Kissingerjeva pot v Afriko zelo kočljiva

Državni tajnik se je podal na obisk v Afriko, ki je nekateri afriške vodnike vznemiril.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Državni tajnik Henry Kissinger se je dolgo pripravljal na pot v Afriko, pa jo je vedno znova odlašal. Ko je bilo objavljeno, da bo ta teden le odšel tja ter kom obiskov vodnikov držav črne Afrike govoril tudi s predstavniki nacionalističnih črnih gibanj v Rodeziji in Namibiji, so se takoj oglasili kritiki.

Prvi je bil predsednik Ugande Idi Amin, ki je sedaj predsednik Organizacije afriške edinstvenosti. Kissingerjevo potovanje v Afriko je odškolil in označil za škodljivo afriški stvari, ki da ji ZDA niso naklonjene.

Škof Abel Muzorewa, vodnik nacionalističnega krila Afriškega Kongresa v Rodeziji, je izjavil v Zambiji, kjer se drži v begunstvu, da je namen Kissingerjeve poti po Afriki okrepitev "ameriškega imperializma".

Položaj ZDA v Afriki je res težaj, prevlada sovjetsko-kubanskega vpliva ga je še poslabšala. ZDA bi rade omejile sovjetski vpliv v Afriki in preprečile odprtje bojevanje med belo manjšino in črno večino v Rodeziji, Namibiji in v Južni Afriki. V tem vidijo nekateri vodniki držav črne Afrike ameriško podporo rasni politiki omenjenih držav. Z nejelovo gledajo na ZDA, ki so dovolile uvoz kroma iz Rodezije kljub gospodarskemu bojkotu, ki ga je nad Rodezijo proglašila skupščina Združenih narodov.

Henry Kissinger bo obiskal med drugimi republiko Zaire in Zambijo, ki sta oboje zahodno usmerjeni, opustil pa bo obisk Nigerije na njen lastni nasvet. Z vodniki držav, ki jih bo obiskal, se bo ameriški državni tajnik razgovarjal o možnostih pomoci v sodelovanju ZDA pri njihovem gospodarskem, socialnem in kulturnem razvoju.

Kdo je napadel kubanski ribiški ladji?

WASHINGTON, D.C. — ZDA so sporočile kubanski vladu, da vodijo preiskavo o tem, kdo je 5. aprila streljal na kubanski ribiški ladji, nedaleč od Floride. Ena se je potopila, pri čemer je en ribič utonil.

Predsednik Kube je obdolžil ZDA za ta napad in zagrozil, da bo odpovedal dogovor proti ugrabljanju letal, ki ga je sklenil leta 1973 z ZDA.

Neka skupina kubanskih beguncev je izjavila, da so izvedli napad njeni člani za obletico izkrcanja v Svinjskem zalivu na Kubu 17. aprila 1961.

Izgredi v New Delhiu

Policija je streljala z avtomatičnim orožjem in razganjala razlučene solzivnimi bombami.

NEW DELHI, Ind. — V pondeljek je prišlo do izgredov v delu mesta, kamor so oblasti poslale buldožarje, da podejajo zasilja, revna blivališča tisočev, ki si kaj boljšega ne morejo privoščiti. V izgredih je bilo precej mrtvih; nekateri trdijo, da so razjedeni demonstrantje ubili vsaj 20 policijev.

Je to temeljna spremembava v odnosu s pogromom, ki ga je predložila lani junija Kongresu. Direktor omenjene zvezne uprave Robert C. Seaman Jr. je dejal, da je ta v glavnem ostala pri svojem dosedanjem programu razvoja jedrske sile, uporabe premoga, oljnega škriljeva, surovega olja in naravnega plina do leta 1985.

Večjo vlogo bodo imeli pri izvajaju programa privatne ustanove, družbe in univerze.

R. C. Seaman je razlagal, da smo v preteklosti v naši deželi vse premalo pazili na varčevanje z viro energije, med tem ko so to drugod skrbno nadzirali.

Varčevanje je možno na celi vrsti področjih, vse od ogrevanja naših stanovanj, oskrbe teh z novanjem na konvenciji julija v vročo vodo, hlajenja in kuhanja, pa do prometnih sredstev.

Indija ima sedaj okoli 600 milijonov prebivalcev, ki jih zaostalo in nerazvito gospodarstvo ne more preživljati. Vlada se že več let prizadeva, da bi omogočila število rojstev in zavrnala prebivalstvo. Prostovoljni programi niso bili doslej kaj uspešni in so se sedaj začeli ukvartiti z uvedbo obveznih. Zvezna vlada je načrtovanje odobrila, pa ga za enkrat prepustila v uzakonitev in izvajanje posameznim državam Indijske republike. Odporn je močan, ker vidijo starši v velikem številu otrok najboljše zavarovanje za pomoč v starosti.


