— PREGLED NAJVAŽNEJŠIH DOGODKOV —

ZDA in Sovjeti se »načelno« sporazumeli glede odprave misilov srednjega doseg — Reagan bo o tem govoril danes dopoldne

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Dobro obveščeni viri v Beli hiši in State Departmentu potrjujejo, da so ZDA in ZSSR dosegle »načelno« soglasje o novi pogodbi, po kateri bodo uničeni vsi misili obeh velesil, ki lahko nosijo jedrske bojne konice in imajo srednji doseg. Viri sicer poudarjajo, da je nerešenih še veliko podrobnosti o izvedbi in o verificiranju izvedbe take pogodbe, da pa gre tu za detajle, ki jih bodo mogli strokovnjaki rešiti.

Danes dopoldne ob devetih bo predsednik Reagan stopil pred televizijske kamere v Beli hiši in uradno sporočil javnosti o tem prvem tovrstnem sporazumu z ZSSR v njegovih šestih in pol letih predsednikovanja. Ako bo pogodba res podpisana in potrjena od obeh velesil, bi morale ZDA po njeni vsebini demontirati in odstraniti 332 misilov, ki so sedaj postavljeni oz. jih še postavljajo v Zahodni Nemčiji, Italiji, Angliji in Belgiji. Ti misili z njihovimi jedrskimi bojnimi konicami so sedaj naperjeni zoper ZSSR. Sovjetska stran bo morala po pogodbi pa uničiti 512 misilov, ki so naperjeni proti Zahodni Evropi, in dodatnih 171, naperjenih zoper Japonsko in Kitajsko. Misili, ki bodo uničeni, imajo doseg od 315 do 3125 milj, torej v sporazumu ne gre za misile medelinskega doseg oz. ICBMs.

Do tkm. načelnega sporazuma sta prišla državni sekretar George P. Shultz in sovjetski zunanjji minister Edvard A. Ševarnadze po treh dneh intenzivnega pogovarjanja in pogajanja. Ševarnadze je na obisku v Washingtonu. Tako po Reagannovem govoru, bo imel Ševarnadze tiskovno konferenco v prostorih sovjetskega veleposlaništva.

Politični analitiki soglašajo, da sporazum o misilih med ZDA in ZSSR zagotavlja, da bo najbrž že novembra ali decembra letos prišlo do uradnega in tudi prvega obiska v ZDA sovjetskega voditelja Mihaila S. Gorbačova, kar si med drugim zelo želi sam predsednik Reagan.

Janez Pavel II. v Kaliforniji — Danes pride v Detroit, kjer bo tudi jutri — Branil dostojanstvo farmskih delavcev

MONTEREY, Calif. — Zadnji dni se je mudil med svojim pastoralnim obiskom v ZDA v državi Kalifornije papež Janez Pavel II. Obiskal je nekatere zelo rodovitne podeželske kraje in v javnih govorih odločno branil dostojanstvo sicer nizko plačanih in večkrat zanemarjenih potujočih farmskih delavcev, ki so večinoma mehiškega rodu in često doživljajo gospodarsko in socialno izkorisťanje. V govoru pred 70.000 v mestecu Laguna Seca je papež dejal, da morajo imeti besedo vsi tisti, ki sodelujejo v agrarni industriji, ne samo lastniki farm in podjetij v prehrambni industriji.

Povsod je bil papež navdušeno sprejet, vendar nekateri opazujejo, da ni toliko ljudi, kot so organizatorji pričakovali. Janez Pavel II. se je srečal z nekaterimi AIDS bolniki in jim povedal, da jih Bog ljubi enako kot vse ljudi.

