Doma in po svetu

- PREGLED NAJVAŽNEJŠIH DOGODKOV -

Adm. John Poindexter prevzel odgovornost za načrt o tajnem financiranju kontras — Reagan ni nikoli obvestil o tem

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Adm. John Poindexter, ki je bil Reaganov svetovalec za nacionalno varnost in kot tak vodil Nacionalni varnostni svet v Beli hiši, je priznal, da je on sam prevzel nase odločitev o tajnem financiranju kontras v Nikaragvi z denarjem, pridobljenim pri prodaji orožja Iranu. Poindexter je rekel polk. Oliverju Northu, da je ta načrt odobren in da naj North o tem načrtu molči. To pomeni, je dejal Poindexter, da sta v okviru Bele hiše vedela za to početje le on in North.

Poindexter je namreč vedel, da je načrt tvegan in da bi povzročil velike politične težave za Reagana, ako bi postal znan. Želel je torej, da bi lahko predsednik resnično in iskreno trdil, da o tem načrtu ni nič vedel in ga ni bil nikoli odobril. Odločitev je bila izključno moja, je rekел Poindexter na včerajnjem zasedanju kongresnih odborov, polk. North ni nič vedel, da Poindexter ni dobil predsednikovega privoljenja.

V Beli hiši so zadovoljni s Poindexterjevim priznanjem, ker potrijuje, kar je Reagan dejal od vsega začetka, da namreč ni nič vedel o tem tajnem financiranju. Poindexter je sicer rekel, da ni dvomil, da bi bil Reagan ta načrt odobril, ako bi bil predsednika prosil, čeprav v Beli hiši pravijo, da bi tega Reagan ne odobril. Predsednik bo imel televizirani govor, ko bosta kongresna odbora končala s svojimi zasedanji. V tem govoru bo povedal svoje mnenje o vsem tem.

Kongresniki in senatorji so deljenega mnenja o Poindexterjevem pričevanju. Nekateri pravijo, da admiral ni govoril resnice in da skuša preprečiti nadaljnjo politično škodo za Reagana s tem, da prevzame sam odgovornost za tajno financiranje kontras. Poudarjajo, da ni drugih dokazov, ki bi potrdili vse, kar Poindexter trdi. Tudi Poindexter je priznal, kot je North, da je uničil dokumente.

Nekateri člani kongresnih odborov, ki preiskujejo iran-kontra afero, vidijo največji in najnevarnejši problem v tem, da si je upal neizvoljen predsednikov svetovalec prevzeti nase odgovornost za tako tvegano početje, kot je bilo tajno financiranje kontras. Tako obsežna odločitev mora biti izključno predsednikova, pravijo. Tudi v Beli hiši priznavajo, da bi bil moral biti Reagan obveščen o tajnem financiranju kontras, da bi bil mogel načrt ali potrditi ali zavrniti.

Poindexter bo nadaljeval s svojim pričevanjem danes in tudi prihodnji teden. Svoje mnenje bodo pozneje povedali med drugimi državni sekretar George Shultz in obrambni sekretar Caspar W. Weinberger, najbrž tudi pravosodni tajnik Ed Meese. Preiskovalna odbora sta največ svojega časa posvetila tajnemu financiranju kontras, v bodoče pa se bosta zanimala za prodajo orožja Iranu. Tu je Poindexter povedal, da je bila ta odločitev kljub močni opoziciji tako Shulta kot Weinbergerja. Reagan naj bi bil največ misil pri tem na talce, ki jih imajo v svojih rokah hiši so bili prepričani, da bi lahko Iranci intervinirali pri izpustitvi teh talcev.

Poindexter je potrdil tudi, da je igral večno vlogo v vsej aferi takratni vodja CIA William Casey, ki pa je pred meseci umrl.

Bojne ladje ZDA bodo začele spremljati kuvejske tankerje že prihodnji teden — Iranci grozijo, da so pripravljeni napadati

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Dobro obveščeni viri v Pentagonu vedo povedati, da bodo ameriške bojne ladje že prihodnji teden spremljale kuvejske tankerje v vodah Perzijskega zaliva. V zveznem senatu so nasprotvnik te politike prenehali z organizirano opozicijo. Iranci trdijo, da bodo tankerje in druge sovražne ladje napadli in da bodo tudi napadli in zasedli vsa pristanišča ob Perzijskem zalivu, ki bi nudila zatočišče ameriškim bojnim ladjam. Čeprav v Beli hiši menijo, da ni pričakovati večjega spopada z Iranom, cena nafte na svobodnem tržišču naglo raste zaradi nevarnosti vojnega spopada v Perzijskem zalivu, ki bi lahko oviral ali celo ustavil plovbo na tem območju.

