Predstavniki doma so soglasno odobrili 46.8 bilijonov dolarjev za narodno obrambo, 712 milijonov manj, kot je predsednik prvotno predložil.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Temu debate v plenumu predstavnika doma je bilo slišati dosti hvale, pa tudi graje na račun obrambnega tajnika McNamara. Razpravljalci so tudi o bodočnosti ladjevnic v New Yorku, Bostonu in Philadelphia, ki bodo po mnenju kong. Carla Vinsona, načelnika Domovega odbora za oborožene sile, še pred koncem tega leta zaprte. Kljub vsej kritiki je glasovalo za novi proračun, ki predvideva skupno 46.8 bilijonov izdatkov, 365 kongresnikov, proti pa niti eden. Odobren predlog je bil poslan v obravnavo Senatu.

Proračun narodne obrambe obsegajo skoraj polovico celotnih izdatkov v proračunu zvezne vlade, pa je za 461 milijonov manjši od tekocega in za 712 milijonov manjši od onega, ki je predstavljen Johnson predložil.

Kong. G. H. Mahon je dejal v Domu, da je "McNamara najboljše informirani obrambni tajnik, kar smo jih sploh kdaj imeli... on ni ujetnik admirala in generalov in to je, kar smo vedno hoteli". Republikanec C. S. Gubser iz Kalifornije je na to hvalio odgovor: "Če nočemo upoštevati naših vojakov, le varčujmo denar. Opustimo West Point in Ann Arbor in Letalsko vojno akademijo... šolajmo naše može pri Fordu in bojudimo naše vojne v Edselih."

McNamara je bil pred vstopom v vlado predsednik Ford Motor Co., ki je prav v tem času poskušala neuspešno spraviti na trg nov avto "Edsel".

equal the amount being paid out as benefits at a given time, the fund is said to be "in balance". Since 1957, however, more benefits have been paid out than were received in Social Security taxes. The 23rd annual report of the trustees of the Social Security Trust Fund, released last month, reported that in fiscal 1962 Social Security expenditures increased nearly 13 per cent while receipts increased only 1.4 per cent. The report also revealed that expenditures exceeded receipts by \$1.2 billion in fiscal 1962.

Therefore, the insecure fiscal position of the Social Security Trust Fund is a matter of anxiety. The Trustee's report indicated that over the 5 years 1963-1967, the trust fund is expected to increase, although the rise will not be very rapid. Social Security taxes on earnings are scheduled to increase from 7 1/4 to 8 1/4 per cent in 1966, and to 9 1/4 per cent in 1968 on the first \$4,800 of earnings. More and more citizens qualify for Social Security payments each year. We have been advised that 91 per cent of those reaching 65 this year are eligible for benefits.

There is a great concern among many members of Congress about tying the Administration's medical care program to the Social Security system. Many believe this could endanger the Social Security fund, since no one has been able to give an accurate estimate of the cost of adding compulsory medical care to the present Social Security program. This is apparently one major reason that the Committee on Ways and Means has taken no action on the Administration's medicare program.

PANAMA

One of the key issues in dispute between Panama and the U. S. was the question of the right to fly the Panamanian flag along side the Stars and Stripes. Several years ago we had reason to believe this controversy was successfully resolved when we agreed to permit the flags to fly together in the Canal Zone. However, our tolerance of the Panamanian request has not been reciprocated. President Johnson ordered all flags at half staff during the week of mourning for General MacArthur. Panama refused to lower its flag. Consequently in the Canal Zone the flag of Panama flew over the Stars and Stripes in this week of national mourning. History will surely remember General MacArthur as one who did so much to preserve the freedom of not only the United States but of the Western Hemisphere. It is not ironic that this freedom granted should yield such arrogance from the beneficiary?

Hidden Resources

The barren mountains whose famed Cedars of Lebanon once yielded timbers for Phoenician merchant vessels and Roman galleys are taking on a new cloak of green.

From a nursery of 5 million cedar, pine and fir seedlings, experts of the United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) are transplanting trees to Lebanese mountains stripped bare during the past 1000 years by logging, fire and an uncontrolled goat population.

Reforestation is being carried out under a 10-year program, with the Lebanese government providing \$1.5 million and the U.N. Special Fund furnishing \$888,000.

The U.N. agency, supported by voluntary contributions from over 100 governments, helps to finance planning and development in low-income countries.

Operating through FAO and other U.N. specialized agencies, the Fund has undertaken more than 250 projects throughout the world. It has just approved 48 new programs, ranging from a telecommunications training center in Afghanistan to a survey of Ecuador's mineral deposits.

But wherever it operates, the Fund's goal is the same: to help underdeveloped countries to help themselves with their own resources.

