

TROCKI POSTAL  
JETNIK NORVEŠKE  
VLADE

Ker ni hotel pristati na zahovo, da se odpove političnim aktivnostim, ga je norveška vlada internirala,

OSLO Norveška. — Norveška vlada je sinoč internirala izgnane boljševiškega voditelja Leona Trockija in njegovo ženo, ter postavila okrog njegovega doma in Hoeneffossi stalno policijsko stražo osmih mož, katerih naloga je, preprečiti vsak Trockija z zunanjim svetom. Trockij in žena bosta zaenkrat internirana v svojem domu, "dokler se ne najde pripravnega mesta za njiju", kakor pravi izjava norveškega justičnega ministra, v čijega področje spada ta stvar. Njegova privata tajna bosta izgnana in telesfonska zveza z zunanjim svetom je bila ustavljenja.

Internacijsko povelje je prislo kmalu potem, ko je Trockij tekton sodne obravnave proti petimi fašistom, ki so bili obtoženi, da so hoteli vlotiti v njegov podeželski dom ter se polnili raznih dokumentov, priznal da je bil v zvezi s svojimi pristojnimi državah ter jim dalo pismena navodila. Po končanem pričanju je bil Trockij poslan na daljšo konferenco s danimi norveške vlade, ki je začela ob njega, da se odpove svojim političnim aktivnostim, dokler živi na norveškem tečju. Trockij je to odklonil.

Kaj bo zdaj storila norveška vlada, ni znano. Namignjeno je bilo toliko, da internacijsko potrebuje še ne pomeni, da se bo Trockija takoj izgnal iz Norveške. Gotovo pa je toliko, da norveška vlada odločena izogniti se vsakemu tveganju zaradi Trockijevih političnih aktivnosti, s katerimi bi ji utegnil povzročiti sitnosti; zato ga je internirala.

### Sovjeti poslali zastopnika v Madrid

V Madrid je prispel prvi ruski zastopnik izza carskih časov, kar se smatra za znak odkritih simpatij do ljudske vlade.

Italija je proglašila embargo na izvoz orožja v Španijo.

MADRID. — Sovjetska Rusija, ki je bila vsa leta svojega obstoja brez diplomatskega zastopnika v Madridu, je včeraj nedvoumno poudarila svoje pravljstvo z madrsko ljudsko vlado, ko je v Madridu otvorila svoje poslaništvo. Med tem, ko poslaniki drugih držav čakajo na francoskih tleh izida krvave civilne vojne, je včeraj prispel v Madrid v Švice Marcel Rosenberg, prvi sovjetski poslanik na Španskem. Vest o njegovem imenovanju za madrskoga zastopnika sovjetske vlade je prišla v javnost šele potem, ko je prispel v Madrid. Sodi se, da bo njegova navzočnost velike moralne vrednosti za špansko ljudsko vlado v njenem boju proti fašističnim rebeljem.

(Mesto Irún, ki šteje deset tisoč prebivalcev, leži na severnih pobočjih Pirenejev, blizu francoske meje. Ce bi se rebeli posrečilo zavzeti Irún, bi postali tudi gospodarji San Sebastiana ob Biskajskem zalivu, kar bi pomenilo zanje prost dostop do morja.)

V San Sebastian je prispolo šest vladnih letal, ki jih je prebivalstvo navdušeno pozdravilo. Kmalu nato so tri rebela letala napadla z bombami tamoznje letališče, toda niso povzročila nobenih žrtev.

Ponesrečenka je bila stara še 21 let. Pred domačo hišo na E. 82. cesti pa je bil ubit od avtomobila 6-letni Joseph Mannino, ki je skočil na cesto za žogo in planil naravnost pod avto. Voznika sta bila v obeh slučajih opriščena krvide. S tem je število letosnjih smrtnih prometnih nesreč v Clevelandu naraslo na 125.

Why should I joy it, why shouldn't I glory in it—live it, fully, unrestrainedly? empty the cup it is offering to its last blissful drop? Yes, life. He believes in organization—he doesn't politics is dull. He and his kind don't pretend that nothing is happening. They know that things are happening, they want them to happen, so they are at it day and night, busily brewing the witches' brew of racial and religious fanaticism, so they may be ready when the opportune moment arrives.

Yes, I hate politics, but there are a few things I love among them, life, liberty and pursuit of happiness. And that these things are in danger it is my business. As for myself, I'll string along with Franklin D. Roosevelt beginning to admire the man for the enemies he makes, then, I realize that going further to the left, this year, will be happening. They know that things are happening, they want them to happen, so they are at it day and night, busily brewing the witches' brew of racial and religious fanaticism, so they may be ready when the opportune moment arrives.
