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Razmišljanje o trpečem Jezusu

Višek notranjega boja v trpljenju je Jezus doživel v uri osamljene molitve na Oljski gori. Kajti njegovi najzvestjši apostoli so pospali. Nebeški Oče je v Jezusovi duši molčal, kot da ne sliši njegove bridke prošnje, da bi mu odvil kelih trpljenja. Jezus je uvidel, da mu sedaj ne preostane drugega kakor, da vskladi svojo človeško voljo, ki bi se trpljenju rada izognila, z božjo voljo, ki to njegovo trpljenje hoče. Da je bil ta boj v Jezusovem srcu res silen, se je pokazalo tudi na zunaj. Kajti evangelist Luka je zapisal:

"In ko so ga obšle smrtne težave, je še bolj goreče molil; in njegov pot je postal kakor kaplje krvi, ki so tekle na zemljo."

A istočasno, ko je Jezusov boj v trpljenju dosegel svoj višek, je dosegla v Jezusu svoj višek tudi čednost potrpežljivosti. Ko je spoznal, da nebeški Oče hoče to njegovo trpljenje in da sedaj zanj ni druge rešitve, kakor da trpljenje vdano in potrpežljivo sprejme, je pokazal v trpljenju tako potrpežljivost, kot nihče med vsemi junaki v trpljenju.

Najprej niti najmanjšega odpora ni več pokazal proti tistim, ki so mu trpljenje pripravljali. Šel je trpljenju celo naproti. Apostola Petra, ki se je hotel bojevati za Jezusa, da bi ne bil izročen sovražnikom v roke, je ostro pokaral: "Vtakni meč v nožnico! Ali naj ne pijem keliha, ki mi ga je dal Oče?" (Jan 18, 11)

Jezus se je sam javil nasprotnikom kot tisti človek, ki ga iščejo. Velel jim je, naj njegova primejo, njegove apostole pa puste, da odidejo.

Tako se je začela Jezusova junaška pot trpljenja. Sprejel ga je s popolno vdanostjo v voljo božjo, z dostojanstvenim mirom in z neizrekljivo potrpežljivostjo, in je ta mir in to potrpežljivost ohranil do trenutka, ko je izdihnil svojo dušo. Očitati so mu vsemogoče zločine, vanj pljuvali, ga bili po obrazu in se na najbolj podel način iz njega norčevali. On pa je molčal in potrpežljivo vse prenašal. Samo enkrat je pokazal pri vseh teh žalitvah sveto ogorčenost. Ko je namreč Jezus na povpraševanja velikega duhovnika glede njegovih učencev in njegovega nauka odgovoril, da je vedno očitno govoril svetu in da na skrivaj ni nikdar govoril, zato naj kar ljudi vpraša, kaj je govoril, ga je eden od služabnikov udaril po ustih, češ da se tako ne odgovarja velikemu duhovniku. Jezus mu je za klobuto vrnil očišček: "Če sem napak govoril, izpričaj, da napak; če pa prav, kaj me biješ." Potem pa niti enega očitka ni več izrekel nad nikomur, dasi je moral pritrpeti še hude stvari: bičali so ga, s trnjem kronali, Herod ga je zasmehoval, zloglasnemu zločincu Barabi so ljudje dali prednost pred njim; skupaj z dvema razbojnikoma je moral nesti težki križ, in še na križ prubit poslušati najhujše sramotitve. Pa je vse to trpljenje in ponižanje prenašal molče in vdano. Popolnoma se je obvladoval in pokazal do vseh surovežev in rabljev nedopovedljivo potrpežljivost. In to on, ki je bil vsemogočen, ki bi bil lahko z enim dejanjem volje vse svoje nasprotnike ukrotil in popolnoma porazil. A ker se je zavedal, da nebeški Oče hoče, da on sedaj vse to pretrpi, je junaško trpel in pokazal krepkost potrpežljivosti v najvišji meri. Dobesedno je izplnil to, kar je preje ljudi učil:

"Pravim vam, da se hudobnežu ne upirajte; marveč, ako te kdo bije po desnem licu, mu nastavi še drugo!" (Mt 5, 40)."