Zadnje tri dni so iraška letala napadla iranske patruljne čolne in njih oporišča. V zadnjih tednih te patruljne čolne napadajo in obstreljujejo tovorne ladje in tankerje. Pentagon pa je potrdil, da bo začela 18-članska ekipa ameriških mornarniških potapljačev iskatki mine, ki jih je v vodah Perzijskega zaliva položil Iran.

Kratke vesti —

Washington, D.C. — Na krajšem dežovnem obisku v ZDA je angleška premierka Margaret Thatcher. Sestala se bo s predsednikom Reagonom, državnim sekretarjem Shultzem in drugimi visokimi člani Reaganeve vlade.

San Salvador, El Sal. — Preteklo sredo zvečer je strmoglavl ameriški vojaški helikopter, na katerem je bilo sedem ameriških vojaških svetovalcev. Le eden je nesrečo preživel. Med mrtvimi je podpolk. James M. Basile, ki je bil namestnik poveljnika ameriških vojaških svetovalcev v El Salvadorju. Kot kaže, gre za navadno nesrečo.

Seoul, J. Ko. — Vihar, ki je opustošil po Južni Koreji, je terjal 68 življenj, več 101 ljudi pa pogrešajo.

Managva, Nik. — Sandinistična vlada je demantirala trditev, da so kontras gverilci zavzeli večjo vojaško postojanko v deželi. Dejansko so gverilci napadli vas v bližini postojanke, ne pa postojanke same. Vlada je povabila tuje novinarje, naj obiščejo kraj in si sami prepričajo o zadevi.

Seoul, J. Ko. — Opozicijski voditelji zahtevajo ostavko reorganizirane južnokorejske vlade, ki je zaprisegl šele pretekli teden. Opozicija zahteva »nevtralno« vlado, ki bi bila sposobna organizirati demokratične volitve.

Islamabad, Pak. — Pakistska vlada je zanikala, da je povezana v poskusu nekega pakistanskega državljanina, ki je skušal kupiti v ZDA radioaktivne snovi, katere bi lahko bile uporabljeni v izdelavi jedrske bombe. Pakistanec je bil aretiran v Philadelphia pretekli teden. Mnogi opazovalci pakistanskih razmer menijo namreč, da bi Pakistan rad dobil lastno jedrsko bombo. Sosednja Indija, s katero je Pakistan globoko spret, že ima lastne jedrske bombe.

Bejrut, Libanon — Policija je aretirala nekega krščanskega tehnika, uslužbenca libanonske vojske, in ga obtožila sodelovanja v atentatu na predsednika vlade, sunijskega muslimana Karamija. Karami je bil ubit 1. junija.

Reagan, North in kontras politika

Na tem mestu sem že pisal o kontras gibanju in o ameriški vladni podpori temu gibanju, ki se bori proti komunističnemu režimu v Nikaragvi. Režim je v mojih očeh res komunističen, čeprav ni tako temeljito zasidran - vsaj danes ne - kot so podobni režimi na Kubi, v ZSSR, vzhodni Evropi, Aziji itd. Pomisleke glede kontras sem imel in še imam radi sumljive preteklosti nekaterih vodilnih oseb in baje tudi navadnih »kontras« borcev, ki so bili povezani s prejšnjo zloglasno Somozovo diktaturo, in tudi, ker so bili in so še kontras tako očitno odvisni od zunanje pomoči. Sandinistični režim je res v deželi nepriljubljen, vendar to ne vodi do kaj obsežnega notranjega odpora. Ne beremo v poročilih na primer, da bi veliko navadnih sandinističnih vojakov prestopilo h kontras skupno s svojim orožjem, kot vidimo to v Afganistanu, ali da bi kontras v spopadih s sandinističnimi silami zaplenili večje količine orožja in streliva. Vtis imam, da kontras čakajo za vse to od zunanjih podprtih, predvsem ZDA. Kljub temu pa sem odločno za nadaljnjo ameriško uradno pomoč tem upornikom.

