Novo velikansko letalo bo pocenilo počevanje

Vojnaško prevozno letalo, ki bo sposobno ponesi do 600 mož preko morja, bo brez dvoma dobilo civilnega tovariša.

AUSTIN, Tex. — Obrambni tajnik McNamara je povedal v torku, da je predsednik Johnson odredil izdelavo in gradnjo letala, ki bodo sposobna enkrat vzeti seboj preko oceana do 600 ljudi ali do četr milijona tonov tovora. Prvo, poskusno letalo naj bi bilo v zraku že v par letih, koncem leta 1968 ali v začetku 1969 pa naj bi jih imelo oborožene sile že več na razpolago. Za enkrat jih misijo zgraditi tri skvadroni, skupno 58 letal. Za izdelavo prvega letala bodo porabili do 750 milijonov dolarjev, gradnja ostalih pa bo stala še okoli en bilijon.

Novo letalo bo največje na svetu in bo zelo skrajšalo čas prevoza ameriških oboroženih sil v katerikoli del sveta. Trije predvideni skvadroni bodo sposobni ponesti celo divizijo z vso opremo v enem samem letalu preko morja.

Novo velikansko jet letalo bo imelo brez dvoma tudi močan vpliv na potniški letalski promet. Saj bo verjetno v kratkem dobilo svojega civilnega tovariša. Potovanje v takem letalu bo na eni strani bolj sproščeno in mirnejše, na drugi pa tudi cenejše. Tako vsaj trdijo letalski strokovnjaki.

Leta 1812 ni iz Rusije pregnal Napoleon mraz

BONN, Nem. — Finski meteorolog dr. Angervo je objavil daljšo razpravo, kjer skuša dokazati, da ni zima pregnala Napoleona iz Rusije. Napoleona armada je prišla na rusko mejo 19. oktobra 1812, je prodrala do Moskve, potem se je začela umikati in je 27. in 28. novembra bila zopet na reki Berezini, ki jo je, kot trdijo zgodovinarji, prekorila brez težav, ker je bila reka pokrita z ledom.

Dr. Angervo trdi, da med 19. oktobrom in 29. novembrom ni bilo v Rusiji nikoli tako mraz, da bi bile reke dalj časa zamrzljene; termometer je kazal povprečno 35 do 45 stopinj F., le redki so bili dnevi, ko je voda res začela zmrzavati. Meteoreolog dokazuje svoje stališče s številnimi podatki vremenskih postaj v Moskvi, Petrogradi, Rigi, Varšavi itd. Dodaja pa, da je v decembru 1812 res nastopil v Rusiji hud mraz, ki je trajal v pozno pomlad leta 1813.

Napoleon sam se seveda sklicuje na mraz, ker noče priznati, da je moglo biti kaj drugega razlog za njegov poraz, ki je posmenil začetek konca njegove zgodovinske vloge.

V Panami pripravljajo izgrede proti Ameriki

Levičarske organizacije z levičarskimi študenti na čelu pripravljajo demonstracije za obletnico lanskih januarskih nemirov.

PANAMA CITY, Pan. — Lani v januarju je prišlo v Kanski coni do hudo izgredov, med katerimi je bilo blizu 20 oseb mrtvih, med njimi tudi par ameriških vojakov, še veliko več pa ranjenih. Povod za demonstracije in izgrede so našli levičarji, ki so jih organizirali, v sporu zaradi izobesjanja panamske zastave na srednji šoli v Kanski coni. Izgredi so povzročili hudo napetost med Panamino in Ameriko. Ta je popustila šele več mesecov kasneje.

Levičarske skupine, z levičarsko študentovsko organizacijo na čelu pripravljajo sedaj sprevide v manifestacije ob obletnici na te demonstracije. Vlad svetujejo, naj se vanje ne meša, če sama sebi dobro hoče. Zadnja objava Združenih držav, da bodo gradile nov preklop preko Srednje Amerike in sklenile s Panamino novo pogodbo o uporabi sedanjega in novega, je organizatorje pohodov malo zmedila, pa so se hitro znašli in začeli znova pozivati ljudi, naj bodo "pripravljeni korakati in umreči za svojo zastavo".

Izgleda, da ti ljudje nimajo dosti smisla za koristi Paname. Ta ima od sedanjega prekopa letno okoli 90 milijonov dolarjev neposrednih in posrednih dohodkov. Če se Združene države odločijo graditi zaradi sovražnega razpoloženja Paname novi prekop, kje drugod, bo Panama te dohodek v dveh desetletjih izgubila, s tem pa tudi osnovno za svoje sedanje sorazmerno blagostanje.

