### Rusi so ustavili zaveznikom vlake proti Berlinu

#### Amerikanci vozijo zdaj potrebščine v Berlin po zraku

Berlin. — Ameriške vojaške oblasti so se uprle Rusom, da bi pregledovali njih vlake, ki se vozijo v Berlin potrebščine, zato so se odločile, da bodo vozile ljudi in tovore v nemško prestolnico po zraku.

Ameriški general Clay, ki je poveljnik ameriških okupacijskih čet v Nemčiji je izjavil, da ne bo umaknil svojih čet iz Berlina. Ameriške in angleške okupacijske oblasti so napravile pri sovjetskem poveljstvu oster protest, ker so Rusi ukazali, da morajo biti pregledani vsi vlaki, kar darujejo čez mejo na ozemlje, ki je okupirano po ruskih četah.

Po odgovoru med štirimi zavezniki, smejo Amerikanci, Anglezi in Francozi obravnavati zračne plete čez to ozemlje do letališč v Berlinu. Rusi bi mogli to preprečiti edino s tem, da bi streljali na zavezniška letala.

To, da Rusi zahtevajo pregled vseh vlakov in vseh trukov, ki vozojijo v Berlin, nič drugega kot poskus pregnati zapadne zaveznike iz Berlina.

Zavezniki morajo dovažati v Berlin potrebščine za 25.000 vojaščin, in sicer je tam 10.000 ameriških, 10.000 angleških in 5.000 francoskih vojakov. Poleg tega skrbijo zavezniki za skorokratno 2.000.000 nemškega prebivalstva.

Ves železniški promet med Berlinom in conami zapadnih zaveznikov je prenehal ob 11:30 dopoldne včeraj. Ameriške oblasti so potem ukazale, da se vrši ves promet v Berlin po zraku.

Rusi okupirajo 100 milijonov pas med Berlinom in zavezniškimi conami. Po tem ozemlju so zavezniki rabili ceste in železniško progo za dobove v Berlin.

Radio iz Moskve je včeraj nazzanjal, da je delitev Nemčije zdaj dogotovljena zadeva in da kontralna komisija štirih zveznikov ne obstaja več.

Zdaj je vprašanje, če bodo skušali Rusi ustaviti tudi zračni promet zaveznikom do Berlina. Ako bodo, bodo morali streljati s topovi na letala. Ako bodo segli Rusi po tem sredstvu in tako zanetili tretjo svetovno vojno, se bo videlo.

#### Poglavarja komunistov v Italiji so izvzvigli

Rim. — V kraju Lecce so sklicali komunisti in levčarski socialisti politični shod, na katerem je bil glavni govorilnik Palmiro Togliatti, v Moskvi treniran komunist. Nad 20.000 oseb se je zbralo na shodu.

Vse je bilo lepo, mirno, dokler ni začel Togliatti udrihati po Zed, državah in pripovedovati, da se mora Italija zanašati na pomoč samo iz Rusije. Takrat so pa zagnali navzoči tako vpitje, življanje in tuljenje, da ni mogel Togliatti pet minut do besede. Ljudje so vplili: "Bog živi Zed, države!"

Ko so na tak način dali duška, so odšli z zborovanja v strnjene vrstah. Na mestu je ostala samo peščica komunistov in socialistov.

WASHINGTON. — Danes bo stopil general Eisenhower pred senatni odsek in urgiral, naj se takoj sprejme postavo za splošno vojaško treningo in za obvezno vojaško službo, kar je edino, če hočemo ustaviti pohod komunizma.

#### Senat je odstranil Španijo iz predloga za Marshallov načrt

#### Ležeče je na 16 državah v Evropi, če hočejo Španijo zraven

Washington. — Ker je poslanska zbornica sprejela k predlogu za pomoč evropskim državam dodatek, da je tudi Španija deležna tega pomoči, je bilo treba določiti še senat, da se izreče za to.

