#### V Argentiniji se zopet uveljavlja vojaški vpliv

Buenos Aires, Arg.

Ko je sedanji predsednik Frondizi začel lani pobijati inflacijo in uvajati zdrave nazore o gospodarstvu, ki pa tudi nalagajo breme vsem slojem prebivalstva,

je njegova gospodarska politika v javnosti naletela na takoj hud odpor,

da se je moral nasloniti na vojaške kroge, ki so ga tudi podprt.

Peronisti in komunisti so bili najmanj zadovoljni z novo nastalim političnim položajem in so začeli s terorističnimi akcijami. Zato je vojaška uprava prevzela v marcu del varnostne službe in skrbila tudi za odsodbo teroristov, kar pa ni zmanjšalo terorističnih napadov.

V 9 mesecih je bilo ubitih 27 ljudi, zadnje tedne so pa začele pokati bombe tudi v stanovanjih višjih oficirjev. Generali zato želijo, da parlament zopet uvede smrtno kazen za teroristična dejanja. V parlamentu ni za tak zakon nobenega posebnega navdušenja, zato še ni jasno, da kaže mere se bo mogel upirati prisiski vojaških krogov.

Do odločitve mora priti kmalu, tako misijo v Buenos Aires, kajti predsednik Frondizi gre 13. junija na potovanje po Evropi in do takrat mora pasti odločitev.

#### Zopet demonstracije

Tokio, Jap. — Skupina kakih 2,000 levicaških študentov je vprizorila znova demonstracije pred domom predsednika vlade Kišija. Policia je demonstrante razgnala.

DETROIT, Mich. — Guv. Williams je izjavil, da bo na demokratični konvenciji v Los Angeles podprt sen. Kennedyja kot kandidata za predsednika ZDA. To izjavo so navedovali že nekaj dni.

BONN, Nem. — Nekaj bivših nacistov, prikritih in odkritih, je poslalo vabilo voditeljem vseh znanih desničarskih gibanj, sedva takih, ki niso sovražila in ne sovražijo nacistov, na skupen "kongres", ki naj bi se vrnil prihodno nedeljo v Wiesbadenu.

Povabljen je bilo baje okoli 800 desničarskih skupin. Kongres naj bi bil tajen. Nemška policija ve za priprave za kongres, toda ni vznemirjena. Podeljena radovednost jo bo pa nagnala, da si bo vse udeležence dobro ogledala, akoravno jih ne misli motiti pri njihovem poslu.

#### BOLJŠA REŠITEV!

V mornariških krogih preudarajo, če ne bi njihovo letalo F-4H bilo primernejše za izvidniške polete kot sedaj že zloglasni U-2.

NAPOLI, It. — Visoki častniki šeste ameriške flote, ki čuva Sredozemlje, trdijo, da bi lahko mornariško letalo F-4H veliko boljše opravilo izvidniške polete nad Sovjetsko zvezo kot znano letalo U-2.

Letalu F-4H doseže višino 98,560 čevljev in leti z brzino do 1,500 milj na uro. Letalu bi lahko vzletelo z ameriške letalonosilke v Perzijskem zalivu in pristalo na drugi v severnem Atlantiku, ne da bi spravljalo v nevarnost zavezničke, na katerih ozemlju so ameriška vojaška oporišča.

#### Sv. Oče bo pospešil priprave za vesoljni cerkveni zbor

VATIKAN, It. — Sv. Oče je pred letom dni imenoval posebno komisijo, ki naj napravi napot za pripravljalna dela za prihodnji vesoljni cerkveni zbor, ki se bo predvidoma začel pozno l. 1961 ali začetkom l. 1962 in bo dobil ime "drugi vatikanski koncil".

Komisija je opravila svoje delo. Zato bo sv. Oče prihodnjoto je binkoštno nedeljo slovensko oznanil, da bo postavil 9 komisij, ki naj pripravijo vso potrebo za koncil. V komisije bo imenoval škofe, kardinale in strokovnjake s celega sveta.

Vse to je sv. Oče povedal 31 kardinalom, jih je poklical na "pol-javen" konzistorij. Konzistorij je tudi odboril poročilo o kanonizaciji novega svetnika iz Španije.

