Zakaj Vzhod hiji pri razgovorih z Bonnom?

Včeraj so se začeli na prigajjanje Vzvoda razgovori med Bonnom in Moskvo.

BONN, Z. Nem. — Kancler Willi Brandt že dolgo želi izboljšati odnose z Vzhodno Evropo, vendar pa pri tem moče hiteti. Zaveda se dobro, da je treba pretehtati vse možnosti in preudariti tudi, kako daleč je možno iti v zboljševanju odnosov skozi komunistični državami vzhodne Evrope, ne da bi pri tem škodoval dobrim odnosom, ki jih vzdržuje vsa leta Zahodna Nemčija z zahodnim svetom. Od tega je končno odvisna varnost Zahodne Nemčije in v veliki meri tudi njena bodočnost.

Vzhodna Nemčija, kjer gospodari Walter Ulbricht, ne vidi prav nič rada zbljževanja med Zahodno Nemčijo ter Sovjetsko zvezo in drugimi državami sovjetskega bloka. Prepričana je, da, da gre to na njen račun in na njeno škodo. Zato ovira zbljževanje, kjer le more in kolikor more.

Zato je posebno zanimivo, da sta Sovjetska zveza in Poljska v zadnjih tednih tako pospeševali priprave za začetek razgovorov. Kancler W. Brandt je predložil Varšavi začetek razgovorov sredji tega meseca, toda Poljaki so tega premaknili na 5. februar. V Bonnu niso mogli pristati na začetek razgovorov z Varšavo pred začetkom razgovorov z Moskvo. Ko so sporočili v Moskvo, da bi naj se razgovori začeli ta teden, je Moskva odgovorila, da želi razgovore začeti že en teden prej. Tako je državni tajnik v Bonnu Egon Bahr naglo letel prejšnji teden v Moskvo, kjer se je takoj sestal s predstavniki vlade ZSSR.

Razgovori med Bonnom in Varšavo so se včeraj začeli, v Moski pa tečejo že nekaj dni. Zahodni politični opazovalci se sprašujejo, čemu se Moskvi in Varšavi tako mudi pri pogajanjih. Za sedaj na to vprašanje še ni bilo zadovoljivega odgovora, četudi razlag ne manjka.

Nigerija izganja katoliške misijonarje

LAGOS, Nig. — Zdi se, da režim generala Gowona nima drugačia dela, kot da se znaša nad vsemi, ki so v državljanški vojni podpirali nedolžno civilno prebivalstvo v krajih, kjer živi plemeni Ibo (v glavnem Biafra). Tako si sneli iz ječ v Port Harcourtu 32 katoliških misijonarjev, ki so jih že preje iz prednosti "obsodili", da so prišli "protizekonito" v Biafr, in jih pod policijskim nadzorom prepeljali v Lagos, tam pa v sredo iz dežele.

V Port Harcourtu je še 28 drugih misijonarjev in misijonskih sester, ki so obsojeni sličnih "zločinov"; med njimi je tudi katoliški škop iz nekdanjega glavnega mesta Owerri v Biafr. Kakšno usodo jim je Gowonova diktatura namenila, še ni znano. Zdi se, da se je Gowon postavil na znano diktatorsko stališče: kdor ni bil v državljanški vojni z nami, je naš sovražnik.

Mislimo, da je nastopal čas, da je svobodni svet bolj natanko poučen, kaj vse počenja nigerijska diktatura. Le izražanje simpatij plemenu Ibo ni zadost.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Demokrati in republikani v Kongresu podpirajo predlog za odpravo odlaganja služenja vojaškega roka za študente in za poselne poklice. Odpravo podpira obrambni tajnik M. Laird, zato se je izjavil direktor vojaškega nabornega urada gen. L. B. Hershey. Dejal je, da bo z odpravo odlaganja rokov vojaška obveznost pravičnejša in bolj enaka za vse.

Sen. E. M. Kennedy je predpar dnevi v senatnem pododboru za oborožene sile predložil, naj bi bili vsi odlogi služenja vojaškega roka ukinjeni. Dovoljene naj bi bile izjemne res v le skrajno nujnih slučajih.

Sedanje predpise o odlaganju služenja vojaškega roka so izrabljali na vajražljivejše načine. Veliko mladih fantov se je vpisalo na visoke šole samo zato, da bi se izognili vojaščine, posebno služenju te v Vietnamu. Ti študentje so seveda najbolj vneto protestirali proti vojskovjanju v Vietnamu in se gnali "za mir za vsako ceno".

