Mednarodni Rdeči križ nejevoljen na Izrael!

Mednarodni Rdeči križ zanika, da bi sodeloval pri izraelskem nastopu proti arabskim ugrabiteljem letala Sabene na letališču Tel Avivu pretekl torek.

ZENEVA, Šv. — Odobr Mednarodnega Rdečega križa je izjavil, da so izraelski komandosi izrabili njegovo posredovanje z arabskimi gverilci v ugrabljenu letalu za pripravo in napad na ugrabitelje potniškega letala Sabene na letališču Tel Avivu pretekl torek.

"Poseg izraelskih oboroženih sil je zastopnike MRK iznenadil," pravi izjava Mednarodnega Rdečega križa, nato nadaljuje: "Mednarodni Rdeči križ ne sme dopustiti, da bi kdorkoli izrabljaj njegovo človekoljubno delo za vojaške ali politične namene. Zato odločno odklanja poskuse spraviti ga v tak položaj in obvezati, da se je sam pustil spraviti v tak položaj..."

Mednarodni Rdeči križ je pod svojo izjavbo kot odgovor na obtožbe arabskih gverilcev, da je "sodeloval pri zločinu". Izraelski prometni minister je arabsko obtožbo MRK odločno zanikal.

Izraelski padalci so v torek nenadno vdrli v ugrabljeno letalo na letališču Lida, ustreličili ob ugrabitelja ter prijeli njihovo pomočnico. 20 let staro Therese Izchaq Hilkah in približno enako staro Rimo Issa.

Van Thieu je zamenjal poveljnika na Osrednjem višavju zaradi neuspehov

SAIGON, J. Viet. — Predsednik republike Van Thieu je oklical vojno stanje in skuša s spremembami v vojaških vrhovih pripraviti deželo na trdnješo obrambo, ki pričakujejo nove močnejše rdeče napade na vseh treh glavnih bojiščih. Pretekli teden je zamenjal vrhovnega poveljnika na severnem bojišču, zdaj je storil isto na srednjem.

Ameriški vojaški svetovalci so že dalj časa dvomili v sposobnosti in v resnem voljo gen. Ngo Dzu, poveljnika vseh vojaških sil na Osrednjem višavju. V dosedanjih bojih se vladne sile niso dobro držale, dva redna polka sta razpadla, predno je sploh prišlo do boja. Sedaj pričakujejo glavni napad na pokrajinsko mesto Kontum, ki dejansko že nekaj časa nima več redne zvezze po zemlji z zaledjem. Glavna cena na sever in na jug je presegana in na več krajin v rokah rdečih.

Za novega poveljnika Osrednjega višavja z nalogo, da tega odločno brani pred rdečimi napadalci, je bil postavljen gen. Nguyen Van Toan, dosedanji namestnik poveljnika 1. vojaškega okrožja v Saigonu. Ameriški vojaški svetovalci v Kontumu sočido, da ne pojde toliko za številno vojaštvo in orožje, kot za voljo vladnih enot do resničnega boja in odpora.

Humphrey, McGovern gledala v Kalifornijo

Ko je vse kazalo, da bo Kalifornijo dobil sen. Muskie, se je položaj okrenil v korist sen. McGoverna po volitvah v Pensylvaniji in Massachusetts.

SAN FRANCISCO, Kalif. — Pred nekaj tedni je bil Humphrey daleč spredaj, zdaj sta pa kandidata v boju za Kalifornijo kar skoraj vstopi. Nihče ni prav gotov, kolikšna je moč katerega od običajnih demokratskih predsedniških kandidatov, toda socijo, da bo odločitev padla v naslednjih tednih. Razvoj v Vietnemu na odločevanje demokratskih volivcev ne bo stal brez vpliva.

Sen. McGovern je znan kot oster nasprotnik Nixonove vietnamske politike in kot eden prvih javnih kritikov ameriškega posega v Vietnam. Sen. Humphrey, ki je bil podpredsednik ZDA v času predsednika L. B. Johnsona, ko so ZDA z vso močjo hotele napraviti red v Vietnamu, je v očeh javnosti že vedno do neke mere povezan s sedanjo vojno, četudi se je ponovno javno izrekel proti njej in se zavzel za ameriški umik. Humphrey pri tem le ni za brezpostojni umik, kot je McGovern. Ta teden je Humphrey zmagal v W. Virginiji v razmerju 2:1 nad guv. G. Wallaceom, pa se v Nebraski, kjer se je meril z McGovernom, slabše odrezal od tega. McGovern je dobil tam 41% glasov, Humphrey pa 35, 12% volivcev je glasovalo za guv. G. Wallacea.

Kalifornija, kjer so primarne volitve 6. junija, je odločilne važnosti za oba kandidata. Kdo bo tam zmagal, bo lahko dobil vseh 271 delegatov za konvencijo.