Here's Rule Which Finley Hoped to Elude With Fence

The controversy over Charles O. Finley's fence involves official playing Rule 1.04, which states, in part:

"Note (a) Any playing field constructed by a professional club after June 1, 1958 shall provide a minimum distance of 325 feet from home base to the nearest fence, stand or other obstruction on the right and left field foul lines, and a minimum distance of 400 feet to the center field fence.

"(b) No existing playing field shall be remodeled after June 1, 1958, in such a manner as to reduce the distance from home base to foul poles and to the center field fence below the minimum specified in paragraph (a) above."

Why do teen-agers take up cigarette smoking? — Why do some youngsters begin smoking even before they reach the teen-age group?

This has been a matter of concern to the American Cancer Society ever since cigarette smoking was established as a major cause of the great increase in deaths from lung cancer, according to Dr. V. F. Pekarek, Chairman of the Public Education Committee.

The Society has learned from studies and interviews some of the answers to the "whys."

One study of 11,060 boys and 10,020 girls, all teen-age students, showed:

...The percentage of smokers is highest among children of families in which both parents smoked cigarettes; lowest in families in which neither parent smoked, and intermediate in families in which only one parent smoked cigarettes.

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The Society, according to Dr. Pekarek, "felt that it was a good idea for teen-agers to take a long look at the facts and to think them over carefully."

"There is tremendous pressure on teen-agers to smoke. There are so many influences in the environment that smoking is a nice habit — a mature habit."

"It isn't valid to argue against smoking when your parents smoke; when they tell you, 'don't smoke' and then light up a cigarette."

With these facts — and the fact that 75 per cent of all lung cancer deaths could be prevented if people did not smoke — to build on, the Society, in 1960, launched a teen-age smoking program.

The program — with appropriate literature, film strips, teaching guides and student conferences — was geared to reach all the secondary school students in the country with the facts about lung cancer and cigarette smoking — and to discourage teen-agers from taking up smoking and to encourage those who have already begun to smoke, to stop smoking.

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About half of the nation's secondary schools in the country have been involved in the program so far. The Society spokesman said, "In our own community we have involved more than 100 secondary schools in the program."

Nationally, he added, more than 4,000,000 copies of a teen-age leaflet, "Shall I Smoke?" have been distributed. In 1962, the Society added another pamphlet to its teen-age educational materials — "Answering the Most-Often-Asked Questions About Cigarette Smoking and Lung Cancer."


The project, which continues throughout April, reminds busy women that Goodwill Industries can turn their discarded items into fresh job opportunities for handicapped workers.

Corn Flake Pancakes Highlight Tray Breakfast



Tray breakfasts are fun, especially when the menu includes piping hot cornflake pancakes with butter and syrup, served in place of the usual toast, which is part of an adequate breakfast pattern of fruit, cereal, milk, bread and butter. Cornflake pancakes are easy to make—merely add the corn flakes to the batter. For additional variety—add a note of spring by placing a tiny pot of violets on the tray.

Pancakes with cereal flakes are but one way to vary breakfast breads. Muffins, coffee cakes, biscuits, and quick breads all take on new textures, flavors, and have increased nutritional value by the addition of breakfast cereals.

Corn Flake Pancakes

1 cup pancake mix 3 tablespoons melted shortening or cooking oil
1 cup milk 1 cup corn flakes
1 egg

Combine pancake mix, milk, egg, and melted shortening or oil in mixing bowl; stir until dry ingredients are moistened and batter is fairly smooth. Stir corn flakes into batter. Pour $\frac{1}{4}$ cup batter onto a hot griddle for each pancake; bake until underside of each pancake is browned and top is full of bubbles. Turn and cook until second side of pancake is brown. Yield: About 8 pancakes.

Peace Corps Launches School-to-School Program

The Peace Corps is launching a major international self-help program, School-to-School, in cooperation with local school and civic organizations, Director Sargent Shriver announced today.

"We hope to build 3,000 schools around the world within the next three years," Shriver said. "School-to-School is a program that is uniquely suited to the Peace Corps idea of self-help."

School-to-School is a program in which a U.S. school sponsors the building of a school overseas. The school in this country raises \$1,000. This is used to buy the construction materials. Villagers in the host country, working with Peace Corps volunteers, build the schools.

"From the beginning to end, there will be no paid labor," Shriver emphasized. "This program could be a major breakthrough in solving the lack of classrooms in developing countries."

A pilot project is already in the final stages in Casa Blanca, Columbia; the supporting groups is the Rosendale Elementary School PTA in Schenectady, New York. The three-room schoolhouse is scheduled to be completed on June 1.

