Na sodni obravnavi zoper Johna Hinckleyja pričajo ushkalci

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Na sodni obravnavi zoper Johna Hinckleyja pričajo tedeni psihiatri, ki so jih naveli odvetniki obtoženega atentatorja na predsednika Ronalda Reagana. Namen njihovih pričevanj je prepričati poroto o tem, da 26-letni Hinckley ni bil prisaben, ko je streljal na predsednika.

Družni tožilci so že na sodni obravnavi zaslišali psihiatre, ki so pričali, da je bil Hinckley prisaben v trenutku streljanja na Reagana in zato nosi vso odgovornost za to dejanje. Porotniki se bodo moralni odločiti o tem, katerim psihiatrom bodo verjeli.

John Hinckley sam nadaljuje s svojim nenavadnim obnašanjem. Preteklo sredo je namreč dvakrat zapustil sodno dvorano — seveda v spremstvu paznikov —, vsakrat z dovoljenjem sodnika Parringtona Parkerja. Hinckley je dejal, da je nemiren in da bi rad šel malo na sprechod.

Hinckleyev glavni odvetnik Vincent Fuller je povedal sodniku, da so bila pričevanja psihiatrov o njegovi nepriselnosti zelo težko breme za obtoženca.

Sodni obravnavi prisostvuje Hinckleyevi starši, ki pa nočejo govoriti z novinarji.

Oparečnik govoril o gladovni stavki v poliskem zaporu

NOWY DWOR MAZOWIECKI, Polj. — Vodilni član sedaj prepovedane delavske organizacije Solidarnost Jan Rulewski je povedal na sodni obravnavi, da on in 16 drugih pripravljenih oporečnikov sodeluje v gladovni stavki v zaporu Bialoleka. Rulewskija sodijo, ker je obtožen krvide v zvezi z avtomobilsko nesrečo, ki se je pripetila marca 1981 in v kateri je bil ubit pesec.

Rulewski, ki je star 38 let in biva v mestu Bydgoszcz, je priznan kot eden najradikalnejših voditeljev Solidarnosti. Aretiran je bil s tisočimi drugimi člani Solidarnosti 13. decembra lani, ko je general Wojciech Jaruzelski izvedel vojaški državni udar. Dotakrat je bil Rulewski na prosti v čakal na začetek sodne obravnave, do katere pa je prišlo še teden.

Sednici Mariji Homa je Rulewski dejal, da so zaporniki začeli gladovno stavkati 13. maja, torej točno 5 mesecev rodu udu gen. Jaruzelskega. Z gladovno stavko protestirajo piščarki zoper nadaljevanje vojaškega stanja na Poljskem.

Med drugim je Rulewski povedal, da v zaporu slabo ravnajo z zaporniki. Ko ga je sednica Homa vprašala, ali lahko sodeluje pri lastni obrambi, je Rulewski odgovoril, da ni dihal svežega zraka 3 dni, da niti ni smel na sprechod. Obtoženca je pregledal zdravnik, ki je potrdil, da trenutno Rulewski ni sposoben prisostvovati sojenju. Sednica je odredila, da bo prekinila scenje za nedoločen čas, naj pa v zaporu zagotovijo boljše življenske razmere za Rulewskega tako, da s e bo njegovo zdravstveno stanje izboljšalo.

