## Kenyatta priznava v Afriki nevarnost od imperializma Vzhoda

Predsednik afriške Kenije Kenyatta je bil hud levicar in se je rad naslanjal na komuniste, sedaj je opozoril Afriko na nevarnost, ki ji preti od komunizma.

NAIROBI, Ken. — Jomo Kenyatta je pred tisoči, ki so mu navdušeno kričali, izjavil tu, da v Afriki ni mesta za komunizem. Ta ne prdestavlja afriški svobodi prav nič manjše nevarnosti, kot jo je zahodni imperializem v preteklosti. Nekdanji vodnik gibanja "Mau-mau", sedaj predsednik neodvisne republike Kenije, je dejal: "Govorim jasno o tem vprašanju, da ne bo priložnosti za nobeno zmedo... Naivno bi bilo misliti, da ni nevarnosti od imperializma Vzhoda. V politiki svetovnih sil ima Vzhod za nas prav toliko načrtov kot Zahod. To je vzrok, da mi komunizem odklanjam. To je razlog, da smo se odločili za politiko neopredeljenosti in afriškega socializma... Žalostna napaka je misliti, da moremo dobiti več hrane, bolnic in šol s kriki 'komunizem'..."

### Spor v vladi

Med tem je prišlo do razkola v sami vlad, ko je trgovinski minister dr. Kiano zahteval odstop podpredsednika Oginge Odinge, ker preveč hvali komuniste, vzdržuje tesne vezi s kitajskimi predstavniki ter obdolži Združene države in Veliko Britanijo, da povzročajo notranjo napetost v Keniji. Odinga je v svojem govoru preteklo nedeljo obdolžil tudi ministra za gospodarstvo in razvoj Toma Mboja ter bivšega vodnika opozicije Ronaldu Ngalo, da sta orodje Velike Britanije v njuni kritiki komunizma. Odinga sam je dejal nedavno, da je "komunizem kot hrana".

Kenyattovo besede so bile brez dvoma jasen odgovor na trditve podpredsednika Odinge in njegove okolice.

### Kenyatta popustil Ugandi

Kenyatta je popustil v sporu z Ugando zaradi 11 tovornih avtomobilov orožja in to ter njene spremjevalec izročil Ugandi, ko ga je prišel za to prosit in se oprostil za kršitev kenijske suverenosti v Kenijo sam predsednik vlade Obote. Napetost, ki je zaradi zasege tega orožja nastopila med Ugando in Tanazijo na eni strani ter Kenijo na drugi, je sedaj popustila in razmere dobivajo znova svoj običajen obraz.

### Senat odobril črno za poslanika ZDA

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Senat je odobril 41 let staro Mrs. Patricia Roberts Harris, odvetnico in pomožno profesorico na Howard univerzi v Washingtonu, za poslanika Združenih držav v Luksemburgu. To je prva črka na takem položaju.

Zapustil je sinova Franka in Josepha, hčere Agnes Kainec, Mary Sila in Angelo Rakar, 16 vnučkov in vnučinj ter 17 pravnukov in pravnukinj. Pocojnik je bil član društva Bled št. 20 SDZ in Društva sv. Lovrenca št. 63 KSKJ. Pogreb bo v ponedeljek ob 8.30 iz Hopko pogreb. zavoda na E. 93 St. v cerkev sv. Lovrenca ob devetih, nato na Kalvarijo pod vodstvom Fortunovega pogreb. zavoda.

### Razmejitev je vprašanje tudi v vatikanski upravi

CLEVELAND, O. — Vprašanje razmejitev ne muči samo ameriških politikov, spravlja v zadrgo tudi vatikansko administracijo, kadar misli, kako velike so razlike med posameznimi škofijami. Vatikan vidi vse neprijetne posledice takih razlik ravno v Italiji. V Italiji živi 52 milijonov katolikov, zato pa je tam 322 škofij in skoraj 500 škofov. Razlike v obsegu posameznih škofij so izredno velike. Škofije v severni Italiji so odlikujejo po svoji velikosti, dočim so škofije v sredini in južni Italiji velikokrat podobne navadnim dekanijam. O tem premisluje tudi sam papež Pavel VI. Je že v svojem nagovoru na italijanske škofje, ki ga je imel 14. aprila 1964, opozoril poslušalce na gornji problem, ki ga je redilo "preveliko število škofij".