#### Papež Janez XXIII. odlikoval judovskega odvetnika

LONDON, Vel. Brit. — Sv. Oče je odlikoval judovskega advokata Leverja, ki je med drugim tudi poslanec delavske stranke v angleškem parlamentu.

Lever je bil preje župan v Manchesteru, sedaj ima tam svoj volivni okraj. Vse svoje življenje je veliko deloval v korist katoličanov v Manchesteru in okolici.

Le redkokdaj se primeri, da Vatikan odlikuje pripadnike drugih ver, zato so v Angliji to izjemo tem bolj opazili.

#### Hruščev zvraca krivdo za polom konference v Parizu na Eisenhowera

Predsednik sovjetske vlade Nikita Hruščev skuša zvrniti krivdo za polom konference na vrhu v Parizu na predsednika Združenih držav Eisenhowera, čeprav je jasno, da je bil poloma kriv sam. Gen. De Gaulle je v govoru francoski javnosti to naravnost pribil.

MOSKVA, ZSSR. — V razgovoru z dopisnikom vladnega časopisa "Izvestija" je predsednik vlade Nikita Hruščev zatrjeval, da je bil predsednik Združenih držav Eisenhower kriv, da ni prišlo med njima do osebnega neposrednega razgovora v Parizu, pa naj bi to že pred znano sejo v ponedeljek, 16. maja, ali pa po njej. Osebni sestanek bi po besedah Nikite moral predložiti edino Eisenhower, ker je bil on kriv za poslabšanje odnosov med obema deželama in njunima vladama. Razgovor je bil objavljen na prvi strani lista, prenata pa sta ga tudi radio in televizija.

Hruščev pravi v razgovoru s časnikarjem, da Eisenhower temeljno v svojem bivanju v Parizu ni pokazal nobene želje odpreti vrat na vrhu niti pred sestankom štirih predsednikov vseh sil niti po njem. Posebno ni pokazal nobenega napora za sestanek z njim, ki naj bi rešil spor zaradi letala U-2. Povedal je, da je imel še pred ponedeljkom sestanek s predsednikom angleške vlade Macmillanom. Ko ga je ta vprašal, če se misli sestanek z Eisenhowerjem, je Hruščev odgovoril, da je pripravljen to storiti, če bo pokazal Eisenhower v tem pogledu kako željo. Trdil je, da on v pogledu sestanka ni mogel nič začeti, ker ni bil on kriv poslabšanja odnosov med obema vladama.

Bil že pred leti izgubil pamet in spada v norišnico. Ponovno je grozil z raketami ne samo proti letalom, ki bi priletela nad sovjetsko ozemlje, ampak tudi z nadpadom na letališča, s katerimi bi se ta letala dvignila. Vprašanje Zah. Berlina bo ostalo "na hladem" samo določen čas. Če zahodne sile ne bodo pristale na predloženo rešitev, bo šla ZSSR svojo pot in podpisala ločen mir z Vzhod. Nemčijo.

#### Fantič umoril mater

Komaj 14 let stari fantič je umoril svojo mater, ker je bila "prestroga."

NEW YORK, N. J. — Deset let stari Joseph Troyli je izpeljal na policiji, da je našel v tretku, ko se je vrnil iz šole, svojega 14 let starega brata Dominika v njihovem stanovanju v Brooklynu, ko je brusil lovske nož. Dejal mu je, da bo umoril njuno mater, 29 let staro Patričio Troyli, ko se bo zvečer po devetih urah vrnila z dela.

#### De Gaulle: U-2 ni bil zadosten vzrok

PARIZ, Fr. — Predsednik republike Charles de Gaulle je poročal kot zadnji od velike četrtine javnosti v pogledu konference na vrhu. Tekom svojega razgovora Hruščev ni nič omenil svojega ultimata Eisenhowerju, ki je dejansko onemogočil vsako nadaljevanje razgovorov.

Prezident sovjetske vlade je dejal, da sta Eisenhower v svojem govoru preko radia in televizije in Herter pred senatnim odborom skušala zavesti ameriško javnost v pogledu konference na vrhu. Tekom svojega razgovora Hruščev ni nič omenil svojega ultimata Eisenhowerju, ki je dejansko onemogočil vsako nadaljevanje razgovorov.

Upor naj bi zajel tudi predele Tibeta v neposrednem zaledju Indijske Ladake, ki ga imajo zasedenega Kitajci že nekaj let kljub vsem protestom iz New Delhi.

