#### Dezerterji poročajo o velikih vstajah v armadi fašističnega generala Franca

Te dni je prispelo več polkov italijanskih karabinjerjev, s katerimi bodo poizkusili zadušiti vstajo Mavrov. — V vrtovih zgodovinske Alhambre so postrelili stotine Mavrov.

MADRID, 30. julija. — Najboljši regimenti italijanskih karabinjerjev so prispevali z veliko nagnico v Španijo, da zaduše razširajočo se vstajo v fašističnih vrstah, katero je povzročilo sovraštvo med afriškimi Mavri in italijanskimi vojaki.

Informacije, da se je revolta razširila daleč v ozadje Francovih čet, je podal Manuel Garcia Gomez, republikanski letalec, ki je bil od fašistov ujet, zdaj pa med drugimi zamenjen za fašističnega letalca, v ujetništvu lojalistov.

Vojnemu uradu je povedalo, da so prišli v Španijo celi polki italijanskih karabinjerjev, da zatruje revolto. Uradno naznanih republikanskih vlade naznana, da so dezerterji iz fašističnih vrst izjavili, da je izbruhi na vnekaterih delih armade generala Franca javna revolta zaradi sovraštva med Mavri in Italijani, toda o tem se je malo vedelo, ker fašisti izvajajo strogo cenzuro nad poročili.



The president of the largest cannery there, The French Sardine Company, is Martin Bogdanovich. He started the company in 1917 with a capital of \$10,000, today its assets are over one million. The cannery is considered one of the largest of its kind in the country. It cans over 850,000 cans a year.