Stališče Reaganove administracije od svojega početka je bilo do sandinističnega režima povsem jasno, javno. Čeprav trdijo predstavniki Reaganove vlade in predsednik sam, da želijo v Nikaragvi le demokratične reforme, uvedbo torej parlamentarne politične demokracije, dejansko pomeni ta povsem upravičena zahteva konec komunističnemu sandinističnemu režimu. Noben pameten človek ne more verjeti, nemim, da bi Nikaragvejci prostovoljno izvolili komunistično diktaturo. To dobro vedo vsi sandinisti od predsednika Daniela Ortega do zadnjega člena sandinističnega gibanja oz. partije. Tako je ameriška zahteva za Ortega in njegove pajdaše nesprejemljiva. Reaganovci trdijo, da bi morda kontras lahko izsilili demokratične reforme v Nikaragvi. Na to trditev ne dajem veliko. Resnica je, naj si bomo na jasnem, da želi Reaganova vlada strmoglavit komunistični sandinistični režim. In s tem ciljem se strinjam.

Vendar je Reaganovi politiki kljuboval in še kljubuje drugi dejavnik. To je bilo in je še splošno ameriško javno mnenje in pa razpoloženje v zveznem kongresu, tu predvsem v spodnjem domu. Ankete javnega mnenja do današnjega dne niso nikoli ugotovile, da večina Američanov podpira ameriško vojaško podpiranje kontras. Tudi v zadnjih dneh, po zelo vplivnem pro-kontras pričevanju polk. Oliverja Northa, take večine ni. Lahko je govoriti o liberalcih v kongresu, ki niso pripravljeni aktivno kljubovati napredovanju komunizma, vendar je odločilni dejavnik glede kongresnega razpoloženja do financiranja kontras ravno javno mnenje. V svojih izjavah v dneh, ko je North tako vneto zagovarjal podpiranje kontras, so nekateri kongresni in senatorji povedali, da sami podpirajo tako politiko, da pa so imeli radi tega resne politične težave v svojih okrožjih ali državah. In to so kongresni in senatorji, ki so bili izvoljeni radi svojega konservativnega mišljenja od konservativnih in sredinskih, ne liberalnih volivcev.

Vsi imamo prijatelje, ki imajo drugačne politične poglede in ideje. Z gotovostjo lahko trdim, da Jegliča njegovi idejni in politični nasprotniki niso sovražniki. Vsi Slovenci so ga spoštovali in občudovali.

Velikonja je premalo poudaril, kakšne ovire in težave je moral škof premagati, ko je ustanovil in zgradil prvo polno slovensko gimnazijo v Št. Vidu nad Ljubljano. Na državnih gimnazijah je bil pouk v slovenščini samo v nižjih razredih, nato je bilo vse nemško. In kje je dobil Jeglič sredstva, da je odkupil zemljo, zgradil gimnazijo in stanova-

Zaradi tega je zvezni kongres nekaj časa zakonsko prečil vladno vojaško podporo kontras gibantu. Ker je Reagan tej odločitvi protivil in si prizadeval, da bi kongres zavil razveljavil, ni pa želel, da bi v tem času kontras gibanje zaradi ustavitev ameriške gromte podpore propadel, je dal vedeti svojim podrejenim, naj najdejo druge načine, po katerih bi lahko kontras še dobivali podporo ZDA, tokrat po »privatnih« virih.