Jezus nam je dal nauk in zgled, da se smemo trpljenju izogniti in prositi Boga, naj nam s trpljenjem priznane. To je storil tudi Jezus tisto uro v molitvi na Oljski gori. A ko je jasno spoznal, da njegov nebeški Oče hoče, da pije iz keliha trpljenja, je spet Jezus dal nauk in zgled, kako moramo v takim primeru trpljenje vdano sprejeti in ga potrpežljivo nositi. Naj se mi še tako trudimo, da bi se trpljenju izognili, bo trpljenje prav gotovo prišlo in se mu ne bomo mogli več izogniti. Ni rečeno, da je tako trpljenje vedno od Boga hoteno; morda smo si ga nakopali čisto po lastni krivdi, ali so ga nam povzročili hudobni ljudje, ki se niso hoteli držati božjih zapovedi v odnosu do bližnjega. A kadar trpljenje dejansko pride nad nas in se mu izogniti na pravičen način več ne moremo, nam Jezus svetuje in narekuje le eno rešitev: vdano sprejeti trpljenja in potrpežljivo prenašanje trpljenja. Potrpežljivost je čednost, ki nam jo je pokazal Jezus sam in nam jo je priporočal kot tisto čednost, s katero si bomo pridobili svoje duše in jih rešili za večnost.

V očeh tega sveta je potrpežljivost nespamet. Nemški filozof Nietzsche je celo trdil, da potrpežljiv kristjan razodeva suženjsko miselnost in suženjsko moralo, katero morajo močne duše obvladovati s silo svoje volje. Križev in nasprotovanj ne smejo ljudje sprejeti s krotkostjo, ampak se jim morajo upreti in jih nadvladati s silo. Tak je bil njegov nauk, in tisti, ki so mu sledili, so končali ali v obupu

ali v blaznosti. Kajti v Nietzschejevi filozofiji nadčloveka je usodna napaka v tem, da ni računal z dejanskim stanjem človeka. Saj za vsakega človeka pridejo trenutki v življenju, ko trpljenja ne more več premagati in se mu izogniti, kajti prav to pasivno-trpno stanje človeka izraža beseda: trpljenje. Rešitev trpnemu stanju je torej le v potrpežljivosti. So sicer še druge rešitve, a so napačne in vodijo samo še v hujše trpljenje.

Nekateri se skušajo rešiti trpljenja s samomorom. Ko bi po smrti ničesar več ne bilo, bi bila to v hudem trpljenju, iz katerega ne vidimo izhoda, pametna rešitev. Dejansko samomorilci spremene le način trpljenja, ki preide v večno trpljenje, katero je v vsakem pogledu še mnogo hujše, pa četudi se Bog zmešanih samomorilcev usmili in jih ne obsodi v peklo. A brez vic verjetno noben samomorilec ne pride v nebesa, razen če je samomor naredil v popolni blaznosti in je preje sveto živel ter že naredil pokoro za svoje grehe.

Kadar se trpljenju ne moremo več izogniti, izpolnimo božjo voljo le, če ga vdano in potrpežljivo prenašamo. In v tej potrpežljivosti se moramo vaditi vsak dan sprti ob malih križih in težavah. Kajti nihče ne bo znal biti potrpežljiv v velikih preizkušnjah, če se ni navadil potrpeti v malih stvarih. Navadno ljudje v trpljenju godrnjajo in se jeze nase in na druge in iščejo vzroka za svoje trpljenje pri drugih, ali se celo nad Bogom pritožujejo. Vendar jim vse to v trpljenju nič ne pomaga, ampak jim vse to trpljenje le še poveča. Zato si ob trpečem Jezusu zapomnimo njegov nauk in njegov zgled:

"V potrpežljivosti si boste pridobili svoje duše."

Dr. S. B. Dickenson, ki je še sama sorazmerno mlada, je dejala, da so mladenke pri odgovorih zelo odkrite. Povedo največkrat naravnost, kaj mislijo in kaj jih posebno moti. Na prvem mestu so navedle slabo mnenje, ki prevladuje v javnosti o današnjih deklicah in mladih dekletih, na drugem odločanje — rade bi napravile pametno odločitev, pa največkrat nimajo za to dovolj znanja — na tretjem mestu so starši, šole na četrtem — pa fantje.

