Sovjetija je ojačila oporišče v Albaniji

Angleška admiraliteta poroča, da imajo Sovjeti v Albaniji 8 podmornic in eno matrično ladjo.

LONDON, Vel. Brit. — Civilni lord admiralte Orr-Ewing je v parlamentu razlagal položaj v Sredozemlju. Pri tem je navedel, da so Sovjeti izpopolnili pomorsko oporišče v Valonij v Albaniji in da imajo tam trenutno 8 podmornic in moderno matrično ladjo za nje. Poleg tega je devet sovjetskih podmornic v Združeni arabski republiki. Sovjeti vežbajo za nje domačo egitoško moštvo.

Zaradi naraščajoče sovjetske pomorske moći v vzhodnem Sredozemlju so Angleži dodali svojim enotam pet podmornic. Zastopnik mornarice je zatrjeval, da je južni kraj NATO obrambe v Evropi še vedno došti trden. Poleg ameriške šeste flote, britanskih sil na Cipru in britskega ladjevja, razpolaga tudi s turškimi in grškimi oboroženimi silami. Turčija je pristala tudi na zgraditev oporišč za ameriške rakete na srednjem daljave na svojih tleh, kar bo v bližnji dočnosti obrambo še okrepilo.

Producija avtomobilov v Evropi dosegla — našo!

ZENEVA, Sv. — Stroški avtomobilov, ki si jih morejo sedaj privoščiti Evropeji, se tudi tudi smatra za znamenje lepega blagostanja. V zgodnji Evropi je sedaj okoli 22 milijonov avtomobilov, v komuničnem vzhodnem področju pa okoli 4 milijone in pol, med temi tudi 915.000 osebnih voz v zasebni lasti.

Evropeji sicer še daleč ne potujejo toliko kot Amerikanci, pa vendar se vozijo mnogo več, kot so se kdajkoli.

Med leti 1950-57 se je produkcija avtov v Evropi podvojila in do leta 1965 bodo tam izdelali kakih 8 milijonov avtomobilov na leto.

Sedem šolskih otrok ubitih

BERLIN, Conn. — Žena je volila v svojem avtu sedem otrok v šolo. Vsi so bili mrtvi, ko je avto zadel vlak New Haven Railroad na prehodu preko proge. Prehod je ozek in nezavarovan, brez čuvanja ali zavornice.

Mrs. Whitaker je vozila te otroke v šolo vsak dan in vsak dan jih je šla iskat, da jih je pripeljala domov. Oblasti smatrajo, da je to najbolj žalostna nesreča te vrste. Predsednik zeleniški družbe je izjavil, da je že večkrat zahteval, naj bi se ta prehod zaprl.

De Gaulle želi Hruščeva peljati tudi v Saharo

PARIZ, Fr. — Predsednik Francije Charles De Gaulle bi rad pokazal Nikiti Hruščevu, predsedniku sovjetske vlade, ki pride prihodnji teden na uradni obisk v Francijo, tudi petrolejska polja v Sahari.

V vladnih krogih govore, da Hruščev na ta predlog še ni pris stal. Menda se boji, da bi Arabci tako pot smatrali za sovjetsko potrditev francoske alžirske politike. Ta misel je brez dvoma tudi v ozadju De Gaullovega vabilna.

Nemci bodo vežbali v Veliki Britaniji!

Med Londonom in Bonnom se vrše razgovori za vežbanje nemških letalcev na angleških oporiščih.

LONDON, Vel. Brit. — V posučnih krogih trdijo, da bo v bližnjih dneh objavljen sporazum med Vel. Britanijo in Zah. Nemčijo o vežbanju nemškega letalstva na letalskih oporiščih v Veliki Britaniji. Tam naj bi se vežbala tudi nemška moštva v rabi rakete Corporal. Še vedno je odprtlo vprašanje vojaških oporišč in skladišč za nemške oborožene sile izven Nemčije.