Razlike so velike tudi v drugih deželah. V Ameriki je okoli 40.000.000 katolicanov, škofi pa le 140. V Franciji živi skoraj ravno toliko katolikov, pa ima dežela samo 88 škofij. V Španiji je 30 milijonov katolikov, imajo pa le 65 škofij; na Poljskem je 28 milijonov vernikov 24 škofij, toliko jih je v Zahodni Nemčiji za 23 milijonov katolikov.

V Vatikanu se peča s tem vprašanjem posebna Kongregacija in išče pota za reforme. Vatikanski krogi pravijo, da bodo minula desetletja, predno se bo sedanje stanje bistveno spremeno.

### V Santo Domingu ne morejo do sporazuma

Uporniki so odklonili predlog vojaške junte za nove volitve. Hočejo najprej vzpostaviti "ustavne" vlade. Vlada palača bila vključena v mednarodni pas.

SANTO DOMINGO, Dom. rep. — Organizacija ameriških držav se prizadeva, da bi pripravila tla za sporazum med sprotimi skupinami v Dominikanski republiki. Zdi se, da se nobeni strani ne mudi preveč.

Uporniki vztrajajo na stališču, da so oni "ustavna" vlada in polk. F. Caamano Denu ustavnemu predsedniku republike, dokler ni v deželi Juana Boscha. Vojaška junta pod načelstvom gen. Imberta Barrere je predložila nove volitve, pri katerih bi naj sodelovalo "vse demokratske stranke", vršile pa naj bi se pod nadzorom Organizacije ameriških držav. Polk. Caamano je izjavil časnikarjem, da bi bilo mogoče misliti na nove volitve sele tedaj, ko bi imela republika vlado na temelju ustave iz leta 1963.

### Zadnji neposredni stik med oboroženima taboroma prekinjen

Brazilske čete so v smislu sporazuma, doseženega v torek s predstavniki upornikov in juntes, zasedle vladno palačo, ki je bila doslej zasedena od juntin, čet, med tem ko je bil trg pred njeno delno pod nadzorom upornikov. S prihodom brazilskega četa je bil pretrgan zadnji neposredni stik med obema skupinama in s tem odstranjena nevarnost za kak nov oborožen spor.

Junta bo v smislu dogovora umaknila svoje vojake iz vladne palače izjemo 25 mož, ki bodo ostali tam kot nekaka formalna posadka.

Zaradi pristanka gen. Imberta Barrere na vključitev vladne palače v mednarodni pas je prišlo v sami junti do precejšnjega spora. Nekateri njeni člani so namreč pritisnili, naj bi jutrine čete po tej poti udarile na upornike.

### Patron Evrope sv. Benedikt dobil svojo mašo

VATIKAN. — Sv. oče Pavel VI. je lansko jesen proglašil sv. Benedikta za patrona Evrope, Kongregacija za sv. obrede je sedaj odobrila besedilo posebne sv. maše v čast patronu. Evropa

bo praznovala god svojega patrona 11. julija.

### William Martin razburil gospodarske kroge

NEW YORK, N.Y. — William Martin ni politik, pa vendar pomni več kot ducat politikov. Je namreč predsednik upravnega odbora Federalnih bank in ima radi tega dosti vpliva na našo denarnino in finančno politiko. Njegova osebnost je tako močna, da si je niti predsednik Johnson ne upa dotakniti. Zato spada Martin med redke Amerikance na vodilnih mestih, ki lahko govorijo, kot mislijo, da je prav, in se ne ozirajo na Belo hišo.

