PREGLED NAJPOMEMBNEJŠIH NOVIC

Gospodarske razmere gredo na bolje

Podatki o gospodarskih razmerah v ZDA, ki jih ima na razpolago zvezna vlada, sedaj jasno kažejo, da ni več mogoče govoriti o gospodarskem zastaju. V januarju je indeks vodilnih ekonomskih kazalcev napredoval za 3,6 odstotka, kar je največji napredek za en mesec vse od 1. 1950. Prodaja novih enodružinskih hiš je bila višja v januarju za 9,9 odstotka. Povprečna prodajna cena teh hiš pa je tudi bila rekordna: \$75,500.

Cene delnic na newyorški borzi so ta teden na najvišji ravnini v zgodovini borze. Opazovalci borze soglašajo, da bodo še cene še višje v naslednjih mesecih. Gibanje cen na borzi jasno kaže, da so investorji in finančniki uverjeni o tem, da se je večletni gospodarski zastoj v ZDA res končal v decembru ali januarju.

Med drugimi kazalci, ki pričajo o oživitvi gospodarstva, so nižje obrestne mere, nižja cena nafte in naftnih derivatov ter trenutno zelo nizka inflacijska stopnja. Znižane obrestne mere so veliko prispevale k pospeševanju prodaje hiš in avtomobilov. Tako v avtomobilski industriji pričakujejo, da bo letošnja prodaja najboljša v zadnjih letih. Kljub vsem tem veselim podatkom, dejstvo je, da je še vedno zelo veliko nezaposlenih delavcev. Celo v Reagorovi administraciji priznavajo, da ni mogoče pričakovati, da bo zelo veliko teh delavcev našlo zaposlitev. Delovna mesta, ki so jih imeli mnogi brezposelni, sploh ne obstajajo več.

Janez Pavel II. v Centralni Ameriki

Preteklo sredo je prispel v državo Costa Rica papež Janez Pavel II. Costa Rica je med redkimi državami na tem območju Latinske Amerike, v kateri niso aktivni komunistično usmerjeni gverilci. Na letališču so papeža pričakali najvišji državni in cerkveni predstavniki, več sto tisoč Costaričanov pa je pozdravilo Janeza Pavla II., ko se je peljal v glavno mesto San Jose.

V nedeljo bo papež obiskal El Salvador. Gverilci so izjavili, da bodo spoštovali premirje v času, ko bo Janez Pavel II. mudil v El Salvadorju.

Barney Clark vesel, da je živ

Barney Clark, prvi človek z umetnim srcem, je prvič govoril javno o svojih čustvih. Intervjuval ga je njegov zdravnik in izumitelj umetnega srca dr. William C. DeVries. Na dan intervjuja je namreč živel Clark z umetnim srcem 3 mesece.

Clark je govoril precej razločno, a vidno s precejšnjo težavo. Rekel je, da je vesel, da je še živ. Vesel je tudi, je pripomnil, da je prispeval k napredku zdravstvene znanosti, kar bo nedvomno v bodoče pomagalo drugim bolnikom.

Zdravnik DeVries je svojega pacienta vprašal, kaj bi svetoval drugim bolnikom glede vsaditve umetnega srca. Ako je izbira takšna, da bo bolnik brez te operacije umrl, je odgovoril Clark, svetoval mu bi, naj pristane na operacijo.

Umetno srce dela brezhibno, je dejal Clark, 62-letni upokojeni zobozdravnik, in nič ne boli. Nič se ne boji, da bi srce odpovedalo, je še pristavil.

V bolnišnici, kjer zdravijo Clarka, govorijo o možnosti nove takšne operacije v naslednjih mesecih. Kdo bo drugi človek z umetnim srcem pa nočejo povedati.

Volitve v Zvezni republiki Nemčiji

Najnovejša javna povpraševanja o razpoloženju zahodnonemških volivev na pragu parlamentarnih volitev, ki bodo prihodno nedeljo, kažejo, da bo vladajoča krščansko-demokratska stranka prejela 43% vseh glasov, socialno-demokratska stranka 42 odstotkov, medtem ko bo svobodno-demokratska stranka dobila 6 odstotkov.

Analitiki teh podatkov poudarjajo, da je v zadnjih povpraševanjih vidno nazadovala krščansko-demokratska stranka. Povsem jasno je, pravijo, da bo treba sestaviti koaličijsko vlado, v kateri bodo zopet igrali veliko in morda celo odločilno vlogo svobodni demokrati.