NASER VPIJE NA AMERIKO

Predsednik Združene arabske republike Naser je včeraj v govoru na "Dan zmage" izjavljal, da bodo Egipčani rajše zategnili pasove, kot pa dovolili vmešavanje Združenih držav v egipčanske zadeve. Priznal je podpiranje upornikov v Kongu.

KAIRO, ZAR. — Med demonstracijami v glavnem mestu Egipta zaradi ameriško-belgijskega posega v Kongu za rešitev belih talcev iz rok upornikov so demonstranti požgali knjižnico informativnega središča Združenih držav, pred par dnevi so egipčanska lovška letala sestrelila ameriško privatno letalo, ko je letelo nad delom zahodne egipčanske puščave, včeraj pa je predsednik Naser javno obdolžil Združene države vmešavanja v egipčanske zadeve in zahteval, da bodo Egipčani rajše zategnili pasove, kot pa da bodo kaj takega dovolili. "Mi ne sprejememo nobene besede proti nam in odrezali bomo jezik vsakomur, ki jih bo izgovoril. Mi ne potrebujemo nihovega denarja!" je prepričeval Naser zbrano mnogočico.

Naser je govoril na "Dan zmage" v spomin konca angleško-francosko-izraelskega pohoda v Egiptu leta 1956. Angleži, Franci in Izraelci so se tedaj umaknili iz Egipta na skupen pritisk Združenih držav in Sovjetske zveze, ki je nekako v istem času z vso grobostjo in nasihem strala protikomunistični upor na Madžarskem. Poleg Naserja je na govorniškem odu v Port Saidu včeraj stal Aleksander Šešelin, eden od podpredsednikov vlade Sovjetske zveze. Ameriškega poslanika Battla je obdolžil Naser gospodarskega pritiska na Egipt in izjavil: "Mi ne bomo sprejeli pritiska od nikogar!" Nato je posvaril svoje rojake na morebitne posledice ukinjenja ameriškega pomoči, ki dosegla letno okoli 140 milijonov dolarjev. Gre predvsem za pšenico in ostale deželne pridelke.

Razvijajoča se industrija in druge gospodarske panege potrebujejo vedno več delavstva in uslužbenstva. Zahodni Berlin dobiva mlade ljudi z Vzhoda, vendar je ta dotok, odkar so postavili znani "Zid", skoraj usahnil, večinoma pa iz Zahodne Nemčije. Tako je prišlo letos od tam v Zahodni Berlin skupno preko 17,100 moških, pa le 8,100 deklek.

Pomanjkanje mladih deklek je postalо očitno in nekateri mladi moški tožijo, da jim je v Berlinu predolgo čas in da se utegnijo zato vrneti v Zahodno Nemčijo, kjer pomanjkanja deklek ni.

Mestne oblasti so se obrnile na vlado v Bonnu, naj skuša pridobiti čim več mladih Nemšk v Zahodni Nemčiji za preselitev v Zahodni Berlin.

De Gaulle se veseli svoje zmage v EGS

PARIZ, Fr. — General De Gaulle ni mogel zatajiti na zadnjem seji francoske vlade svojega veselja nad sporazumom, ki so države Evropske gospodarske skupnosti (EGS) dosegle glede cen za pšenico, koruzo in pa drugih žit. Resnici na ljubo je treba ponoviti, da generalovo stališče ni bilo napačno. Nemčija je v okviru EGS dobila celo vrsto koncesij vprid njeni industriji, ki je po tej postali vodilna v Evropi in ne samo v EGS. Počemu naj bi sedaj ne nosila nekaj žrtev na račun svojega poljedelstva? Nemška vladava vsemu temu ni dosti ugovarjala, povdraljala je le to, da zanje še ni prišel čas, da popušča na račun svojih kmetov. Imela bo prihodnje leto parlamentarne volitve in ne sme odbiti volivcev od sebe in jih pognati socialistom v naročje. Ako že mora priti do žrtev na nemški račun, potem naj del teh žrtev nosijo tudi ostale članice EGS, da tako ne bo nemško kmetijstvo preveč prizadeto. De Gaulle je pokazal razumevanje za nemško stališče in proti svoji navadi dovolil svoji diplomaciji, naj tudi svoje strani popušča in omogoči sporazum. Sporazum bo začel veljati šele v l. 1967, torej celo leto po nemških volitvah. Nemška krščansko-socijalna stranka bo imela dosti prilike, da potolaže svoje kmetske volivce in da jim naračuna, kako bodo pokrili svoje zgube radi nižjih cen za žita s pšenico na celu.