Grečko v Siriji

DAMASK, Sir. — Sovjetski obrambni minister maršal Andrej Grečko je prišel sred tedna na 4-dnevni obisk in razgovore z vojaškimi vodniki Sirej. Ogledal si je položaj na izraelsko-sirijski meji.

naj bi Severni Vietnam opozoril, da je še vedno izpostavljen uničenju z letalskimi napadi, če bo nadaljeval z ofenzivo. Kissingerjeva pot v Moskvo je kazala, da bo morda le prišlo do obnove razgovarov v Parizu in do njih uspešnega zaključka.

Razočaranje je bilo veliko, ko je Kissinger na tajnem sejstanku z Le Duc Tho-jem spoznal, da Hanoi ni pripravljen na resna pogajanja, pač pa odločen doseči vojaško zmago v Južnem Vietnamu. V Moskvi so pri tem namigavali, da dela to Hanoi na svojo roko.

Po temeljitem tehtanju vseh možnosti se je odločil Nixon na zaporo Severnega Vietnama na morju, na kopnen in v zraku. Dr. H. Kissinger je dejal, da druge izbirne skoraj ni bilo in da "tveganje ni bilo nesprejemljivo". Z drugimi besedami naj bi to pomenilo, da Nixon ni raču-

Krščanski demokrati v Italiji so se okrepili

Pri parlamentarnih volitvah preteklo nedeljo in ponedeljek so krščanski demokrati nekaj malega napredovali, neofašisti pa so svoje glasove kar podvojili. Komunistična partija je pridobila 2 poslance, pa izgubila 7 senatorjev.

RIM, It. — Krščanski demokrati, najmočnejša stranka Italije, ki je na oblasti ves čas po drugi svetovni vojni, je pri nekajih volitvah kljub notranjim trenjem okrepila svoj položaj. Dobila je skupno 38,7% v starem le 30, senatorjev pa 26 proti 13 preje.

Okrepitev neofašistov je precejšnja, vendar ne tolikšna, kot so se bali. Položaj se dejansko bistveno spremenil, zato je tudi težko računati z naglo rešitvijo vladne krize. Ključ je pri socialistih, ki so zahtevali premik vlade se bolj na levo in predlagali pritegnitev komunistov. Volitve so med tem pokazale mal premik javnega razpoloženja proti desni, kar je brez dvoma povečalo odpor sredine. Ko je ta v začetku tega leta razpadla, je predsednik republike parlament eno leto predčasno razpustil in razglasil nove volitve.

Krščanska demokracija je nekaj okrepila svojo moč. Italijansko socialno gibanje (neofašisti) je svoje sile skoraj podvojilo od 4,6% v letu 1968 na 8,6% letos, komunisti pa so izgubili 2% glasov. Leta 1968 so dobili 30% glasov, tokrat pa 28%. Socialni demokrati in socialisti, ki so oba bili v vladni koaliciji zadnjih 10 let, se pri volitvah niso posebno dobro odrezali.

Pri takem položaju je verjetno, da bodo krščanski demokrati zopet skušali oživeti "vlado lice sredine", če bodo seveda za to tudi socialisti in socialni demokrati. Če bi socialisti delali kakšno sitnost, je možen mal premik proti desni z izključitvijo socialistov iz vlade, pa z vključitvijo liberalov in ostalih desničarskih drobcev, toda brez neofašistov.

V novem parlamentu imajo krščanski demokrati 267 poslancev, enega več kot v starem, in 135 senatorjev kot v starem. Komunisti, druga najmočnejša stranka v republiki, imajo 179 poslancev, 2 več kot preje, in 94 senatorjev, 7 manj kot preje. Italijansko socialno gibanje ali neofašisti, kot jih običajno imenujejo, so podvojili svoje sile. V novem parlamentu imajo 56 poslancev, med tem ko so jih imeli

KELLOGG, Idaho. — Sinoči so našli v velikem srebrnem rudniku žadnjih 7 pogrešanih rudarjev mrtvih. Skupno je v rudniku v požaru, ki je nastal v njegovem globini, našlo smrt 91 rudarjev.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Kon. W. Mills je izjavil včeraj, da je resen predsedniški kandidat in da upa, da bi mogel združiti demokratsko stranko, ki trpi na notranjih sporih in prepirih že vrsto let.

TOKIO, Jap. — Tukajšnji viri pravijo, da sta pluli skozi morški prehod med Korejo in Japonsko dve sovjetski vojni ladji proti jugu. Ena je bila težka križarka, druga pa rusilc oborožen z rakетami. Ugljibljejo, da bi mogla imeti tako zvezo z vojaškim položajem v Indokini.

All proceeds of the two day Festival will go for the two-story building addition to the Slovene Home for the Aged at 18621 Neff Rd.


