Dr. Meršol, Camp officials, and all my friends of UNRRA D.P. Camp Lienz!

I have returned from my holiday in Italy to find many changes.

I, myself, am leaving you and many of my UNRRA staff have already left.

I have lived with and for you since UNRRA took over this Centre in December last and I leave you with a heavy heart.

When I was given the responsibility of controlling Lienz D.P. Camp, to me you were simply 3500 human beings who, being refugees from tyranny, deserved all the help it was in my power to give.

Now, after some six months of work with you, I leave, I believe, a community of my friends, and knew that I am the one who has been fitted from our association.

We have worked in harmony and peace towards a common aim - the wellbeing of all in the camp - and I want to thank you all, especially your leaders, for the many kindnesses, help and cooperation you have given so freely to me and my UNRRA staff in the exercise of our duties.

Sometimes there have been difficulties but I have always felt that no matter what decisions I have believed it my duty to make you have accepted them cheerfully and helpfully, and so have lightened my burden very greatly.

When I have felt in doubt as to the right course of action to take I have asked God to give me guidance. I believe that guidance was given to me and so we have been able to surmount many difficulties together in a spirit of harmony and friendship which I shall never forget.

I am sure my successor will give you as much as or more help than I have been able to, and so I say in parting, may God bless you all and soon give you the homes and conditions of living which you deserve.

Sodelovali smo v harmoniji in miru za skupni cilj - blagostanje vseh v taborišču. Želim se zahvaliti Vam vsem, posebno pa Vašim voditeljem za veliko prijateljstvo, pomoč in sodelovanje, ki ste ga nudili prostovoljno meni in UNRRI-nem osebju pri izvrševanju naših dolžnosti.

Mnogokrat so bile težave, vedno pa sem čutil, da ste z veseljem in z dobro voljo prevzeli vsako odločbo, kakršno koli sem bil dolžan

zdati in ste tako moje breme zelo olajšali.

Če sem bil v dvomih, kakšne ukrepe bi podvzel, sem prosil Boga, naj me vodi. Mislim, da sem to vodstvo tudi dobil. Tako nam je bilo mogoče, skupaj premagati mnoge težave v duhu harmonije in prijateljstva, katerega ne bom nikoli pozabil.

Gotov sem, da Vam bo moj naslednik nudil tudi toliko ali več počeli, kot sem Vam jo mogel nuditi jaz.

Ko Vas zapusčam, Vam pravim: Bog naj vas vse blagoslovi in naj vam da kmalu domove in življenske pogoje, ki jih zaslužite. Zahvaljujem se Vam za pomoč in sodelovanje.