NORTON, Va. — Predsednik Nikita Hruščev je poslal Oliveru Powersu, očetu letalca, ki so ga zajeli Sovjeti 1. maja z letalom U-2, sporočilo, naj le pride v ZSSR, da mu bo on pomagal, da bo mogel videti svojega sina. Oliver Powers se je obrnil na Hruščeva "kot oče na očeh" takoj, ko je zvezdel za njegovo zajetje po Sovjetih. Oliver pravi, da bo vabil Hruščeva sprejet in šel v ZSSR k svojemu sinu.

ZENEVA, Šv. — Sovjeti predstavniki pri razgovorih o končanju preskušanja atomskega orožja, je dejel, da hoče biti Sovjeti navzoči pri poskuših, ki naj izpopolnijo tehniko odkrivanja eksplozij podzemlja, od začetka do konca. Sama nima v načrtu noben

## Pred avtomatično špijonažo v vesolju

Našo vojno letalstvo je poslalo v maju v vesolje novo satelitsko raketovo in ji dalo ime Midas II. Je to zaenkrat najtežja raketa, ki smo jo poslali v vesolje z nalogom, da kroži okoli Zemlje. Tehta 3,000 funtov in nosi s seboj instrumente, ki imajo vsi najprvo namen: dognati takoj vsako atomsko eksplozijo kjerkoli na svetu in to v trenutku, ko strelivo eksplodira. Druga važnejša naloga Midasa naj bi bila, registrirati tudi vsak izstrelak raket na srednje in velike daljave in ugotoviti, v kateri smeri letijo.

Vse to se ne da dognati s fotografiranjem topote, ki nastane pri eksploziji potisnih motorjev. Vsaka raketovo požnejo namreč v zrak posebni potisni motorji, ki v trenutku eksplozije razvijejo neverjetno visoko temperaturo. Kraj in mesto te temperature je mogoče ugotoviti s takoimenovanimi infra-rdečimi žarki. Temperatura pa ne nastane samo v trenutku, ko raketovo zapusti oporišče; v njej so vdelani potisni motorji, ki eksplodirajo tekom poleta in gonijo raketovo zmeraj višje in višje. Vsaka raketa ima navadno vdelane po 2-3 motorje, ki jo med potjo poganjajo v vesolje.

Satelit Midas II. ima torej nalogu, da lovi potom infra-rdečih žarkov kraj in čas ne samo tiste topote, ki nastane, ko raketovo zapusti zemljo, ampak tudi tisto topoto, ki nastane tekom poleta raketove, ko jo poganjajo dodatni potisni motorji v višino.

V satelitu Midasu so instrumenti, ki ne lovijo samo podatkov o topotah, ampak jih tudi pošiljajo nazaj na Zemljijo na ameriška oporišča, kjer s hitrimi računskimi stroji ugotovijo, kje je bila raketovo izstreljena in v kateri smeri leti. Ti instrumenti, ki vežejo Midasa s Zemljijo, pa ne delujejo avtomatsko; delujejo šele in samo takrat, kadar jih naše prizadeto oporišče požene v pogon. Tako so instrumenti izmaknjeni ruski kontroli, kajti poskrbljeno je za to, da ne bodo nikoli pošiljali svojih "novic" v taki smeri, da bi jih Rusi mogli zajeti.

Vse te operacije: lov na temperaturo pri izstrelku raketove, lov na temperaturo tekom poleta, prenos dobljenih podatkov na Zemljijo, preračunavanje v računskih strojih, se vrši s tako hitrostjo, da naše oporišče lahko v že v 15 minutah, kdaj in kje je bila sestreljena sovražna raketovo in v kateri smeri leti. Taka raketovo rabi za pot iz Rusije v Ameriko povprečno 45 minut. Naše oporišče ve torej nekako pole, predno bi prišla ruska raketovo v Ameriko, kdaj bo prileta in kje približno bo udarila na zemljijo. Tekom te pol ure je mogoče poslati v boj proti sovražni raketovi naše raketove, to je raketove, ki imajo samo en namen: prestreči pot sovražni raketove in jo takoj uničiti, kakor hitro jim pride na pot.