Podatki kažejo, da bo nova protivojna stranka "zelencev" tudi dobila okoli 6 odstotkov vseh glasov in s tem tudi najmanj 25 sedežev v novem parlamentu.

Krščansko-demokratska vlada, ki ji načeljuje Helmut Kohl, je v težavah predvsem zaradi večletnega, globokega gospodarskega zastaja. Trenutno je v Zvezni republiki Nemčiji brez dela 10,5 odstotka delavcev.

Sen. John Glenn bo res kandidiral

Ni več nobenega dvoma, da bo ohiski demokratski zvezni senator John Glenn napovedal svojo predsedniško kandidaturo. V zadnjih mesecih je Glenn vneto sestavljal svojo kampanjsko organizacijo ter potoval po ZDA in iskal sodelavce, seveda tudi denar.

Vodilni demokratski kandidat je bivši podpredsednik Walter F. Mondale, ki zagovarja liberalno politično ideologijo. Sen. Glenn bo iskal podporo tako med zmernimi liberalci in konservativci kot sredinci. Sen. Glenn sam pripada sredini in je uverjen, da mu bo to tudi prineslo končno zmagovo na stankini konvenciji, potem na predsedniških volitvah.

Sen. Paul Laxalt iz Nevade, republikanec, ki je zelo blizu predsednika Ronaldu Reagana, je izjavil, da bo Reagan ponovno kandidiral. Laxalt in drugi republikanci so postali optimističnejši v zadnjih mesecih predvsem zaradi oživitve ameriškega gospodarstva. Prepričani so, da bo Reagan ponovno izvoljen novembra 1984, naj bo demokratski nasprotnik kdor koli.

Volitve v Argentini oktobra letos

Argentinski predsednik, gen. Reynaldo Bignone, ki načeljuje vojaški vladi, je dejal, da bodo volitve 30. oktobra letos. Dne 30. januarja 1984 bo prevzela politično oblast v Argentini civilna vlada.

Argentinska vojska je izvedla državni udar 24. marca 1976 in s tem strmoglavila peronistično vlado predsednice Isabel Peron. Takrat so bili zelo aktivni gverilci in je vojska skupaj s policijo vodila kruto borbo zoper le-te in jih končno tudi premagala.

Ekonomski razmeri v državi so pa težavne. Inflacija lani je bila kar 210%; okoli 15 odstotkov vseh Argentinev nima zaposlitve.

OPEC države še iščejo kompromis

Šejk Ahmed Zaki Jamani, minister za nafto saudske vlade, trdi, da bodo OPEC države le našle pot do kompromisne rešitve glede cene nafte, ki jo izvažajo na svetovni trg. O novi ceni nafte šejk Jamani ni hotel nič reči, opazovalci OPEC pa menijo, da bo nekje med 27 in 30 dolarjev za sod.

Skof Dr. Gregorij Rožman, D.D. 1883-1959



Prihodnjo sredo, 9. marca 1983, bo sto let, kar je bil rojen v Dolinčičah št. 1., po domače pri Pongracu, župnija Smihel nad Pliberkom v Podjuni na Slovenskem Koroškem, poznejši ljubljanski škof dr. Gregorij Rožman. V mašnika je bil posvečen 21. julija 1907; pomožni škof ljubljanski s pravico nasledstva je postal 17. marca 1929; v škofa je bil posvečen 14. julija 1929; ljubljanski ordinarij pa je postal 1. avgusta 1930. Umrl je kot škof-begunec, kar se zgodi izjemno redko, 16. novembra 1959 v Clevelandu, Ohio, ZDA; njegovo truplo počiva začasno na samostanskem pokopališču slovenskih oo. frančiškanov v Lemontu, Ill.

Podpisani bi se danes v zvezi s škof-Rožmanovo stoletnico rojstva rad na kratko pomudil pri zgodovinskem veledelu, ki nosi naslov "SKOF ROZMAN" s podnaslovom "Duhovna podoba velike osebnosti na prelomnici časa". O tem našem znanstvenem delu se je namreč kot celoti doslej pisalo med nami še zelo malo.

Napisal ga je slovenski misijonar-lazarist dr. Jakob Kolarič, rojen v Radomerju pri Ljutomeru na Stajerskem 20. 7. 1902. Ta je med nami v ZDA in Kanadi dobro poznan kot ustanovitelj prve slovenske r.k. župnije v Toronto, Ontario, Kanada. Njegovo delo o škofu Rožmanu pa je nastalo v St. Jakobu v Rožu na Koroškem, kamor se je bil njegov avtor preselil zaradi svojega šibkega zdravja k slovenskim šolskim sestram, ki imajo tam slovensko strokovno deklisko gospodinsko šolo.