V svojem zadnjem govoru na Columbia univerzi v New Yorku je precej brezobjzno izjavil, da ne veruje, da bi morala naša sedanja gospodarska konjunktura trajati večne čase, čeprav tako mislijo in trdijo gospodarski strokovnjaki, voditelji federalne administracije in zastopniki velikih podjetij. Opozoril jih je, da delajo napačno, ako pozabljajo na veliko medvjetino gospodarsko krizo pred dobrimi 30 leti. Se bolj pa grešijo po njegovem, ker nočejo videti, kako tudi sedanja konjunktura kaže mnogo takih znakov, kot jih je konjunktura pred veliko krizo pred 35 leti.

Njegov govor je nenačadno močno odjeknil na naših borzah, tečaji so začeli padati in se niso zaustavili. Padanje daje prav Martinu. Opozara namreč na dejstvo, da se sicer vsi veselimo sedanje konjunkture in blagostanja, ki iz nje izvira, da pa nismo vsi tako do optimistično razpoloženi glede prihodnosti kot so prenogli vidni voditelji naše politike in našega gospodarstva.

Mislimo, da je opomin predsednika Martina prišel ob pravem času. Res ni treba, da bi sedanja konjunktura dirjala kot dirkalni konji.

### Znižanje davkov mora odobrili še senat

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Predstavniki doma je v sredo izglasoval znižanje prometnega davka na avtomobile in vrsto vsakdanjih potrebsčin v skupni vrednosti 4.8 bilijona s 401:6 glasovom. Predlog za znižanje je stavila sama zvezza vlada. Če ga bo v sedanji obliki sprejel tudi senat, bo stopil delno v veljavno 1. julija, zadnja stopnja pa šele januarja 1969.

V znižanju je vključen davek na avtomobile, na gospodinjske potrebsčine, na kožuhovino, ročne torbice, na zlatino, toaletne potrebsčine, lepotila, na telefon, na vstopnice za gledališče in kino ter drugo.

Prva stopnja znižanja davka na avtomobile in klimatske

naprave bo veljala za nazaj do 14. maja letos.

## AMERIKA IN RUSIJA STA V TEKMI NA LUNO VŠTRIC

Bernard Lovell, direktor Jodrell Bank Radiotelescope Observatory na Angleškem, je izjavil, da je včerajšnji uspeh Gemini 4 in astronomov McDivitta in White pokazal, da sta Amerika in Rusija v tekmi na Luno dejansko vštric klub precejsnjim prednostim, ki so jih imeli Rusi od vsega začetka.

CLEVELAND, O. — Včeraj dopoldne ob 11.16 so vzliali raketo Titan 2. Mogočno in brezhibno se je dvignila s tal in zdrvila proti nebu z vesoljskim vozilom Gemini 4, v katerem sta bila astronauta McDivitt in White. Do zakasnitev vzleta za eno uro in četrtek je prišlo zaradi težav, ki so se pojavile pri zadnjem pregledu naprav in rakete same. Polet je potekal brezhibno, le da je drugi del rakete Titan 2, s katerim sta se astronauta v Gemini 4 imela namen srečati v vesolju, odletel dalje proč, kot so računalni. Astronauta sta mu skušala približati, pa sta prišla do spoznaja, da imata za uspešno srečanje z njim premalo goriva. Tako je bil ta del načrt v soglasju z nadzorniki poleta na Zemlji opuščen. White bi moral po prvotnem načrtu stopek tukom druge krožitve okoli Zemlje nekako nad zahodno obalo Združenih držav iz vesoljskega vozila neposredno v vesolje in ostati tam 12 minut. V drugi krožitvi okoli Zemlje tega ni bilo mogoče napraviti, ker sta bila oba astronauta preveč zaposleni z drugimi stvarmi, zato pa je bil načrt izveden pri tretji poti okoli Zemlje. White je nad Havajmi odpril svoj del vesoljske kabine, se dvignil na sponjem sedežu, nato pa stopil v vesolje. Tam je ostal 22 minut, 10 minut več, kot je bilo prvotno določeno.