De Gaulle se torej veseli in napoveduje nove čase za Evropo. Sedaj obstaja samo "gospodarska Evropa", mora pa priti tudi do "politične Evrope", seveda take, kot si jo zamišlja general. Pri tem "gospodarska Evropa" še ni dogotovljena, treba je doseči še sporazume o sadju, zelenjavni, alkoholnih pijačah, oljih, mesnih in mlečnih izdelkih itd. Treba je dalje doseči sporazume na finančnem polju.

Senator Young se znaša nad guv. Rhodesom

CLEVELAND, O. — Naš demokratski senator Young je zmagal pri zadnjih volitvah, da je stavil na hotel nihče staviti na njegovo zmago. Zmaga res ni bila veličastna, toda zmaga je vendarla bila. Young se ocitno ne strinja s tako ponižno razlagom in je radi tega napadel guvernerja Rhoda, da je pri volivnem postopku uganjil naravnost umazano izigravanje glasovanja na tistih voliščih, kjer so volivci glasovali s pomočjo volivnih strojev. Po guvernerjevem naročilu so namreč volivne komisije postavile ime republikanskega kandidata za senatorja Tafta prav blizu imena predsednika Johnsona. Tako je mnogo volivcev, ki so glasovali za Johnsona, iz nemarnosti ali zaniknosti glasovalo tudi za Tafta, dasiravno so mislili na Younga. Youngovi pristaši so to dognali s primerjavo Youngovih glasov na voliščih z volivnimi stroji z volišči, kjer so volivci volili z volivnimi listami.

Kako se bo guverner Rhodes oddolžil Youngu za ta nenavadni božični pozdrav, bomo moranda videli tik pred novim letom. So namreč v navadi tudi novoletna voščila.

Svojevrstna ameriška "napadalnost" na korejski fronti

SEOUL, Kor. — Na meji med Severno in Južno Korejo vlada mir, toda tam so še zmeraj na straži vojski oddelki in ne običajna obmejna policija. Da se tam naši vojaki dolgočasijo, ni težko razumljivo. Zato so si letos izmisli posebno zabavo: začeli so se pozimi kepati s komunističnimi nasprotniki, ki so postali kar vneti za ta način preganjanja dolgega časa. Drugih misli je bilo poveljstvo rdečih čet. Poslalo je našim oficirjem oster protest proti "ameriški napadalnosti" v obliki kepanja in sporočilo, da je dalo svojim vojakom nalog, da se takega bojevanja s kepami ne smejo več udeleževati.

Naši vojaki so dalje postavili na vidnih mestih prirodna božična drevesa in jih lepo okrasili in razsvetlili. Komunistični oficirji so pa tudi proti temu, ker kaj takega ne predvideva dogovor o premirju! Rdeči protest je v tem slučaju ostal brez uspeha, s čemur so menda redči vojaki kar zadovoljni.

Leta 1957 je bilo na švicarskih alpskih področjih v obratovanju že osem cevovodov za mleko, tako imenovanih "laktodrov", dve leti kasneje se je njihovo število zvišalo na 50 in doseglo skupno dolžino 240 km. Po najdaljšem med njimi — osem kilometrov — steče v sezoni okoli 60,000 litrov mleka.

Novost, ki se je obnesla najprej v Švici, so uvedle tudi druge dežele, med njimi Avstrija, Nizozemska, Danska in Švedska. Nizozemci in Švedi so začeli polagati podzemeljske plastične cevi, po katerih teče mleko pod pritiskom tlačilk in črpalk.







Dog License

County Auditor Ralph J. Perk announced that he has opened 26 substations for the sale of dog licenses. Mr. Perk stated that Section 955.01 of the Ohio Revised Code requires that "every person who owns, keeps, or harbors a dog more than three months of age, shall, before the 20th day of January of each year, file, in the office of the County Auditor of the county in which such dog is kept or harbored, an application for registration for the following year, beginning the 20th day of January of each year, stating age, sex, color, character of hair, and the name and address of the owner of such dog. A registration fee of \$2.00 for each dog shall accompany such application."

