Angleška vlada pošlje novo svarilo Nemčiji

Zakulisna politika evropskih velesil

FRANCIJA SE NE RAZBURJA

London, 30. avg. — London je včeraj pozorišče mrzljih aktivnosti. Ministrski predsednik Neville Chamberlain, zunanjim ministrom Halifax in finančnim ministrom Simon so se sestali na posebeni seji, katere se je udeležil tudi Neville Henderson, angleški poslanik v Nemčiji, ki je bil pozvan domov. Danes se bo ponovno sestali na konferenci kabinetu, ki bo morda odločila mode Evrope.

Londonski tisk piše, da bo angleška vlada naslovila novo svarilo nemški vladi. To bo vsebovalo med drugim poziv, naj Hitlerjev avgusta konflikt med češko vlado in sudetskimi Nemci na enem način. Od Francije se pričakuje, da bo naslovila Hitlerju angleški poslaniku. Oba dokumenta sta spisana v "prijetljanskem" in soglasju s pomirjevalno politiko premijera Chamberlaina.

Čeprav angleški tisk silovito napoveduje vojno, ki lahko vsak čas izbruhne. Drugi vidijo v splošni neizkušnji le bluff angleških in nemških diplomatov.

Hugh R. Wilson, ameriški poslanik v Berlinu, in Joseph P. Kennedy, ameriški poslanik v Londonu, sta se včeraj sestala v zari. Danes bosta konferirala W. C. Bullittom, ameriškim poslanikom v Franciji.

Pariz, 30. avg. — Kljub vojnim oblastom, ki se zbirajo nad Evropo, je Francija ostala mirna. Upaziti ni nobenega znamenja, da se razburja zaradi potrebnega konfliktu med Nemčijo in Češkoslovaško. Na seji kabinet, ki je trajala več ur, so se razpravljali o mednarodni situaciji in narodni obrambi, točno odmevi teh razprav niso dosegli francoške javnosti.

Daladierjeva vlada opozarja, da ne širi vesti, da je vojna v Evropi neizbežna in da moralizacija nemške oborožene sile predstavlja nevarnost. Vlada hoče uverti javnost, da ima Francija na svoji strani Anglico, ki je dočisto nastopili v kritičnem momentu proti Hitlerju, a bo provokiral vojno.

Naciji odgovorili katoliškim škofom

Vlada protektira cerkvene ustanove

Berlin, 30. avg. — Minister angleške propagande je včeraj izkoristil škofom, ki so v svojem pastirskem listu obdolžili klerike, da hočejo uničiti katoliško cerkev v Nemčiji.

"Vladi prispeva milijone mark za katoliške cerkve," se glasi delovnik. "Dejstvo, da je bilo pastirsko pismo prečitano v cerkvah, samo pobuja trditve o perzektivi. Vlada neprestano skrbi, da katoliška cerkev protektira pred demonstracijami."

Pastirsko pismo je bilo sezavljeno na konferenci katoliških škofov v Fuldu zadnjem tednu. Avstrijski škofje se niso udeležili konference, pač pa so namenili, da bodo imeli sestanek v bližnji bodočnosti in izolirana.

Praga hoče preprečiti nacijski puč

Načelnik nemške delegacije se sestane z Benešem

Praga, 30. avg. — Češkoslovaška vlada, parlamentarni odseki, voditelji političnih strank in vsečaki sestavljajo nov načrt z namenom, da potolažijo sudetske Nemce in druge narodnostne skupine. S tem nameravajo v prvi vrsti izbiti Hitlerju priliko, da bi pod katerokoli pretvezo napadel Češkoslovaško. Ako ne bo uspel, bo odgovornosti za konflikt padla na Nemčijo.

Edvard Beneš, predsednik češke republike, bo danes sprejel poslanca Ernsta Kundta, načelnika delegacije sudetskih Nemcev. Druga konferenca se bo vrnila med Konradom Henleinom, vodjem nacijske stranke, in loredon Runcimanom, načelnikom neuradne angleške komisije, ki je prišla v Prago, da posreduje med vlado in nemško manjšino. Runciman bo zahteval od Henleina, naj pojasni svoje stališče glede predlogov, kateri so mu bili predloženi zadnjo nedeljo.

Detroit, Mich. — (FP) — Določno odlašana intervencija vodstva Odbora za industrijsko organizacijo v notranji spor avtne unije bo, kakor vse kaže, odobrena na seji eksekutive, ki se bo vrnila v prvih dneh septembra. John L. Lewis, načelnik CIO, je že posiljal okrožnice avtne unijam s pozivom, naj na redijo mir v svoji hiši.

