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## V Beogradu nekaj vre

Nova levica je po vsem sodeč pognala med študenti v Beogradu močne korenine.

BEograd, SFRJ. — Kdor bera v Belgradu znani študentski časopis Študent, je opazil v številki preteklega tedna očitno spremembo. Zmanjšalo je imen vseh urednikov, na notranji strani so pa bile slike vislice, sekar, glijotin, rabljev itd. Komentarja k tem slikam ni bilo. V uredništvu Študenta je torej prišlo do revolucije, ne morda revolucije od spodaj, ampak do revolucije od zgoraj.

Polični krogi so radovalni, kakšen bo prihodnji korak beograjske policije. Zaenkrat se je oglasil tajnik partijske organizacije na univerzi, ki je skušal dati dogodku tradicionalno razlagovo.

V Beogradu se je med študenti zasidrala nova levica, ki kolikor mogoče odkrito napada sedanjem Titov režim. ## Zborovanje v Vzhodni Aziji v znamenju časa

Diplomatje nekomunističnih držav jugovzhodne Azije so razpravljali v glavnem mestu Malezije o narodenem položaju.

KUALA Lumpur. — V okoli Kuala Lumpur so se zbrali diplomatje organizacije ASEAN. Je to kulturna zveza Filipinov, Malezije, Tajske, Indonezije in Singapurja. Kot gostje so bili povabljeni tudi diplomatje iz Laos in Južnega Vietnam, na pa bilo nikogar iz Kambodže. Dnevnih red dvojnega posvetovanja je bil obsežen, kar 98 predmetov je bilo na njem, toda azijski diplomatje se jih niso ustrashili, so vse skupaj "obdelali" v nekaj minutah. Ves drugičas so pa posvetili izmenjavi mnenj o sedanjem položaju v jugovzhodni Aziji.

Pri tem so časniki opazili nekaj značilnih političnih potez. Odbit je bil na primer predlog, da bi Južni Vietnam postal reden član te zveze. Vsi so vedeli, zakaj, toda nihče se ni spustil v debato. Malezija in Singapur še nista zgubila vere v Anglijo, upata še zmeraj, da jih bo londonska vlada branila tudi potem, ko se bodo angleške čete umaknile iz Singapurja. Vse delegacije so simpatično pozdravile izjavo tajškega zunanjega ministra, da namerava njegova delžela na tistem navezati stike s Peipingom.

Malezija in Filipini so sklenili, da se ne bodo prepirali med seboj in obnovili redne diplomatske stike. Vsi diplomatje so se pritoževali, da se velesile še zmeraj preveč vtikajo v njihove domače razmere. Pozornost je buditelo, da se je za vse posebno zanimal indonezijski zunanj minister A. Malik.

Ker so bili vsi diplomatje pred leti in desetletji šolani v Angliji, so zvesto spoštovali tradicijo, da so vsako jutro najprej uganjali šport, šele potem so šli na poklicne razgovore.

HONG KONG. — Opazovalci vietnamske domače politike opozarjajo zadnje čase, da se napadi na posamezne dele notranje vietnamske politike stalno ponavljajo v časopisu, ki veljajo za glavne režimske trobente. Da bo položaj razumljiv, je treba opozoriti na sledče:

Ko je 3. septembra umrl Ho Či Minh, je zapustil za seboj obširni politični testament, toda nobenega naslednika. V testamentu je več kot enkrat pozival tovariše, naj bodo složni povsod in zmeraj. Ker je moral poznati svojo stranko, je verjetno, da je videl v njej dosti particev, tudi na visokih položajih, ki niso ravno vneti za disciplino in za žrtev, ki jih disciplina nalaga. Kar je pri tem nerazumljivo, je dejstvo, da je za formalnega naslednika v predsedstvu republike izbral 81-letnega Ton Duc Thonga, ki v partiji ni igral nikoli nobene posebne vloge. Je tudi kot predsednik republike v partiji še danes brez ugleda in vpliva.

## Kakšna komisija naj bi nadzirala glasovanje v Južnem Vietnamu

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Ko je zadnjic vprašal francoski zunanji minister M. Schumann, kakšna komisija naj bi nadzirala splošne volitve v Južnem Vietnamu, kadar bo pač o tem prišlo do sporazuma v Parizu, je državni tajnik W. Rogers odgovoril, da bodo v komisiji zastopane vse politične skupine v Južnem Vietnamu z Osvobodilno fronto vred in je zastopnik iz drugih azijskih držav.