Pooblaščenci obeh zbornic so se končno zedinili na tem, da se dodatek glede Španije črta iz predloga in da se prepusti 16 evropskim državam, ki bodo sodelovali pri Marshallovem programu, da odklopi, če hočejo Španijo ali ne.

Iz Bele hiše je prišlo poročilo, da je predsednik Truman proti temu, da bi se Španijo vključilo v predlog. Ravno tako je bil proti senator Vandenberg, načelnik senatnega odseka za tujezemske zadeve.

Ker Marshallov predlog za novo Evrope govorji, da so vrata odprta vsaki državi, ki hoče sodelovati in ker se je prvočnih 16 držav že organiziralo za ta načrt, bi ne bilo prav, če bi ameriški kongres na svojo roko priključil Španijo zraven, je izvajal Vandenberg.

Pozno sinoči so zastopniki obeh zbornic glasovali in danes bo končno sprejet predlog za Marshallov načrt.

## Katoliški odbor za naselitev beguncev je zopet zboroval

V tork 30. marca je v Hotel Sheraton, St. Louis, Mo., imel svoje mesečno zborovanje Katoliški odbor za naselitev beguncev v Ameriki. Zborovanje je počastil s svojo navzočnostjo nadškof v St. Louis N.J. Eksc. Jos. E. Ritter, ki je gvoril tudi pozdravno besedo. Nadškof je predsednik škofijskega odbora in posebni zagovornik programa za naselitev beguncev v USA. K popoldanskemu delu se je prišel tudi novo imenovan pomočni škof Msgr. Leo Steck, ki je imenovan za pomočnika škofa v Salt Lake City, Utah, a je doslej z večim uspehom vodil v St. Louis-u karitativne akcije v pomoci beguncem kot škofijski direktor. Sejo je vodil Msgr. Edward E. Swanstrom, navzočih pa je bilo okrog 40 zastopnikov ameriških katoliških dobrodelenih organizacij in zastopnikov raznih narodnosti skupin v Ameriki. Liga sovenskih katoličev Amerikanov so zastopali predsednik Rev. Matija Butala, Rev. Karl Madic in dr. Miha Krek.

Seja je z velikim zadoščenjem vzel na znanje izčrpno poročilo predsednikovo, iz katerega je razvidno, da se je organizacija za naselitev beguncev razširila že v 95 škofijsih, kjer so imenovani škofijski direktorji in organizirani škofijski odbori. Nekatere škofije in nekatere narodne organizacije so že izvedle preglev dobrtnikov, ki so pripravljeni sprejeti begunce, jim pomagati pri kritiju transportnih stroškov ter jim preskrbeti stanovanje in zaposlitev. Več tisoč takih prijav je že prišlo. Rev. Matija Butala je poročal o uspešni delegaciji Lige v Washington. V imenu Lige so Rev. Matija Butala in gg. Anton Grdin, Matt. Intihar in Frank Mrvar obiskali več senatorjev in poslancev ter jim predložili željo katoliških slovenskih Amerikanov, da se čimprej sprejemine in v zavodnem potrebnem postava, ki bo omogočila beguncem vstop v U.S.A. Pri svojem obisku je delegacija Lige posebej poudarila težko stanje, v katerem se nahajajo slovenski begunci v Avstriji, Nemčiji in Italiji. Gmotno v zdravstvene razmere med njimi so take, da je nujno potrebno, da se naselitev izvrši v najkrajšem času, ker je sicer nevarnost, da jim bo pomanjkanje in razne bolezni uničilo zdravje in delomnočnost. Delegacija je bila povzročena povsod ljubezljivo sprejeta in dobitila zagotovila, da se bo delo za to zakonodajo kar najbolj pospešilo. Podobne delegacije so bile na 1. strani

Tajnik Marshall je urgiral južne države za pomoč proti Rusiji

Dolžil je Sovjetsko Rusijo, da edina ovira mira je Španijo ali ne.