Umrla je 92 let stara dobro poznana slovenska pionirka Mary Otoničar, rojena Arko v vasi Podklanec, fara Sodražica, od koder je prišla v Cleveland 4. novembra 1909, k svoji teti Frances Lunder na Addison Road, vdova po leta 1965 umrlem možu Rudolfu, mati Rudolfa ml. (umrl 1. 1947), 3-krat stara mati, 8-krat prastara mati, tašča Mary, sestra Pauline Lunder. Rajinka je bila izredno aktivna na družvenem polju. Bila je članica in veliko let tajnica v blagajničarka Olтарnega društva fare sv. Vida, bivša podpredsednica in nad 44 let tajnica in blagajničarka Podružnice št. 25 SZZ, kateri je pridobila nad 1200 članic, ustanoviteljica in bivša uradnica društva sv. Cecilije št. 37 ADZ, ustanoviteljica društva sv. Marije Magdalene št. 162 KSKJ, ustanoviteljica sv. Neže Catholic Knights of Ohio, članica Materskega kluba fare sv. Vida, Misijonskega, Barago-vega in Slomškovega krožka ter Marijine legije. Bila je odlična kuharica in je pripravila gostite za svatbe, nove mase, birmje, jubileje in druge slavnostne prireditve pri Sv. Vidu več desetletij. Prala in likala je cerkveno perilo nad 40 let, prav tako je pomagala kuhati v župnišču, kadar se je pokazala potreba.

Pogreb bo iz Zakravškega pogrebnega zavoda na 6016 St. Clair Ave. jutri, v soboto, ob 9.30 dopoldne, v cerkev sv. Vida ob 10., nato na Kalvarijo. Na mrtvaškem odu bo danes, v petek, ob 2. do 9. zvečer.

Petar Stambolić novi predsednik predsedstva SFRJ; srbski politik

BEograd, SFRJ. — Pretekli ponedeljek je potekla enoletna mandatna doba Sergeju Kraigherju kot predsedniku predsedstva SFRJ, po ustavi najvišjega državnega telesa Jugoslavije. Kraigherja je nasledil 70 let stari srbski politik Petar Stambolić. Sergej Kraigher bo ostal slovenski predstavnik predsedstva.

Za podpredsednika predsedstva za prihodnje leto je bil izbran dr. Vladimir Bakarić, predstavnik Hrvatske. Dr. Bakarić je tudi star 70 let, a je v slabem zdravstvenem stanju, tako da se slovesne seje predsedstva ni mogel udeležiti. Po ustavi SFRJ, bo dr. Bakarić nasledil Stambolića prihodnjega maja.

Petar Stambolić je bil rojen v Brezovi pri Ivanjici v Srbiji. Končal je agronomsko fakulteto v Beogradu, leta 1935 pa postal član komunistične partije. Od začetka partizanskega gibanja v Srbiji je bil med voditelji tega. V povojnem obdobju je postal član komunistične partije. Od leta 1944 je bil imenovan za sekretarja hrvaške komunistične partije.

Dr. Vladimir Bakarić se je rodil v Veliki Gorici pri Zagrebu. Diplomiral je na pravni fakulteti v Zagrebu leta 1935, dve leti kasneje pa tudi doktoriral. Član komunistične partije je postal že leta 1933. Kot Stambolić v Srbiji, tako je imel Bakarić visoke funkcije v hrvaškem partizanskem gibanju. Oktobra 1944. leta je bil imenovan za sekretarja hrvaške komunistične partije.

Od 1945. do 1954. leta je bil Bakarić predsednik hrvaške vlade, ob 1954. do 1963. leta pa predsednik hrvaškega sabora. Nekaj časa je bil predsednik centralnega komiteja hrvaške partije. Član predsedstva SFRJ je vse od leta 1974.

Po pok. Edvardu Kardelju velja dr. Bakarić za enega glavnih ideologov jugoslovanske kom. partije.

LONDON, V. Br. — NEW YORK, N.Y. — Danes dopoldne so začeli Angleži napadati Falklandske otoke. Kot kaže, bodo Angleži napadali argentinske položaje z manjšimi četami. Potem takem ne bodo svojemu gostu iz Moskve dali Jugoslovani le novice o svojih vodstvenih ustrojih v prihodnosti, marče bodo predvsem od njih zahtevali — s svežimi vtiči iz Aten — izjavo o sovjetskih namerah v Egejskem morju in na Balkanu.