The law further states that if such application for registration is not filed and paid on or before the 20th day of January of each year, a penalty of \$1.00 shall be assessed against the owner.

Under the present law, should a dog be acquired after January 20, a license must be applied for within 30 days, otherwise a penalty of \$1.00 shall be assessed upon the owner.

The penalty upon a dog kennel operator for failure to apply for a license in time is \$5.00.

Headquarters for all licenses is the County Auditor's office, in the County Administration Bldg., 1219 Ontario St., Room 121.







HOT TEA LEMONADE

No other time of the year brings with it as complete a return to tradition as the observance of the Christmas Season. And what is more traditional than the punch bowl, an age-old symbol of hospitality and good cheer? With holiday parties coming up there's a need for easy-to-taste, good-to-taste beverages. Any punch is equally at home at an informal "open house"... at a more formal "reception"... at an after-sports gathering. You don't even need an elegant punch bowl to have punch parties. Use a large colorful plastic bowl with a few holiday stickers around the outside and you'll have a gay and festive serving piece. Or, if you're having a hot punch, serve it from a chafing dish.

And, punch can be spirited without spirits. Tea is the magic ingredient. It gives body to the punch without masking the flavors of the other ingredients. More than a treat to your taste, it will be a treat to your pocket book and won't set budget limits to your holiday entertaining.

Include other refreshments but keep them simple. Refrigerator cookies can be baked in just a few minutes, decorated with a little icing and a few colorful sprinkles to add to your festive atmosphere. Cut your sandwiches into attractive squares, triangles or oblongs or into circles with a cookie cutter. To make it a real occasion, add

a few garnishes to the punch. Easy delicate touches like lemon rings studded with cloves... an ice ring made by freezing water or fruit juice in a ring mold pan... sprigs of holly on punch cup handles and laddle... holiday greens or Christmas tree balls around the base of the punch bowl... and cinnamon sticks for muddlers in the punch cups.

To start you off on your punch-bowl entertaining here are some recipes to make everyone pleased as punch.

Hot Tea Lemonade

(makes 8-12 servings)
¾ cup cold water
¾ cup granulated sugar
2 quarts freshly drawn cold water
3 tablespoons loose tea or 9 bags
12 whole cloves
½ cup lemon juice


Make simple syrup by combining ¾ cup water and ¾ cup granulated sugar in a saucepan. Bring to a boil, reduce heat and simmer 10 minutes. While syrup is simmering, prepare tea by bringing two quarts freshly drawn cold water to a full rolling boil. Immediately, pour water over tea. Let stand for 3 to 5 minutes. Strain into a chafing dish or other serving container. Add simple syrup, cloves and lemon juice. To serve, place a lemon slice speared with an additional whole clove in each cup and fill with tea.

Pin-Ball Tea Punch

2 quarts freshly drawn cold water
¼ cup loose tea, 15 teabags or 5 tablespoons instant tea
1 cup sugar
1 cup water
2 2-inch cinnamon sticks
1 tablespoon grated lemon rind
2 teaspoons grated orange rind
½ cup orange juice
½ cup lemon juice
½ cup pineapple juice

For tea leaves or teabags, bring two quarts of water to a full rolling boil. Pour over tea, cover and let brew 3 to 5 minutes; strain. For

instant tea, merely dissolve in cold water. Combine sugar, 1 cup water, cinnamon and fruit rinds. Simmer 15 minutes. Add syrup and fruit juices to tea and chill thoroughly. Serve in punch bowl over ice cubes, or make pretty ice ring like this: Arrange seasonal or well drained frozen or canned fruit in a shallow layer of water in the bottom of the ring mold or angel food cake pan. Put in freezer until fruit pattern is frozen in place. Add more ice water and return to freezer until entire ring is solid. Unmold by running a little water over bottom of pan.



HOLIDAY PUNCH

Holiday Punch

(makes about 4 quarts)

1 quart boiling water
½ cup loose tea (15 teabags)
1 teaspoon whole cloves
1 6-ounce can lemonade
2 cups cranberry juice
1 can (20 ounces) crushed pineapple
2 cups orange juice
sugar to taste
lemon slices
cinnamon sticks (optional)

Pour boiling water over tea and cloves. Brew 4 minutes. Stir and strain. Add remaining ingredients except lemon slices and cinnamon sticks. Pour into pre-heated bowl. Garnish with clove-studded lemon slices. If desired, place a cinnamon stick in each punch cup to serve as a muddler.

