Kilajci naj spremene svoje sovraščvo v moč

Vodstvo rdeče Kitajske poziva kitajske milijone, naj spremene svoje sovraščvo v povečan napor v proizvodnji za uspešen boj proti Sovjetski zvezi.

HONG KONG. — Vodniki rdeče Kitajske so začeli po vsej širini deželi pozivati načrtno milijone delavcev in kmetov, naj svoje sovraščvo do Rusov spremene v povečan delavnih napor in usposoblju Kitajska za uspešen nastop proti Sovjetski zvezi. Ta teden je prišlo do novih demonstracij pred sovjetskim poslaništvom v Pepingu, ki pa so le odgovor na demonstracije Rusov pred poslaništvom Kitajske v Moskvi konec preteklega tedna.

Propaganda proti Sovjetski zvezi se med tem načrtno nadaljuje. Uradna propaganda še vedno strogo loči med sovjetskim "ljudstvom" in sovjetskimi vodniki. Članki v uradnem glasilu Kitajske Komunistične partije "Ljudski dnevnik" v Peipingu trdijo, da ni dalet čas, ko "se bodo ruski delavci dvignili proti fašističnemu preganjanju Brežnjeva, Kosygina in njihove tolpo zločincev".

"Spremenite svoje tovarne in rudnike v bojišča produkcije! Spremenite sovraščvo v moč!" poziva čaoispisje in radio Kitajske v mestih in na podeželju po vsej širini deželi od severa do juga, od morja pa dalet v notranjost.

Zunanje ministrstvo dolži za mejni spor Sovjetsko zvezo, ki da je odklonila ponudbo po ureditvi meja. Pri otoku Damanskij ali Chenpoa, kot ga imenujejo Kitajci, je prišlo po tem poročilu v zadnjih 2 letih do 16 oboroženih spopadov med Rusi in Kitajci.

Petric, rojen v Clevelandu 2. maja 1937, sin Johna in Mary, roj. Novak. Obiskoval je ljudsko šolo fare Marije Vnebovzete v Collinwoodu, nato višjo šolo sv. Jožeta, kjer je graduiral leta 1955. Nato se je vpisal na univerzo v Daytonu, kjer je graduiral leta 1959 in R.O.T.C. (s častjo). Nato je bil imenovan za poročnika v US Army in je služil v Nemčiji kot vojaški pilot. V Vietnamu je odšel prvič leta 1965, drugič pa lani.

Bil je član društva Immaculate Council #3767 Kolumbovih vitezov v Marijinega dvora št. 1640 Katoliških borštnarjev.

Zapušča ženo Lindo v Kettering, Ohio (Dayton), otreke Joana, Johna III. in Stephera, starše Johna in Mary (Lastnik Petric's Barber Shop na E. 185 St.), sestri Mary-Joyce, Barbaro in Veronico, brata Timmyja in Rudija, stare starše Antona in Antonijo Novak in več drugih sorodnikov. Preden je vstopil v vojaško službo, je živel na 451 E. 156 St.

Kolektivno vodstvo Tito predlog za SFRJ

Na 9. kongresu komunistične partije je Tito predložil preureuditve partijskega vodstva.

BEograd, SFRJ. — Josip Broz Tito je na kongresu Zvezke komunistov Jugoslavije pripomnil, da so "nekateri že v visokih letih", ko je predlagal sprememe vrhovnega partijskega vodstva. Zavzel se je za kolektivno vodstvo, v katerem ne bo "nihče ne prvi ne drugi ali tretji", ampak vsi enaki, vsi z enako besedo.

Glavno vodstvo partie bo prezvela "izvršna pisarna" 15 članov. V njej bosta po 2 zastopnika particev iz 6 republik, po 1 iz obeh avtonomnih pokrajin in načelnik, za sedaj Tito sam. Vsi člani "izvršne pisarne" bodo odločali skupno in skupno nosili tudi odgovornost za odločitve. Tito ni nič povedal, kdo bo vamo povelj, ko bo kongres sprememb obdaril. Poudarjal je potrebo po slogi in edinstvu v vodstvu partie.