Razburjenje, ki je nastalo ob vesti, da skušajo Nemci vzpostaviti v Španiji vojaška skladišča in letalska oporišča, se je poleg, ko so tako Francija, kot Združene države in Vel. Britanija priznale potrebo po oporiščih za nemške oborožene sile izven Nemčije. Clintonac NATO je seveda ljubše, da so taka oporišča na njihovih tleh. Tako so jih ponudili najprej Francozi, sedaj pa se vrše razgovori med Nemci in Angleži.

Najnovejše vesti

LOGAN, W. Va. — Reševalne poskuse so morali prekiniti zaradi velike vročine in dneva, ko so reševalci bili od zajetih: 18 rudarjev le še okoli 100 čevljev. Reševanje se nadaljuje, toda upanje, da bi nešli rudarje še žive, je z vsako uro manjše. Zasulo jih je pretekli torki.

CLEVELAND, O. — Včeraj so pokrajine južno od Ohio dobile znova sneg, ponekod pa dež. Oblasti se trudijo, da bi prodile do zametenih v odrečnih gorskih krajih. V štirinovorih okrajih Svet. Karoline je ločenih od sveta v snegu od 500 do 700 drenž. Snega je tam ponekod zapadlo do dveh do treh čevljev, zatem pa se visoki tudi do 15 čevljev. Vojска in narodna garda uporabljata težke tovorne avtomobile in helikoptere pri reševanju in oskrbi teh družin.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Predsednik Eisenhower je predložil Johnu C. Doerferju, načelniku Zvezne komisije za komunikacije, naj se odpove svojemu položaju, ker je pretekli mesec sprejel od neke radijske postaje razne usluge, kar je v nasprotju s predpisi. Radio postaja spada namreč pod njegovo pristojnost. To je sedaj že tretji visoki uradnik Eisenhowerove administracije, ki je moral iti s svojega mesta zaradi sprejemanja uslug od oseb ali ustanov, ki bi jim zaradi svojega službenega položaja lahko pomagal.

Pred novimi spopadi v formozanskih vodah?

Povečana letalska dejavnost rdeče Kitajske v vodah med Formozom in celino napoveduje nov viharni čas v tem področju.

HONOLULU, Hav. — Poročila obveščevalnih služb Združenih držav in nacionalne kitajske vlade na Formozi trdijo, da je treba v bližnji bodočnosti pričakovati zopet večjih nastopov rdeče Kitajske proti področjem, ki so v oblasti nacionalne kitajske vlade na Formozi. V katero smer pojdejo ti napadi, je trenutno težko uganiti.

Vesti iz omenjenih virov trdijo, da je rdeče letalstvo vsak dan živahnješ in udarnejše, pa tudi bolj spremno v spopadih. V nedavnem spopadu s skupino nacionalnih kitajskeh letalcev se je rdečim posrečilo uiti raketa Sidewinder, ki same lete proti cilju, ki oddaja vročino. Ameriški strokovnjaki sodijo, da se je komunistom posrečilo najti uspešen način obrambe proti vodljivemu sistemu raket, zgrajenim na načelu infrardečih žarkov.

Predsednik Izraela v Ameriki

BOSTON, N.Y. — Predsednik vlade Izraela Ben-Gurion je prišel v Združene države, da sprejme častni doktorat, ki mu ga je podelila Brandeis univerza v Waltham, Mass. Obiskal bi predsednika Eisenhowerja in državnega tajnika.

Namen njegovih razgovorov bo utrditi mir v prednji Aziji in urediti odnose z arabskimi državami, da bi popustila napetost.

Izjavil je, da gleda v bodočnost z velikim zaupanjem kijub težavam, ki v mednarodnem področju niso majhne.

De Gaulle za Alžirijo povezano s Francijo

PARIZ, Fr. — Predsednik republike De Gaulle je ponovno pozval alžirske muslimane, naj se pridružijo ostalim Alžircem in ustanove alžirske države, ki bo tesno povezana s Francijo.

