RESOLUTION

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Supreme Board by the provisions of section 54 of the By-Laws of the Western Slavonic Association, be it hereby enacted that the sections hereinafter designated by the same numbers as said sections are designated in the By-Laws be amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 5. A "member in good standing" shall mean a member who has complied with the provisions of these By-Laws and who has paid all dues and assessments on or before the last day of the month in which the same are due and payable.

sociation and shall be reinstated only if he has fully recovered from such sickness or disability and after medical examination. Section 125. Any person who obtains any benefits from the Association by fraud or who secures admission into the Association by any false warranty or misrepresentation made with actual intent to deceive or which materially affects the acceptance of the risk and the hazard assumed or any person who testifies falsely at any hearing held by a lodge trial board or the Supreme Judiciary Committee or any member resorting to suit against the Association before exhausting all means within the Association for the adjustment of claims, shall upon conviction, be subject to suspension for a period not exceeding ninety days or may be expelled from the Association as the Judiciary Tribunal of the Association may decree providing that a penalty of expulsion must be approved by the Supreme Board before becoming effective.

not attained the age of eighteen years, provided, however, that the insurance on applicants beyond the age of sixteen years nearest birthday and the insurance continuing beyond the anniversary date of the certificate nearest the sixteenth birthday of persons previously insured by the Juvenile Department is conditional upon the Insured becoming a member of the Adult Department with all the rights, benefits and obligations incidental to regular adult members. The proviso herein contained is applicable to Sections 4 and 7 of the Juvenile By-Laws and shall be as effective as if fully set forth in said Sections.