Komisija naj bi imela ne le pravico pregledovanja in nadziranja, ampak tudi pravico odločanja. To bi ji na vomejini meri dala v okviru sporazuma južnovenamske vlade.

Do komisije in ob volitev, ki naj bi jih ta nadzirala, je še zelo daleč. Tako vsaj misli glavni tajnik ZN U Tant, ki je v začetku tedna dejal, da si volitve pri sedanjih razmerah nemogoče.

On se je zavzel v svojem razglasu položaja za novo "narodno vladó" v Saigonu, ki naj bi imela široko osnov z zastopom vseh skupin, orej nekako tako kot Rogersova "komisija".

STOCKHOLM, Šed. — Pretekli torek je prišel sem na izlet skupina 80 ljudi iz Češkoslovaške. Kar 43 jih je zapisalo za politično zatočišče. Napovedali pa so, da jih bo ostalo na Švedskem še več, če bodo le dobili dovoljenje.

Zastopnik teh, ki so prosili za politično zatočišče dejal, da se razmre na Češkoslovaško, stalno slabšajo, d' je politični pristisk vedno hujško dobivajo, konservativni komunisti zmeraj večjo besedo v upravi in v partiji.

## IZRAEL DROBI EGIPTSKO OBRAMBO VZDOLŽ SUEZA

Včeraj so izraelska letala napadla egiptiske vojaške naprave vzdolž Šueškega prekopa neprerogoma 8 ur. Napadni so bili usmerjeni predvsem na oporišča SAM raket za obrambo pred letalskimi napadi. Izraelci "gradio" vzdolž prekopa "demilitarizirano cono".

JERUZALEM, Izr. — Izrael sko letalstvo je začelo ustvarjati "demilitarizirano cono" vzdolž Šueškega prekopa. Izraelska letala so včeraj nad 8 ur neprestano bombardirala in obstrelevala vojaške naprave na egyptovski strani prekopa vse do 10 milij daleč v notranjost. Njihov cilj je uničiti vse egyptovske vojaške naprave v širokem pasu vzdolž prekopa in na ta način vsaj zelo otežkočiti, če ne že preprečiti vse večje egyptovske napade preko prekopa na Sinaj.

Med glavnimi cilji napadov so bila oporišča SAM raket za obrambo pred letalskimi napadi. Te rakete so Egiptu dobavili Sovjeti, da bi se zavaroval pred izraelskimi napadi iz zraka, ki so se izkazali v kratici vojne junija 1967 tako uničujoči za Egipt. Izraelci so ta oporišča stalno skozi več tednov napadali v preteklem septembru. Tedaj so trdili, da so vsa uničili. Zdi se torej, da so jih morali Egiptani zgraditi znova. Ko so Izraelci to ugotovili, so jih skušali včeraj z enim samim udarcem uničiti. Porocajo, da so v tem uspeli.

Zanimivo je, da egyptsko letalstvo ni skušalo Izraelce pregnati ali jih vsaj ovirati pri njenem uničevalnem poslu. To dejstvo dokazuje, da je egyptsko letalstvo kljub številnim novim letalom, ki mu jih je preskrbelo Sovjetska zveza, prešibko ali pa preboječe, da bi se spustilo v odpri boj z izraelskim. Dokler so Izraelci gospodarji zraka nad Sueškim prekopom in njegovo okolico, ne morejo imeti Egiptani nobenega upana na kak uspešen vojaški nastop proti Izraelu. Izrael obvladuje popolnoma tudi zračni prostor nad Jordanijo in Sirije.

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## SAIGON, J. Viet. — Zavezniška

stran je objavila, da so rdeči krščni enodnevno božično premirje 115-krat. V spopadih so bili trije Amerikanci ranjeni, Južni Vietnamci so imeli v tem času 12 mrtvih in 25 ranjenih, rdečih pa naj bi bilo mrtvih preko 100, okoli ducat pa ujetih. Ko je premirje poteklo, so odšle ameriške in južnovenamske patrole zoper stikat za rdečimi, letala pa bombardirat rdeča zbirališča in oporišča.