Robert H. Bork mora braniti svoja gledanja do ustave ZDA pred kritičnimi senatorji — Izid potrditvenega procesa še ni jasen

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Senatni odbor za pravosodstvo nadaljuje zasljevanje 60-letnega Roberta H. Borka, ki ga je bil predsednik Reagana imenoval za novega člena Vrhovnega sodišča. Imenovanje bo pa veljavno samo po potrditvi zveznega senata. Številni demokratski in liberalni senatorji odločno nasprotujejo Borku, ker menijo, da je nekak desničarski radikal, ki bo dal zanesljivo večino konservativnemu elementu na sodišču. Najbolj glasen v tem oziru je sen. Edward M. Kennedy, ki sicer ni sam povsem neoporečen glede svoje preteklosti, kar mu pa nič ne ovira pri ostrem napadanju Borka.

V odgovorih na vprašanja, skuša Bork pojasniti svoja stališča in senatorje prepričati, da v resnici ni noben skrajnež, ki bi s svojimi odločitvami oziroma gledanjem na ustovo prikrajšal pravice ameriških državljanov. Dejstvo je, menijo opazovalci zveznega senata, da je velika večina senatorjev že opredeljenih do Borka in sicer za ali proti. Tako Borkovi podpiratelji kot nasprotniki se torej zanimajo predvsem za tisto skupinico senatorjev, ki trdi, da se še ni odločilo za ali proti Borku. Zadeva je pomembna, ker menda imajo ti še neopredeljeni senatorji ključ do Borkove potrditve ali zavrnitve.

Demokratski predsedniški kandidat Joseph R. Biden v političnih težavah zaradi domnevne naklonjenosti plagiatu

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Včeraj je na tiskovni konferenci demokratski predsedniški kandidat Joseph R. Biden priznal, da je med šolanjem na pravni fakulteti na Syracuse univerzi zakril plagiatus, ko je napisal nek referat. Čeprav je bil takrat od pravne fakultete ustrezno kaznovan, je svoje šolanje končal, je reklo Biden, ki je poudaril, da se je to žgodilo pred 22. leti. V zadnjem času pa naj bi Biden uporabljal odlomke govorov drugih politikov v svojih lastnih govorih, ne da bi poslušalcem povedal, da gre za citate.

Biden je v skrbih, ker utegne zadeva resno in celo morda usodno škodovati njegovi komaj začeti predsedniški kampanji. Časovno je tudi neprijetna, ker je Biden računal na veliko pozitivno publiciteto med demokratskimi in liberalnimi volivci zaradi njegovega vodenja senatnega pravosodnega odbora, ki sedaj pretehta imenovanje Roberta Borka za člena Vrhovnega sodišča. Biden nasprotuje Borku in je upal, da bo to za njegovo kampanjo izredno dobrodošlo. Sedaj pa ima težave, ki lahko končajo zanj zelo neprijetno.



California Slovenians Honor Blessed Mary with Mass

Slovenians in Southern California gathered for the 37th year on the third Sunday in May in honor of our Blessed Mother at the Sacred Heart Church in Etiwanda near Fontana. Mary gives herself freely without reserve and devotes herself totally to the Person and work of her Son. Mary was the first and best disciple of the Lord. Her only interest,

"Do what He tells you."

Father Hlebs spoke also on our candidates for sainthood, Bishops Slomšek, Baraga and Gnidovec, all devoted to Mary our "Light of Faith."

The women's choir sang beautifully in Slovenian. Frank Zebot and Nada Stopar gave the readings of the Mass.

After the service, a delicious Slovenian dinner with wine was served in the spacious parish hall.

City Inspectors in Collinwood, Nottingham

A new City of Cleveland inspection program is being conducted by the Division of Building & Housing. Qualified city inspectors are conducting an inventory of all exterior conditions of both residential and commercial property in the Collinwood Neighborhood Action Area — bordered by Dorchester Dr., I-90, E. 200 St., and Nottingham Rd.

Those homes which have no significant exterior code violations are commended, in writing, for being maintained in an exemplary manner.

As the inspectors travel Col-

linwood and Nottingham, they are also noting all community maintenance problems such as chuck holes, bumpy manhole covers, blocked catch basins, damaged fire hydrants, etc.