S tem je razjasnil svoje stališče. Zavrnil je integracijo — spojitev — Alžirije s Francijo, pa dejansko tudi njeno polno neodvisnost, čeprav načrta za ljudsko glasovanje o takih rešitvah ni preklical.

Nova De Gaullova izjava je odstranila strah levle in nekaterih sredinskih skupin, da se je De Gaulle odločil za trdo vojaško pest, ki naj uniči vsak odpor med muslimani in združi Alžirijo dokončno s Francijo.

Pravda za otroka

Štiri leta staro deklico hočejo vzeti iz okrilja skrbne družine, kjer je vse od prvega meseca starosti.

TRENTON, N.J. — Petletna deklica Alice Marie je predmet pozornosti in razgovorov po celem mestu. Ko je bila mesec dni stare, sta jo vzela v oskrbo z konca Combs, ki imata sama tu dvi svoja otroka.

Vsi imajo Alice tako radi, da jo hočejo obdržati za vsako ceno. Državni urad za varstvo otrok pa misli, da zakonca Combs nista primerno izobražena za vzgojo tega otroka, ki je izredno brihat in nadarjen. Zato hoče urad otroka vzeti družini in ga dati v oskrbo drugam.

Pravda za dobrega otroka vzbuja splošno sočutje, ker sta Combsova znana kot skrbna, pridržljiva, katera imata lep in dovolj prostoren dom.

Cetudi ima urad za varstvo otrok morda po črki nekega pravilnika prav, ga po občutku srca ijdije v večini ne razumejo.

Skrivnostno pismo Hruščeva Eisenhowerju

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Sovjetski poslanik Mihail Mensikov je izročil predsedniku Eisenhowerju osebno pismo sovjetskega predsednika vlade Hruščeva, ki je povzročilo nagnjo sejanje diplomativ. Nihče ne pove, kaj je v pismu.

Dejansko so se takoj sestali poslaniki Francije, Velike Britanije in namestnik državnega tajnika Merchant in razpravljali o skupnem stališču zapadnih velesil z ozirom na vsebino pisma.

Tiskovni tajnik predsednika Eisenhowerja ni mogel povedati, kdaj bo vsebina pisma objavljena.

Podmornica bila kitajska

WASHINGTON, D.C. — V krogih vodstva vojne mornarice zavračajo trditve nekega diplomata rdeče Kitajske, da je bila podmornica, ki so jo lovili Argentinci v Golfo Nuevo pred nekaj tedni, kitajska.

Kitajec trdi, da je njihova podmornica zašla tja po nerodnosti, ko je ogledovala argentinsko obalo.

Kozlov in Suslov

MOŠKVA, ZSSR. — Tekom odsotnosti Hruščeva v južni Aziji je vrnil posle predsednika vlade prvog podpredsednik Frol Kozlov, posle glavnega tajnika partije pa Mihail Suslov, ki je sicer znani kot pristaš stalinizma.

IKE JE ZAVRNIL "VISOKE" POLETE V ZAHODNI BERLIN

Državni tajnik Herter je dejal, da se je predsednik odločil proti visokim poletom v Berlin, ker trenutno "niso nujni." Obveljala je angleška previdnost.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Pred kakimi dvemi tedni je prišla v javnost vest, da so zahodne sile sklenile pošiljati v Zah. Berlin ni iz njega svoja moderna letala tudi v višinah preko 10.000 čevljev in da so o tem obvestila Sovjeti. Čez nekaj dni je bilo sporočeno, da so vlade noto Sovjetom zadržale. Ko je sovjetski zastopnik v Vzhod. Berlinu izjavil, da bo Sovjetska zveza smatrala take polete za kršenje suverenosti Vzhod. Nemčije, v kolikor ne bodo zahodne sile v tej prejše vprašanje uredile potom razgovor, je bilo sporočeno, da je bil ves načrt na pritisk Vel. Britanije odložen.