Ko se je White vrnil v vesoljsko ladjo, je ta s svojima potnikoma kot predvideno krožila dolje okoli Zemlje. Astronauta sta sporočila, da se počutita dobro, sta jedla in izmenoma spala. Vodniki poleta na zemlji natančno zasledujejo bitje njunih srce, injuno dihanje, telesno temperatu in seve tudi temperatu v samem vesoljskem vozilu. To ima do prihodnjega ponedeljka še naloži menjati oddaljenost od Zemlje tekom svojega kroženja okoli nje. V celoti jo bo obkrožilo predvidoma 63-krat in se v ponedeljek vrnil nekje vzhodno ob Bahamskega otočja na zemljo.

WASHINGTON, Dom. rep. — V znani Cibao dolini, najbolj rodovitnem delu republike, je prišlo do manjših demonstracij proti vojaški junti, ki vladata nad vso republiko z izjemo dela glavnega mesta, kjer se drže uporniki. Vojaštvo skrbno pazi na razvoj in vzdržuje z odločno roko mir in red. Med tem je prišla sem trojica, ki jo je imenovala OAD s ciljem, da pripravi pot k političnemu sporazumu. V njej so Ilmar Penna Marinho iz Brazilije, Roman de Clairmont Dueñas iz Salvadorja in E. Bunker iz Združenih držav.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Predsednik je včeraj predložil Kongresu, naj bi v kovancih za 25 in 10c ne bilo več nobenega srebra, v kovancih za 50c pa le 40 % namesto sedanjih 90 %. Svoj predlog je utemeljil z dejstvom, da je potreba po srebru v gospodarstvu tolikšna, da ga za kovanje novcev skoraj ni več na razpolago.

## Castrov vpliv se čuti med španskimi dijaki

MADRID, Šp. — Med visokošolsko mladino obstaja navidezno brezpomembna organizacija FUTE (Federacija demokratičnih univerzitetnih študentov). Menina ima samo kakih 500 članov. Stevilka pa ne pomeni dosti. Važen je način organiziranja. FUTE obstaja namreč iz trojki, zahteva slepo disciplino, toda ni zahtevna v naštevanju dolžnosti. Obveznosti je malo, toda treba jih je brezpogojno izvrševati. Clani FUTE so vsi vneti za "socijalizem", obožujejo Marksa, toda bolj jim je simpatičen kubanski diktator Castro, saj je Kuba edina latinska dežela, kjer vlada "socijalizem".

FUTE pa ne obožuje samo Castra, je tudi zagrizena nasprotinja naše dežele. Protestira proti "ameriškemu imperijalizmu" ravno tako vneto kot kubanski dijaki. Na zunaj je pa FUTE nepolitična organizacija, skuša držati stike z vsemi gibanji, ki nasprotujejo Francovim diktaturam. Zanimivo pa je, da FUTE člani pripadajo bogatim in ne proletarskim slojem. FUTE program je za študente priladen, saj zahteva na prvem mestu svobodo govora, združevanja, tiska, vesti itd.

Mnogi opazovalci razmer na španskih univerzah misijo, da je FUTE lahko seme, ki se bo razvilo v gibanje, ki lahko postane nevarno za režim, pa tudi za vse tiste Špance, ki bi radi dosegli miren prehod iz sedanje diktature v svobodno demokracijo.

## De Gaulle vendar močno vpliva na svoje rojake

PARIZ, Fr. — Francozi so znani neverni v politiki. Redki so politični voditelji, ki morejo nanje imeti vsaj malo vpliva. Večina francoskih volivcev pa smatra politiko za potrebno zlo.

De Gaulle je pa izjema. Dočim svobodni svet ocenjuje generalove poglede na mednarodno politiko s precejšnjim nezupanjem in tudi Francozi kažejo videz, da misijo podobno, povedo številke nekaj drugega. Francozi smatrajo na primer Johnsona za skoraj enako nevarnost za mednarodni mir kot Kitajca Mao. Mao jim je samo za dve točki nevarnejši. Za polovico manjšo nevarnost predstavljajo Brežnev-Kosygin, Nasar in Castro.