Pretekli teden 70 mrtvih amerikanskih vojakov v Vietnamu

SAIGON, J. Viet. — Po uradnem poročilu je padlo v boju pretekli teden v Južnem Vietnamu 70 Amerikanec, 704 pa so bili ranjeni. V istem času so imeli Južni Vietnamci 343 mrtvih in 985 ranjenih, rdeči pa 2029 mrtvih.

HRVAŠKA IN SLOVENIJA STA SAMOZAVESTNEJSI

Hrvatje in Slovenci se ne boje več očitkov "šovinizma", postali so odločnejši v obrambi svojih pravic napram Beogradu. Napade na hrvaški nacionalizem iz Beograda so vodniki Zveze komunistov Hrvatske v Zagrebu javno zavrnili.

CLEVELAND, O. — Sodelavnavaja, da Slovenija in Hrvatje New York Timesa Paul Hefmann je poslal listu iz Zagreba poročilo, ki ga je ta objavil v četrtek. V njem trdi, da se čuti v glavnem mestu Hrvatske in v Sloveniji nov duh samozavesti in da ne izgleda, da bi se še kdaj bo cítkov "šovinizma". Pri tem omenja posebej zasedanje Centralnega komiteita Zveze komunistov Hrvatske pretekli mesec v Zagrebu.

Na tem zasedanju so vodniki Centralnega komiteita vse od dr. Savke Dubčević-Kuča pa do dr. Bakarića ostro prijemale dr. Miloja Žanka, ki je objavil v beograjski "Borbì" vrsto člankov, v katerih je hudo napadal hrvaški nacionalizem, ki da je prodrl v vodstvo Zveze komunistov Hrvatske. Ti članki so toliko nanimivejši, ker je dr. M. Žanko sam član Centralnega komiteita Zveze komunistov Hrvatske. Govori, v katerih so vodniki komunistov na Hrvatskem zavrnili Žanka in njegove napade, so bili skoraj v celoti objavljeni v zagrebških listih.

Dr. Bakarić je v zvezi s tem opozoril na delo hrvaške politične emigracije, ki kaže skrbno spremlja razvoj doma in o tem stalno obvešča vodilne sile na Zahodu. Emigracija dela za samostojno Hrvatško in vsak nastop Beograda proti Hrvatški izkrasti za svoje načrte. Bakarić je predlagal, da se ne bojeva za prihodnje leta 540 milijonov.

Nixonova poslanica, ki jo je prebral pomožni državni tajnik ZDA C. A. Meyer, je bila sprejeta z vlijudnostnim ploskanjem.

V očeh Latinske Amerike je ta pomožni premajhna.

Fulbrightov odbor začenja zopet "dialog" o Vietnamu z Belo hišo

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Načelnik senatnega odbora za zunanjopolitično senator Fulbright bi rad zopet organiziral "dialog" z Belo hišo o smislu vojskovjanja v Vietnamu. Zadnjic ga je s predsednikom Johnsonom, sedaj je prišel na vrsto predsednik Nixon. Fulbright je kot pravi profesor poskrbel za uvod dosti preglednega poročila o stanju tega problema, ki ga je sestavil urad senatnega odbora. Poročilo je primeroma kratko, toda je jasno in jedrnatno. Najbrže ima namen ustvariti nesporno podlago za debato v odboru, zato niti polemico. Opira se najrajšje na dejstva, v ocenah dejstev je pa obzirno in skuša biti nepristransko.

Poročilo obravnava 3 točke, ki so po mnenju avtorjev medrodajne za bodočnost ameriške udeležbe pri vojskovjanju v Vietnamu. Na prvo mesto postavlja vprašanje vietnamizacije vojskovjanja, ki obstaja v tem, da se mora narodna obromača Južnega Vietnamu čim preje opreti na domače sile, da do-

ski komunisti, severni in južni. Ali je mogoče računati s tem, da bodo mirno opazovali, kako Amerika izvršuje svoj načrt, bodisi, da jim gre to v račun, bodisi, da ne bi upali prepričiti izvrševanja ameriškega načrta, akoravno bi ga radi. Ali ni verjetno, da bodo komunisti skušali motiti postopen umik ameriških čet, kar bi spravilo Ameriko v precep: Ali se na hitro popoloma umakniti iz Vietnamoma pod komunističnim pritisom, kar bi pomenilo vojaški in diplomatski poraz, ali pa se znova spustiti v boj s komunisti. Začeti bi ga bilo lahko, toda kako naj se novo vojskovjanje konča.