Državni tajnik Herter je sedaj izjavil, da je predsednik Eisenhower še po svojem povratku iz Latinske Amerike pretresal ta načrt in odklonil trenutno polete preko 10.000 čevljev višine,

ker da "niso nujni." Herter je zatrjeval, da ni bilo prej o tem vprašanju niti sklenjenega in da zato ta objava ni nobena sprememb stališča. Njegova izjava je časnikarje iznenadila po vsem tem, kar je prišlo v javnost. Za predlog zadnjih tednov o tem načetu in sporu o njem med Paristoma, sta jo vzela v oskrbo z konca Combs, ki imata sama tu dvi svoja otroka.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Senat je s 53 proti 42 glasovom zavrnil predlog za končanje leta 1960, da se bo izjavil sovjetski zastopnik v Berlinu zazdeli vseč predvrgana in so privili Washington, naj načrt odloči. Združene države so poslale lanskou spomlad nekajkrat svoja jet-prevozna letala v Zah. Berlin v višini preko 10.000 čevljev.

Na poti so jih obletavala sovjetska vojaška letala. Združene države so protestirale, toda Sovjeti so proteste zavrnili češ, da je predstojnik iznad 10.000 čevljev pridržan za sovjetska in vzhodnonemška vojaška letala. Washington je to stališče odločno zavrnil in poslal pravico, na zahtevo posameznikov izstliti mešanje ras v šolah in poskrbeti sicer za konec segregacije.

Senat je soglasno odobril predlog za znižanje kazni onim, ki nasprotujejo izvajajujočim sestavam.

Debata se nadaljuje. Neprekiniteno teče že ves pretekli in ves teden. Le čez preteklo nedeljo so si senatorji dovolili kratki odmor.

ZN pozivajo k pomoči za rešitev kulturnih spomenikov v Egiptu!

PARIZ, Fr. — Organizacija Združenih narodov za vzgojo, znanost in kulturo se je obrnila na ves kulturni svet, naj pomaga s finančnimi sredstvi in tehničnim znanjem pri delu za ohranitev starih kulturnih spomenikov v dolini reke Nila, ki jih bo sicer pokrilo jezero, nastalo za novim jezerom pri Aswanu.

Za načrt se je zavzel sam glavni tajnik ZN Hammarskjöld, vendar je vprašanje, če bo uspešno zavrnjeno. Saj računajo samo za zavarovanje templja Ramzesa II. v Abu Simbel do \$40,000,000 stroškov.

Poleg omenjenega templja bi znanstveniki radi rešili posebno tudi tempelj boginje Izis na otoku Nila pri Filah.

Novi poveljniki NATO

PARIZ, Fr. — Severno-atlantski zavezniški svet je imenoval za glavnega poveljnika na Atlantiku admirala Roberta Lee Dennison, dosedanjega poveljnika vzhodnega Sredozemlja.

Dennison je Amerikanec. Za poveljnika srednjega Sredozemlja je imenovan italijanski admiral Luciano Bigi, dosedanjega vojaškega svetovalec predsednika Italijanske republike.

Baje je zagrabil za idejo, da bi podfarmarjem odškodnino v psemici in ne v denarju. Ali bodo farmarji zagrabili za to idejo, nijasno; zaenkrat niso zanjo posebno navdušeni.

Alžirija, parcelacija ali amputacija?

Zadnja izjava vodstva alžirski upornikov in odgovor generala De Gaulle sta znova pokazala, kako daleč sta si narazen oba nasprotnika v vseh bistvenih elementih spora o usodi Alžirije.

Predsednik alžirske vlade Ferhat Abbas še zmeraj trdi, da le vodstvo upornikov predstavlja vso Alžirijo in nihče drugi. Zahteva najprej pogajanja o garancijah za plebiscit, potem šele naj pride do premirja. Je proti vsaki delitvi Alžirije na kantone, province itd., ki bi dale dejeli federativni ali konfederativni značaj. Hoče se seveda pogajati s Parizom kot enakim.