TB And Christmas

Today, TB strikes more than 50,000 persons in the United States every year. Tomorrow, TB may be gone. The difference between today and tomorrow is you and your use of Christmas seeds. The Anti-Tuberculosis League of Cleveland and Cuyahoga County relies upon the funds derived from Christmas seals for research and for educational programs connected with both tuberculosis and the various respiratory diseases.

Tuberculosis, still a scourge in remote parts of the world, is no longer a major killer in the United States.

This is no reason to forget about the disease; in fact, it is more reason to remember it. The road to complete eradication is a shorter one. As for instance, there were 719 new cases of tuberculosis within Cleveland in 1963; 38 deaths attributable to TB, and 75 reactivated cases, reports Health Commissioner J. Glen Smith.

Public health nurses follow up all tuberculosis cases by making home visits, teaching patients to care for themselves and to take certain precautions. More patients are being treated at home wherever possible, rather than being hospitalized.

Tuberculosis education, part of the on-going prevention program of the Anti-Tuberculosis League, helps keep the public aware of the need for preventive care.

Yearly X-rays and/or tuberculin tests should be standard procedure. Perhaps you remember the old radio program mystery, "The Shadow Knows." In the case of tuberculosis, the shadow on the lungs tells the doctor that something is wrong. Chest X-rays may be obtained free of charge at six of the seven health centers, at City Hall, or at the County Tuberculosis Clinics. In addition, during the spring, summer and fall months mobile units provided by the League travel to neighborhoods, schools and industries. A Letter from Puerto Rico

The following interesting letter was received from Bro. Frank Mocnik, S.M.

Dear Folks:

Forgive me for this type of letter for Christmas. If I had the time, I would like to write a personal letter to each and every one of my family, relations and friends. I usually start my Christmas mail the day after Thanksgiving, but that day is gone, and there is only a few days before Christmas left. We three Marianists up here on top of the Mountain, in the center of the Beautiful Island of Puerto Rico, extend to each and every one of you our wishes and prayers for a very Merry Christmas and a Happy and Blessed New Year. May we all be united at the Christmas Mass or Service as one big happy family asking the Infant Jesus and Mother Mary to help each and every one in our daily problems and to give us health and happiness throughout the New Year. In union there is strength, and may our humble prayers be heard.

It seems strange to hear Christmas Carols on the radio while all of the trees and flowers are in their full bloom and glory. Along the highways we see beautiful poinsettias in different shades and colors, not as small plants, but as bushes and trees. Snow we do not have here what we are used to in the States. When the sugar cane is mature it is crowned with a tassel like a miniature silvery pine tree. When we go up and down the mountain and with the sun shining on these tassels, it gives an impression of snow.

Being assigned up here in our Parish of about 25 square miles and about 10,000 poor is indeed a privilege. Being able to give what little we have to help them and to help them improve their lives is a privilege that money cannot buy. To be part of them, to eat with them in their homes, to work with them and to pray with them, is an experience. The first time I was invited into a typical home for lunch was not easy, but as I entered the house I offered up a little prayer asking Our Lord and Mother Mary to accept this for the success of our works here.

What they call their home is a hut with four walls, a roof and a floor. Primitive but yet a place they call mi casa. The place where I am building a Chapel has no drinking water nor electricity. The family just below the Chapel site gives us a lunch daily. At first I told the lady of the house that I did have my sandwiches, but no, she had lunch for us. The daily meal consists of a fried egg in grease, cooked plantain which looks like a banana, but is a vegetable, fried potatoes and cod fish. This is topped off with coffee. To refuse her hospitality would have been harmful, so I gave the sandwiches to her children and partake of the meal she was so gracious to prepare. The dining room table is made out of old boards and the chairs the same. The walls of the house inside are unfinished with just the outside siding keeping out the cold and rain. In this house they have 3 rooms: living room & dining room, and 2 bedrooms. Family total is 7. How they do it, I do not know, but they are happy and healthy. Why they live like this in this day and age is not because they are lazy and want this, but what money they make picking coffee, bananas and other crops is just about enough to feed them for the year.