Centralni komitet bo prenehal, njegove posle bo verjetno prevzela letna partijska konferenca 300 vodilnih članov iz vse dežele. Namoč dosedanja 35-članskega predstavlja bo novi 52-članski, ki bo odločal vsakodnevna vprašanja in nadziral izvedbo sklepov partie. Dosedanje 11-članske izvršne odbor bo opuščen, njegove naloge bo prevzela, kot omenjeno, 15-članska izvršna pisarna.

Wilson pojde v Nigerijo

LONDON, Vel. Brit. — Predsednik vlade Harold Wilson pojde v prihodnjih 10 dneh v Nigerijo, kjer je prišlo v državljeni vojni med Biafore in zveznimi četami do zastaja. Wilsona je povabila na obisk vlada v Lagosu z misljijo na posredovanje v tej vojni.

Vesti z bojiščem trdijo, da imajo biafranske čete obklojeno v mestu Owerri eno zvezno brigado z okoli 2,000 vojakov. Če se jim jo posreči uničiti ali prisiliti k predaji, utegne biti to odločilen zarez.

Za nemiri na univerzah se skrivajo komunisti?

OTTAWA, Kan. — Na letni konvenciji progresivnih konservativcev je pri razpravi o nemirih na visokih šolah trdil James Russell iz Halifaxa, da so ti nemiri v glavnem uspeh dela komunističnih agitatorjev, ki prihajo v Kanado od drugod. Zato je predložil, naj bi Kanada v tem pogledu poostrial zakone o veseljevanju.

Pred kakimi 50 člani posebnega odbora, ki je razpravljal o tem vprašanju, je Russell dejal, da ne bi moral izgledati kot "kak konservativni John Birch", toda Kanadčani ne smejo dovoliti, da bi jih liberalci porivali nemoteno sem in tja s trditvami, da komunizem ni več neveren. "Prenekateri nezadovoljne na univerzah so komunistični simpatizerji in večina visokošolcev sledi priznanim vodnikom brez kakih posebnih misli," je razlagal Russell svoje trditev. Nato je poučil, da so zakoni postavljeni za varstvo in jih nimajo nihče pravice kršiti, tudi tisti ne, ki delajo to "v skrbi za socialna vprašanja".

Proti stališču J. Russella je bilo nekaj ugovorov. Nekateri so izjavili, da je študentovskim skrajnežem treba dati vsaj priložnost, da povedo svoje mnenje. Velika večina je pa podpirala stališče, da je treba proti študentovskim skrajnežem nastopiti trše.

Televizijski programi kritizirani v Iranu

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Naš televizijski mreže so sicer v tehničnem pogledu res na višku, toda s sedanjem povprečno, kakovosten programov se pa ne morejo ponujati. Vse preveč je kakovost odvisna od želje po velikih zasluzkih, ta želja pa izrablja tudi najnižje človeške nagoni in strasti.

Pričo na ta način je dosti, toda ne pridejo lahko v javnost, ker jih uprave televizijskih mrež skušajo čim manj vpoštovati. Dovalile so se pritožbe do senata in ta je povabilo voditelje televizije na zaslišanje, ki ni bilo ravnino nekaj prijetnega za gospodarje naše televizije. Vsekakor je televizija slišala kritiko od tiste strani, ki jo lahko pošteno okrca. Upajmo, da bo to nekaj zalezlo.

SENAT ODOLIL DOGOVOR OOMEJITVI ATOMSKEGA OROŽJA NA ATOMSKE SILE

Senat ZDA je včeraj odobril s 83:15 glasovom dogovor oomejivti atomskega orožja na sedanje atomske sile, ki pa nudi tem, ki se atomskemu orožju odpovedo, sodelovanje pri nevojaškem izkoriscenju atomske sile.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Senat je včeraj po več urah razprave, tukom katere je bilo zavrnjenih več dopolnil, izglasoval s 83:15 glasovom mednarodni dogovor oomejivti atomskega orožja na sedanje atomske sile. Dogovor je bil dosežen v okviru razorožitvene konference ZN v Ženevi in je bil lani sprejet v glavni skupščini Združenih narodov. V veljavjo bo stopil, ko ga bodo odobrile tri glavne atomske sile, Amerika, Rusija in Anglija, ter 40 drugih držav. Doslej pa je odobrila Anglija in nekaj drugih držav, računa pa, da bo ameriški odobritvi naglo sledila Rusija in druge države. Pri razpravi o dogovoru nista sodelovali atomske sile Francija in Kitajska. Čeprav ga sedaj nočeta odobrili, obstoji vendar prepričanje, da se ga bosta držali.