Gumijasti grelec na vročo vodo lahko uporabimo s pridom za podložek kolenom pri čiščenju ali pletku na vrto, ko se je izrazil za svoj prvotni namen. Napolnimo ga s penasto gumo.



Sol je koristna

Sol je naša vsakdanja začimba, ki je normalno uživamo vsaj 25 g dnevno v jedi, čez mero pa tudi 40 do 50 g, torej mnogo več, kakor bi je morala vsebovati naša hrana. Svoje telo tako v pravem pomenu besede nasopoljujemo, kajti človeški organizem normalno ne potrebuje niti 2 g dnevno.

Sol je nevarna predvsem ledvicam; povzroča, da se nabira voda v organizmu, s čimer je srce škodljivo obremenjeno.

Koristne so pa solne kopeli, za katere uporabljamo kuhinjsko morsko sol in jo zdravnik predpiše v razni jakosti: za polno otroško kopel 1 kg soli, za odrasle 1,5 do 2 kg, za močnejše 3 do 4 kg soli. Kopel traja 15 do 20 minut pri 30 do 40° C.

Solne kopeli dražijo kožo, da postane rdeča, ker se kri odvajajo od notranjih organov proti površini; to dobro vpliva pri malokrvnosti, pri dolgotrajnih živčnih in krvnih boleznih, pri ekzematih in oprsju in trebuhu, pri nekaterih ženskih boleznih, pri skrofulozi in pri tuberkulozi kosti. Preden začnemo uporabljati solne kopeli, seveda vprašajmo zdravnika za svet.

Presojeno jed izdatno izboljša, ako napremo preko posode čist prtič, napojen z mlekom, in nateremo nanj prav nad posodo 2 do 3 žlice moke. Tako naj jed stoji približno četrt ure, da se moka napoji s slano paro. Nadalje lahko razsolimo presojeno jed tako, da za malo časa položimo vanjo gobico, ki jo imamo samo za ta namen. Gobica vsrka sol. Marsikatero presojeno jed pa tudi izboljšamo, če v nji skuhamo nekaj rezin surovega krompirja.

Francija je predlog zavrnila, ostale članice NATO pa se še niso dokončno odločile.

V NATO ni posebnega navdušenja

Nekatere države NATO so načelno proti posebni atomski oboroženi sili NATO, druge pa trdijo, da bi taka oborožena sila itak ostala pod nadzorom Združenih držav, poleg tega bo skrajno nepraktična, če bo sploh uporabna. Vsi mornarji, ki se bodo udeležili vezbanja na rušilec Biddle, bodo morali znati angleško. Kdor ne bo znal dovolj, ga bodo naučili, ker bo zapovedovalni jezik na ladji le angleški.

Rusi protestirajo

Rusi vedno močnejše protestirajo proti ustvaritvi večnarodne atomske pomorske sile NATO, da je to širjenje atomskega orožja med države, ki ga še nimajo. Amerika in Anglija to odločno zanikavata, dejansko pa priznavata, da je to način, ki naj prepreči zahtevo Zahodne Nemčije po ustvaritvi lastnega atomskega orožja, kot ga sedaj izdeluje Francija. Nemško atomsko orožje v čisto nemških rokah in pod izključno nemškim nadzorom bi bilo vsekakor veliko nevarnejše od večnarodnega. V Moskvi se boje že tudi tega. Pred Nemci jih je še vedno strah, se še predobro spominjajo, kaj so jim prizade-

li v obeh svetovnih vojnah, zlasti pa v zadnji.

Uporaba atomskega streliva za kopanje kanalov še ni dosti raziskana

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Politika in napredek v vodnem prometu silita našo administracijo, da misli na novo kanalsko zvezo med Tihim in Atlantskim oceanom, ki naj bi bila na ravni morske površine. Načrtov za tak kanal ne manjka, so pa vsi zelo dragi in računajo s tehniko, ki je še nismo obvladali. Pri kopanju kanala naj bi namreč rabili atomsko strelivo.