De Gaulle je pa v primeri z Maom in Johnsonom pravo jaganje miru, saj je za mednaroden mir desetkrat manj nevaren kot Mao ali Johnson. Čudno je le, da je v francoskih očeh alžirski diktator Ben Bella še manj nevaren za mir kot De Gaulle. Značilno je tudi, da bi v slučaju vojne bilo samo 14% Francozov za Ameriko (lani jih je bilo že 30%), 7% za Moskvo, zato pa 62% za neutralnost. De Gaulle torej še zmeraj misli za vso Francijo.

## V Clevelandu dovolj posla za študente

CLEVELAND, O. — Krajevni upravnik državnega urada za zaposlitev Emden C. Schulze je mnenja, da so izgledi za zaposlitev študentov v letosnjem poletju dosti boljši kot so bili v zadnjih letih in precej ugodnejši kot drugod v deželi. Prenekatere družbe in podjetja so se odločila najti študente kot začasno nadomestilo za uslužbence na počitnicah.

Na splošno v deželi je posnemanjanje začasne zaposlitve, ki bi bila primerna za študente višjih in visokih šol. Take je zvezna vlada začela s posebno kampanjo, ki naj bi nudila študentom v počitničanju priložnost za zasluzek. Predsednik Johnson je na celo te kampanje postavil pod predsednika Humphreya in ji določil za cilj dobiti zaposlitev za 2 milijona mladih ljudi.

## Brazilija se začela kopati iz gospodarskih težav

RIO DE JANEIRO, Brazil. — Sedanji predsednik general Castello Branco je že lani začel z gospodarskimi reformami. Kot prvo nalogi si je postavil zajetive inflacije. Pri tem je nalepel na odpor prav povsod. Stabilnost vrednosti narodnega denarja je zahtevala žrtve od vseh slojev prebivalstva, posebno od potrošnikov. Branco je vztrjal in danes že žanje prve uspehe svoje gospodarske politike.

Denar je začel dobivati ugled in pomen, cene so se ustalile, kapital ne veži več iz dežele, obseg investicij raste, na drugi strani si pa proizvodnja še ni pomogla, pa tudi brezposelnost ne popušča. Izgleda na novo že tev so dobr, obeta se lep pridelek, škoda je le, da cene za bralziko izvozno blago niso višje.

Sedanji režim misli tudi na socijalne reforme, prvega poskuša pa ne bo napravil pred koncem leta, ko se bo videlo, kolikor se bosta popravila proračun in plačilna bilanca, ki oba navadno izkazujeta primanjkljaj.





There is no effort here to fly-speak every little thing that happens in the new Houston Astro-dome. Because it is new and different, however, and there are no precedents for some of the things which are going on down there, all must be inspected and evaluated.

**WE CAN LEARN**

Poverty, with all its concomitants — substandard housing, inadequate educational and recreational facilities, absence of cultural opportunity, and the rest — is commonly considered a major cause of juvenile delinquency.

And there can be no doubt that environment is an important factor. But, perhaps, we tend to exaggerate its weight.

For example, most of the Chinese living in this country — even in such famous Chinatowns as San Francisco's — live in poverty. Yet, while seven per cent of America's juveniles will be in trouble with the law this year, not one of them will be Chinese!

Paul Harvey makes that statement, in a column appearing in The Suburban & Lawrence Journal of Indianapolis.

Why is it so? He quotes one Chinese leader as saying: "We keep a tight rein on our children until they are really responsible." Another says: "Our children just naturally respect and obey their parents. A boy or girl would not bring shame on his family or his family name."

It looks as if we can learn something from the American Chinese — including those whose lives are spent in grinding poverty.

**EXCISE TAX RELIEF.** Relief from the major burden of present day excise taxes now seems certain in the near future. Last week the House Committee on Ways and Means reported out a bill providing reduction or repeal of most excise levies. Strong support is virtually assured from the Republican side as we have been trying to reduce these taxes for years. Last year we made a concerted drive for excise tax relief but our amendment was defeated by twelve votes as a result of Administration opposition at that time.