Smotri atomskega dogovora je prepričeni širjenje atomskega orožja še na nove države, ki ga nimajo, pa so ga sposobne izdejati ali pa ga dobiti od tistih, ki ga izdelujejo.

Dogovor prepoveje atomske silam izročitev atomskega orožja državam, ki ga nimajo, tem pa njegov sprejem. Neatomske sile, ki bodo podpisale dogovor, bodo imelo polno priložnost sodelovanja pri rabi atomske sile za nevojaške namene.

Dogovor oomejivti atomskoga orožja ima dodatek, ki govorji oomejanju atomskegaoroževanja in o razgovorih med atomske silami za zmanjšanje zalog atomskega orožja. Sen. J. W. Fulbright, načelnik zunanjopolitičnega odbora Senata, je izjavil po odobritvi dogovora, da smatra to za glas proti nadaljevanju graditve Sentinel obrambnega sistema proti medcelinskim raketam.

— Apollo 9 je včeraj ob 12:01 točno, kot je bilo predvideno, pristal na Atlantiku v bližini Bahamov komaj 3 milje do letalonosilke Guadalcanal, ki je tam nanj čakala. Eno uro po pristanku so bili vsi trije astronauti zadoljni na krovu letalonosilke. Prvi zdravniški pregled je pokazal, da so 10-dnevno potovanje po vesolju odlično prešlo.

— CORONADO, Calif. — Včeraj je bilo končano zaslijanje moštva ladje Pueblo. Kapitan Bucher je izjavil, da nosi polno odgovornost za vse svoje odločitve. Branil je predajo ladje brez odpora in zvračal odgovornost za neuničenje tajnega gradiva na ladji na vojno mornarico, ki ladjo ni opremila z za to potrebnimi sredstvi.

Protestni enodnevni štrajki zgubljajo svoj pomen

PARIZ, FR. — Zadnji splošni enodnevni štrajk v Franciji je pokazal, da so taki štrajki že zgubili svojo privlačnost, zato pa tudi ne dosegajo svojega namena: preplašiti javnost in vplivati nanjo. Ljudje jih smatrajo za neprijeten dogodek, bolj podoben izrednemu, neplačanemu prazniku kot sadu razrednega boja, kot si to zamišljajo delavske unije.

Štrajk je bil dobro organiziran, nemirov ni bilo v večjem obsegu, zanimanje zanj pa ni presegalo običajnih mej. To je moral čutiti tudi De Gaulle, kajti ni imel preveč poslušalcev, pa tudi ni sprožil nekdajnih živahnih debat.

Štrajk tudi ni preusmeril pogledov na francoško gospodarsko stanje. Nihanje cene za zlato zunaj Francije je postal skromnejše, tudi zaskrbljenočnost o božnosti francoškega razvoja ni narastla. Seveda čaka evropska gospodarska jaynost, kaj bo generalov režim storil v prihodnjih dneh, nihče pa ne pričakuje novih senzacij, čeprav bi francoškim politikom prišle prav. Vse se bo vrtele, tako mihajo, okoli mezdnih pogajanj v Parizu, ki ne bodo verjetno potekala čisto gladko.

Ideja sestanka štirih glede izraelsko-arabske krize še živi

NEW YORK, N.Y. — Protokoncu lanskega leta je Sovjetska zveza sprožila idejo, da bi bilo dobro, ako bi se Rusija, Amerika, Anglia in Francija v okviru ZN sporazumele, kako je treba reševati krizo v sporu med Izraelom in njegovimi sodisci. Amerika je v januarju idejo pozdravila, ni pa povedala svojega stališča glede jamstva gornjih držav, ki naj bi bilo podlaga za mir na Srednjem vzhodu. V načelu je bila ideja sprejeta od vseh štirih držav.