Lewisov program uključuje ponovno sprejetje petih članov eksekutivnega odbora, katere je Homer Martin izklučil, prepoved frakcijskih razprav do prihodnje redne konvencije in poravnava sporovnih vprašanj po CIO, ki jih eksekutiva avtne unije ne more sama rešiti.

Program je v bistvu kompromis, ki sili Martina k priznaju,

naj bo razvedel o pozivu, da se načrte opozicije ni bila pravična. Na drugi strani bo morda Lewis preprečil načrte opozicije, ki hoče odstaviti Martina. Dasi program ne ugaja nobeni v konfliktu zavojevani grupi, ima vseeno oporo pri večini članov.

Glasovi iz naselbin

Moj obisk v Toronto
Cleveland, O. — Na polletni seji gl. odbora sem bil pooblaščen, da v družbi predsednika br. Cainkarja zastopam S. N. P. J. na kongresu ameriških podpornih organizacij. Ta kongres se je vrnil dne 22., 23., 24. in 25. avgusta v Toronto, Kanada. O poteku in sklepih tega kongresa bom poročal našim članom in članiteljem Prosvete enkrat pozneje, da danes pa se želim omejiti le na moj obisk pri naših prijazninih rojakih in članih v tem drugem največjem kanadskem mestu.

V Toronto sem prišel v soboto večer, dne 20. avgusta. Takoj drugi dan po mojem prihodu, to je v nedeljo, dne 21. avgusta dopoldne sem se podal na pot, da poščem naše Slovence. V spremstvu moje žene, ki je potovala z menom, sem najprej obiskal tajnik društva Bratska Sloga št. 68 S. N. P. J. br. Leopolda Trčka. Ko se pogovarjava o raznih društvenih in lokalnih zadevah, me Trček opomni, da je ta dan tretja nedelja v mesecu in poščem se vrši društvena seja. "Ali hočeš iti na našo društveno sejo," me vpraša tajnik Trček. Seveda sem to povabilo z veseljem sprejel in se iste udeležil.

Seja je bila tako dobro obiskana, zlasti če vzamemo v poštev dejstvo, da so naši rojaki v Torontu tako razrezeno naseljeni in oddaljeni po več milj drug od drugega. (Tisti med nami, ki smo oddaljeni samo 5 ali 10 minut od društvenih sedežev, pa kljub temu zanemarjam obisk sej, si lahko vzamemo naše Kanadane za vzor.) Navzoči sta bili najmanj dve tretjini društvenih članov. Brat Valentin Ručigaj, predst. društva, eden naših agilnih in vplivnih članov v Toronto, stanuje v mestu Oshawa, Ont., ki je oddaljeno od Toronto skoraj 33 milj. Pomislimo, potovati 66 milj vsak mesec na društveno sejo!

Na tej seji in pozneje sem imel priliko seznaniti se z raznimi rojaki in rojakinjami: z družino Trček, Ručigaj, Vipavec, Petrich, Klemenčič, Ogulin... in mnogimi drugimi, cijih imena mi niso ostanala v spominu. Prav priravnena vsem gori omenjenim in tudi drugim, ki so se trudili, da napravijo naš obisk v Toronto kolikor mogoče prijeten.

Toronto je tako prijazno kanadsко mesto, četudi imajo tudi nekaj slumskih predelov. Na človeka napravi vtič aktivnosti in solidnosti. Seveda imajo tudi v Toronto nekaj brezposelnosti, toda ta problem ni tako akuten kot je na primer v Clevelandu ali Detroitu. Plače morda tako "sajnjne" kot pri nas v "States", kakor imenujemo našo državo, ampak delo je bolj stalno in gotovo in zdi se, da kažejoči sistem v Kanadi ni tako skrbhujan kot pri nas.

Na vse zadnje, delavec s prilici, katere hočem naslednje pojasni-

ti, "kako dobre so insurance kompanije."

Ali je res insurance tako pomeni? NE! Je presneto drag, in ne samo v enem oziru, ampak v vseh! Žalostno, a resnično je to, da večina ne zna računati, koliko plača po "nikelnih, dajmih ali kvodrih" v enem mesecu, letu in dokler je lahko zavarovan, in koliko dobi, ko zavarovalna policia poteka.

Pri navadnem zavarovanju v mladinskem oddelku je asesment po 18c mesečno do starosti 10 let, za kar je otrok zavarovan za \$500 smrtnine, in ko dopolni starost 16 let, dobi takozvanii "kredit" za plačevanje asesmenta v oddelku odraslih, in ako je otrok bil vpisan v mladinski oddelok, ko se ni bil star eno leto, dobi \$15.00 tege "kredita".
