PO KRSTU SMO LJBLJENI BOŽJI OTROCI

Na praznik Gospodovega krsta v prvem berilu spoznamo Izaijevo prerokbo, ki jo navajajo evangeliji glede poslanstva Janeza Krstnika. Prerok razglša tolažbo za judovske izgnance v Babilonu. Čas kazni za grehe je minil. Bog sam se bo postavil na čelo zmagoslavnega sprevoda ob vrnitvi v obljubljeni deželo. Potrebno je torej pripraviti pot Gospodu v puščavi, ki ločuje Palestino od Babilonije. Zato prerok kriči: »V puščavi pripravite pot Gospodu, zavnajte v puščavi cesto našemu Bogu! Vsaka dolina naj se dvigne in vsak hrib in grič naj se poniža«.

Krstnik se predstavi, tako judovskim duhovnikom kot levitom, ki so prihajali iz Jeruzalema in ga spraševali o njegovi identiteti in poslanstvu, da ni Mesija niti prerok Elija ali prerok, podoben Mojzesu. Je samo glas v puščavi, ki kliče: »Pripravite pot Gospodu,« kot je povedal Izaija (Jn 1,19-23).

Prerokovo vabilo, moralne narave, tj. zapolniti vse velike pomanjkljivosti božje postave in znižati vse preponosne predsodke in nasprotovanja. Krstnik spodbuja ljudi, naj se spreobrnejo in se dajo krstiti, da bi tako pokazali, da se imajo namen očistiti.

Če tako gledamo, je bil Jezusov krst nekaj presenetljivega, nepričakovanega. Samo po sebi ne bi bilo potrebno, da bi bil Jezus krščen. Janezov krst je bil namreč namenjen grešnikom.

Janez je krščeval z vodo, ki očičšuje, umiva. Tako ponazarja očičševanje, ki ga zahteva krščenje.

Pavel nam pravi, da ima krst tudi večji pomen: pomeni smrt greha, da bi živeli v čistosti in svetosti. V tistem času so krščevali s potapljanjem, to pomeni, da se je krščenec povsem potopil v vodo in tako pokazal, da je skoraj mrtev, potopljen. Potem spet pride na površje, da pokaže, kako se je vrnil v novo življenje.

Jezus ni potreboval krsta zase, kajti bil je brez greha. Sprejel pa ga je, da bi lahko nakazal svoje poslanstvo: prišel je zato, da bi naše prevzel naše grehe, da bi umrl grehu namesto nas in bi lahko vstali v novo življenje; življenje, ki ga s tem polaga pred nas.

Janez je vnaprej videl, da bo tisti, ki bo prišel za njim, podelil

veliko bolj učinkovit krst, kot ga je podeljeval sam: »Jaz vas krščujem z vodo, pride pa močnejši od mene, in jaz nisem vreden, da bi mu odvezal jermen njegovih sandal; on vas bo krstil s Svetim Duhom in ognjem.«

Janezov krst je bil znamenje, hotel je pokazati na učinkovitost Jezusovega krsta, in Jezus ga sprejme kot znamenje svojega poslanstva, da bo za nas umrl in vstal od mrtvih, tako, da nam bo lahko podelil krst v Svetem Duhu. V Jezusovem krstu gre za pričevanje Svetega Duha. Luka pripoveduje, da se je med Jezusovim krščevanjem, takrat, ko je molil, odprlo nebo in nadenj se je spustil Sveti Duh, v telesni podobi kakor goloba in slišal se je glas: »Ti si moj ljubljeni Sin, nad teboj imam veselje.«

S temi besedami je Oče Jezusa poveličal. Njegovo ponižanje - njegov krst je bil ponižanje, ki ga ni bil dolžan sprejeti - rojeva njegovo poveličanje.

V drugem berilu pa od Jezusovega krsta prehajamo k našemu krstu, ki je sad velikonočne skrivnosti. Pavel ga imenuje »kopel preropenja in prenovitve po Svetem Duhu«, kar se sklada z Janezovo prerokbo: »On vas bo krstil s Svetim Duhom« (Lk 3,16).

Apostol izpostavlja, da je krst čudovit božji dar. Zaradi velikodušne Jezusove ljubezni, da je »dal sam sebe za nas, da bi nas odkupil iz vse grešnosti«, »sta se razodeli dobrota in človekoljubnost Boga, našega odrešenika«.