Bogota, Colombia. — Ameriški državni tajnik je včeraj govoril na konferenci ameriških republik ter otočil Sovjetsko Rusijo, da je edina, ki dela ovire proti miru po vsem svetu.

Urgiral je južne republike, naj pomagajo Zed. državam ustaviti pohod komunizma preko Evrope s tem, da dajo Evropi materialno pomoč.

"Ako bodo človečanske pravice in svobode pognane iz Evrope, bodo v nevarnosti tudi v našem Novem svetu," je reklo Marshall.

Povedal je tudi južnim republikam, da ne smejo pričakovati pomoci od Zed. držav, nasprotno, Zed. države apelirajo nanje, naj pomagajo Evropi k ekonomski obnovi.

Ako bi hotela Sovjetska Rusija sodelovali, bi nastal mir na svetu in svet bi si pomagal na noge. Toda če Rusija noče sodelovati, nas to ne sme ovirati, da dosežemo svetski mir in izboljšanje ekonomskega položaja po vsem svetu," je reklo gen. Marshall.

## Pogreta rihta iz Gardenove kuhinje

Komunisti so uporabljali in ŠE UPORABLJAJO SLEHERNEGA izmed teh Bakuninovih 'naukov,' mnoge sim zavezničkom, kar pomeni, da ta pobratimija s Hitlerjem ne bo preveč topla ali celo trajna."



**C**HERRY Blossom Time! Rains followed by a day or two or summer heat have turned the tidal basin almost over night into a fairy-like beauty. It will take a few days to reach the climax, but Spring is here and the Spring moon adds her soft light to the miracle.

**M**UCH happens on Capitol Hill. The Senate is debating S. 472, brought out of the Committee on Labor and Public Welfare of which Senator Taft is Chairman. This bill authorizes the appropriation of funds to assist the States and Territories in financing a minimum foundation education program of public, elementary and secondary schools and in reducing inequalities of educational opportunities. A very great deal of study has been given this legislation and proponents feel that the present draft protects the integrity of the States while it will bring the general standard of education to a higher level. It is anticipated that a vote will be taken promptly.

**R**EORGANIZATION of all sorts is taking place within the armed services. This last week the House Armed Services Committee swept women out of the services. The Senate bill (S.1641) making the WACS, WAVES, WAFFS and Women Marines a permanent part of the armed forces was completely revised. Substituted was a plan permitting women to enlist in the Reserve Corps, subject to call to active duty at any time. From what I can gather this re- is expected.

**S**ENATE action this past week would seem to indicate that when the House has voted the Recovery program the Senate will be ready to bring to the conference its action on China, Greece and Turkey, thereby avoiding the delays opponents of the House Omnibus Bill prophesied. A House vote is anticipated for Tuesday, March 30, and prompt conference action

Oppression follows automatically when a people, stripped of property, must rely blindly on a government run with a free rein by men who need no longer recognize antitrust laws, labor unions, or anything else—men who can abandon the constitutional trappings of a free country because they are bigger than the law by right of might.

Total control is always the dream of ruthless men. The ultimate in total control is total government. The one thing standing in the path of total government in the United States is the private ownership of property vested in millions of American citizens. It must ever remain so.

### Last Day to Register

The last day to register, to be eligible to vote in the May 4th primaries is April 5th and the only place that this can be done is at the Board of Elections, Room 119, City Hall, which is located at E. 6th St., and Lakeside Avenue.

Any person reaching the age of 21, and persons that haven't voted at least once at general elections in the past two years are required by law to register to be eligible to vote.

People that have voted at least once in the past two years are not required to register, while those that have moved are required to transfer their registration cards to the voting precinct of their new address. THESE TRANSFER CARDS MAY BE HAD AT OUR OFFICE saving you a trip to the Board of Elections.

Anyone who will be 21 years old before November 2nd, the date of general elections can vote at the primaries May 4th if he registers before April 5th at the Board of Elections, City Hall. This is the rule of the Election Board.