In tako pridemo do zgodbe, ki se sedaj odkriva na zasedanjih posebnih kongresnih odborov. Od vseh dosedanjih prič, je naredil najmočnejši vtis na ameriško javnost polk. North, ki je neposredno vodil zadeve v zvezi s prodajo orožja Iranu in nato uporabo prebitka te prodaje za tajno financiranje kontras. Ker so bralci najbrž glede teh zadev bolj ali malo že seznanjeni, jih ne bom tu ponovil. Poudariti pa želim, da je v izvrševanju svoje naloge, pooblaščen od nadrejenih, polk. North lagal zveznemu kongresu, lagal javnosti, uničil uradne dokumente, nekaj jih vzel domov in šele pozneje pod zakonskim pritiskom vrnil. Čeprav se strinjam z njegovo razlagom o nevarnosti prodiranja komunizma v državah Srednje oz. Latinske Amerike, to že ne pomeni, da je človek upravičen kršiti obstoječi zakon, ne da bi bil za to kaznovan. Res je sicer, da je adm. John Poindexter priznal, da je on, brez neposrednega privoljenja Reagana, odobril tajno financiranje kontras. Ne trdim torej, da bi moral North v zapor, nikakor pa ga ne bom smatral za kakšnega »junaka«, naj bo javno mnenje o njem in tudi mnenje mnogih bralcev teh vrstic čisto drugačen. Isto velja za Poindextera. Bati se je treba tudi dobromislečih idealistov, ki so pripravljeni v svoji vnemi kršiti zakon, ko jim ta ovira. Demokratična družba ne more mirno trpeti takih kršitev, ker so zakoni v taki družbi demokratično izglasovani in dopuščajo možnost, da se po isti poti spremeni ali razveljavijo. V nedemokratičnem političnem sistemu, ki je po mojem mnenju prav radi svoje nedemokratičnosti nezakonit, ti pomisliki ne pridejo v poštev. A ameriški sistem ne spada v to kategorijo. Demokracija, ki ni pripravljena odločno braniti zakon, ni vredna tega naslova.

When his mother died here in Cleveland, Holmar decided to return to Slovenia in 1923.

Members of Lira choir during his tenure at St. Vitus recall that Matej L. Holmar was a truly professional and talented organist and director.

Spetich to be honored at Oktoberfest

Frankie Spetich of Barberton, Ohio will be honored for his exceptional effort over the past 50 years in the field of music and most especially his promotion of the Slovenian-style polka and waltz. The honor and accompanying award will be presented by The Medina Area Chamber of Commerce at its "10th Annual Medina Oktoberfest" to be held September 18, 19, 20, 1987 at the fairgrounds in Medina, Ohio. Making the presentation will be Tony Petkovsek of Cleveland, Ohio: himself a well known radio personality providing ethnic music for the past 16 years.

Born Frank Louis Spetich October 7, 1924 his first experience with a musical instrument involved an Albert System Clarinet in the third grade. During high school he participated in several school bands playing sax, trombone and clarinet and today there are not too many instruments Frankie can't play.

On entering the army in 1943 he had the opportunity to play with several armed services bands in England, Wales and France.

While in Germany he married Lili, a Ukrainian girl and the marriage produced three children; Frank Leon, Judy Ann and Michael John. At present Frankie is single, never having re-married after his divorce.

Following his 1946 army discharge he started a band named MELODY MAKERS and made melody from 1946 to 1949. In November 1949 he formed THE FRANKIE SPETICH ORCHESTRA which has been active ever since.

Frankie has recorded 18 45RPM's, 8 LPS and has three more awaiting release. Recording companies include Q-Cue, Spotlight, Pepperment and Marjon. Additionally, he played piano for a recording with Ted Zalac cut four country-westerns with Al Barket in 1960, recorded two polkas for Walter Ostanek with an all-star band consisting of Joey Miskulin, Al Markic, Joe Pianiki, Richard Ostanek and Norm Kobal.

"Good musicians", commented Frankie, "will help you sound your best!"

His Television exposure includes appearances on the Johnny Vadnal Show, Stylecrest Show, and Polka Varieties. Certainly no stranger to Radio, Frankie had his own half-hour show from 1953 to 1958 over WCUE Akron, Ohio; occasionally filled in for Tony Petkovsek over

WXEN Cleveland in the early sixties; and in October 1982 began his hour-and-a-half "Slovenian Melodies" which is still aired today from 4 to 5:30 p.m. Sunday over WAUP FM Public Radio at Akron University.

IN 1957 Frankie opened his own music store and studio in Barberton, Ohio and taught brass, woodwind, piano, accordian and diatonic button-box. The music store has been phased out, his studio is still open for students of all ages.

He has given lessons to adults from California, Mississippi, Pennsylvania, Mexico and many Ohio cities. The out-of-staters will phone Frankie to advise they will be passing thru Ohio on a given date and ask for an appointment for a lesson or so.