General De Gaulle je na svojem zadnjem potovanju v Alžirijo vse te predloge gladko odbil. Ne prizna uporniške vlade kot edinega zastopnika Alžirije. Zahteva najprej "pacifikacijo," to bi pomenilo, da morajo uporniki jenjati z državljanško vojno, šele potem bo mogoče govoriti o politični rešitvi alžirjskega vprašanja. Ne odpove se ideji federacije Alžirije. V njenem okviru bi obstajali, recimo kantoni s pretežno francoskim in pretežno domaćim prebivalstvom, ki bi bili ne samo ravnopravni in zelo samostojni napram federalni alžirski upravi, ampak bi bili obenem preko federalne uprave vključeni v evropsko francosko skupnost.

Zadnje generalove izjave niso prinesle v tem pogledu ničesar novega, nov in nepričakovani je bil samo izredno oster ton teh izjav. Generalov oster nastop tolmačijo poznavalci razmer z okoliščino, da je zadnji generalov obisk v Alžiriji veljal samo voditeljem francoske armade v Alžiriju:

Razpoloženje francoske armade v Alžiriji je poglavje zase in ne ravnob v pred mirni rešitvi alžirjskega problema. Francoska armada ima že od 1. 1940 za seboj celo vrsto kapitulacij in porazov. Vse to jo strašno boli, toda ne vse armade kot take. Moramo jo radi preglednosti deliti v tri dele: največji del armade tvorijo pravi vojaki iz Francije, ki služijo vojaški rok. Ti še primeroma najmanj žalujejo nad usodo francoske armade. Večina od njih je srečna, ako čim preje in s čim manj nevarnosti odsluži vojaški rok in razne začasne vpoklice. Drugi del tvorijo vojaki tujih narodnosti, ki služijo kot legijonarji na dogovoren rok. Dasislavno ima sistem francoskih legij že dolgo zgodovino za seboj, se do sedaj ni nikoli posrečilo, da bi poveljniki napravili iz vojakov v legiji duhovno strnjeno enoto. Najemnik pač ostane najemnik, naj služi kjerkoli na svetu. Zato legija tudi ni noben politični problem za francosko vlado. Tretji del francoske armade obстоje iz poklicnih vojakov, nizjih in višjih častnikov. Ti so politično najbolj nevarni. Odkar so med drugo svetovno vojno pod vodstvom generala De Gaulle odpovedali pokorčino legitimni francoski vladni maršala Petaina, njihova privrženost francoskim vladam ni več stodostotna. V njihovih sreih se vedno borita patriotizem in lojalnost. Da iz tega nasprotja lahko pride do upora pariški vladni, smo videli ob času krize, ki je spravila generala De Gaulle na oblast.

De Gaulle vse to dobro ve, zato je po zadnjih nemirih med Francozi v Alžiriji takoj izmenjal vse poveljnike, jih premestil v Evropo ali pa vpokojil. S tem seveda ni ubil duha nezadovoljnosti v vojaških krogih. Da jih potolaže, je odletel za tri dni v Alžirijo, da bi jih še enkrat osebno skušal prepričati o pravilnosti svoje politike. Pri tem se je zgodilo še to, da so uporniki obnovili državljanško vojno ravno v tistih krajih, ki jih je general obiskal. To ga je moralno še posebej razjetiti, zato je tudi tako ostro govoril. Predvsem je povdral, da Alžirija je in ostane francoska vkljub njeni pravici do samoodločbe, da Francija ne bo nikoli pozabila tistih alžirjskih pokrajin, kjer živijo francoski priseljenci in da bo ostala francoska tudi Sahara s svojo nafto in svojim oporiščem za preskušanje atomskega orozja. V Franciji so sicer razumeli generalovo nejveljivo, toda vkljub temu so zadnje njegove govore močno obsojali pripadniki sredine in leve.

Ker je general ponovno vstopil na ideji, da mora biti Alžirija deljena na zelo neodvisne pokrajine z enotnim seštvom prebivalstva, je s tem izrazil vprašanje, ki se ga je doslej vsakdo izogibal: ali ne kaže Alžirije deliti po vzorcu Koreje in Vietnamu. Ali ne bi bilo morda mogoče preseliti manjše francoske naselbine v strnjena francoska področja in tako potegniti mejo med francoskimi priseljenci in domaćini.

