Ko se črnci v južnih državah množično vpisujejo v volivne imenike, je eden registrarjev v Louisiani prisil sodišče, naj ustavi izvajanje zakona, ker da je v nasprotju z zvezno ustawo.

NEW ORLEANS, La. — Zvezni registrarji vpisujejo črnce v volivne imenike v državah Louisiana, Mississippi in Alabama v smislu novega zakona, ki ga je predsednik podpisal pretekli petek. Črne volivne upravičence vpisujejo v volivne imenike neoziraje se na to, ali znajo pisati in brati ali ne, če le drugače odgovarjajo predpisom zakona.

Registrar okraja Orleans Albert P. Gallinghouse je poslal sudišču vlogo, v kateri to poziva, naj ustavi izvajanje zakona, ker da je v nasprotju z določili zvezne ustave. To naj bi kršil ali ji nasprotoval v dopolnilih 10, 14, 17 in 24. Zadnje določilo je bilo uzakonjeno šele lani. O tej pritožbi bo odločeval mali senat.

Oblasti so naročile okrajnim registrarjem, naj se novega zakona drže in črne volivce vpisujejo v imenike, dokler ne bo sudišče odločilo drugače.

Glavni državni pravnik, guverner države in njegovi svetovalci se še vedno posvetujejo, kako pot naj končno uberejo. V državi Louisiana so bili po državnih predpisih določeni posebni izpiti o pismenosti. Kdor tega izpita ni napravil, ni mogel biti vpisan v volivni imenik.

Južne države stote na stalihu, da imajo posamezne države pravico določati predpise o volitvah, to naj bi jim jamčila sama zvezna ustanova. Zato oni ne govorijo foliko naravnost o volivnem zakonu, kot o kritvitiv državnih pravic od strani zveznih oblasti.

Podpori za stanarine sledi dodatek k plačam?

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Nekateri napovedujejo kot naslednji korak pri uresničevanju "velike družbe" sedaj, ko je uzakonjena podpora revnim družinam za stanarinu, dodatek k plačam očetom velikih družin s podpovprečnimi zaslužki.



Papandreou je zato začel popuščati. Pri zadnjem pogovoru s kraljem ni več zahteval, da postane vojni minister; tudi ni zahteval, da pride njegov sin v vlado. Mislijo, da so to znaki, ki kažejo, da se ne počuti več tako trdnega na svoji politični liniji kot se je pred p. dnevi. Odložil je tudi svoje agitacijsko potovanje po deželi.

Njegovi nasprotniki pa vneto iščejo novega kandidata za место ministrskega predsednika. Mislijo, da bi bil za to mesto dober tudi prejšnji minister za notranje zadeve.

Prejšnja vlada jih je vneto podpirala in se s tem zamerila vsem sosedom. Sedanja sudanska vlada bo pazila, da se na njenem ozemlju ne bodo zbiralni politični nasprotniki zakonitih sosednih vlad. Mahgoub bo pregnal fronto iz Sudana, zato bo cesar Haile Sellassie onemogočil sudanskim upornikom prehod v njegovo deželo.

Z novo sudansko politiko seveda niso zadovoljni levicari, posebno komunisti, ki bodo moralni sedaj iskati za svoja podtalna gibanja drugje svoja prizbežališča.

Odprto je pa vprašanje, koliko bodo takci dogovori vredni. Mahgoub je zastopnik Arabcev, sudanski sosedje so pa črnci, ki niso nikoli imeli dogovora z Arabci v časteh.





Census Bureau Will Sample TV Ownership In The United States

Families in this area will be asked about ownership of television sets

during the August Current Population Survey by the Bureau of the Census, according to Director Robert A. Kerrey of the Bureau's Regional Office in Detroit.

The Advertising Research Foundation and the Federal Communications Commission have requested the TV information in addition to the regular inquiries on employment and unemployment asked by the Bureau each month to furnish information for the U.S. Department of Labor's Bureau of Labor Statistics.

The TV questions will be aimed at determining:

1. If the sample family owns a television set.
2. Number of sets in the household.
3. If the household has color TV.
4. If it has ultra high frequency TV (Channels 14 to 83) and the type of UHF receiver if there is one.

A similar survey done in May 1964 showed that 93 percent of U.S.

households had television sets at that time. No questions were asked about color or UHF television in the 1964 survey.

The information will be collected during the work week starting Aug. 15 from scientifically selected sample households in this area as well as other sample areas throughout the U.S.

Over a two-year period, there have been cuts in federal income taxes.

Recently, Congress passed and the President signed a long overdue bill repealing the federal excise, or sales, taxes on a number of commodities in general use and reduced the levies on others. But just how much benefit will this be to the average person as measured by an increase in his spending power?

The answer seems to be: Very little at best.


Here's why: State and local tax increases are offsetting the federal reductions. During this legislative year, state after state has increased sales taxes, income taxes, gasoline taxes, cigarette taxes, and so on down the list. Local tax unit spending has followed a similar trend, and the property tax has reached a crisis point in many areas.