Schooling here is a problem. Some have to leave their homes at 6 a.m. to get to school by 8 a.m. They walk to school rain or shine, and when they get there, they may find out that the teacher did not show up. So that means another day of schooling lost, their lunch which they get free at the school which may be their only meal for the day, not received, and so they walk back home up and down muddy roads and paths. Many do not get too far in school, for as soon as they are able to work, the family needs them for support. In one of the many plans that we have here, one of them and a very important plan, is to build a school for Junior and Senior High. When and how we are going to do this we do not know, but if it is the Will of God, it will be done.

Father Albert Schmidt, S.M., is from Cleveland, Ohio, and Father Ignatius Kinchus, S.M. is from Pittsburgh, Pa. They are both doing a wonderful job, and it seems that they have the understanding and attention of the people here. Nothing is too difficult for them to do. Each Sunday they each have three Masses, and their first meal will be Sunday evening after they finish their Masses. At times they have to travel on foot to reach the Chapel they are to have Mass, for it has been raining or still is, and the road is not useable. So up they climb the mud and rain, not an easy chore, but it has to be done, for reaching the place for Mass, people will be waiting for him. Thank goodness we have a washer and drier here, for getting home, the first thing to do is to put their cassocks and clothes in the washer to get out the mud. It is hard to believe this to exist here in Puerto Rico, for many of us think of missions in places like Africa and South America. May Our Lord and Mother Mary give our two Priests the strength and courage to keep

Housecleaning ... As Easy as 1, 2, 3

New ideas and products have brought us just shy of push button cleaning.

As a result, the days of housecleaning sapping all your energy and making a major dent in your pocketbook are gone forever. Provided you make use of today's new cleaning techniques and methods.

Draperies

For example, remember when it cost a small fortune to have your draperies drycleaned commercially? Well not anymore! Now all you do is take the draperies, curtains and slipcovers down to the coin-op dry-cleaners, and for just a few dollars they're ready to hang again within hours. Ironing is unnecessary since whatever rumpling there is hangs out... or stretches out over upholstery.

Venetian Blinds

Before you hang your clean drapes, windows and venetian blinds should be washed. The very thought of cleaning blinds was once enough to make one weary. Many modern homemakers now soak their blinds in the bathtub. While the blinds are soaking, they go about another chore. The tub should be about half full of sudsy water, and the blinds soak for 10 or 15 minutes, they should be thoroughly rinsed. It's best to dry them out of doors — there's usually more room and they dry faster.

If you prefer to clean your blinds while they're still hanging, try a liquid clean-up wax which will remove grease and grime easily. Apply the wax on a damp cloth to each slat and wipe dry immediately with a clean cloth. Work from the bottom up, raising the blind as you go. Waxen venetian blinds will stay clean for a long time.

Rug and Carpet Cleaning

Carpets and rugs are probably the most expensive furnishings in your home, and unfortunately these precious possessions get dirtier than practically anything else. For instance, did you realize that a 9'x12' rug absorbs about three pounds of

up their fine work.

Life up here is different in many ways. First of all we are 2½ hours from San Juan and 1 hour from Ponce. In these two places we have schools. We go to Ponce to buy what supplies we need, pick up our mail and spend some time with our fellow Religious there. At times we may be fortunate to pick up the English newspaper, and this I read from cover to cover. We get the news up here on the radio, but my Spanish is limited, and to take time to study is the thing to do, but the days are only 24 hours long. I love my work and the people, and the day that I can sit down with them, and talk with them in their native tongue will be the happiest day of my life. I do speak some, but it is limited. This will come with time and practise.

For those of you who have not been up to what my assignment is here, I'll brief you. In our Parish of 25 square miles we have 10 Barrios or Villages where we have a Mission Chapel. Three of the ten are worthy to be called Chapels. The other 7 are storage barns, private homes and one pool hall. Slowly we hope to erect little Chapels to replace the 7 that are temporary. At present I am building a Chapel in Bauta Abajo. It is slow work here, for all supplies have to be hauled up in our little truck from the main highway. The jeep trail going up to Bauta is impassable for big trucks and very dangerous. You may get up and then a rain comes as it has the past 3 months, and then you are stuck up there. You do not dare drive down. So you let the truck stay and walk down to the main road and hitch a ride back to the Mission here. This Chapel is about completed. Along with the construction of the Chapel we are adding on to the rear of the Chapel a recreation room. Why all this extra work, you may ask. The youngsters and adults do not have a place where they can congregate and have meetings, parties and dances. So where do they congregate but in the little stores and this is not ideal for the youth. We feel that our future up here is to get the youth to understand their Christian principles and to live by them. This will come with teaching and instructing them and patience and understanding on our part. We are not better than they are so we accept their customs and habits and diet and when possible will give suggestions when asked. This is very important in the Mission that we become part of them and once they see that we are sincere, we may be able to advance.