V tem slučaju bi Francija obdržala kraje s francoskim prebivalstvom in saharsko puščavo z ozko mejo ki bi puščavo vezala z morjem, na ostalem področju naj pa imajo domaćini popolno samostojnost. Ali naj se to izvrši potom dogovorjene parcelacije med uporniki in Parizom ali potom enostranske amputacije od francoske strani, to je stvar taklike, kakor hitro bi padla načelna odločitev. Treba je poudariti, da trenutno to idejo pobijajo tako uporniki kot De Gaulle, vsak od obeh hoče imeti popolno oblast nad vso Alžirijo. Tako stališče na obeh straneh bo seveda imelo za po-

sledico, da se bo državljanška vojna vlekla v nedogled, akravno so jo siti Francije doma in domaćini v Alžiriji.

Ideja o parcelaciji ali amputaciji bi seveda preko noči spremenila značaj državljanške vojne. Francija bi potegnila svoje čete nazaj na ozemlja, ki jih smatra za svoja, ostalo zemljo bi prepustila upornikom. To bi Parizu izredno olajšalo obrambo zmanjšanega ozemlja in zahtevalo tudi manj žrtev na fronti. Uporniki bi namreč prišli v neugoden položaj. Dočim se borijo sedaj proti francoski armadi kot partizanske edinice, bi morali v slučaju parcelacije ali amputacije odvzemati francoski armadi njene postojanke z bojevanjem na normalni fronti. Da bi mogli na ozemlju, kjer nimajo domaćini večine ali pa jih sploh ni, voditi uspešne partizanske boje, to je malo verjetno. Obravnavanje misli o parcelaciji ali amputaciji bi seveda zahtevalo od obeh strani veliko žrtev na račun narodnega ponosa, toda tudi to je mogoče, kar je pokazala delitev Vietnam.

Ideja o parcelaciji ali amputaciji sicer ni nova, toda dolje je izzvala na obeh straneh samo ogorčenje, kar je in bo državljanško vojno samo podaljšalo. Toda nepotrebno prelivanje krvi je nazadnje tudi političen faktor, ki premaga še tako sveta osebna in narodna čuvstva.

V njem se članji zbirajo na sestanke, družabne prireditve in zabave, v njem pa najdejo zavetišče tudi slovenski rojaci in rojakinje, ki pridejo za kak teden iz vročega Buenos Airesa v andski planinski raj.

Ko je France zaključil svoje zanimivo pripovedovanje, se mu je predsednik Lilije g. Zorman lepo zahvalil za obisk in poročilo.





CANCER DRIVE

Several years ago a poll was taken of dozens of newspaper editors as to the headline they most wished to read in their paper.

In a large majority of cases, the headline had one underlying theme — "Cancer Conquered."

Next month, thousands of Cancer Crusade volunteers will raise funds in an effort to help write that headline.

In the opinion of many medical experts, this headline will become a reality in the 1960s if sufficient funds are raised to follow the promising leads recently uncovered about this disease.

At the National Crusade Meeting held in Columbus early in February this year, prominent physicians and surgeons indicated that the long-sought cure for cancer may be closer than most people realize due to recent discoveries which indicate that the effect of nucleic acids on the chromosomes in all living cells can cause certain types of cancer.

The possibility of developing a vaccine against cancer was also stressed. Recently research teams at the Medical College of Virginia reported that the use of a blood substance had been successfully employed to immunize rats against six different types of cancer. Considerable more research must yet be done on this immunizing agent before its use on people can be tested.

However, even with the presently employed methods of cancer detection and treatment, more than 1,000,000 people are alive today who have been afflicted with cancer.