Strokovnjaki za atomsko strelivo so sedaj izjavili pred Kongresom, da bo treba najmanj 5-10 let, predno bomo imeli u-

porabno atomsko razstrelivo za take potrebe. Na tem polju se obširnejše preiskave in poskusi sploh še niso začeli. Kar se je dosedanjim poskusom posrečilo, je samo občutno zmanjšanje radioaktivnosti. To je seveda veliko vredno, toda s tem še niso našli optimalne razdiralne moči atomskega streliva. Preiskavanja na tem polju bodo trajala najbrže 5-10 let. Proročjali so tudi, da bi bilo za prekop hribov in grebenov za nov kanal treba nad sto primernih atomskih bomb. Danes pa niti ne vedo, kakšne naj bodo.

Z vsemi temi podatki se strinja tudi predsednik naše atomske komisije Seaborg.

Novoizvoljeni predsedniki ne bodo začeli dela brez denarja

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Vsak na novo izvoljeni predsednik nastopi službo šele januarja. Ima torej dobrih 10 tednov časa, da organizira svoj režim vsaj v temelju, kajti drugi dan po zaprisegi mora že začeti uradovati.

Organiziranje temeljev nove uprave je draga stvar, stroški znašajo po približni cenitvi nekaj sto tisoč dolarjev. Odkod naj jih predsednik vzame? Na strankino blagajno se ne more zanesti, iz svojega ne more dati, ako ni ravno res bogat. Mora torej zelo varčevati, da ne zleze v dolgove. Vse to ga naravno ovira pri organizaciji federalne uprave.

Da olajša novemu predsedniku posel, se je sedanji Kongres odločil, da izglasuje zakon, ki bo dal predsedniku takoj po novembrskih volitvah na razpolago fond v znesku \$900,000, ki ga bo novi predsednik lahko porabil za kritje stroškov, ki jih bo imel s pripravo na prevzem poslov v januarju.

Na Kapitolu upajo, da zakonski načrt ne bo našel na ovire in da ga bodo kongresniki in senatorji obeh strank hitro odobrili.

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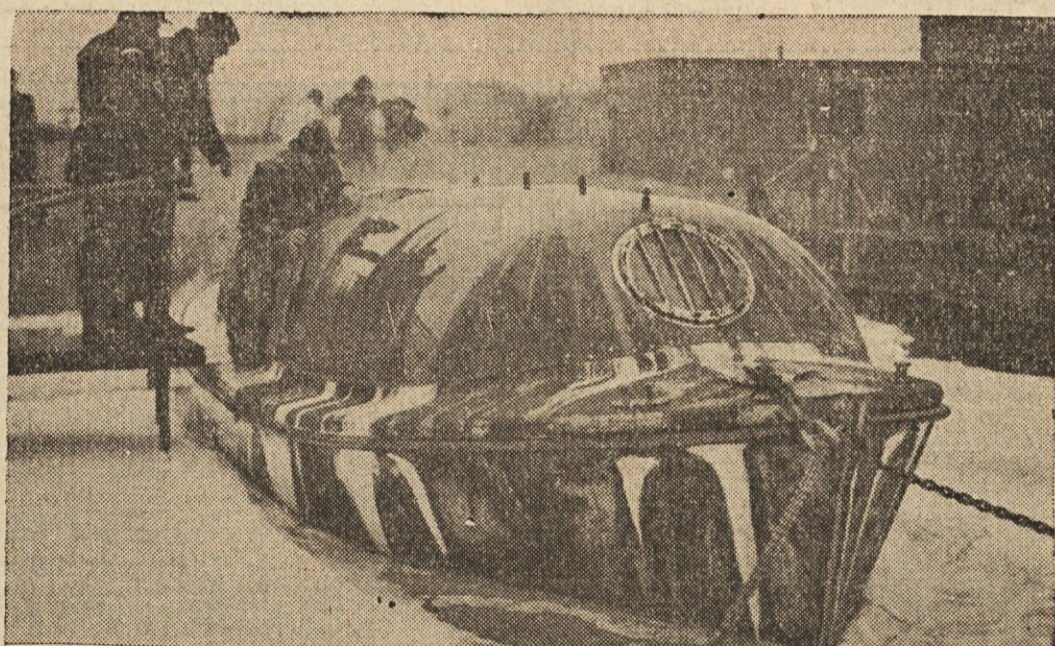