Scheduled for elimination on July 1, 1965, if the new law is approved, is the 10% tax on handbags, luggage, toilet articles, jewelry and furs. Also due for repeal is the 10% manufacturers' levy on radio, television, and phonograph sets, sporting goods, cameras, musical instruments, fountain pens, and air conditioners; as well as the 5% tax on refrigerators, freezers and other electric, gas and oil appliances.

The 10% manufacturers' tax on passenger automobiles would be reduced to 7% this year and would be completely eliminated by 1969. The 10% tax on telephone service would be reduced to 3% on January 1, 1966 and ended by January 1, 1969. (My bill, H.R. 418, would repeal this tax immediately.)

The 10% admissions tax applicable to movies, theatres, and athletic events and the 10% tax on club dues would be eliminated as of July 1, 1966. At that time the 10% tax on light bulbs and the 8% tax on automobile parts and accessories would also be repealed.

For years I have sought to repeal these taxes because they are discriminatory and unfair. Most of them were enacted as special "temporary" wartime measures, but they have lingered on for all these years.

#### ANOTHER NUISANCE TAX

While much has been said about the efforts to repeal excise taxes, little has been said about another action taken by the Committee on Ways and Means (under Administration pressure) which would limit

### STORIES THAT LIGHT THE SCREEN

No one has ever doubted the ability of the movies to entertain. They've also had a powerful effect on our mores and morals... our fashions and foibles.

But, sometimes overlooked are the films that light the screen, and, at the same time, inspire us with the purity and simplicity of the stories they tell.

Brilliant photography and casting in Carl Dreyer's 1927 silent production of "The Passion of Joan of Arc" captured the pure faith of the little maid of Domremy, France, who obeyed the voices of her saints and rallied the French against the English.

Subsequent films on St. Joan with Ingrid Bergman and Jean Seberg delivering the "perpetual imprisonment" soliloquy also sharply contrasted the martyr's unshaken faith with the hypocrisy of the men who tormented her.

One of the outstanding films concerning the spiritual side of life was the 1942 adaptation of Franz Werfel's book, "The Song of Bernadette." Jennifer Jones, in her first screen role, received one of the five Oscars awarded for classic achievement.

Her portrayal of the French peasant girl who saw a vision in a grotto of the now famous shrine in Lourdes is a shining example of the film world's interpretation of inspirational themes from real life or fiction.

Bernadette's life was profoundly changed after seeing the vision of "a Beautiful Lady in 1858, as were the lives of millions of people in France and around the world. She entered the Church, as was her destiny, and 54 years after her death in 1879, was canonized a saint.

The bitter yet realistic problems involved in facing a life of complete humility and self-effacement were sensitively portrayed in "The Nun's Story." Audrey Hepburn enacted the life of the actual nun who wrote the best selling book.

The film tells the story of a Belgian girl who enters a convent and after training at a school for tropical medicine, becomes a nursing nun in the Congo. Here she meets a doctor, played by Peter Finch, and the conflict between love of God and love of man begins to take shape.

A bout of tuberculosis, the disease continuing of her work in the Congo, Belgium's surrender during World War II, and the death of her father, widen the breach until she realistically, yet painfully, leaves the ecclesiastical life.

In a lighter vein, "The Bells of St. Mary's" explored the warm and human side of the coin. Ingrid Bergman portrayed a nun seeking a new parochial school and Bing Crosby was the parish priest who aided the nuns in getting their building.

Miss Bergman visited parochial schools to study the customs and speech patterns of nuns in order to give a realistic portrait. The screen was illuminated with the dedication of the sisters in their endeavor, yet much humor and simple pathos were also conveyed.

to \$50 (it's now \$165) the retail value of goods which can be brought to the U.S. by returning tourists without paying the duty charged on commercial imports. The Administration asked for this change as a part of its program for reducing the deficit in our international balance of payments, but most critics strongly doubt it will have any appreciable effect.