MILITARY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM—MUTUAL SECURITY

This year the Administration has requested \$2 billion to carry forward the Military Assistance Program during the coming year. Designed to strengthen the collective security system of the Free World, the Military Assistance Program represents a vital part of our own defense effort and our over-all military planning. Through this program our allies are enabled to maintain a sufficiently strong defense posture to ward off any actual or potential aggressor. As a result of the military assistance program, the armies of our allies have been increased from 3½ to 5 million men; allied navies from 1,200 to 2,200 combat ships; and allied air forces from 17,000 to over 25,000 aircraft, about half of which are jet. Their self-confidence has been strengthened, and their determination to resist has become steadily firmer. As a practical matter, no amount of money spent on our forces could give the United States the same asset of trained, well-equipped allied forces, familiar with the terrain, acclimated to local conditions, and deployed for immediate resistance to local aggression. The amount requested, for fiscal 1961 is consistent with the requirements of modernization and improvement, without which Free World Forces would fall behind in their ability to counter modernized aggressor forces.

GOVERNMENT TO AID SMALL BUSINESS IN FOREIGN TRADE

The Administrator of the Small Business Administration, Mr. Philip McCallum, recently announced that his office is starting an educational program designed to help the small businessman get business from overseas through the St. Lawrence Seaway. The educational program will be designed to inform small businessmen about the various procedures and regulations for going into foreign trade such as locating

foreign markets, shipping procedures, licensing requirements, foreign exchange rates, etc.

There are ever increasing opportunities in foreign trade through the Great Lakes and it is hoped that this new program will prove helpful. Further announcements will be forthcoming from the Small Business Administration in the near future, but in the meantime anyone interested may want to write directly to Mr. Philip McCallum, Administrator, Small Business Administration, Washington 25, D. C.

CENSUS OF SHAREOWNERS IN CORPORATIONS

A recent study of the New York Stock Exchange shows that a total of 12,490,000 persons are shareowners in American Corporations. This is nearly double the 1952 total of 6,490,000, and is 45 per cent higher than the 1956 count. The growth rate for 1956 to 1959 was double that of the 1952-55 period. Other interesting highlights brought out by the study are as follows:

One out of every eight adults is a shareowner, compared to one in twelve years ago. The largest single group of stockholders are housewives numbering 4 million. Percentage-wise women shareowners outnumber men by 52 to 47 per cent—a somewhat larger margin than in 1956. Employee stock purchase plans, which are offered by many publicly-held companies, have contributed materially to shareowner growth. More than 2.5 million people first acquired their stock holdings through company plans, while an estimated 1,340,000 now invest regularly through such programs.

TAX RETURNS

Met Opera

Cleveland's gay Spring Festival of grand opera will have two new productions never before heard here before among the eight to be presented this year in Public Hall from April 25 thru May 1, it was announced today by Mrs. R. Livingston Ireland, president of the Northern Ohio Opera Association, sponsors of the annual event.

Two others will also be brand-new productions and the other four on the repertoire have been revised during the past five years so that this 35th season of the Met's appearance in Cleveland will be one of the most lavish and diversified to be presented in the "world's largest opera house."

The "first time" productions are "Gypsy Baron" by Johann Strauss, which won the critics' praises in New York, to be presented on Tuesday evening, April 26, and Giuseppe Verdi's enchanting "Simon Boccanegra" to be heard on Saturday evening, April 30.

Walter Slezak, who starred with the late Enzio Pinza on Broadway in the musical hit "Fanny," moves to the opera stage in "Gypsy Baron," taking the part of Szupan, a wealthy pig farmer. One of the Met's most glamorous young singers, Lisa Della Casa, along with Laurel Hurley and Regina Resnik, have the leading feminine roles, with tenor William Olvis, Ezio Flaggello and Slezak.

Cyril Ritchard, Broadway and TV actor and producer, stages this production which is sung in English and conducted by Erick Leinsdorf, formerly conductor of the Cleveland Orchestra.

Three of the Met's more popular male voices, Richard Tucker, Leonard Warren and Giorgio Tozzi, team with the tall Massachusetts-born dramatic soprano, Mary Curtis Vernon, to take the leads in "Simon Boccanegra," which was premiered in Venice, Italy, in 1857, and first performed by the Met in 1931. Nino Verchi, new among the conductors to Clevelanders, directs this opera which is sung in Italian.