Thank you for taking time to read this and we hope that it may give you an idea of what we 3 Marianists are doing down here on the Beautiful Island of Puerto Rico. If at times when you are praying, please say a few for us up here. We need prayers, for by ourselves we can do nothing. Thank you and may the Infant Jesus and Mother Mary bless each and every one of you and give you their protection and love. KEEP SMILING.

dirt each year — and each pound of dirt contains over a billion germs?

And dirt that is allowed to remain in a carpet can change its color and seriously shorten its life?

Until recently carpet shampooing meant hiring expensive so-called "professional" cleaners. But with today's do-it-yourself rug shampoos and applicators, you can do as good a job of cleaning your rugs as outside cleaning services and at a fraction of the cost.

To shampoo rugs and carpets, you need a good detergent, and an applicator to apply the detergent... one with a sponge roller and brush. It's best. Before you start be sure to vacuum the carpet thoroughly. Then apply the shampoo with short even strokes covering a four foot area at a time.

The shampoo, not the scrubbing, cleans the rug and new applicators with a foam generating system eliminate the danger of soaking a rug. The shampoo liquid surrounds dirt particles and releases them from the rug fibers at it dries, preventing dirt from re-adhering to the carpet pile. Drying time is usually three to four hours. After the rug is dry, it's easy to remove all the dirt and color dimming soil with a vacuum cleaner. That's all there is to it and you don't have to have your home "torn up" or have outsiders come in.

It's a good idea to turn rugs around (unless they are tacked down) so that they will wear evenly. In places where the pile of the carpet has been pressed flat by furniture legs, you can restore pile this way: lay a wet towel, folded twice, over the spot. Then steam it gently with a hot iron. This will lift the pile, but only if you do not press too hard with the iron.

A most valuable item to keep floors and carpets clean is the use of doormats at all entrances — including entrance ways to cellars and attics — and keeping all walkways well swept.

Upholstery Cleaning

You can also enhance the life beauty of your upholstered furniture as easily as you shampoo carpets. Just this year, the Bissell people, the nation's oldest manufacturer of home care products, have made this cleaning task literally as simple as pushing a button. At a touch of a finger, an aerosol can produces a dry foam — so dry there is no risk of over-wetting — and the sponge-brush attached to the can does the work. This new shampoo is good to use on all colorfast fabrics, except velvet.

Before cleaning, vacuum the upholstery to remove loose dirt. Work the foam with circular strokes, in six inch areas. Overlap the areas you clean to eliminate the possibility of "rings." The action of the foam, which disappears in less than a minute, brings the dirt to the surface for easy removal. And you don't have to rinse when you use the new shampoo. When the furniture dries — in about an hour — simply use the vacuum or a stiff brush to remove the dirt and soil.

Mattresses

This "dry" foam shampoo also cleans mattresses and cloth covered box springs beautifully. Just use the same method. When you replace mattresses after shampooing, turn them over both lengthwise and sideways. This helps mattresses wear better.

Wood Finishes

Your wood finishes too receive special care at housecleaning time. To clear furniture before polishing, use one part boiled linseed oil to four parts turpentine and apply with a clean soft cloth. Let settle for a few seconds and then buff. A good waxing will then restore the natural beauty of the wood. Be sure you always rub with the grain of the wood.

Heat and Water Stains

Heat and water stains can be improved and sometimes completely erased if you rub a mixture of cigarette ash and linseed (or vegetable) oil over and over the spot with your finger or with a soft cloth.

To remove a new water ring from a table top, place a clean white blotter over the spot and press a warm, not hot, iron on it until the ring disappears. (A word to the wise — never wax a water stain until it has had days and days to dry or you'll set it permanently.)

Furniture Scratches

A recipe for furniture scratches is a mixture of a little rubbing alcohol and a lot of furniture polish. Stubborn stains or scratches in mahogany and walnut furniture often respond to rubbing with the meat of a pecan or walnut.

With this little bag o' tricks, your house will shine in no time... and so will you! You'll not only enjoy sparkling clean home during the coming seasons, you'll enjoy it while you're making housecleaning as easy as 1, 2, 3.