Tak je načrt naše narodne obrambe v boju proti ruskim medcelinskim raketam. Načrt pa še ni preskušen. Zaenkrat naj bi sedanjem satelit Midas II. samo nabiral podatke o topotah ni jih pošiljal na zemljijo. Ko ga bodo izpopolnili v tej smeri, bo dobil nove naloge.

Z ugotavljanjem topote ne bo šlo gladko. Visoke temperature ne rodijo namreč samo eksplozije potisnih motorjev pri raketah, ampak tudi druge vrste eksplozije. Kako torej določiti, katera eksplozija je "prava" in katera ne? Odgovor na to vprašanje bo dala še praksa. Ta problem je podoben onemu, ki ga imajo strokovnjaki pri načrtu, kako kontrolirati atomsko eksplozijo pod zemljijo, o čemur smo že večkrat pisali.

Najnovejša poročila trdijo, da instrumenti v Midasu II. ne delujejo čisto po načrtu. Lahko je mogoče, da bo treba kmalu poslati v vesolje nov Midas z boljšimi instrumenti. Vsekakor pa strokovnjaki upajo, da bodo v par letih lahko ugotovili za vsako rusko medcelinsko raketovo, kdaj je bila izstreljena in v kateri smeri bo letela.

Veliko zanimivejši in razumljivejši je eksperiment z satelitom Samos, ki ga pa še sestavlja. Ta bo letal okoli Zemlje in imel takoj dobre fotografične aparate, da bo do podrobnosti fotografiral med svojimi poleti okoli Zemlje vse, kar se godi tudi na sovražnih oporiščih. To je za našo narodno obrambo izredno važno, kajti vsak napad z medcelinskim raketami je treba pripravljati cele tedne in satelit Samos bo take priprave hitro opazil in jih sporočil našim oporiščem. Samos bo tako onemogočil Rusom, da bi nas mogli nepričakovano napasti z medcelinskim raketami in atomskimi bombami.

To je svetla stran kolajne. Obstaja pa tudi temna. Rusi tudi ne mirujejo na polju elektronike. Preiskujejo posebno načine, kako bi motili vse naše naprave, ki temeljijo na elektroniki. Motnje so se jim do dobra posrečile pri telemunikacijah kot so radijske oddaje. Sedaj se jim je menda tudi posrečilo, da uspešno motijo radarske naprave. Angleži so zadnje čase hoteli preskušati naše že precej starele raketove tipov Corporal in nekega oporišča na morski obali. Tako so se pokazale v bližini ruske ladje z očitnim namenom, da motijo angleško radarsko službo, kar se jim je menda tudi posrečilo. Angleži niso mogli pregnati rus-

kih ladij, ker so ostale na visokem morju in se niso približale obrežju na 12 milj.

Moramo računati z verjetnostjo, da bodo Rusi poskušali motiti smer poletov naših satelitov, kot so Midas in Samos, in motiti telekomunikacijske oddaje s satelitov samih. Lahko se zgodi, da se jim bo to deloma posrečilo, seveda ne takoj.

Začasno zaključimo samo par stvari: človekovo sodelovanje v špijonazi bo izgubilo na vrednosti, enako pa tudi vrednost izvidniških letal, kot je na primer znano letalo U-2. Hladna vojna se bo prenesla tudi na elektronsko polje. Pa polju radarske službe jo že imamo, pri satelitih jo lahko še pričakujemo.

Poudarjam, da je Glasbena Matica nepolitična, samo pevska ustanova ali organizacija in ponovno vabimo vse, ki se resnično zanimajo za petje, da se zboru pridružijo. Vsak kogar petje resnično zanimala, nam je bil v preteklosti in nam bo tudi v budučnosti vedno dobrodošel.

Naj Vas brezmiselnano anonimno pismo, za katere noben član Matice ni odgovoren, ne ustavlja, če ste prijatelj petja, ki je edin predmet pevskega zbora. Če se hočemo dobro pripraviti za nastope, nam časa še primanjkuje.

V Severni Afriki je živel 27 živali, ki so izumrli, nadaljnji devet pa v afriških pokrajinalah na obeh straneh zemeljskega ravnika. Francoski znanstvenik Roger Heim, predsednik Mednarodne zveze za zaščito narave, je nedavno zapisal, da je v minulih 500 letih izginilo 100 vrst više razvitih živali, nadaljnji sto vrstam pa grozi skorajšnji konec.