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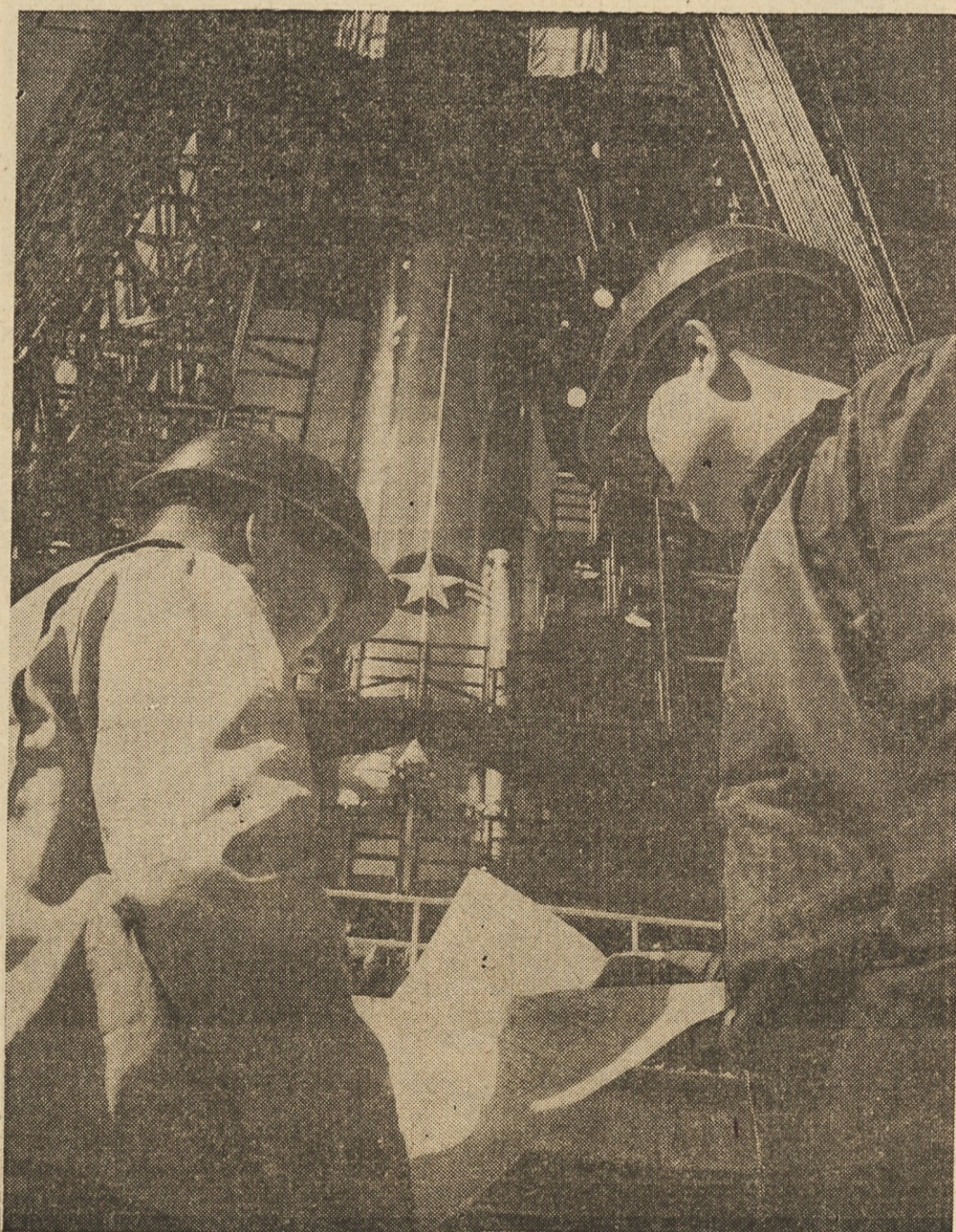

"Old 69"

"Old 69" is gone and there are no tears shed over its passing at the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company.

The last of the Illuminating Co.'s forest green trucks — "Old 69" as it was listed on the transportation log — has been retired and turned over to a scrap metal dealer.