Milost, ki jo prejmemo pri sv. krstu, je zastonjski dar, ki ne temelji na dobrih delih, ki smo jih že prej izvršili. Vendar pa nam ta milost daje luč in moč, da smo »vneti za dobra dela« in »naj se odpovemo brezbožnosti in posvetnemu poželenju ter razumno, pravično in res pobožno živimo v sedanjem veku«, seveda v pričakovanju Kristusovega veličastnega prihoda.

Sv. krst pomeni, da je Jezus prišel odrešit vse ljudi. Sprejmimo razodetje Jezusovega krsta kot razodetje njegove krotkosti, ponižnosti in na drugi strani kot izredne rodovitnosti njegovega ponižanja, ki je posledica njegovega poveličanja. Vse to je pravzaprav v odrešenju, ki nam je vsem podeljeno in česar smo nenehno deležni.

Response: O, bless the Lord, my soul!

FIRST READING: *Isaiah 42:1-4.6-7*

Centuries before the birth of Jesus, Isaiah gives us a description that fits perfectly.

SECOND READING: *Acts 10:34-38*

St Peter also gives a brief description of Jesus' life and mission and explains that the Good News is for everyone.

GOSPEL: *Luke 3:15-16. 21-22*

St Luke describes how the humble Christ comes to be baptised by John in the river Jordan.

“You are my Son, the Beloved; my favour rests on you”.

I'm sure there are plenty of fathers at Mass today who have been asked by a nervous young man to give their blessing on the marriage of their daughters. "Do we have your blessing?" is a question that demands a serious answer. After all, "I give you my blessing" is so much more meaningful than, "Well, if that's what you want" or "I've no objection!"

There is a desire deep within each one of us to be blessed, to have our parents or other significant people say, "You are my beloved child; with you I am well pleased." In fact, if our parents or guardians withhold their blessing, we can carry a lifelong wound. What we can be assured of, without exception, and without conditions, is that each one of us is beloved of God who blesses us abundantly with his grace and favour.

Gospel teaching

At the beginning of Jesus' mission, after the hidden years of life in Nazareth, the heavens open and the Holy Spirit descends on him. This is another Epiphany when God is manifested in the person of Jesus of Nazareth. A voice from heaven reveals Jesus' identity, not only as the carpenter, the son of Mary and Joseph, but as the Son of God, the Beloved. It is also made clear that John the Baptist is simply the forerunner of Christ; he baptises with water only, but Jesus baptises with the Holy Spirit and the fire of Pentecost. Jesus Christ is truly human and truly divine.

The three persons of the Trinity are described in our Gospel reading. The Father, Son, and Spirit enter human history in the event of the baptism of the humble Christ who associates with sinners. We hear that while Jesus was at prayer, "heaven opened". In other words, heaven and earth are connected powerfully and we come to "share in the divinity of Christ who humbled himself to share in our humanity".

Application

Every Sunday, along with hundreds of millions of other Christians, we recite the Creed, most often the Nicene Creed. During this Jubilee Year, 2025, we celebrate the seventeenth centenary of the Council of Nicea, which is the basis of the Creed we still use today. Just imagine, seventeen centuries during which, using these same words, billions of Christians have expressed their belief in God as the One who loves, the One who is beloved, and the One who is the Love between them. During that gathering in Nicea, in the year 325, well before these islands were evangelised, the Council delegates came to a unified statement of who Jesus Christ is. We



are the heirs of those who gathered so long ago, and we too believe in the mystery of God's continuing presence in our world, and in our call to live in that mystery while being Christ's hands and feet in our concrete service and generous love for suffering humanity.

When we say the words of the Creed, we are committing ourselves to beliefs that have practical, real-life implications. For example, when we say: "I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only Begotten son of God... through him all things were made", we are expressing our belief in Christ's identity as true God and true man. But we are also expressing our understanding of our own identity as human beings created in God's image and disciples of Christ. In this vision, there is no separation between us and God, and we share in the blessedness of all that God has made. In fact, when we say, "through him all things were made", we acknowledge that every part of God's creation – and not just human beings – is graced and full of dignity. All of creation is beloved and God's favour rests on all God has created. This means that we can never see other people or our world as things to be exploited or used solely for our benefit. We walk upon a sacred earth and each of our interactions with others has the potential to be encounters with God.

Let us, then, be a blessing to each other and to our world, following the example of Jesus, who did not need to be baptised but chose to humble himself to be in solidarity with the weak and vulnerable. Let us go the extra mile, not seeking entitlement or exemption, but being people of humble service in the manner of Jesus. Perhaps that can be our New Year resolution.