Mihajlov v bolnišnici

POLETNI ČAS NASTOPI!

Egipt in Kitajska sklenili sporazum o tesnejših vezeh



Egipt bo v okviru dogovora dobil rezervne dele za orožje svojih vojaških sil.

PEKING, LR Kit. — Kitajci so sprejeli egiptsko zastopstvo z vsemi častmi. Razgovarjalo se ni ponovno le s predsednikom vlade Hua Kuo-fengom, ampak je bilo sprejeto tudi pri samem Mau. Kitajski vodniki niso pravni skrivali svojega zadovoljstva nad tem, da je Egipt odpreval pretekli mesec zavezniško pogodbo s Sovjetsko zvezo in se sedaj obrnil proti Kitajski.

Na slavnostnem banketu, ki so ga priredili v pondeljek Kitajci svojim gostom in nato v sredo Egipčani Kitajcem, so v svojih govorih poučarjali korenitost tesnih vezi in bodočega sodelovanja. Ker so Sovjetska zveza in njeni sateliti bojkotirali slavnostni banket v pondeljek, Egipčani na svojega niso vabili nikogar razen svojih kitajskih gostiteljev.

V sporazumu, ki so ga podpisali v Pekingu tekom tega obiska, naj bi Kitajci obljudili Egipt rezervne dele za MIG-17 in MIG-21 letala, ki jih je Egipt dobivala Sovjetska zveza, pa je sedaj ustavila dobavo rezervnih delov za nje. Kitajska ne izdeluje letal MIG-23, ki jih je Egipt dobil šele lani.

Po opravljenih uradnih razgovorih in podpisu dogovora si je egiptsko delegacijo pod vodstvom podpredsednika Moberaka, v kateri je 36 članov, ogledala še nekatere kitajske zanimivosti, predno se je odpravila domov.

BESEDA IZ NARODA

Povestitev škofa dr. Alojzija Ambrožiča v Torontu

CLEVELAND, O. — Po zanesljivih vesteh iz Kanade je datum posvetitve sedaj dokončno določen. Novi škof bo prejel sv. redove na praznik Vnebohoda, 27. majnika, ob 4h popoldne v nadškofijski stolni cerkvi sv. Mihaela v Torontu. Posvetitev bo izvršil nadškof Filip Pocock ob asistenci par drugih škofov. Žal, da med posvečevalci ne bo slovenskega pomožnega škofa Stanka Leniča iz Ljubljane, ker je v majniku zapisan v vizitacijami župnij in birmovanjem po nadškofijski.

Proletarski internacionalizem vodilo 15. kongresa KP v Pragi

Pretekli teden je imela Komunistična partija Českoslovaške republike svoj 15. kongres v Pragi. Priprave nanj so vzbujale več pozornosti v tujini kot doma. Nekateri v svobodni Evropi so pričakovali, da utegne biti glavni tajnik Komunistične partije Gustav Husak, ki je nasledil gen. Ludvíka Svobodo tudi kot predsednik republike, potisnjeno z vodstva Partije. Nasledil bi ga naj znani stalinist Vasil Bilak.

V to smer naj bi kazali napadi na Aleksandra Dubčka, očeta "praške pomlad" in njegovih nekdajnih somišljenikov ter podpornikov. Gonja je bila pred začetkom kongresa obsežna in zagrizena, pa je neposredno pred začetkom kongresa zastala.

Gustav Husak je v svojem obsežnem programskem poročilu ponudil bivšim liberalnim komunistom, ki so podpirali Dubčka in bili po njegovi odstranitvi z vodstva Partije iz te izključeni, ponovni sprejem v Partijo, če ji obljudijo zvestobo in vdano službo. Iz Komunistične partije je bilo po avgustu 1968 izključenih okoli pol milijona Dubčkovih pristašev, doslej pa so jih spreveli nazaj vanjo le nekaj tisoč. Šlo naj bi v prvi vrsti z gospodarske strokovnjake, ki jih režimu baje primanjkuje in zaradi tega gospodarstvo trpi škodo.

Gustav Husak je bil sam podpornik "praške pomladi" in sodelavec A. Dubčka, zato ga imajo trdi stalinisti, katerih vodja je Vasil Bilak, vedno nekako na sumu in mu ne zaupajo čisto. Če bi bilo po njihovo, bi ga že spravili z oblasti, pa se morajo ozirati na Moskvo.