It won't be missed because in today's heavy traffic — particularly at night — the truck was difficult to see. Why? The color — green — worked against it on all but the best lighted streets.

All of the company's vehicles, from a three-wheeled scooter used for mail delivery to the 26,000-pound lumbering line trucks, are painted yellow for safety's sake. Each, of course, carries the distinctive Reddy Kilowatt insignia.

The retirement of "Old 69" — a line truck — marks the end of a company program to change the color of all its vehicles.

Most of the green trucks and sedans were retired; a few were repainted.

Yellow was chosen by safety and transportation experts in the Illuminating Company because it is easily recognized; green, on the other hand, is difficult to spot until motorists are right on it.

The vehicles are important, but the safety of the men who drive them and are transported in them is paramount, as is the safety of motorists — Illuminating Company customers.

Thus, the switch from green to yellow.

The Illuminating Company maintains a fleet of 798 trucks and passenger cars and other rolling stock, tailored to the often unique jobs in the electric generation and distribution business.

Peace Corps

The Peace Corps has announced that the next Peace Corps Placement Test, required of all applicants interested in serving overseas, will be given on Saturday, March 14 at approximately 825 locations in principal cities throughout the United States. The Test begins at 8:30 a.m. local time.

Over 5,000 qualified Volunteers are needed to begin training this summer, said Sargent Shriver, Director of the Peace Corps. The most critical skills in demand, he said, are in the fields of agriculture, health, engineering, construction and education — particularly math and science teaching. But the Peace Corps, he added, also needs people skilled in physical education, home economics, architecture, geology, social work, and several hundred other categories to fill additional requests from the 46 countries where the Peace Corps is now working.

The two required tests, the General Aptitude Test and the Modern Language Aptitude Test, take about one and a half hours to complete. Applicants who have any proficiency in French or Spanish are asked to remain for an additional one-hour language achievement test.

Knowledge of a foreign language is not a requirement for taking the Placement Test or applying for Peace Corps service, officials said. Placement Test results are used, together with other criteria, in finding the most appropriate overseas assignment for each applicant. — Therefore the Test is "non-competitive", and there are no passing or failing grades. Scores are not released to applicants, and no applicants may take the Test more than once.

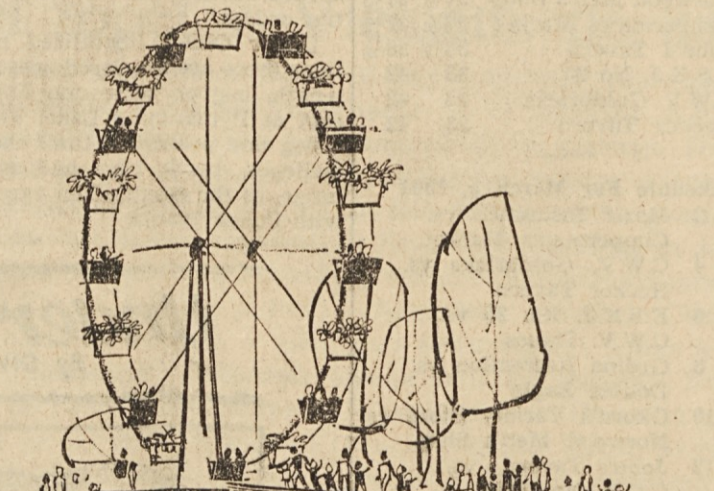
To take the Placement Test, applicants should bring with them a completed Peace Corps Questionnaire, if they have not previously mailed it to Peace Corps headquarters in Washington. Questionnaire forms are available from most post offices, college Peace Corps liaison officers, or from the Peace Corps, Washington, D.C. 20525. Applicants who have not submitted a Questionnaire will be asked to remain at the test center to complete one immediately following the Test.

Basic requirements for all applicants are that they be American citizens at least 18 years of age. There is no upper age limit. Married couples may apply if they have no dependents under 18. A college degree is not required, but college or vocational training increases an applicant's potential contribution. Liberal arts college graduates with no special "skills" are often used as teachers and community development workers.

