Nevarnost štrajka na železnicah ni minila

Vprašanje kurjačev na Diesel železniških strojih dela težave že preko 11 let in utegne sprožiti splošni železniški štrajk v deželi.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Na parnih železniških strojih so bili poleg strojevodij potrebni tudi kurjači, ki so morali skrbeti za nalaganje premoga v peč. V Diesel strojih kurjačev ni treba, ker ni treba skrbeti za nalaganje kuriva, to teče avtomatično v motor. Unija kurjačev se je od vsega začetka postavila na stališče, da so kurjači tudi v Diesel strojih potreben, če ne za drugo kot "drugi strojevodje", da bi bil promet varen, pa naj se tudi glavnemu strojevodju kaj pri-

meri. Po dolgih pregovarjanjih in sporih je bilo odločeno, naj ostanejo kurjači le v Diesel lokomotivah potniških vlakov, v ostalih pa so jih opustili. To je bilo določeno o posebnem zakonom v Kongresu 1. 1963. Sedaj je veljavnost tega zakona potekla in Združena transportna unija, kot zastopnica 20,000 železniških kurjačev, zahteva, da se kurjača znova nastavi na vse Diesel lokomotive. Železniške družbe to odklanjajo in trdijo, da je treba smatrati odločitev Kongresa za nekaj stalnega in ne začasnega.

Položaj se je tako zategnil, da je obstojala resna nevarnost, da bi prišlo včeraj do splošnega železniškega štrajka. Le posredovanje Bele hiše je to preprečilo. Unija je pristala na podaljšanje pogajanj za dva tedna. Če tedaj do sporazuma še ne bo prišlo, bo še vedno priložnost in seveda — nevarnost za splošni štrajk.

Dobrinin skoro pojde?



20. Uršulinka M. Ksaverija Pirc (II).

PRINCETON, N.J. — Naj sadej je danes teden v AD misjonarka Pirčeva končala: "Od vstopa na učiteljišče pa do danes imam zvesto Obe sta koristno branje za daljnje prijateljico, Resl-na Susteršič, ki je mnogo vplivala name. Bila je vsa drugačna od mene. Bila je naročena na celo vrsto nabožnih listov in tudi na Zamorčka, tedenji edini misijonski list v Ljubljani. Vedno je imela kakega izmed naših profesorjev, za katerega je posebno molila, ker je videla, da nima vere, ali da ne živi po njej. Tudi mene je skušala pridobiti za svojo akcijo. Ob desetih doldpne so na pripravnici prodajali zelo okusne štrukle. "Anica, (moje krstno ime), kaj ko bi žrtvovali ta štrukelj ob sredah in petkah za dr. K...., da najde pot k Bogu?" Seveda nisem mogla odreči, a sem kar mogoče dostikrat pozabila, da je sreda ali petek, in sem kupila štrukelj. Seveda, če je kupljen, ga je treba pojesti. Kako je bila Resl začudena, ko sem ji povedala, da grem v samostan. Ona, ki je pripravljala pot Bogu v moji duši, je pa o-stala med svetom.

31. avgusta 1916 sva odšla z mamico v Škofjo Loko. Ni bilo lahko zapustiti naš ljubi domek v Rožni ulici v Ljubljani in zlasti zlato mamico. 1. septembra so mi dali kopreno postulantke. Naslednje dni so tekle solze kar same od sebe, potokoma... ne-popisno domotožje! Sosetre so me gledale s sočutjem in so mislite: "Ne bo ostala." In vendar me je Gospod v svojem usmiljenju obdržal.

Noviciat je bil v Mekinjah. Lepo je bilo pod Kamniškimi planinami. V obednici smo brašli o uršulinskih misijonih v Ajlaski, o junaškem življenju uršulink v večnem snegu. "To bi bilo zame!" Zagorela je želja po misijonskem poklicu.

Dve leti sta hitro minuli in po prvih oblubah sem prišla nazaj v Škofjo Loko. Zelo so rabiли učiteljic za matematiko in fiziko. Poslali so me v Ljubljano, kjer je bil tečaj za učitelje na srednjih šolah. Bog je bil zopet dober. Ob letu sem napravila izpit iz fizike in matematike — z odliko. Vrnila sem se v Loko, da izpolnim vrzel med učiteljstvom.

