V tajništvu za socialno skrbstvo, vzgojo in zdravje razpravlja o zboljšanju socialne zakonodaje v pogledu pokojnin.

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Tajnik za socialno skrbstvo Fleming je na nekem zborovanju povedal, da se v njegovem tajništvu pečajo z načrti o zboljšanju sedanje socialne zakonodaje. Napovedal je, da bo tajnik Štvo zagovarjal povisjanje sedanje najvišje osnove za starostno zavarovanje, ki znaša kot znano, \$4,800 na leto.

Kako visoko naj bi šla nova gornja meja, ni povedal. Treba bo dalje najti način, kako bi federacija vsaj nekaj prispevala k strškom za zdravljene vsem tistim zavarovanjem, ki živijo samo od pokojnine. Tajništvo ni za to, da bi starostno zavarovanje nosilo vse bolniške in zdravne stroške. Potreбna je tudi reforma invalidnega zavarovanja, ki je sedaj navezano na starost 50 let, kar je očitno preveč hud pogoj. Zborovanje učenjakov ali borza za sužnje?

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Kot vsako leto, je tudi letos zborovalo pod okriljem Odbora industrijske konference večje številno Narodnih zvez za ekonomsko in socialno vedo. Največ zanimanja je bilo za javno debato o gospodarskih pogledih v naši deželi za prihodnje leto, ki se je udeležilo 155 najbolj znanih ekonomistov.

Strinjali so se v glavnem v tem, da bo prihodnje leto dobro za vse naše gospodarske panoge, da bo naroden dohodek dosegel višino 500 milijonov dol., da se krize ni treba batiti, da bodo cene kolikor toliko stalne, dela pa dosti in da se bo brezposelnost vrnila med 3,000,000 in 3,500,000.

V krogih interesarjev je to zborovanje znano pod imenom "borza za sužnje." Na zborovanje ne prihajajo namreč samo učenjaki, stari in mladi, zaposleni in brez posla, ampak tudi zastopniki velikih podjetij, ki iščijo moči za svoje gospodarske sekcije. Skušnja namreč trdi, da jih podjetja še najlaže dobijo ravno ob tej priliki.

AUGUSTA, Maine. — Včeraj je umrl v vladni palači 64 let stari demokratski guverner države Clinton A. Clauson, doma iz Mitchell v Iowi. Nasledil ga je po ustavi predsednik državnega senata 38 let stari republikanec John H. Reed.

Po sodbi zdravnikov je guvernerja zadebla možganska kap. Zapustil je odraslo hčerko in sina.

SESTANEK NA VRHU JE DOLOČEN ZA 16. MAJ

Predsednik Eisenhower je včeraj sprejel z zadovoljstvom sporazum med tremi Zahodnimi silami in Sovjetsko zvezo, da naj se sestanek na vrhu začne 16. maja v Parizu.

AUGUSTA, Ga. — Predsednik sovjetske vlade Nikita Hruščev je sprejel predlog Zahodnih sil, naj se vrši sestanek na vrhu v Parizu 16. maja, potem ko je preje sporočil, da 27. april zanj ni primeren. Svoje soglasje je sporočil v posebnem pismu Eisenhowemu.

Hruščev je pisal: "Sprejel sem Tvoje pismo od 29. decembra, v katerem se izražaš v prid 16. maja kot dneva sestanka štirih sil v Parizu. Sovjetska vlada smatra ta dan za sprejemljiv."

Pančen lama v ozadju

V novem odboru za upravo Tibeta po navodilih Peipinga na več Pančen lame, ki so ga Kitajci doslej vsaj formalno priznavali za vodnika Tibeta.

TOKIO, Jap. — Rdeča Kitajska je Pančen lamo, poleg Dalaj lame, najuglednejšega človeka Tibeta, pustila ob strani, ko je sestavljala novi Tibetanski ljudski odbor, katerega naloga je uvesti v deželi komunistični red.