SAIGON, J. Viet. — Pretekli teden je padlo v bojih v Južnem Vietnamu 66 ameriških vojakov, 712 pa je bilo ranjenih. Južni Vietnam je inel v boju pretekli teden 411 mrtvih in 1019 ranjenih, rdeči pa 2007 mrtvih.

ROCKVILLE, Md. — Tukajšnja potresna postaja je ugotovila včeraj močan potres v okolici otoka Gvadelupe v Karibskem morju. Cetudi je bil potres močan, 7,8 na Richterjevi lestvici, ni doslej nobenega poročila o kaki večji škodi in žrtvah.

SKOPJE, Jug. — Tu so včeraj zabeležili precej močan potres sunek, ki pa ni napravil nobene škode. Skopje je bilo v potresu leta 1963 skoraj uničeno.

MOSKVA, ZSSR. — Komentator sovjetske poročevalske službe TASS je označil konferenco v Rabatu včeraj za "važen korak k edinstvu arabskih držav", pa četudi jo Arabci sami smatrajo za polomijo. Končala se ni le s preporočilom in nejevoljo, ampak tudi brez zaključnega poročila. Zastopniki Sirije, Iraka in Sudana se sploh niso marnali udeležiti zaključne seje zadnjo sredo.

all. Then, somewhere along the being told every day that this years, the public sentiment is the way to be. We have forgotten to enjoy the simple things of life, such as breathing in the fresh morning air, or walking past flowers and seeing the clouds in the sky.

The public, or shall we say, the vociferous public minority, misunderstood him. Instead of asking, they started to demand. Instead of being kind and courteous, they became loud and insolent.

These are the things that made President Nixon start his administration by stating that it was time to "lower our voices," so we could hear one another. ## TURN THOSE IDEAS INTO BIG CASH

New York (NAPS) — Many ideas that have revolutionized U.S. industry did not come from professional inventors. Some of the greatest ideas were extracted from company suggestion boxes, resulted from accidents, or were by-products of other projects.

In 1912, for example, an American naturalist was living in Labrador, where the weather was nearly always cold enough so that meat left outside the naturalist's shack would freeze. The man noticed that meat frozen almost instantly in the 40 to 50° below zero of the winter tasted much better than foods frozen in spring and fall.

Back in the states, the naturalist tried quick-freezing a

whole variety of foods, launched the frozen food business, and in 1929 Clarence Birdseye sold his company for \$22,000,000!

Nicholas Appert is another example of a man who applied his knowledge in a new way. Appert, a Frenchman born in 1750, worked at various times as a chef, pickler, brewer, distiller and confectioner. His idea: why not pack food in containers, like wine? Voila! The idea worked, and all France hailed Appert as a national hero. Today, more than 150 years after Appert published word of his invention, Americans open more than 60,000,000 cans daily!

Englishman Harry Brearley developed a new alloy that he

hoped would solve a problem that had long plagued military men. Gunpowder originally had a highly corrosive effect on the steel used to make gun barrels, and the barrels quickly became pitted and virtually useless. But Brearley's alloy, advanced in 1912, was so corrosion resistant, it would withstand repeated assaults by powder.

A boon to military men? No again. American industrialists thought of other applications for the alloy stainless steel, and today there is probably no one person in America or Europe who does not benefit from Brearley's discovery.

In the 1930's, when jobs were scarce, young Chester Carlson considered himself fortunate in

"Holiday cheer and alcohol are a lethal mixture," Judge local traffic picture, it would August Pryatel, President of be beneficial to keep these the Greater Cleveland Safety points in mind," he concluded.

"Alcohol really belongs with the anesthetic series of drugs as it is chemically related to ether, chloroform, and other anesthetics. It has been proven that blood alcohol levels of 0.06% raise the probability of causing an accident to double that of a non-drinking driver. Drivers with 0.10% blood alcohol levels are from six to seven times as likely to cause an accident," Pryatel said.

Pryatel also said that statistics show that about half of all drivers and adult pedestrians injured in highway crashes had been drinking. Those responsible for initiating crashes is proportionately higher. In 1968, there were 55,200 traffic fatalities. If drinking could be controlled, 27,600 lives annually could be saved.

"Anyone who reaches an alcohol blood level of 0.10%," Pryatel continued, "loses enough clearness of intellect and self-control to interfere with his mental and physical capabilities."