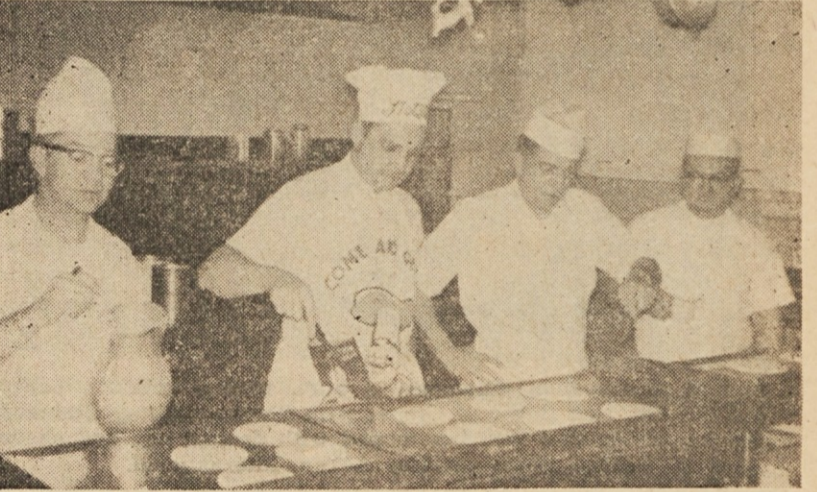

SPECIAL REPUBLICAN TASK FORCE ON EXPENDITURES. A Republican Expenditures Task Force, which last year succeeded in cutting the Administration's spending requests by some \$6.5 billion, hopes to save the taxpayers nearly the same amount this year. Headed by Representative Frank Bow of Ohio, the group is again fortunate to have the assistance of two top-flight experts, Maurice H. Stans, former Director of the Budget Bureau, and Robert E. Merriam, former Deputy Director of the Budget, both of whom served under President Eisenhower.

In spite of the Administration's claim that the Budget submitted this year calling for \$97.9 billion in expenditures is an "economy budget", it is felt there is still plenty of "fat" that can be eliminated. Actually the President is asking for new obligatory spending authority of \$103.7 billion. This is the real barometer of federal spending. Unless substantial reductions are made we will be in for continued deficit spending for many years to come. This would mean that the value of the dollar will be further eroded, causing more hardships for those with fixed annuity incomes such as retired persons. For these reasons it was decided to continue the Task Force this year. Every spending request in the Budget will be analyzed, item by item, with the view of reducing proposals where it is possible to do so without weakening our defense or undermining non-defense activities.

PRIVATE INVESTMENT GUARANTY PROGRAM

One of the more effective but least known provisions in the Foreign Assistance Act is the guarantee investment program. Briefly, the United States Government provides an insurance policy for private enterprise to investigate business possibilities overseas. To promote private investment in the underdeveloped areas, the Agency for International Development (AID) assumes some of the cost of investigating business opportunities. AID absorbs up to 50% of the cost of an investment survey if the results indicate a venture would not be suc-

cessful. However, if the survey is favorable, the firm pays the total cost and retains all rights to the information.

So far the program has attracted investors to the emerging nations at little cost to the Government. The average expenditure per survey has been under \$12,000. It has made a real difference to small business firms which might have been unable to bear the full cost of an unfavorable survey.

Private enterprise has everything at stake in the global struggle with international communism. The story of American capitalism can never be told as effectively as it can be demonstrated. This investment guarantee plan offers the business community a unique opportunity at a minimum risk to further private interest as well as the public good.