Kaj pa z misijoni? Kako najzazposim, da me pošljemo, ko vidi, da me tako zelo potrebujejo doma? Pa nisem bila sama, ki je želela v misijone. Sestra Rafaela Vurnik je bila istih misli. Kako naj pustijo dve? Pa je Bog posegel vmes in vse se je uredilo. 4. avgusta 1924 zgodaj zjutraj najuje samostanski vožiček potegnil na postajo Trata. V Ljubljani najuje pričakovana mamica na kolodvoru. Sestra Rafaela je odšla s svojim bratom inž. arhitektom Vurnikom na njegov dom na Mirju — jaz pa domov! Še enkrat doma v Rožni ulici za nekaj ur. Bilo je lepo — pa je svetlikalo še toliko lepšega na obzoru, da smo se poslovili brez solza. Na kolodvoru so se zbrali sorodniki, prijatelji in znanci ob večernem vlaiku za Belgijo. Začela se je uresničevati tako vroča želja.

Tisto noč in ves naslednji dan sva brzeli preko Evrope skozi Avstrijo, Švico, Francijo in 6. avgusta sva bili v Tournai-ju v Belgiji. Tam sva srečali še dve sestri, določeni za isti misijon: Bangkok na Sijamskem.

Vsa nadaljnja leta pa so popisana v knjižici mojih spominov, ki je izšla v Argentini: 'Skoro 50 let v misijonih'. Če jo pridno razpečavate, mi bo v veliko veselje, ker je g. Lenček oblijubil, da bo ves dobiček za naš sijamski misijon. Marija Ksaverija Pirc O.S.U." Knjiga lahko vsak naroči pri sodelavcih MZA in poverjenikih KM v ZDA in Kanadi. BILL RANDLE PROMOTES 'POLKA POWER' MUSIC

After all these years the polka is finally becoming popular with radio stations other than the Slovenian manned shows. Oh, once in a blue moon a disc jockey might venture into the unusual and play a polka on a semi-annual basis with as much enthusiasm as walking through a burning building. But now the proprieties have changed. Bill Randle of radio station WERE (daily 11 a.m. to 4 p.m.) not only has sprinkled the polka sound throughout his various talk shows, but he is very enthusiastic about the ethnic music.

Recently Randle played a cut

from Al Tercek's new album "Polka Power" which was premiered live at Tony Petkovsek's "Bands of Tomorrow" outing at the AMLA Recreation Center, Sept. 20, in Leroy, Ohio. The piece is called, "The Swap and Shop Polka", named in honor of Randle's two hour Swap and Shop portions of his radio show. He became so enthusiastic about the sound, he told his engineer-balloonologist Jimmy Church, to use the song as a second theme during the program. The popular radio personality will also have the album available for sale at his "Swap and Shop Fair" in

Cuyahoga Falls this weekend.

Bill Randle became acquainted with the polka sound thru his friendship with our own Tony Petkovsek. The two have put out cookbooks together and have shared the microphone at various functions around town.

The popularity of Bill Randle began in the early 1950's when every youngster in the Cleveland area listened to his show. He was Mr. Music and Cleveland was the No. 1 music center of the world. Most songs got their break here, mainly from Randle. He is given credit with

launching to stardom the Four Lads, the Four Coins, the De-Castro Sisters, the Everly Brothers, the Four Aces and many more. We all remember the time he appeared on the Jackie Gleason Show and introduced the career of a new rock and roll singer (at that time) — Elvis Presley.

During that era Randle worked a 7-day-a-week show besides going to school and earning his Masters and Doctorate and teaching.

Maybe Bill Randle has launched a new musical career. After

the Second World War polkas such as, "Just Because" became popular. Perhaps now is the time the American Yugoslavs will again share their folk music with the rest of the world. At the recent downtown festival a polka band was playing with much enthusiasm because the big applause urged them on. Those doing the clapping represented every nationality and race in our town. The polka may be on the threshold of again making the big time. An intelligent music man, Bill Randle seems to think the sound is worthwhile.

GAS SUPPLIES NEED \$ HELP

Today, although geologists say there is plenty of potentially recoverable natural gas in the United States, gas reserves are dwindling. 