Dr. Kolarčeve delo "SKOF ROZMAN" je izdala in založila Družba sv. Mohorja v Celovcu, ki se je tako na najdostojnejši način oddoložila svojemu velikemu rojaku.

Preden je šlo delo v tisk, je rokopis pregledal dr. Jože Jagodic, ljubljanski škofijski kancler v času Rožmanovega škofovanja. S tem je avtorjevo

delo pridobilo samo na svoji vrednosti. Pri zbiranju gradiva pa so mu poleg koroških rojakov zlasti pomagali tako južnoameriški kako tudi severnoameriški Slovenci.

Dr. Kolaričeva zgodovinska študija obsegata tri dele (knjige): prvi je izšel 1. 1967 in obsegata 382 strani; drugi del je izšel 1970 in obsegata 542 strani; tretji in zadnji del z 992 strami pa je izšel 1. 1977. Potemtakem obsegata celotno delo 1976 strani. Pisal pa ga je, če se prav spominjam, dobrih 14 let.

Tudi v interesu bralcev je, vedeti, po katerih principih je dr. Kolarič napisal svoje delo. Glavno načelo, po katerem se je ravnal, nam je povedal v uvodu v prvo knjigo: "Življenjepis ni modrovanje, še manj pisateljeva domišljija; življenjepis so nepotvorjena dejstva. Zato mora v življenjepisu govoriti človek, ki ga življenjepisec opisuje, govoriti mora s svojimi lastnimi besedami, ki jih je napisal ali govoril; govoriti morajo njegova dejanja, njegove stvaritve. Poleg tega pa smejo govoriti tudi tisti, ki so njegovo življenje gledali iz neposredne bližine, pa tudi ti samo tedaj, če so ga gledali brez predsodkov, z očesom pravičnosti in brez sovraštva.

Dober življenjepis mora zato poskušati, da tudi iz teh sodb izlušči košček resnice, če ga vsebujejo." Življenjepisec dr. Rožmana se je po tem načrtu

zvesto ravnal in je tako dobilo njegovo delo vsestransko veljavo in pomen.

Za sklep teh svojih spominskih vrstic ob dr. Rožmanovi stoletnici rojstva, pa citiram iz tretje knjige naslednje: "(Dr. Kolaričev) delo obravnava škofovo ideološko borbo proti komunizmu. Skof Rožman se je boril proti ideologiji komunizma, komuniste pa je vedno ljubil s tisto krščansko ljubeznijo, ki zmoto zavrača, tistega ki se moti, pa skuša pripeljati k resnici. Dokazov za trditev bo njen bralec našel v knjigi dovolj."

Slovenik v Rimu

— V svojem letnem poročilu zastopnikom po svetu, Slovenikov rektor, prelat dr. M. Jezernik poroča o dogodkih in uspehih zavoda v preteklem letu.

Glavna novica je pač ta, da je najemnik v pritličju — delavnica za lestenice — izpraznil prostore v prijateljskem vzdušju, in je sedaj na vodstvu, da preuredi le-te po lastnih potrebah. V pritličju nameravajo urediti novo kapelo, dvorano za romarje, večjo obednico in knjižnico. G. Jože Kregar je njihov arhitekt.

Ker vlada v Italiji huda draginja, saj je en dolar že 1300 lir, računajo, da bodo stroški dosegli kar \$200,000. Nekaj denarja res imajo na roki, prihranjenega od prodaže zemljišča in darov, polovico vsote pa bo kljub temu treba iskati drugod: pri vrnih in narodno zavednih rojakih po svetu.

Letos bo zavod obhajal 10. obletnico blagoslovitve. V tem času je 65 duhovnikov končalo svoje študije na rimskih univerzah in so sedaj v pomoč slovenski Cerkvi.

Pred kratkim so trije končali svoje študije: dr. Jožko Pirc, ki je doktoriral iz teologije na Lateranu in je bila njegova tematika "Aleš Ušenčnik" in sedaj v Kopru vodi pastoralni urad na škofiji, in Lojze Pirnat iz Maribora, ki je sedaj špiritual v Mariboru. Dne 10. januarja pa je branil svojo tezo še dr. Nace Potočnik na Urbanianu.