Predhodni razgovori so se zaključili z dogovorom, naj poklicna diplomacija v okviru ZN izvrši pripravljalna dela. Tako so se začela pogajanja med vsemi štirimi delegacijami, ameriško, rusko, francoško in angleško, ki se danes niso zaključena. Posebno agilen je glavni angleški delegat Lord Caradon.

Za idejo se briga tudi naše državno tajništvo. Na njegovo pobudo bo prišel v Washington izraelski zunanj minister Eban. Danes se bo sestal z Nixonom in našimi vodilnimi diplomati in jim pojASNIL stališče nove izraelske vlade.

Sen. Proxmire ne upa v možnost nadzora obrambnih izdatkov

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Senator Proxmire je v senatnem plenarnem načelu bolno točko naše demokracije: kontrole izdatkov za narodno obrambo. Trdil je, da sedaj že ni mogoče pregledati in nadzirati izdatkov, ki jih dela Pentagon. Tega ne premorejo več ne Bela hiša ne federalni urad za proračun ne Kongres.

Treba je najti drug sistem, ki bo omogočil ustavnim faktorjem kontrolo na "vojaško-industrijsko koalicijo", ki danes neomejeno gospodari že z \$80-100 milijoni na leto.

Moskva se oglasila k razpravi o ABM v ZDA

Uradno glasilo vlade ZSSR Izvestia je zapisalo, da bi graditev Sentinel obrambnega sistema proti raketam utegnila škodovati razgovorom oomejiti obozrevanje.

MOSKVA, ZSSR. — V glavnom glasilu vlade Izvestia je znani komentator Vikenty Matvejev zapisal, da je doseženo med obema glavnima silama sveta nekako ravnotežje sil, ki daje priložnost in možnost za uspešne razgovore o zamrzitvi in omejitvi atomskega obozrevanja.

Pisec poudarja, da je Sovjetska zveza predložila razgovore oomejiti atomskega orožja, napadalnega in obrambnega, načelno opozarjan, naj ne bi nobena stran podvzela ukrepov, ki bi sedanje ravnotežje sil menjali v škodo druge.

Članek sicer ne omenja neposredno razprave o tem, ali naj Amerika gradi dalje obrambo proti medcelinskim raketam Sentinel, ki jo je Kongres lani odobril in za nje že določil tudi del sredstev, ali ne, je pa očitno, da se na to nanaša.

Sovjetska zveza je začela graditi proteraketno obrambo še v času Hruščeva. Postavila je rakete lovec okoli Leningrada in Moskve, pa nato lani to delo ustavila, ko je po meniju zahodnih strokovnjakov spoznala, da ta v dotedanji obliki ne bi bila posebno uspešna. Rusi izpopolnjujejo radarske naprave, ki naj bi elektronsko pregledavale nebobi in prožile obrambne rakete proti bližajočim se sovražnim. Na ta način je zamisljeno delovanje Sentinel sistema, ki naj bi varoval Ameriko pred kakim manjšim raketenim napadom.

Predsednik Nixon je obljudil, da bo danes na svoji tiskovni konferenci zavzel neko stališče v razpravi, ali naj Amerika nadaljuje z gradnjo Sentinel sistema ali naj počaka, da bo ta izpopolnjen in bolj učinkovit, in vidi, če se le ni mogoče pogovoriti z Rusi oomejiti obozrevanja.





1/4 cup water	

Soak chicken for 30 minutes in ice water; rinse and dry with absorbent paper. Arrange skin side down in a 3-quart (13 1/2 x 8 1/2 x 2-inch) baking dish. Brush with melted butter; sprinkle with salt and paprika. Place sliced onions and green pepper on top of chicken. Bake in a moderate (350°F.) oven 30 minutes. Turn the chicken pieces skin side up; bake 30 minutes. In a medium-size saucepan, bring 1/4 cup water to a boil; add frozen vegetables. Return to a boil; cook 15 minutes or until vegetables are tender. In a small bowl, mix the 1 1/2 cups water, nonfat dry milk, flour, salt and pepper over surface of water. Beat with rotary beater just until blended. Add to cooked vegetables. Place over low heat; stir constantly until mixture has thickened. Pour over chicken in baking dish. Return to oven for about 3-5 minutes or until thoroughly heated.