What it will do, unfortunately is to penalize those Americans who have been saving for years to spend few weeks in Europe and bring back some inexpensive presents for their families. The net cost of a cut in the duty-free allowance could vary from \$5 to \$50 per tourist, depending on the articles purchased. Thus the proposal would not be likely to discourage many people from traveling abroad or from making some purchases there. But the nuisance value of this new tax — and that is what it amounts to — would be great. It does not seem to me to be good policy to impose nuisance taxes for their alleged "psychological" value while refusing to take concrete steps to get at our balance of payments problems.

#### FEDERAL "AID" IS NO BARGAIN

According to a study by Tax Foundation, Inc., a private research organization, last year the State of Ohio paid \$1.51 in Federal Taxes for every \$1.00 received in the form of grants in aid, etc. In this category Ohio ranked seventh from the top. The figures range from the high of \$2.53 paid by Delaware for every dollar of aid received down to Alaska which paid 13 cents in taxes for every \$1.00 in Federal Aid.

Eighteen of our fifty states paid more in Federal Taxes than they received in "aid" (from \$2.53 to \$1.01). The other thirty-two states got back more in Federal "aid" than they paid in taxes. The figures, said the Foundation, do not include the Administrative costs as the tax dollars make the trip first to Washington only to be sent back as "aid," or the "matching" costs the Federal government requires from state and local entities in some programs.

### From the Indian Teepee



The long-awaited and popular Bat Day is scheduled for Cleveland Stadium Sunday, June 6.

The Indians, who meet the Detroit Tigers in a single game that afternoon are prepared to distribute to youngsters under 16 years of age, an official Louisville Slugger Little League bat.

To qualify for one of these bats, a youngster must be accompanied by an adult and an adult-child combination of two only, will receive one of the bats.

For example: A mother attends with a son; 1 bat.

A mother and father attend with two children; 2 bats.

A mother and father attend with three children; 3 bats.

A mother and father and another adult attend with three children; 3 bats.

This year, when the parties enter the Stadium, a certificate will be handed to the youngster. This certificate will be redeemed at one of five distribution centers located near the gate entrances. There, uniformed police will form lines and the children will be given their bats.

The Indians want to stress that only one bat will be given to each youngster with a certificate. A youngster can not come to the claim area and turn in three or four certificates to pick up bats for friends. This will just cause congestion at the distribution areas.

The bat distribution areas will be in the following sections:

Section 5      Section 11  
Section 27      Section 39  
Section 51

During the course of the game, the Indians will ask all of the youngsters who have bats, to hold them high in the air and a picture will be taken.

Persons who enter the Stadium on passes will not be entitled to a bat.

#### Stop the Drip

The leaking faucet, long the butt of jokes, really is no laughing matter!

It's the cause of hard-earned dollars slowly, a drip at a time, going right down the drain. Only most homeowners never stop to think about it.

According to the Clev. Plumbing Information Council, a faucet that drips just 1/32 of an inch of water wastes 25 gallons of water in a 24-hour period.

Or, if the faucet leaks even more, the waste is estimated at 100 gallons during 24 hours. This would be for a stream about 1/16 of an inch.

If it's a 1/8-inch drip, the Council estimates that you would lose about 400 gallons in 24 hours. If this continued for an entire month, 12,000 gallons would go down the drain. Figures vary, of course, with differences in water pressure.

It is not only water that represents a waste of dollars, but the fuel needed to heat the water.

Thus from every point of view, keeping faucets from leaking is good business.

Many faucets, however, are beyond the stage where they can be kept in repair. For them, replacement is indicated.

### Tornado Safety Rules

TO KNOW WHAT TO DO WHEN A TORNADO IS APPROACHING, MAY MEAN THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN LIFE OR DEATH ! ! !

1.—THERE IS NO UNIVERSAL PROTECTION AGAINST TORNADOES EXCEPT UNDERGROUND EXCAVATIONS. When time permits, go to a tornado cellar, cave, or underground excavation which should have an air outlet to help equalize the air pressure. It should be kept fit for use, free from water, gas or debris; and preferably equipped with pick and shovel.

