCHILL

The House has passed and sent to the Senate H. R. 4374, which authorizes and directs the President to proclaim Sir Winston Churchill as honorary citizen of the United States. The former Prime Minister of Great Britain, who is the son of an American mother, was praised by all speakers as one of the outstanding statesmen of history.

As the author of the first resolution introduced in the 88th Congress directing the President to proclaim Sir Winston an honorary citizen, I am happy the House has taken this action. The gift of honorary citizenship in the United States of America is one honor, one token of rare esteem and love, which is within this country's power to bestow through the Congress. That it has never been done before makes it all the more cherished in the hearts of all who had hoped that this might be brought to pass. Certainly it is worthy of Winston Churchill's place in history. This is something no man can buy or acquire in any way except through the grateful generosity of the American people. It

is the most appropriate gift we can convey to symbolize the warmth and affection that an appreciative and admiring people feel toward him. The bill is now before the Senate Judiciary Committee. It is hoped that they will act without undue delay so that this honor may be speeded to Sir Winston.

DRAFT EXTENSION

As reported in my News Letter last week, the House has voted to extend the Draft Act for four additional years. In view of this many young men who have not fulfilled their military obligation may wonder about the outlook. The Selective Service and Defense Department advise the picture in general is this: A young man must register with his draft board at age 18. He is subject to at least six years of military service, part of which must be on active duty. He is subject to the draft from age 18½ to age 26, or to age 35 if he has been deferred before reaching 26. Barring deferment as a father, student, or on other grounds—he will be drafted near his 23rd birthday. As a draftee, he will have two years of active duty in the Army. Draft calls are expected to average about 90,000 a year in the next few years, only a fraction of the number who will be of draft age. But for everyone who is drafted, there are six or seven young men who enlist voluntarily so they can choose the branches of service they like and pick the times when they wish to serve.

Those who volunteer have a wide range of choices. They can enlist for two or more years of active duty. They can enlist through a local Reserve unit for as little as six months of active duty, followed by three or more years in the Ready Reserve. They can become officers under several programs—in addition to the academies and college Reserve Officers Training Corps. A young man can get a good idea of the ways he can fulfill his military obligation from an official booklet listing programs of all the Armed Forces. A copy can be obtained by card or letter addressed to: "It's Your Choice," Department of Defense, Washington 25, D.C.

ACCIDENTAL POISONING

Will your child be one of the 20 in Cuyahoga County who will be accidentally poisoned tomorrow? As you read this, does your child have within his reach one of the potentially deadly household products. Can you recognize the poisoning agents most frequently swallowed by children in the hazardous rooms in the home, the kitchen, bedroom and bathroom?

In 1962, the Poison Information Center of Cleveland, a United Appeal agency, received 7,851 calls about suspected victims of accidental poisoning. Ninety one percent of them were from parents of small children. Two of them died.

What are the greatest threats to children in the home? Aspirin is still the chief offender, although for the first time in 1962 there were no fatal aspirin poisonings in children. Soaps and detergents of all kinds are second and in successive order, cologne and perfume, paint, bleach, vitamins, insecticides, anticeptics, ointments and lotions, cough medicine and various hair preparations. Hundreds of other agents are responsible, from moth balls to cement and glue, for emergency visits to hospitals.

Unfortunately, another killer has reared its head after a lapse of many years. Kerosene poisoning killed two children in 1962. In each instance the child drank small amounts of too easily available liquid furniture polish which was left unattended and within their reach.

"If only we could impress upon mothers the importance of putting household products out of reach of their children if they must leave the room for even a few moments", said Dr. Barbara Kaufman, medical director of the Center. "So many of the accidents could be prevented with even minimum precautions when the mother must go to the door or answer the phone while using cleaning agents", she said.

Adults are no exception to accidental poisonings. In fact, their cases tend to be even more serious than those of children. Many cases of coma were due to barbiturates and to overdoses of sleeping tablets taken by adults who did not suspect the potency of these drugs.