THE POOR GET POORER

As government gets bigger in proportion to the growth of the population and the productive capacity of the people, the rising cost of supporting it must be spread over the backs of more and more people. The old saw about soaking the rich is an empty phrase. There aren't enough of them. The poor also pay taxes, and if inflation and the cost of government continues to rise, the ranks of the poor will increase. This is as certain as night following day. The wealth of the rich is like the proverbial fly speck on a barn door compared to current government spending and borrowing. Payment for multibillion dollar federal programs must be drawn mainly from the limited resources of the majority of citizens — including those in the lower income brackets.

U.S. News & World Report recently published figures showing that taxes take 34 per cent of annual family incomes under \$3,000, because of rising income taxes, social security levies, state and local sales and property taxes. Tax experts, economists and other authorities are now trying to figure out a way to relieve the poor of part of their tax burden. In the meantime, taxes continue to go up as the cost of government continues to grow. Anyone who doubts this has merely to look at the jump in his social security tax that heralded the new year. There is only one way to relieve the tax burden for the poor, as for everyone else. And that is to trim back on government spending and debt.

Bowling Tips...



Perfect Shot Requires Perfect Grip

Johnny Guenther, 1968 Miller High Life Open champion and the only active professional to shoot a 300 game on national television, explains the proper grip in bowling:



While all phases of delivery are important, an incorrect grip can ruin what would otherwise be a perfect shot. Most pro bowlers insert their fingers into the ball first to the proper depth—and then the thumb. (see sketch 1)

You'd be surprised how many beginners and "amateurs" do not have the proper grip. It's the fingers that impart the proper roll and that should be your primary concern. If the ball is drilled properly, you should be able to let the ball hang loosely at your side without squeezing. (see sketch 2)

The grip should be comfortable, with no significant strain on your fingers from over-reaching. The finger holes should fit snugly with the thumb hole slightly larger so that thumb will come out first and easily.

YANK ERA ENDS

Ft. Lauderdale, Fla. — Mickey Mantle pulled down the curtain on one of baseball's greatest careers with a one-line statement, the simplicity of which typified the country boy who became one of the sport world's most glamorous stars. When he said, simply and succinctly, "I'm not going to play any more baseball" to a hurriedly called press conference on March 1, Mickey did more than announce his retirement.

He also pulled down the curtain on what has to be the most exciting, glamorous and legendary era ever enjoyed by an athletic team. From Babe Ruth in 1921, the Yankees had a succession of super-stars, success and spectacular accomplishments unrivaled by any team in any sport.

Now, with Mantle following Babe Ruth, Lou Gehrig and Joe DiMaggio into history, the Yankees are bereft of a super-star for the first time in almost a half century. With Mickey gone, the New Yorkers become a team without a glamour star.

Positive Steps Taken To Prevent Power Failure

A renewed determination to prevent widespread blackouts was pledged by a group of 26 interconnected electric utilities, including the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, serving 32 million people in eight East-Central states.

In observing the second anniversary of the East Central Area Reliability Coordination group, Karl H. Rudolph, president of the Illuminating Company and vice-chairman of the ECAR organization, said its members have a single unified goal: achievement of the "highest possible degree of reliability" in their bulk power supply.

ECAR members serve all or parts of Michigan, Indiana, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Kentucky, West Virginia, Virginia and Maryland.

When ECAR was formed two years ago, its members had a total of more than 37-million kilowatts of electric generating capacity and 24,000 miles of high-voltage transmission lines.

"Since then, they have added more than 5-million kilowatts of generating capacity and 2,000 miles of line," Rudolph said.