2.—If you are in open country:

1. Move at right angles to the tornado's path. Tornadoes usually move ahead at about 25 to 40 miles per hour.

2. If there is no time to escape, lie flat in the nearest depression such as a ditch or ravine.

3.—If in a city or town:

1. Seek inside shelter, preferably in a strongly reinforced building. STAY AWAY FROM WINDOWS!

2. In homes: The southwest corner of the basement usually offers greatest safety, particularly in frame houses. People in houses without basements can sometimes be protected by taking cover under furniture against inside walls. Doors and windows on the north and east sides of the house may be opened to help reduce damage to the building.

3. Standing against the inside wall on a lower floor of an office building offers some protection.

4.—If in schools:

1. In city areas: If school building is of strongly reinforced construction, stay inside, away from windows, remain near an inside wall on the lower floors when possible. AVOID AUDITORIUMS & GYMNASIUMS with large, poorly-supported roofs!

2. In rural schools that do not have strongly reinforced construction, remove children and teachers to a ravine or ditch if storm shelter is not available.

5.—If in factories and industrial plants:

On receiving a tornado warning, a lookout should be posted to keep safety officials advised of the tornado's approach. Advance preparation should be made for moving workers to sections of the plant offering the greatest protection.

6.—Keep calm! It will not help to get excited. People have been killed by running out into streets and by turning back into the path of a tornado. Even though a warning is issued, chances of a tornado striking one's home or location are very slight. Tornadoes cover such a small zone, as a rule, that relatively only a few places in a warned area are directly affected. You should know about tornadoes "just in case."

7.—Keep tuned to your radio or television station for latest tornado advisory instruction. Do not call the Weather Bureau, except to report a tornado, as your individual request may tie up telephone lines urgently needed to receive special reports or to relay advisories to radio and television stations for dissemination to thousands in the critical area.

Reports coming to Cleveland from other areas where skate-boarding has become extremely popular point up a few valuable safety hints.

Just buying a skate-board and turning a youngster loose with it is not enough — and, in fact, invites trouble and, maybe, tragedy.

Skate-boarding requires a lot of skill and a lot of keen judgment. So, lessons supervised by responsible teachers are a must. Because skateboarders have no brakes, even the skilled skateboarder may bump into an accident. Therefore, special play areas — away from traffic, pedestrians and fixed objects — are required. To provide special play areas for skateboarders and for other

### Poison Accidents And Summer

"The summer months," says Dr. Samuel Gerber, President of the Greater Cleveland Safety Council, "open up many more chances for accidental poisonings around the house and yard — and about two out of three of the victims are children under the age of five."

"This is the time of the year when all of the children are home from school and all of the family spends more time outdoor. To the small child, outdoor poisonous products like gasoline, paint solvents and insecticides, whether in their original containers or in pop bottles, fruit jars or cans, look like something good to eat or drink. A very small child may eat poisonous lead paint which has flaked off from the house."

"While the rest of the family is gathered around the back yard barbecue, a small child may wander into the house unnoticed and help himself to a lethal dose of candy aspirin, a sedative, alcohol, antiseptics, cough medicine, household detergents, lye, or many other drugs and harmful household products — if they have been left where he can reach them."

"You can keep your child from becoming a coroner's statistic or an emergency hospital case," says Dr. Gerber, "by practicing a few simple precautions."

"When your doctor orders medicine for the family, ask him to have the druggist put the name of the medicine, as well as safety precautions on the label for your information. But, keep all medicine locked up."

"Read the label on every product that you bring into your home. Unless you are sure a product will not harm your child, store it so that he can not get to it."

"If someone in your family swallows a poisonous material accidentally, call your physician and be prepared to tell him what the poison is."

"Questions regarding specific poisons and their antidotes can be answered by the Poison Information Center (CE 1-4455) which is on call 24 hours a day and 7 days a week. Call them about any drug or product that you suspect."