On top of that, a major increase in the federal social security tax, which is automatically deducted from the pay of all workers, is coming.

In other words, we have been putting more money into one pocket — and at the same time we are taking it out of another. Continued creeping inflation, which is largely the result of deficit spending by government, cuts further into spending and saving power. The tax cuts may make happy headlines — but that's about as far as they go.



In our day, kids weren't coddled with a menagerie of manufactured toys seen everywhere today. Instead we had the fun of inventing our own. Remember how a 21-inch tire was just large enough to climb inside for a jolting ride down a hill? And how inner tubes, when cut into half-inch bands, made excellent "slings" for hand-whittled guns.

Ah what great battle games we had with those guns that we sawed from a corner of an orange-crated frame. By ingeniously fixing a rubber band and one of Mom's clothespins—the kind that sprung—around the guns, we made triggers that worked like a dream. Unfortunately, our great guns were the bane of parents and teachers alike.

How versatile the old orange crate was. It made a perfect neighborhood lemonade stand, but if you didn't make a scooter out of one, you weren't one of the gang. All you needed aside from the crate was one roller skate, a 2x4 about 3½ feet long and some big long nails.

You took the skate apart and nailed a set of wheels to each end of the 2x4 and were careful to "toe" the nails (drive them in at an angle towards each other). Two strong sticks went on top of the orange crate for handlebars, then you nailed the crate to the front end of the 2x4. Hardly sophisticated, but so what. It was the greatest feeling in the world to barrel lickety-split down the middle of Main Street, doing tricks all the while, especially if a curly-headed little girl was watching your deeds of derring-do.

Today it's skateboards, probably more treacherous than orange-crated scooters. At least we had something to hold on to when we fell. Let us forget, however, how many times did we run home with scraped knees and elbows, battered shins, a bloody nose? Scrapes, cuts and bruises, sunburn, frostbite are perennial reminders that boys will be boys and girls sometimes seem bent on self-destruction, too.

Remember how it stung when our mothers put that ugly stuff on our wounds! Antiseptics today are less inducers of tears and more promoters of healing than they were when we were kids. Your Election Laws

This being the year for municipal elections, we are often asked why it is that in some cities there are seven councilmen, while other cities have nine; why some cities have wards and others none; why some have law directors and others solicitors, why some cities have non-partisan elections while others have ordinary partisan elections, and so on. There is substantial variety among the forms of government found in Ohio cities and villages, and many people wonder why.

The answer is that for more than fifty years Ohio has granted home rule to its cities and villages. Municipal home rule means that, within certain limitations, municipalities in Ohio are free to organize their governments as they see fit and to perform their municipal functions in whatever way suits them.

Ohio cities and villages may be governed under frameworks of government provided in state law—and state law provides several alternative forms from which they may choose—or they may, by framing a charter, adopt an original form of government designed for the individual community. But whether a city or village has a charter or not, it still has home rule, and it is free to make its own laws and regulate its local affairs in such manner as may please the people of that community—subject only to the general limitations contained in the state constitution.

Many people have the impression that if a city adopts a charter it must adopt the city manager form of government. That is not true. The charter may provide a city manager form of government, or it may provide for the mayor-council form if that is what the people prefer. In fact, a charter may simply duplicate the statutory form the community was using before it adopted a charter.

No charter may be adopted except by the vote of the people of the municipality. First they vote on the question of whether or not a commission shall be elected to draft a charter. If they vote in favor, an elected commission of fifteen members writes the charter. When they finish the draft, it is submitted to the people for their vote as to whether or not it shall be approved. Unless they approve of it, it does not go into effect.

Once the charter is adopted, it becomes a sort of municipal constitution. It can be amended only by popular vote.

The process of charter writing is a sort of experiment in local self-government, and the charters are as varied as the communities which adopt them.

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Postal Efficiency Plan

Postmaster Nelson E. Sundermeier announced that all Cleveland Post Office employees will be asked to take part in the new Postal Efficiency Plan called PEP, announced Wednesday, July 22, by Postmaster General John A. Gronouski.

The Postal Efficiency Plan includes comprehensive programs for improving postal service and reducing costs and it is our way of helping President Johnson fulfill his pledge to provide more effective and economical government services."

Postmaster General John A. Gronouski termed the plan's twin objectives of economy and service betterment "a matter of highest priority" and called for total involvement of all employees through the Post Office suggestion program.

Semi-annual reports will be made to the President, Mr. Gronouski said, and realized savings will be reverted to the Treasury or applied to improving postal service.

Mr. Sundermeier stated that a local committee will be organized to fulfill the two purposes of the plan:

1. Reduce costs
2. Improve services

Ideas generated by individual employees will be taken up by the committee. Accepted ideas will be passed on to Washington for possible application on a national level. Employees whose ideas are adopted nationwide will be given national awards. The Postmaster General will personally oversee the program.

Postmaster Nelson E. Sundermeier will be chairman of the local committee to implement PEP.