Vse kaže, da bodo letos končali še nadaljnji trije študenti. Slovenikovo skupnost pa sta pomladila Tone Mlinar iz Ljubljane, ki študira moralko na Alfonsianumu, in Ivan Štuhec iz Maribora, ki študira na Gregoriani. Kot znano, Slovenik vzdržuje te duhovnike brezplačno, saj slovenski škofje nimajo sredstev, da bi zanje plačevali, kot je to bilo pred vojno.

Zvesto ravnal in je tako dobilo njegovo delo vsestransko veljavo in pomen.

Za sklep teh svojih spominskih vrstic ob dr. Rožmanovi stoletnici rojstva, pa citiram iz tretje knjige naslednje: "(Dr. Kolaričev) delo obravnava škofovo ideološko borbo proti komunizmu. Skof Rožman se je boril proti ideologiji komunizma, komuniste pa je vedno ljubil s tisto krščansko ljubeznijo, ki zmoto zavrača, tistega ki se moti, pa skuša pripeljati k resnici. So Long, Everyone

Tuesday, Feb. 22 was my last day on the job. Within a month I would be dead and buried.

It was a snow-less chilly evening and the work-place was empty except for me and my boss, Jim who had come in to be with me that final night. We had worked hard many evenings together. But shortly I would be put on the scrap heap—a useless antique who had served its time, and now the young upstart was coming in to do my job.—And by all I can see, he can do it better, and faster.

But it was not always thus. I remember years ago when I first came to the American Home Publishing in 1924. I had worked elsewhere first, getting my first job in 1907. But the Slovenians were anxious to see me perform. I was fast and perfect then. But they were not used to my style and it took them a few months to get accustomed to the way I worked.

Ah, but soon the company employees and I became used to each other and they were real proud of my production.

I remember John Jadrich at my side, helping me do my best. We learned together what the Slovenians wanted, and we gave them something remarkable and lasting—their own newspaper to record their events and the nation's and the world's in their own language.

Joseph Andolsen was also at my side in later years. We printed over 2 million newspapers a year. The Ameriška Domovina was published five times a week. We also did newspapers for fraternal lodges. It was not uncommon to print 20,000 newspapers with eight full-length pages in one day. We really worked hard then. I don't know how those guys did it.

I wonder where they are now. I fondly recall Mike Kolar, Vic Knaus, Jerry Knaus, Vic Jadrich, Ed Debevec, Phil Pagon, Frank Sustersic. We had a good team. There were lots of heartaches, but in the end the finished product showed our devotion and skill.

And those writers. My, how everyone hung on to their words. There were Louis Pirc, James Debevec, Vinko Lipovec, Frank Turek, Anton Sabec, and hundreds of contributors of articles. Then when James Debevec died in 1952 his wife, Mary, took over the operation of the place for 25 years until 1976 when you, Jim, took over. After Lipovec retired, Rudolph Susek became the editor.

My eyes are becoming dim now. I guess it's part of the hazards of working with the written word so very

often—eyestrain. I haven't been feeling too well lately. I've had many operations in the past five years. Doctors tell me my system won't stand any more strain.

At night, when no one else was around I began chatting with that bright golden stallion standing a few feet away from me. I guess he's all right. They say, "Youth must be served," and he seems well equipped to handle the job. Although he stands regal and proud right now, a few years down the road, we'll see how he fares up under the strain of constant work. I bet he won't last over 70 years like I did!

Now we're printing the Our Voice for American Mutual Life Association. Everything seems to be going smoothly. Maybe I won't give Jim too difficult a time this last night. We have gone through a lot together and have a keen understanding of each other's feelings.

"Hey, what's going on now?" There's the door opening and coming in is a group of persons who call themselves "Friends of Ameriška Domovina". I see Paul Kosir, John Dejak, Ivan Hauptman, Rudy Kolaric, Mario Percic, Tony Lavrisha. This is my proud moment. I will show them I can still do my stuff.

Wait a minute. Those guys are paying too much attention to the new fellow sitting confidently over there. Oh, my gosh, now they're starting him up. Holy cow, this is supposed to be my final night and they have left me by myself.

It's been fun, we've had our share of ups and downs, and now it's time for us to go our (if you will excuse the expression) parting ways.

So long, everybody. We have had our share of laughs, sorrow, crisis, and fond remembrances. Keep telling the truth and make the Slovenians proud of their heritage. Good luck with the new kid--And farewell.