Potreba, strah, neznanje, ne-pazljivost in veliki gozdni požari so dolgo pustosili med bogatim živalskim svetom Afrike. Domäne prebivalstvo je ubijalo nilske konje, ker uničujejo riževa polja, antilope, ker se pasejo po žitu, gorile zaradi tega, ker spravijo po sto banan dnevno, in tudi slone, ker napravijo na plantažah neverjetno razdejanje. Ko so začeli po afriški celini razpredati brzjavno in telefonsko omrežje, so prišel na vrsto žirafe zaradi dolgih vravot, s katerimi so trgale žice, stari levi, ki ne morejo več ujeti lahkonih gazel, zeber in bivolov, pa so postali strah in trepet nespretnih lovecev. Zadostovalo je že to, da so lačne zveri raztrgale nekaj ljudi, in že je človek ravnal tako, kakor da je obsodil na smrt vso vrsto. Nedavno so v Fort Lami uničili slonjo čredo, ki je začrivila smrt 13 ljudi. V koži so našli nad 50 krogel, ki niso mogle prebiti debelega slonjega oklepja.

Letala iste vrste so tekoma zadnjih 4 let fotografirala tudi Peiping, atomske eksplozije, oporišča, letališča in podobne vojaške objekte ne samo na Ruskem, ampak tudi na Kitajskem in v satelitskih deželah.





In discussing his Cleveland Indians' pennant prospects this spring, Manager Joe Gordon indicated that his club's chances hinged to a great extent on his ability to come up with a top relief pitcher — one who could preserve a tie or narrow lead in the late innings of a ball game. Gordon appears to have solved this problem in the person of veteran Johnny Klipstein.

National Leaguer with Cincinnati, Chicago and Los Angeles for the past decade, Klipstein has turned in sterling relief performances for the Indians and is now the acknowledged number one relief specialist of the Indians.

### Don't Get Off on Wrong Foot Buying Shoes

Teenagers, particularly girls, frequently get off on the wrong foot when buying summer shoes, a leading foot doctor has warned.

Dazzled by color and design, they're likely to accept poor fit and construction on the grounds that summer shoes are "just for knocking about," according to Dr. Benjamin Kauth, prominent podiatrist and director of the American Foot Care Institute. More likely, says the foot specialist, "it's the teen's feet that get the knocking about."

Fads and fancies keep the teen world bright and interesting. Dr. Kauth agrees, but whether you're relaxing at the beach, camp counsellor or working this summer you need shoes that provide health and comfort as well as color afoot. Here's what the doctor orders for the young shoe shopper:

Flats are best for all-day wear. For dress occasions a mid-heel is in order, but not a spike. To navigate in high heels before the foot is fully matured invites a mincing, teetering and rolling gait.

Sneakers belong on the gym floor and bowling shoes at the alley. Beach shoes should be worn only on sand, where the foot doesn't need the same sort of support as on concrete pavements, hardwood floors or even grassy lawns.

The best all-hours, all-purpose shoes is one made of leather top and bottom. A supple leather top conforms to the natural contour of the foot and a firm, flexible sole offers support while it "gives" with each step. The controlled elasticity of leather allows the shoe to stretch in walking, resuming its shape at rest.

Check shoes sizes at least once each season — particularly before the summer. Fast-growing teenagers can shoot a full size in less than three months, especially at this season. Outgrown shoes bewilder teenagers with bumps, blisters and baby bunions.

In the "dog" days ahead, your feet will appreciate a breath of fresh air, too. Leather shoes, made of a natural material with millions of pores, "breathe" and expel perspiration formed by a moving, working foot. In any season, leather allows dry air into the shoe, keeping the foot happy and healthy.

With shoes, "neither a borrower nor a lender be..." A clumsy dance partner stomping on a borrowed pump may cost a girl her best friend, as well as her favorite toe. Besides, shoes mold themselves to the wearer's feet and you can't walk in some one else's footprints — not without trouble.

If foot ills develop, visit your family podiatrist. Self treatment — whether it be a patent medicine or "bathroom surgery" — is usually ineffective and sometimes dangerous.