To help achieve ECAR's objective, he pointed out, the Illuminating Company has launched a \$400-million expansion program designed to boost its generating capacity by 1974 to 40,340,000 kilowatts, a 78 per cent increase.

The Avon Lake and Eastlake Power Plants are adding 625,000-kilowatt generators to the system. Near Warren, Pa., the Seneca Power Plant nearing completion is the first pumped storage hydro-electric plant on the system, adding 380,000 kilowatts to be shared with Pennsylvania Electric Company, Rudolph added.

The program also includes construction of Ohio's first large-scale nuclear generating facility, the 872,000-kilowatt Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Plant to be built near Toledo as a joint project with the Toledo Edison Company.

Dates of the organization of these initial counties are: Washington, 1788; Hamilton, 1790; Wayne, 1796; Adams and Jefferson, 1797; Ross, 1798; Clermont, Fairfield, and Trumbull, 1800; Belmont, 1801 and Columbiana, Franklin, Gallia, Greene, Montgomery, Scioto and Warren, 1803.

HEART DRIVE TOTAL STANDS AT \$118,000

Preliminary total for the Cuyahoga County Heart Sunday Drive stands at \$118,000. Results of the eight-county Heart Sunday residential campaign are \$180,000, an increase over last year's figures at this date, according to Mr. George B. Chapman, Jr., Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Heart Association of Northeastern Ohio.

The bank is still tabulating contributions.

"We would like to express our deep appreciation to those who contributed so generously to the Heart Fund volunteers on Heart Sunday," he continued. "However, it is not too late to donate by simply mailing a check or money order to the Heart Association of Northeastern Ohio, 1689 East 115th Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44106."

Nearly 30,000 volunteers canvassed the area served by the Heart Association of Northeastern Ohio on Heart Sunday to distribute heart-saving literature and to receive funds to help support the fight against disease of the heart and blood vessels.

At homes where no one answered the door, the Heart Fund volunteer left an envelope to be used to mail in that family's donation to the Heart Fund. "It is our sincere hope that generous contributions will be enclosed in these envelopes and mailed promptly," Mr. Chapman said.

Money donated to the Heart Fund is used to further important heart research projects. This year, there are 25 researchers working on heart research projects under grants sponsored by the Heart Association of Northeastern Ohio. In addition to supporting research, money contributed to the Heart Fund will also be used to continue the work of community service programs, such as the Rheumatic Fever Prevention Program and the Work Classification Clinic. A public and professional education program designed to keep the layman and the profes-

tors across the country are making every effort to raise National's full goal of \$58,338,000. More than \$28,000,000, or 49 per cent of the total budget, is earmarked for Service to the Armed Forces and their families," Leahy continued, "which is the highest since World War II."

The leaders of United Appeal and Red Cross agreed not to conduct an organized solicitation for funds to make up the needed \$24,000 but will rely totally on spontaneous giving so that Red Cross can continue its work with more than 600,000 men committed to Vietnam.

Moscow State Symphony Here March 14th

The Moscow State Symphony, under the musical direction of Maxim Shostakovich will be heard during its second series of United States appearances at the Music Hall on Friday, March 14 at 8:30 p.m. under the auspices of the Cleveland Opera Association.

Intimately associated with such composers as Shostakovich, Prokofiev and Khachaturian, the orchestra was founded in 1936 in connection with the famous Moscow Conservatory, and during the thirty-three years of its existence, the Symphony has given more than 3,000 concerts. While performances throughout the Soviet Union have been extensive, the Symphony has seldom appeared outside its borders.

The Symphony has not only premiered most of the important Soviet music of the last two decades, but also has introduced to Russia the music of such American composers as Samuel Barber, Aaron Copland and George Gershwin.

In addition to its own series of distinguished conductors, the Mos-

cov State Symphony has played under the batons of such visitors as Otto Klempener, Erich Kleiber, Oska Fried, Andre Cluyens and Sir Malcolm Sargent, among others. The Symphony will have Nikolai Petrov as piano soloist, and Russian program will include: Symphony No. 5, Concerto No. 3 for Piano and Orchestra, and Entr'acte from the opera "Katerina Izmailova".