Ta je tekom 15. kongresa Komunistične partije Českoslovaške pokazala očitno in odločno, da za enkrat smatra Husaka še vedno za koristnega in morda celo tudi za nepogrešljivega. On je namreč od vseh znanih komunističnih prvakov, kot trdijo, še najmanj osovražen. V Moskvi se, izgleda, nanj zanesejo, saj jim od avgusta 1968 vztrajno in pokorno služi. Od tedaj ni nikoli krenil z uradne moskovske linije, ki temelji na "proletarskem internacionalizmu" ali na doktrini Brežnjeva.

O tej doktrini so na 15. kongresu KP v Pragi veliko govorili in jo vedno znova poudarjali. Husak in njegovi so stalno hvalili Sovjetsko zvezo in njeno vodstvo, kazali so ji pokornost in podrejenost, kot da bi bila ČSR sovjetska republika. Romunski in jugoslovanski partijski zastopniki so to podrejenost čeških in slovaških komunistov Sovjetski zvezzi, ki je prehajala tu in tam že v pravo hlapčevstvo, označevali za nesprejemljivo in odvratno.

Zanimivo je, da se kongresa KP ČSR v Pragi niso udeležili zastopniki Španske Komunistične partije, med tem ko je bila Italijanska KP zastopana samo po "opazovalcih". Ti in vsi drugi so morali poslušati vztrajno in dosledno ponavljanje in poudarjanje "proletarskega internacionalizma", pod katerim je nekaj Lenin mislil združitev vseh proletarjev sveta v skupnem boju proti "razrednemu sovražniku", v Moskvi pa ga sedaj razlagajo kot pravico Sovjetske zvezze, da gre s silo varovat komunistične režime v katerokoli državo, če pridejo ti v nevarnost. Tako so sovjetski tanki rešili komunistični režim na Madžarskem novembra 1956 in avgusta 1968 na Češkoslovaškem.

Komunistične partije večine zahodne Evrope so to moskovsko stališče odklonile in ga zavračajo. Posebno jasna je v tem pogledu Italijanska KP, manj pa Francoska in Španska.

V Moskvi trdijo, da bi opustitev "proletarskega internacionalizma" oslabila "socialistično skupnost, odprla vrata kaosu in desnemu oportunizmu". Zastopnik Komunistične partije Sovjetske zvezde na 15. kongresu v Pragi Andrej Kirilenko, član moskovskega politbiroja, je hvalil Gustava Husaka v imenu Brežnjeva in drugih sovjetskih vodnikov kot "vzor proletarskega internacionalizma". Zbranim je trdil, da je samo zasluga "vztrajnega skupnega napora držav socialistične skupnosti", da ne padajo bombe in da molče topovi na evropskem kontinentu".

Nato se je Kirilenko ostro lotil različnih "odpadnikov" in "protirevolucionarjev", ki so našli zatočišče v središčih imperializma.

Gustav Husak je izjavil: "Sodelovanje s Sovjetsko zvezo je glavno iamstvo narodne svobode in državne neodvisnosti." Po njegovem ne more biti pravega domoljubja, če ni to temelječe na "proletarskem internacionalizmu". Brežnjeva, ki je avgusta 1968 poslal sovjetske tanke v ČSR, končat "praško pomlad", je Husak proglašil za "junaka Češkoslovaške in velikega prijatelja naše domovine in ljudstva".



Father Aloysius M. Ambrosic, 46, recently was appointed Auxiliary Bishop of Toronto, Canada.

Father Ambrosic was born at Gaberje, Slovenia and emigrated to Canada in 1948.

He graduated from St. Augustine's Seminary and was ordained June 4, 1955 in St. Michael's Cathedral by the late Cardinal James C. McGuigan.

His first two years of priest-

hood were served at St. Teresa's Parish in Port Colborne, Ont.

Father Ambrosic continued his academic studies and earned three graduate degrees in biblical literature.

He has written two books, *The Hidden Kingdom* and *Remarks on the Canadian Catechism*.

At the time of his episcopal appointment, he was dean of studies at St. Augustine's Seminary and faculty member of

Toronto School of Theology.

Bishop-elect Ambrosic can speak fluently in five European languages, and also is able to work with several ancient languages as a biblical scholar.

His consecration to the episcopacy will take place before the end of May.

Although he has not had time to form any definite plans, Fr. Ambrosic said one of his first concerns would be the children

of immigrants since they often "experience a certain amount of tension between the parents who represent one culture and their peers who represent Canadian culture."