Opening Cleveland's Spring Festival will be the fast moving and colorful favorite, "Faust" by Charles Gounod, with the lovely, dark-haired, Elizabeth Soederstrom as Marguerite; Cleveland's own Mildred Miller as Siebel; Nicolai Gedda in the name role of Faust and Cesare Siepi as Mephistopheles. Jean Morel, will conduct this opera which is sung in French and was last seen in Cleveland two years ago.

A completely new production of Verdi's "Il Trovatore" with its ever hummed "Anvil Chorus" and the "Miserere," will be heard on Wednesday evening, April 27. One of the Met's top divas, soprano Antonietta Stella, along with Carlo Bergonzi, the thickset, muscular Italian singer, and Robert Merrill, will sing the leading roles under the baton of Fausto Cleva. The opera is sung in Italian.

Umberto Giordano's "Andrea Chenier," an opera of the "hot tempered" days of the French Revolution, has a Met favorite, soprano Zinka Milanov, in the lead as Madalena di Coigny and Richard Tucker, tenor, as Andrea Chenier, a poet. This will be heard on Thursday evening, April 28.

The ever popular "Marriage of Figaro" by Wolfgang Mozart, in new production settings and costumes, appears on Friday evening, April 29, with the vivacious Lucine Amara, Miss Soederstrom, Mildred Miller, George London and Cesare Siepi, in the top roles. This all new Italian production, was also staged by Cyril Ritchard for the Met and will be conducted by Erick Leinsdorf.

The week-end will offer a special package of three operas in two days for out-of-town music lovers. Giacomo Puccini's "Madama Butterfly," sung in Italian, will be heard at the Saturday matinee on

April 30, with Antonietta Stella as "Cio-Cio San" and Eugenio Fernandi as B. F. Pinkerton; the all-new production of "Simon Boccanegra" will be on Saturday evening, and Verdi's recently new production of "La Traviata" with the Met's glamorous new discoveries, Anna Moffo as Voletta and Barry Morell as Alfredo, appearing on the Sunday matinee, May 1. Both Saturday and Sunday matinee performances begin promptly at 1:30 p.m. EDST.

The choreography of Zachary Sолов will be presented by the Met's famed Corps de Ballet in "Faust" and "La Traviata" with Alexandra Danilova doing "Gypsy Baron" and John Butler the "Marriage of Figaro." The renowned Metropolitan Opera Chorus, directed by Kurt Adler, will be heard in all operas.

"Our well-rounded repertoire for 1960 was tailored to fit the tastes of everyone," Mrs. Ireland commented in reviewing the program.

"Cleveland, long regarded as the second home of the Met, enjoys the perfection of a repertoire based on the expressed wishes of those who attend," she stated. "This is truly a wonderful selection of eight operas for the seven day season and runs the gamut from old masterpieces through to the most colorful new productions. And of course, the singers include the outstanding ones heard in New York itself only over the course of an entire season of months."

Mrs. Ireland pointed out that of the six new productions included in the New York repertory this year, four will be given here in Cleveland, and three of the Cleveland season operas were presented in the opening season of the Met in 1883 and 1884.

Prices for single performance tickets will be \$2, \$3, \$4, \$5, \$6, \$7, \$8, \$10 and \$12. Season tickets will be \$16 24, \$32, \$40, \$48, \$56, \$64, \$80 and \$84. There is no tax.

All evening performances are at 8 p.m. sharp. Saturday and Sunday matinees at 1:30 p.m. All performances are on Eastern Daylight Saving Time.

Orders for both season and single performance tickets may be mailed immediately to the Northern Ohio Opera Association box office in the main banking lobby of the Union Commerce Bank, E. 9th and Euclid Ave., Cleveland 14.

Since Monday, Feb. 29th, the box office was available for mail orders over the window. For one week, March 7th thru the 12th, the box office will be open for season ticket sales and on March 28 single performance tickets will go on sale.