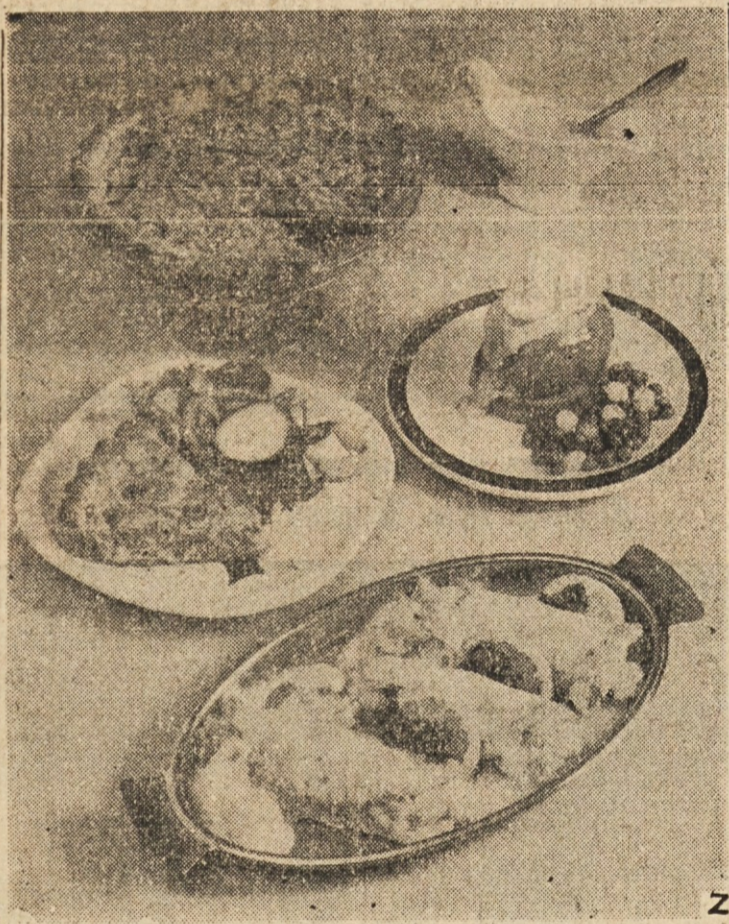
SALUTE TO BOY SCOUTS

Whatever is on the menu, whatever the occasion, the good cook makes sure that all dishes, however varied, have one element in common — top flavor!

CREPES WITH SHRIMP

½ cup sifted all-purpose flour
½ teaspoon salt
½ cup evaporated milk

¼ cup water
1 egg
Sift together flour and salt. Add evaporated milk, water and egg; beat. Measure 2 tablespoons of the batter; pour quickly into center of lightly greased 7-inch skillet. Tilt pan to spread batter over entire surface. Cook over medium heat until brown; turn and brown other side.

YIELD: 8 crepes.

SHRIMP FILLING

4 tablespoons butter or margarine
4 tablespoons flour
1 tablespoon finely chopped parsley
1 teaspoon Ac'cent
1 teaspoon prepared mustard
1 teaspoon salt
2 cups milk
2 cups cooked shrimp
Melt butter in a saucepan. Blend in flour, parsley, Ac'cent, mustard, and salt. Gradually stir in milk. Cook, stirring constantly, until mixture thickens and comes to a boil. Add shrimp; heat. Divide mixture among the crepes; fold.

YIELD: 4 servings.

CRABMEAT QUICHE

1 8-inch unbaked pie shell
2 eggs
1 cup light cream
1 teaspoon Ac'cent
¾ teaspoon salt
1/16 teaspoon cayenne
3 ounces Swiss cheese, grated
3 ounces Gruyere cheese, grated
1 tablespoon flour
1 can (6½ ounces) crabmeat, flaked.

Prick bottom and sides of pie shell with fork. Bake in a very hot oven (450° F) until delicate brown, about 10 minutes. Beat together eggs, cream, Ac'cent, salt and cayenne. Combine grated cheese, flour and crabmeat; sprinkle evenly in pie shell. Pour in cream mixture. Bake in a slow oven (325° F) 45 minutes to 1 hour or until tip of knife inserted in center comes out clean. Cut into small wedges.

YIELD: 16 wedges.

Poland's National Dance Company, "Mazowsze" To Appear in Music Hall

"Be sure to get your new fishing license before March 1," he said. "Also when you purchase your license be sure to ask for the Fishing Law Digest.

"This guide provides general information. Wildlife orders contain the details and are available for review in the office of the clerk of courts in each county. Fishermen should familiarize themselves with the orders."

Under Ohio's liberalized regulations there are no closed seasons, no length, bag or possession limit except at Pymatuning Lake. There is a bag and possession limit there on walleyes, black bass and muskellunge, as the result of an agreement with Pennsylvania.

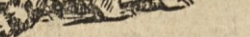