In case of rain, the event will be held in

St. Mary's goes modern; guitarists help fill church

The 6 o'clock Saturday evening Mass at St. Mary's church on Holmes Ave. in Collinwood is fast becoming the most popular service there.

The reason is the guitar and folk singing group who provide modern music at that time.

THE PASTOR, Father Victor N. Tome, realizes this and is sincerely happy about it. "The youngsters came to me with the idea of singing a guitar-vocal type Mass at our church for one Sunday last year," he recalls.

"I told them if you want to sing, sing every week, not just once."

They agreed.

FR. VIC'S FAVORITE saint is John Bosco (1815-1888) who is famous for his work with the youth. Fr. Vic is the modern-day Bosco. He is known for his companionship and toil with and

for the youngsters.

So it was natural that his parish, St. Mary's, was chosen as the site when a group of high schoolers and college students and others in the business industry got together with the idea of singing some songs at Mass with guitar accompaniment rather than the traditional organ.

"We come from all over Cleveland and Euclid," says leader and full-time Cleveland State College student Larry Spilar, 715 E. 159 St.

"**MOST KIDS DRIVE** here from a great distance. I guess if you're really serious about something, no obstacle is too great to overcome," says the 24-year-old Spilar.

Thomas Somrak of Kent State University was instrumental in forming the group. They were first organized to sing at a Ca-

tholic Order of Foresters No. 1640 fund-raising event.

They decided that once the assembly was born, it would be a shame to waste all that good talent. That is when they went to Fr. Vic with their idea.

Their first church performance was in May, 1971.

BUT SLOVENIANS are very traditional.

"At first they (parishioners) didn't know what to make of us," Spilar recalls. "We were sitting in the first two rows in church and stood up and started singing and playing the guitars and everyone was looking and wondering where all that noise was coming from and what was going on."

"After a while, they got used to it and most really enjoy it now and look forward to coming to the 6 o'clock evening Mass





Tender fresh asparagus and chunks of chicken are blended with mushroom soup for a savory base. The corn bread topping, made with a dependable, time-saving corn muffin mix, adds complementary flavor.

CHICKEN-ASPARAGUS CASSEROLE

Makes 6 servings

Base:
1 lb. fresh asparagus, cut into 1-inch pieces OR
One 10-oz. pkg. frozen asparagus, thawed and cut into 1-inch pieces
2½ cups chopped cooked chicken
One 10½-oz. can condensed cream of mushroom soup

¾ cup milk
½ teaspoon salt
½ teaspoon marjoram
Topping:
One 12-oz. pkg. Flako Corn Muffin Mix
1 egg
½ cup milk

Heat oven to hot (400°F.). If using fresh asparagus, slightly sauté asparagus in 2 tablespoons butter or margarine. For base, combine asparagus, chicken, mushroom soup, milk, salt and marjoram in 2-qt. casserole. Bake in preheated oven (400°F.) about 12 minutes, or until mixture bubbles.

For topping, empty contents of muffin mix package into bowl. Add egg and milk. Blend only until dry ingredients are thoroughly moistened. (Batter should be slightly lumpy.) Spread over hot chicken mixture. Bake in preheated oven (400°F.) about 30 minutes or until topping is golden brown.

Slov. Chapel Book Still Available

American Home in one of its recent issues, and possibly also other Slovenian newspapers, contained a report on the final meeting of the Slovenian Chapel Fund in Cleveland and the disposition of funds that remain after payment of all costs related to the construction and dedication of the Slovenian Chapel in the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington. How to save electrical costs on air conditioners

With air conditioning weather here (last April 30 it was 88 degrees), would you like to save money cooling your home this summer?

By choosing a room unit with top efficiency, you can save about \$1.50 per month in electricity, compared to the least efficient model. The Illuminating Co. points out.

To ascertain efficiency, check the air conditioner's nameplate for the BTU (cooling) capacity and electrical use (watts). Then divide watts into BTU's. The more BTU's per watt, the more efficient the unit.

Some 7500-BTU models, for instance, are rated at 1300 watts per hour. More efficient ones use as little as 860. Naturally an 860-watt model costs more. But it will use about \$1.50 less in electricity than the 1300-watt model in a month of normal operation.

Operate the unit on the highest "comfortable" setting, instead of an arbitrary 70 or 72 degrees. (Each degree the room

is over 70 degrees saves about 5% of your air conditioning costs for that room.)

Shade out sunlight with draperies, awnings, etc. When possible, reschedule to cooler periods (early morning or late evening) such heat and/or moisture-producing activities as laundry, bathing, floor-mopping, etc.

For each square foot of room, allow 18 BTU's. Too small a unit won't cool enough. One too large will shut off before it can remove enough humidity.