Ob Gromykovem obisku v Beogradu se stavljajo Jugoslovani načelno vprašanje, ali lahko nadaljujejo s Titovo igro ravnotežja med Zahodom in Moskvo. Ko je naredil Andrej Gromyko leta 1962 enega svojih prvih obiskov v Beograd, je dal Tito vtakniti v jeo Milovana Djilasa: ta je bil prav tedaj s svojo knjigo "Pogovori s Stalinom" spravil Sovjetje v neprijeten položaj. Tito se je pa hotel ogniti vsem, kar bi utegnilo spraviti Ruse v slabovo voljo. Danes ni na vidiku tako razburljivih ukrepov. Bolj kot kdaj se pa stavlja vprašanje, kako bo Jugoslavija, ki se po Titovem odhodu politično tako opoteka, gospodarsko je pa postala tako slabokrvna, zmogla nadaljevati Titovo igro ravnotežja.

Včasih, ko sem bil v Ndoli, sem imel priliko obiskati naše misijonske postaje. Bil sem presenečen nad delom, ki so ga minoriti opravili v teh 50-ih letih, odkar so tukaj. Vidi se, da so delali nesobično in zelo požrtvovalno. Zraven številnih cerkva so zgradili več šol, misijonskih bolnic, naselej za gobave, zavetišča za invalidno mladino itd. Vse to ni zrastlo samo od sebe, ampak je bilo potrebne veliko dobre volje, ne samo s strani misijonarjev, ampak tudi s strani dobrotnikov širom po Evropi. 'Ljubezen vse premore.'

V začetku marca

sem se preselil v Lusako. Minoriti imamo tukaj dve župniji in v eni od njih pomagam kot kaplan. Ker so tukaj ljudje zbrani od vseh vetrov in ne razumejo lokalnega jezika, imamo eno nedeljsko mašo v angleščini in ta je sedaj moj delež. Med tednom nekajkrat mašujem tudi zunaj v vaseh. Župnik mi je z veseljem prepustil va-

si, ki so mu vzele veliko časa. Jaz pa sem jih z veseljem sprejel, saj se je tam najlaže učiti jezika domačinov, pa tudi maševati je čudovito sredi vasi, pod milim nebom, v senči palm ali banan.

Zupnija nima večjega števila vernikov, je pa zelo prostora, saj je zadnja vas oddaljena kar 9 m od župnijske cerkve. Med verniki je nekaj dobro stoečih farmarjev, ki župniji pomagajo iz finančnih težav, ki jih nikoli ne zmanjka, saj kar naprej popravljamo in zidamo. Trenutno gradimo hišico za mežnarja in vzidavamo nova okna v cerkvi. Ko bomo to končali, pa nas čaka gradnja učilnic, tako da mi tudi s te strani dela ne bo zmanjkalo.

V začetku maja bom začel obiskovati jezikovni tečaj, ki traja 4 meseca. Činyanja jezik, ki ga ljudje tukaj govorijo, in sem se ga tudi jaz že začel učiti, se mi ne zdi pretežek, vsaj maševati ni bilo težko začeti. Ko sem prvič maševal v njihovem jeziku, so bili ljudje silno resni, le ministranti so se nekajkrat prijeli za nos, da so zadržali smeh. Tako nekako poteka najino življenje tukaj v Zambiji. Lepo je tukaj in če se

nama pridruži še kdo iz domovine, bo še lepše. Vsem prijetjem v domovini in o-krog po svetu prisreč misijonski pozdrav. Priporočava se Vam v Vaše molitve in spomin pri sv. maši, da bi Bog blagoslovil našino delo. Vaša Miha in Ernest. — P.S. Dragi Amerikanci in Kanadčani! Tako, vidite, me je nekdo rešil pisanja, saj je tudi v mojem imenu napisal nekaj besed. Ko končamo cerkev, se pa tudi oglasim s svojim pismom in kakšno sliko cerkve. Vaš priatelj pater Miha."