In Columbia alone, there is a shortage of 40,000 classrooms. The new Casa Blanca School will be the first school in the area that is able to accommodate students through the fourth grade. It will also be co-educational rather than the male only classes common in many developing nations.

"School-to-School will have a dual effect," Shriver explained. "It will, of course, give the host country needed classrooms. But it will also give the children of this country a chance to become better acquainted with the people of the world in which they will live as adults."

President Johnson, on hearing about School-to-School, expressed his interest to the program's founders.

"Through the efforts of the Rosendale School, the people of Columbia will soon see the power of American ideals at work," the President said. "I am confident that the project will stimulate similar programs by hundreds of school groups throughout our country."

Miss Laura Enders, principal of the Rosendale School, said her students are already showing a greatly increased awareness of international news.

"We are finding the project filled with possibilities for arousing interest in letter writing, penmanship and geography," Miss Enders said. "This is one of the few projects undertaken by a PTA which directly involves the children. They are truly proud of it."

Rosendale has already gotten letters of appreciation from students whom they are assisting in Columbia. An active pen-pal club has also started.

When the school opens in Casa Blanca, Rosendale will also hold a corresponding ceremony. Each School will exhibit articles made by the other.

The School-to-School program was suggested to the Peace Corps by Gene Bradley, the Rosendale PTA president and editor of the General Electric Forum, during a business meeting with government officials overseas.

"Our PTA raised \$750 last year. What could you have done with that money?"

"Build a school," replied the official.

When Bradley expressed his surprise that a school could be built with so little money, the official explained that he didn't mean sending in construction crews.

"I mean buying the cement and the block-making machines and letting the people do the work — self help," said the official.

On the basis of this, the Rosendale School started the pilot project in Casa Blanca. The Colombian townspeople agreed to furnish the additional money required to complete the school. Through the pilot project, officials found a small school could be built for as little as \$1,000, depending on local conditions and materials available.

School-to-School will only operate in sites where the Volunteer shows a need for the classrooms. The choice will be approved by the Ambassador and the Peace Corps Representative in that country.

"The beauty of School-to-School is in its simplicity," Shriver said. "As we have a Volunteer on the spot in each location, we can be assured that the money will not be wasted."

The benefits of this program will not only accrue to the host country. It will develop in our own school children a deeper awareness of the world — a keener sense of democracy, geography, compassion and understanding."

History's Mystery

Grandpa was regaling his grandson with stories of the old western gunfighters.

"Is that so?" remarked his attentive grandson. "What kind of a car did he drive?"

— Advertising and notification of the proper authorities should be

reinforced by personal search in old and new neighborhoods and asking the help of neighbors, school children, mailmen and others who are most likely to encounter the missing animal.

Just how big the lost-dog problem is also was indicated in the Purina Pet Care Center study.

The Los Angeles Department of Animal Regulation in its fiscal year 1962-63 impounded, housed and cared for 46,241 dogs. Only one out of three was returned to the owner or found another home.

In 1962, the Delaware County (Pennsylvania) S. P. C. A. received 6,989 dogs at its shelter. Of these 1,506 were adopted and 525 returned to the owners.

In both cases, many of the dogs were picked up by request or brought into the shelters by owners. Put when Los Angeles lists 46,241 impoundees compared with its 172,105 licenses and applications, it's obvious that the lost-dog problem is great.

The too-common assumption that a dog can take care of itself often leads to carelessness. Back in the good, old days, a lost or stray dog had to contend with firearms, traps, poison, other dogs, dogmanning and disease.

Obviously, they first suggest that you take every precaution to prevent your pet's getting lost and every measure to speed its recovery in the event that it strays. Dogs being dogs, they sometimes manage to get into trouble despite the finest training and treatment.

The basic rule is: Keep your dog at home, keep it under control when away from home, train it to obey and treat it in such a manner that it won't want to run around. If possible, fence it in. Be a "Good Dog Neighbor."

Here are the experts' suggestions:

— Always keep your dog on leash when walking it. This is the law in many places.

— Don't leave your dog in the car with the windows open so wide as to permit its escape. (Leave them open enough for ventilation.)

— When you move into a new neighborhood, keep your dog under stricter-than-usual control until he becomes familiar with his new home; then keep him home.

— Your dog should wear a collar with complete identification at all times. In addition to the license and rabies immunization information, a tag that gives the owner's name, address and phone number may speed recovery of a lost animal.

Tattoo identification is valuable, especially for dogs with few distinctive markings.

— Profile and front photographs of your dog will help expedite its recovery.

— Should you lose your dog, the best way to recover it is to advertise in the papers, on radio and television, and notify humane and police officials.

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