### 100th ANNIVERSARY OF THE NOMINATION OF ABRAHAM LINCOLN

On May 18th the Members of the House were privileged to observe the 100th Anniversary of the nomination of Abraham Lincoln as the Republican candidate for the Presidency of the United States of America. It was a pleasure to join my colleagues in paying tribute to the memory of this great and beloved man, who gave so much to his country. The nomination of Lincoln took place at the Republican Convention of 1860 in Chicago, held in a \$7,000 especially built cavernous barn called the Wigwam, an immense wooden box anchored against a brick wall. It could hold 10,000 people. Four times that many sought admission. This was the second Republican Convention. The first was held in Philadelphia in 1856, and named John C. Fremont as its candidate for President. Lincoln and his Vice President Hannibal Hamlin of Maine carried forward a program based on unity, progress, individual rights and liberties. So vital have these principles appeared to the citizenry ever since, that of the 18 Presidents we have had since 1860, 14 have been Republicans while only 4 have been Democrats. Of Lincoln it can be said that he truly demonstrated that leadership is "just wisdom and courage and a great carelessness of self."

### STUDENT WORK-STUDY PROGRAMS

I wonder how many of our Slovenian people in New York and vicinity know of a place called the "Folk Dance House"? It is a non-profit organization specializing in the teaching of Folk Dancing, directed by Mary Ann and Michael Herman, who founded Folk Dance House in 1940. It is located at 108 West 16th St. (near 6th Ave.) in New York City. Mary Ann and Michael Herman have given folk dance workshops throughout the United States, Canada and in Puerto Rico.

In 1956 they were sent to Japan by the U. S. State Department to teach folk dancing in 19 cities throughout Japan where over 21,000 people registered for their sessions.

They have directed folk festivals in the N. Y. World's Fair, at Rockefeller Plaza and various parks. When the famous Moiseyev Russian Folk Dancers came to the United States they visited Folk Dance House to learn American dances and the Hermans later taught them the Virginia Reel which they did as an encore during their tour.

Michael Herman and his orchestra have recorded over 200 records on THE FOLK DANCER label, some twenty records for the Board of Education of the Methodist church, and Seven Albums for RCA Victor. These are considered the best in good folk dance music.

They have trained many local and national leaders through their various workshops and courses. Some of their students are now skilled leaders in Japan, Finland, England, Germany, Puerto Rico, Canada, Holland as well as in major cities of the United States.

In the last six months there were visitors and participants from 27 different countries at Folk Dance House.

Open all year around, it is listed as an important place to visit in many books about New York City.

On Wednesday and Thursday, June 8th and 9th, at 8:00 p.m., three dance couples from Folk Dance House, dressed in Slovenian National costumes (Narodne Nose) will dance a Slovenian polka as a specialty number at Power Memorial Glee Club and Band Concert.

This concert of seventy singers and a school band of forty musicians will be held at Amsterdam Public School Auditorium, located on Amsterdam Ave. and 61st St., in New York City.

A new Art Gallery in the Cleveland Public Library will be opened to the public at Noon on Tuesday, June 7, with an exhibition: "Changing Styles: Cleveland Paintings and Ceramics," lent by the Cleveland Museum of Art. Exhibits, planned and arranged by the Extension Exhibition Department of the Museum of Art, will be changed every few months and will feature works of art and educational themes built around.

The Library Art Gallery, first downtown Museum extension in a public building, has been made possible by a gift of Mr. and Mrs. Harold T. Clark, who contributed funds to remodel library space as a tribute to Miss Linda A. Eastman, distinguished former Director of Cleveland Public Library. Years ago, Miss Eastman suggested the need for an art gallery, open to the public in a convenient downtown location.

Jointly sponsored by the Cleveland Public Library and the Cleveland Museum of Art, the Gallery is located in the former "Room 36" on the foundation floor of the Main Library at 325 Superior Avenue, in space made available as a result of library expansion to the Business and Science Building.

Gallery hours, tentatively set, will be from 12 Noon to 9 p.m. on Mondays and Thursdays; 12 Noon to 6 p.m. on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, and 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturdays, unless the Library itself is closed.

### New Office Schedule for B. of U. C.

All Cleveland area offices of the Ohio Bureau of Unemployment Compensation will operate on a five-day business basis, being closed each Saturday since May 14, Edment C. Schulze, Acting Area Director, announced.

He pointed out that the new office schedule will permit a full staff on duty Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. It is anticipated that the new schedule will permit better service during the five days the office is open.