Frankie has hosted three tours to Europe in 1974, 1984 and 1987. One of his most humbling experiences occurred in 1974. At the airport and later at the Union Hotel in Ljubljana, Yugoslavia, an exceptional musician named Tone Buchan played the button box. From the sounds Tone was getting out of the instrument, Frankie thought he was playing a Chromatic. When he later learned from Tone himself that he was get-

ting those sounds thru his mastery of the capabilities of his regular button-box and not a Chromatic, Frankie was understandably embarrassed and confessed, "I found out how little I knew about the button-box" Frankie knows now, however, and can generate sounds and effects out of a regular button-box that is the envy of many of his peers.

Awards received by Frankie include a presentation at a July 4th picnic in Skofja Loka, Yugoslavia in 1974 recognizing him for four decades in Polka Service. More recently he was presented with an award for his "Slovenian Melodies" Radio Show over WAUP-FM Public Radio.

An example of Frankie's faith in and service to the polka: when the TV stations cancelled the Polka shows in 1957 because they felt Polka was dead, Frankie hired three bands to put on a Jam Session for a program he called "A Slovene Weekend" which was held in the Slovene Center Ballroom in Barberton. Doubters told him he must be crazy to gamble on such a thing after the TV people pronounced the demise of polkas.

Recipes

COUNTRYSIDE CHICKEN BAKE

1 cup uncooked rice
1 cup celery slices
3/4 cup chopped onion
2 teaspoons parsley flakes
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/8 teaspoon pepper
1 10 3/4-oz. can condensed cream of mushroom soup 3/4 cup Miracle Whip salad dressing or Miracle Whip Light Reduced Calorie salad dressing.
1 1/4 cups water
3 chicken breasts, split, skinned

Place rice in greased 12 x 8-inch baking dish. Cover with combined vegetables and seasonings. Combine soup and

salad dressing, mix well. Gradually add water to soup mixture, mixing until well blended. Pour half the soup mixture over vegetables, top with chicken and remaining soup mixture. Bake at 350°, 1 hour or until chicken is tender and rice is cooked. Sprinkle with paprika, if desired. 6 servings.

CAULIFLOWER PUREE

A delicate puree that's an interesting switch from the tried-and-true cauliflower in cheese sauce.

1 small (about 1 1/2 lbs.) cauliflower
1 tablespoon cornstarch
1 cup half and half cream

2 tablespoons butter or margarine

1 teaspoon salt
Generous dash pepper
Generous dash nutmeg
Cut cauliflower into florets. In saucepan bring 1 inch water

to a boil. Place steamer rack in saucepan (or a colander) and add cauliflower. Cover and steam 15 to 20 minutes or until tender.

In large saucepan combine cornstarch and cream. Stir until smooth. Add butter or

margarine, salt, pepper, nutmeg. Bring to a boil, stirring constantly; boil 1 min.

In food processor chop steamed cauliflower. Add to cream sauce, reheat if necessary. Makes 6 servings, about 115 calories each.





Immigrants Honored

A resolution in the United States Congress to honor America's immigrants, authored by Senator Dennis DeConcini (D-Ariz), and Congressman William O. Lipinski (D-Ill.), co-chairs of the DNC Ethnic Council, was signed into law on June 29.

The resolution designates October 28, 1987, the 101st anniversary of the Statue of Liberty, as "National Immigrants Day."

"A symbol of freedom — a new beginning, was what the Statue of Liberty represented to millions of immigrants who sailed into New York on their journey in pursuit of a new life," DeConcini said. "It is only fitting that on her anniversary we honor those she welcomed to our shores."

The Ethnic Council is dedicated to revitalizing the lines of communication between the Democratic Party and all ethnic Americans.

Senate Bill to discourage auto thefts

Columbus—Senate Bill 10, sponsored by State Senator Gary C. Suhadolnik (R - Parma Heights), designed to take the profit out of auto theft by tightening requirements for the re-sale of salvaged vehicles, was unanimously passed by both Houses of the Ohio Legislature.

Under the bill, if an insurance company considers a motor vehicle economically impractical to repair, the company would be permitted (but not required) to assign the title to a salvage dealer or scrap metal processing facility. In such a case, the insurance company then would be required to send the assigned title to the clerk of the court of common pleas of the county in which the salvage dealer or scrap metal processing facility is located, after marking the title, "For Destruction". Finally, the company would be required to deliver a photocopy of the title to the salvage dealer or scrap metal processing facility for its records. The bill would prohibit any motor vehicle titled with a title marked "For Destruction" and surrendered to the clerk from being used for anything except parts and scrap metal.