Za nobeno med temi tremi točkami ne najde poročilo zadovoljivega odgovora. Pri vsaki ugotavlja, da odpira le nezanesljive poglede v bodočnost. Pa ga je Fulbright vendarle predal odborovim članom in javnosti, obenem pa že v začetku tedna sklical prvo sej, kamor je povabil prvo vrsto interesentov; bili so sa-



parish, Transfiguration of Christ Eastern Orthodox Church, provided us with a unique opportunity to observe the occasion on the 25th, when they held their annual "slava" in honor of St. Sava at our school hall.

Following the blessing of the holy bread by their pastor, Fr. Paul Ziaty, we were treated to a banquet and a splendid program.

The program consisted of Dr. Ray M. Jurjevich, well-known Denver psychologist, showing slides of his recent visit to Greece's Mount Athos, and of various Slavic selections performed by the Junior Novo Kolo Tamburitzans of Pueblo.

According to Dr. Jurjevich, St. Sava is "the most important personage in Serbian history." Sava was responsible for the establishment of an autonomous Serbian Orthodox Church, and was its first Archbishop. He produced some of the earliest pie-

ces of Serbian literature, notably a translation into Serbian from the Greek of the *Monastic Rule*, and a description of his father's death.

In 1195, with his father, King Stephen I Nemanya, the first king of Serbia, Sava founded the Hilander Monastery, which accommodated at its peak some 300 monks. The present population of monks at Hilander is about 20. Following his reign as king, Nemanya retired to the monastery as a simple monk, taking the name of Simeon.

Dr. Jurjevich's presentation consisted not only of slides of Hilandar and other monasteries on Mount Athos, but also, in comparison, of the Montserrat Monastery near Barcelona, Spain.


Dr. Jurjevich is widely admired as a psychologist, and is deeply respected as a devout Orthodox layman.

Make this a daytime job, so you can have the lights "off." Reflector bowls and (incandescent) bulbs can quickly become too hot to handle, when lights are on.

Clean portable lamp glass or plastic reflectors like this: Make sure the lamp is "off" and cool. Unplug it. Remove the reflector, in warm (but not hot) soapy water. Rinse in clean, warm water. Wipe completely dry. Replace reflector in lamp. Plug the lamp back in.

Wash glass or plastic shades or "bowls" from ceiling fixtures the same way. Make sure the fixture is "off" and cool while you handle the bowls. DO NOT wash a reflector or globe while still on a lamp or fixture. NEVER apply moisture directly to a lamp or lighting fixture. (Outdoor postlights are designed to be weatherproof and unaffected by rain or snow.) While the globes or reflectors

(Continued from Page 5) Christ already on this side of the Life Eternal.

The activistically oriented Westerners could not grasp the "logic" on which these monks based their life. They thought the monks should do more good works: preaching, teaching, building, caring for the sick and all sorts of worthy activities. I felt that these Westerners were trying to gloss over their spiritual shallowness and capitalize on their only strength, the activity, be it physical, social, cultural.

His son Sava wrote a beautiful description of his father's death, which represents one of the earliest pieces of Serbian literature. Later on, the monks of Hilandar were the bearers of civilization and spiritualizing influence to our still barbarian forefathers. I stayed four days at Hilandar, and my chief impressions of Athos are from there.

In contrast to the impressions conveyed by some of the Western visitors with whom we talked, my feeling about Athos was overwhelmingly positive. They looked upon these monks, their dwellings and their ways from a distorted angle. They deplored the dilapidation allowed to set in many structures, objected to hard beds and to bed sheets which were not

changed daily, abhorred the odorous outhouse, questioned the worth of the contemplative life and separation from the world. They failed to see the basis of the life on the Holy Mountain.

The Westerners were bound in their cultural set: they took it for granted that active seeking for pleasures and achievements is the only sensible way of living.

Here they were confronted with diametrically opposite concepts of what human life is about. The monk started with and continued building on an undiluted interpretation of the Gospels; instead of living for the hedonistic experiences as do those who are still immersed in the transitory world, they try to live consistently "sub specie eternitatis," in the perspective of eternity. To them the Kingdom of God is a reality more important than any other concern. They try to live for it now, in a humanly halting way, being thrilled by the prospect of eternal bliss with Christ.

HERE was the Christian faith at its sublimest: Christ's words were taken literally and without any rationalist nonsense. They have staked everything, like early Christians, on the announcement of the Good News, the Gospel. They have left their families, their properties, their pleasures and ambitions, to follow Christ in unceasing prayer in a mighty effort to keep the desires of flesh and pride out of their soul, and to unite it with
