PROTI RUSKIM ZAROTNIKOM

V letih 1930. in 1931. so se moje vezi z desničarji ojačale. Preko Gaisterja sem vedel, da trojka Rikov - Buharin-Tomski ojačuje svoj boj zoper stranko in da so ti ljudje v več pokrajini RSFSR in narodnostnih republik stvorili svoje "podtalne," nelegalne organizacije. Koncem 1931. mi je Gaister na nekem nezinem sestanku očital pasivnost. Ko je izvedel, da končam učenje, me je vprašal, kaj bi bilo, če bi me on priporočil na dokaj odgovorno delo v tajništvo Kujbiševa. Temu se nisem odrekel. Začetkom 1932. sem bil poklican h Kujbiševu in sem kmalu nato nastopil svojo službo.

Tekom 1. 1932. se je moja mreža z desničarji pojačala. Potem ko sem se seznanil s drugimi desničarji, Rosenholcem in Kravljem. Seznanil sem se s funkcionarjem Dr. Z. Deusehem in drugimi. Nato me je Gaister spojil z Enukidzejem. Od Enukidzeja sem izvedel, da delujejo desničarji za stragglanje obstoječega vodstva, zato da bi izpremenili položaj in usmerili razvoj dežele v restavracijo kapitalizma.

Sredi 1. 1934., približno koncem avgusta, me je nekoč Enukidze telefonično poklical k sebi na pogovor, ki je imel v našem zame najresnejše pomen. V tem pogovoru mi je Enukidze rekel: "Poprej so desničarji računali, da se bo po pomočjo organiziranja boljši protisovjetsko mislečih, zlasti kulakov, sedaj pa je položaj spremenil. Ta kar je 'stihana' in treba je preiti na bolj aktivne metode za straggljenje oblasti." Te najresnejše metode mi je takoj razložil: desničarski center mora postati z zlojcevci sklepi, da je treba izvršiti več terorističnih činov zoper člane Polno. To naj se doseže s tem, da se podkoplje zdravje vodi-

ti, je rekel, se morate udeležiti terorističnega čina zoper Kujbiševa, pripravite katerega se začela. Zdravnik Levin in njegov bosta znala storiti svoje delo. Od vas pa se zahteva: da jima omogočite in jih ohranite, da bosta mogla po-

Slovenski narod v domovini ima dolgo zimo, ki se vleče že leto dni, in nekateri so že obupali, češ, saj za nas ne bo nikdar več pomladi; legli so in umrli. Za ljudi, kateri ne verujejo v pomlad, je smrt edina rešitev. In prav je, da umrjejo, da s svojo boleznijo ne okužijo tudi ostali del našega naroda, kateri je trdno prepričan, da pomlad je bližju, in da bo prišla kot cvetoča nevesta, in dvignila slovenski narod, kateri leži danes strt na tleh.

Žalostno je, da imamo tudi tukaj med ameriški Slovenci dosti takih živih mrličev, kateri so videli veliki petek slovenskega naroda, in sedaj ne verujejo, da za velikim petkom vedno pride tudi velika nedelja, ali dan vstajenja. Vsem tem malovernežem naj bo povedano, da vstal bo slovenski narod, in njegovo vstajenje bo toliko bolj veselo in veličastno za tiste, kateri so prepričani, da ta dan mora priti. Za vse tiste pa, kateri sedaj stojijo pri strani in podirajo to, kar z velikim trudom gradijo drugi, bo pa to dan sramote, ker videli bodo, da kljub svojim sebičnim namenom niso dosegli, da bi razdvojili ameriške Slovence, kateri se trudijo, da bi pomagali rojakom v domovini proslaviti na čim lepši način veliko noč, oziroma prihod težko pričakovane pomladi.

Pomožna akcija za rojake v domovini ima veliko zaprek in predbacivanj, in to posebno od ljudi, kateri do sedaj niso še ničesar storili ali darovali v to svrhu. Takim ljudem bi jaz rekel: "Why don't you mind your own business?" katerega si častil vse življenje, jel denar, vsega izročiti. Če se gotovo ne boš pomagal, ker ne čutiš z ljudmi, kateri trpijo. Zato pusti ljudi, kateri sočustvujejo z bratom, ki je v potrebi, ker ti ljudje imajo življenjski cilj, katerega ti sploh ne moreš razumeti.

Ne darujem, ker se ne pomagam sedaj. Ne darujem, ker ne zaupam ljudem, ki to stvar vedo. Ne darujem, ker imam svoje sorodnike tam, in bom pomagal, kadar se bo dalo. Ne darujem zato, ker se že sedaj nabira. Zakaj bi se ne pričelo nabirati šele, kadar bo vojne konec?

To so glavni vzroki, katere vam navedejo ljudje, kateri ne vedo darovati. Zakaj se ne pošlje denar sedaj tja, je več vzrokov. Prvi je ta: kdo nam more garantirati, da bodo v resnici denar dobili ljudje, kateri so v potrebi? Koliko Slovencev je še tam, posebno še v krajih, katere je zasedla Nemčija? Ali ni mogoče, da ljudje, kateri so še tam, so navadni nemškutarji, kateri so z odprtimi rokami čakali prihod Hitlerja, da so mu lahko izdali vse zavedne Slovence, katere je potem izgnal in pobil? Mogoče želite, da bi pomagali tem izdajicam slovenskega naroda? Pošljite naj se denar tam! Saj se bodo podpisali! Jaz verjamem, da morda res prejme človek, na katerega ga pošljete, in da se podpiše. Verjamem pa tudi, da drugi dan pridejo Nemci ali pa Italijani in da jim mora človek, kateri je pre-

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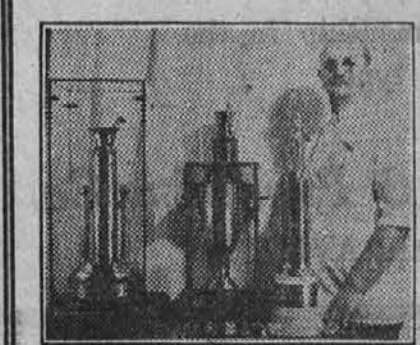
