

Angleška diplomacija v ognjeni preizkušnji

ABESINCI SE JUNAŠKO BORIJO, DA BI REŠILI MESTO ADUWO

Vojaki Haile Selassija se borijo v strelskih jarkih. Italijani so zasedli Adigrat. 5000 ubitih in ranjenih. Rim slavi prvo zmago.

LONDON, 4. okt. — Iz Addis Abebe se brzjavno počela, da je ameriški zamorski zrakoplov John Robinson, ki je pilot v abesinski armadi, uspešno odbil napad neveč italijanskih letal ter varno prinesel poročila iz fronte v glavno mesto.

Robinson je iz Chicaga, kjer je svoječasno vodil avtomobilski garaz.

Z ITALIJANSKO ARMADO V ABESINII, 4. okt. — Italijanske čete, ki so včeraj brez večjih težkoč okupirale postojanke, proti katerim so bile namenjene, so danes izbrala na odločen odpor na gorskih slemovih katerih naleteli na Aduwo. Italijani so izkopali strelske jarke in se hrabro borijo proti italijanski premoči.

Italijanske čete so napadle sovražnikove pozicije, med tem ko je trideset aeroplakov, ki so pluli precej nizvodno, sipalo na Abesince ogenj iz strojnici in metalo bombe. Abesinci so na aeroplane odprii ogenj, toda niso nobenega zbilji na zemljo.

Zrakoplovski kader grofa Ciano je ponovil včeraj operacijo ter bombardiral sovražnikove sile, ki so se severno od Aduwo.

V četrtek niso italijanske čete naletele na nikakšno posrednico ter so s pomočjo tankov, ki so jim odpirali pot do divje pokrajine, v teklu 12 ur prodri 19 milj globočino v sovražnikov teritorij.

Italijansko poveljstvo pravi, da prebivalci v abesinskem vaseh niso bežali pred italijansko vojsko, temveč so jo sprejeli z udanostjo in prijateljstvom. Trdi se, da se v koptičnih (staro-krščanskih) cerkvah moli za skorajšnjo italijansko zmago.

RIM, 4. okt. — Tu je bilo danes poročano, da so italijanske čete zasedle vas Adigrat in da se pričakuje, da bodo jutri zasedle Aduwo. Koliko izgub so Italijani dosegli utrpi, v javnosti ni poročano.

Počasi v Rimu so ves dan nepotrežljivo čakali, kdaj bo v sili pred palačo, kjer biva francoski poslanik. Več tisoč fašistov je marširalo pred palačo, kjer so vsej demokratiji: "Viva Francia!" in "Viva Duce!" Namen te je bil, Zahvaliti se Franciji, ker je zavzela državljansko stališče glede sankcij. DADDIS ABABA, 4. okt. — Medtem ko si abesinski generali na severu desperatno prizadevajo ustaviti italijansko ofenzivo, pa je Haile Selassie danes poslal ojačanja na južno fronto v provinci Ogaden, kjer so zbranili že 50 tisoč njegovih vojnikov in najboljih zbrane, da obdijejo napad iz italijanske Somalije.

WASHINGTON, 4. okt. — Ameriška vlada je danes deklarirala, da ne bo uvelda embarga proti pošiljtvam vojnega materiala, toda odredila je strogo nadzorstvo na vse posiljative v inozemstvu.

TOKIO, 4. okt. — Japonska vlada bo ostala neutralna pred posiljatve v Afriki, kot je izjavil danes neki predstavnik, ako bi ga ji Liga narodov poslala.

Na to je Liga odsodila radi okupacije Mandžurije.

Here is Mussolini of the past:

He was a Socialist, of a Socialist father. During his revolutionary days he was a bomb advocate. Mussolini spent time in exile in Switzerland, and hob-nobbed with Bernstein and other revolutionaries. At one time he wanted to assassinate the Italian king, but was restrained by his fellow Socialists. In Milan he edited the Socialist paper "Avanti" and advocated opposition to the World War.

As the War progressed, propaganda became ripe for intervention of Italy. Mussolini dropped the Socialist paper and went over to the "Popoli D'Italia." At this time he began forming the Fascist organization. He entered office as premier, not by any legitimate, democratic, popular method, but by a coup d'état. During the crisis of government, he and his muscle-men marched to Rome and evicted the chosen government of the people.

One, Matteotti, beloved by his constituents, was whisked away off the streets by henchmen of Mussolini. Matteotti was found dead in a near-by cave. His murderers were known and brought to a mock trial concluded by lenient sentences.

Here is Mussolini's program, in part, at the inception of Fascism.

Reconcile it with the present order: Abolition of Monarchy, Senate, and Nobility; International Disarmament and abolition of compulsory military service; Confiscation of war-profits, and capital levy; Abolition of stock exchange and dissolution of limited liability companies and banks; Land for the peasants; Transference of control of industry to syndicates of technicians and workers.

Today we recognize him as favoring the church. But here is one of his earlier quotations: "Fascism is the