March was named for Mars, Roman god of war, and in the time of Romulus it was the first month in the year. In that day there were only ten months in the calendar year. These were of uneven lengths, some having less than twenty days and some containing as many as thirty-five days.

When Numa became king, which was about 700 years before Christ, he decided that there should be 12 months and added two — January and February — and placed them at the beginning of the calendar, and in that way March became the third month. Among the old Saxons this month was known as Lent, meaning Spring, and this is the origin of our word Lent.

April is from the Latin word Aperio, to open, it is at this season that the flowers and the leaves begin to bloom. The Saxons called the month Easter Month in honor of Easter, the goddess of Spring.

May was named for Maia, daughter of the Roman deity Atlas.

June was named for the goddess Juno.

July for a long time was known by its old name of quin-tillis, from latin meaning five, as it was the fifth month in the ancient calendar of Romulus, but the name was changed to July in honor of Julius Caesar.

August, too, retained its old name of Sextilis, (the sixth month) until the time of Augustus, who changed it to August. September is from the Latin septem, seven, originally the 7th month. It has been the 9th for 2,000 years.

October, November, and December also retain the names by which they were known when there were but 10 months in the year, being derived from the Latin words Octo, Novem, and Decem — eight, nine, and ten.

### Immunize Early Against Flu

Winter is a great time of the year, if you're taking a vacation in some far off sunny clime. Unfortunately, for most of us winter only conjures up visions of dreary days, icy winds, snow drifts to be shoveled, and, of course, influenza.

Since persons with heart or circulatory problems are more likely to be seriously affected than others if they develop the flu, the Northeast Ohio Chapter of the American Heart Association recommends that those persons check with their physician as early as feasible about the advisability of vaccination.

Especially those persons who have chronic debilitation conditions, regardless of their age should check with their physicians regarding flu shots. These conditions include:

Rheumatic heart disease, especially mitral stenosis (a narrowing of the valve opening).

Coronary heart disease and high blood pressure, particularly with evidence of inability of the heart to perform its function properly.

Asthma, chronic bronchitis, cystic fibrosis, bronchiectasis, pulmonary fibrosis, pulmonary emphysema and advanced pulmonary tuberculosis.

Diabetes mellitus or Addison disease.

Older persons, who may have incipient or potential chronic cardiovascular and bronchopulmonary disorders, also should be considered candidates for vaccination.

Flu vaccine is administered in two doses, about two months apart, the Heart Association notes. However, the interval can be reduced if an epidemic threatens. Those vaccinated within the past two years need only one booster dose.

### Aliens Must Report Addresses During Jan.

Cleveland, O. — Thomas M. Pederson, District Director of the Immigration and Naturalization Service stated that certain aliens in the United States will be required to report their addresses to the Attorney General in the near future.

All aliens, with few exceptions, who are in the United States on January 1, each year must report their addresses by the end of the month. The following classes of aliens are excused from this requirement:

(1) Accredited Diplomats; and

(2) Persons accredited to certain international organizations.

The reports are to be made on forms obtained at any Post Office or Immigration and Naturalization Service Office during the month of January.

Mr. Pederson said that the law provides severe penalties for failure to comply with the reporting requirements.

(Continued from Page 5) anywhere in the world by signing in the lower right hand corner. The traveler's check was born. Billions of dollars worth have been sold since that time!

Like Fargo, an 18th century Parisian named Jean-Jacques Perrett was also outraged. Far too often, it seemed to Perrett, he contracted skin infections from being cut on the face while his barber shaved him. Wouldn't shaving be much safer, Perrett reasoned, if a wooden guard were attached to a straight razor so that only a snap of the blade protruded?

Perrett built such a razor in 1762 — and launched the safety razor industry. Today, one company spends \$30,000,000 a year just to advertise its safety razors and blades!

Do these success stories offer any clues as to HOW good ideas can be turned into cash? Three lessons seem to emerge.

1. When something makes you really angry, it may be giving you an opportunity to create that Big Idea. Many other people may be angry at the same thing. One key to making money, however, is coming up with something that solves the problem.

2. Don't be discouraged by lack of immediate success. An idea, however brilliant, may never pay off unless it is used to accomplish something. Brearley's stainless steel, though to his day not widely used for can barrels, is one of the world's most important metals.