In an effort to reduce the 300,000 accidental poisonings across the country each year, President Kennedy has declared the week of March 17 as National Poison Prevention Week. Information about poison prevention will be broadcast through schools, pharmacies, doctors' offices, newspapers, and radio and television to alert parents to the potential hazards in their homes.

Here are some simple rules to help your home "Poison Proof":


- Always keep household products in a safe place out of the reach of curious children. This includes such preparations as lye, cleaners, furniture and metal polishes, strong detergents, kerosene,

From the Indian Teepee



TUCSON, Arizona. — After two weeks of spring exhibition games, it becomes apparent that all of the kind words expressed in print and over the air this past winter about the Cleveland Indians' rookie outfielder, Vic Davalillo, have certainly been justified.

Everybody, including members of the press corps, agrees that this 147 pound Mighty Mite from Venezuela, is the most colorful player to appear in the Tribe's spring camp since 1951 when Minnie Minoso arrived in Tucson. As a matter of fact, he may turn out to be the most exciting player to make his debut in any major league camp in the past decade.

Other Cleveland rookies such as Rudy Regalado and Walter Bond may have displayed greater batting power here and some like Herb Score belonged in still another category. But no one has excited both the fans and baseball experts with such ardor as has Davalillo.

General Manager Gabe Paul has stated that he will publicly apologize on Cleveland's Public Square if Davalillo doesn't make the majors this year and thus far it appears that Vic doesn't ever intend to have anyone apologize for him.

Despite bout with the flu, a bone bruise on one of his hands and large blisters on the other, Davalillo has been one of the Indians' batting leaders with a mark well over .300. However, his full worth to the Tribe is not reflected in the batting averages but in the field and on the base paths.

He is a "hungry" player who has a devil-may-care attitude on the base paths and in the outfield. Some folks say he wasn't supposed to be able to go back well for balls hit over his head. Supposedly, that's why he plays center field deeper than most players. Yet so far this spring he's dashed back to the fence at least a half dozen times to snare balls many other players would never have reached.

On the bases, he provides a spark similar to such base stealers as Maurice Wills and Luis Aparicio, although he probably will never steal as many bases as either. When Vic runs, he's going to take every base he can. Let an outfielder juggle even for a slight moment a ball just as Chicago Cubs' outfielder Danny Murphy did last week and Davalillo moves to second with the instinct and speed of a frightened deer.

Or consider still another game against the Cubs last week when Davalillo blew a 2 to 1 game wide open by beating out a bunt down the third base line to start the sixth inning. The bunt so rattled Barney Schultz, the Cub pitcher, that he walked the next three batters and before the inning ended, the Tribe had scored seven runs.

Consider still another game of last week when Davalillo opened the game by striking out. But when the Houston catcher dropped the third strike, Vic reached first base and the Indians were on their way to two runs.

Writers from every city who visit the Indians' camp keep asking Manager Birdie Tebbetts, "Just how good is Davalillo?" This, of course, is a subject dear to Tebbetts' heart.

"He's a better player right now than Vada Pinson was when I had him as a rookie in Cincinnati", is the way Tebbetts answers the question.

"Is there anything he can't do?" is the next question put to Tebbetts.

"No, I know he will hit, he runs like a deer and has an outstanding arm. Maybe he could learn more about stealing bases, particularly in how long a leadoff to take but this will come with experience," Tebbetts replies.

Davalillo came to the Indians this year with some mighty fine credentials. The 23 year old Venezuelan, in his initial season as a regular, sparked Jacksonville to the International League pennant by leading the league in five offensive categories — hitting (.346), most hits

(200), most total bases (296), most triples (18) and most stolen bases (19).

Bobby Maduro, owner of the Jacksonville club and formerly the president of the Havana club of the International League, had first signed Vic in 1958 as a pitcher. Davalillo actually pitched through the 1961 season with just a so-so record.

In 1961, he played as an outfielder in the Venezuelan Winter League and led that circuit with a better than .400 average. With Jacksonville he was installed as an outfielder where he became a standout. Last winter, he again paced the Venezuelan League with a .390 mark.

If Davalillo can continue to excite the American League fans in a manner similar to what he has done in the Cactus League out here, then fans throughout the league are in for a fine treat.