Ko je pobegnil po uporu v Lhasi preteklo spomlad tibetanski svetni in duhovni vladar Dalaj lama v Indijo, so Kitajci priznali Pančen lamo za svetnega in duhovnega vodnika dežele.

Dejansko ni imel v deželi nobene oblasti, vodili pa so ga vendar po Kitajskem na razne proslave in ga kazali ljudem, kot podpornika rdeče vlade. Sedaj je izgleda svojo vlogo odigral in jim ni več potreben, potisnili ga bodo torej nekam na stranski tir, kjer ne bo mogel nikogar več motiti.

Spor med Peipingom in Rusijo dogovorjena igra?

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Zadnje dni se vedno bolj množijo govorice, da je spor med Moskvo in Peipingom deloma tudi dogovorjena igra. To se pravi: razlike v političnih ciljih in političnih metodah res obstoja, toda obe strani se ne trudita, da bi jih odpravile ali tajile, marveč jih včasih celo počrtavata z zelo razumljivimi namigi.


Mož je zajecljal "Gratias-hvala" in je tiho odšel kakor po lisičji tacah.



1 pound caramels 8 medium-sized eating apples, washed
2 tablespoons water 3 cups oven-toasted rice cereal, regular, presweetened, or coco flavor
3 heavy wooden skewers

Combine caramels and water in small covered saucers; place over low heat and melt caramels, stirring frequently. Insert wooden skewers in stem ends of apples. Swirl apples in caramel mixture to cover completely. Lift out of caramel mix and hold over pan to drain. Swirl apples while draining. Roll in cereal at once. Stand on waxed paper to cool and set. Yield: 8 Caramel Apples.

Polish State Folk Ballet To Make Cleveland Debut



Unique among song and dance ensembles of the world is "Slask," the exciting Polish State Folk Ballet which S. Hurok is introducing to the United States and Canada on a 25 city tour which opened Friday, Oct. 30th at Boston. Following a Broadway engagement, the troupe began a cross-country swing which will bring it to the Music Hall on Friday and Saturday evenings, January 8 and 9th and Sunday matinee, January 10th.

Young, as companies go — it was founded in 1953 — it has a glorious heritage of colorful folklore.

"Slask" is the idea of Stanislaw Hadyna, a well-known Eileens composer and writer, and son of a celebrated folk-song collector. His idea for a youth ensemble which would perpetuate the folk music of Poland met with favor, and in November, 1952, he set about recruiting the first members of this group.

He wanted sincere young people, with charm and good voices which could be properly trained or with ballet training. His problem was not in merely finding talent, but in discovering talent both fresh and unspoiled by stage routine. He had to use persuasion, both with prospective members, and in many cases, with parents uneasy about their children's future.

Not content with his own recruiting campaign, the indefatigable Hadyna launched a radio campaign in order to reach the widest possible number of young people.

There was an amazing response. More than 12,000 applicants, eager to become a part of the new organization, swamped those who had arranged for interviews and auditions. The Ministry of Culture made the Youth Palace in Katowice available and examinations were held for the next six months.

During this period, the committee selected one out of every hundred, so that by May of 1953, 120 girls and boys from all parts of Poland, but mainly from Silesia were ready to begin the exciting venture of starting a career and becoming part of something brand new. Most of the young people were children of peasants and working families and had never been away from their homes before. Their ages ranged between 15 and 16.

The Government had allotted to "Slask" the historic castle of Duke of Hohenlohe in Koszecin. This beautiful castle, located on a hill just beyond the village, had figured prominently in Poland's history. King Jan Sobiski stayed there during the period of his Vienna Campaign.

In July, 1953, all reported to

"Slask" made its first appearance in the fall of 1954 in Warsaw and was an immediate success. The press hailed these young heirs of the old minstrel tradition.

Since that first concert, their songs and dances have been performed before more than three million spectators. They have toured through the Netherlands, Belgium, France, Germany, Austria and the USSR. Their repertoire now includes some 500 songs and dances. Hundreds of costumes accompany them as they bring their unusual company to America for the first time.


