## ČETE ZDRAVENIH NARODOV GREDO DELAT RED V KONGO

Varnostni svet je včeraj pooblastil glavnega tajnika ZN Hammarskjölda za sestavo posebne vojaške sile, ki pojde vzdrževati red v Kongu.

ZDRAVENI NARODI, N. Y. — Položaj v Kongu se je v zadnjih dneh tako zaostril, da se je domača vlada čutila prisiljena zaprositi Varnostni svet Združenih narodov za vojaško pomoč. V svoji prošnji je poudarila željo, naj bodo v vojaški sili samo čete nevtralnih držav, ne pa članic obeh svetovnih blokov. Včeraj v ranih urah je Varnostni svet po dolgi in ostri debati odobril tunizijski predlog, da naj Združeni narodi pošljajo v Kongo zaprošeno silo, ki bo prevzela nalogo vzdrževanja reda in mirov in omogočila s tem umik belgijskih čet na njihova oporišča.

NEW DELHI, Ind. — Splošni štrajk javnega uslužbenstva ni uspel, je pa vendar zavzel precejšen obseg in povzročil javni upravi, pa tudi sami vladni dosti skrbi. Na večih krajih je prišlo do izgredov in spopadov. V

Dohadu v zahodnem delu dežele je policija streljala na razjarjene demonstrante, pri čemer je bilo pet mrtvih. V celoti so tekom prvega dne štrajka prijeli okoli dva tisoč stavkujočih.

Policija je zastražila vse one naprave in ustanove, ki so za redno poslovanje potrebne. Ponovno je moralna nastopiti proti stavkujočim. Ti so skušali ponuditi ustaviti želesniški promet s silo, kar pa jim ni uspelo. Ponokod so bile prerezane telefonske in telegrafske napeljave.

### Nehru: Štrajk je izdaja dežele!

Predsednik vlade Nehru je pozval javno uslužbenstvo, naj ne štrajka, ker da je to izdaja v trenutku, ko je dežela ogrožena od zunaj in se bori doma za izvedbo novega gospodarskega načrta. Uslužbenstvo se je po večini držalo njegovega svarila iz strahu, da bodo mesta stavkujočih naglo zavzeli drugi, ker je število brezposelnih veliko. Nehru je svojim sodelavcem zatrjeval, da so za stavko komunisti, čeprav to na prvi pogled ni očito.

### Anglija želi revizijo pogodb o oporiščih ZDA

LONDON, Vel. Brit. — Tekom običajne debate o angleški zunanji politiki je ministrski predsednik Macmillan na zahtevo socijalistične opozicije izjavil, da bo predlagal Eisenhowerju revizijo pogodb o ameriških letališčih in oporiščih na angleških tleh.

Sedanja pogodba je bila sklenjena že 1. 1951, ko Anglija še ni imela ne svojega atomskega orožja, ne svojih raket. Treba je to torej prilagoditi stanju sodobne narodne obrame.

Macmillan se misli pogajati z Belo hišo po običajnih diplomatskih kanalih. Ne bo radi tega hodil v Washington.

Macmillan je ob tej priliki tudi izjavil, da še zmeraj veruje, bodo obenem imeli priliko, da so sestanki državnih poglabnabrejo kandidate za svoje varjev dobra ideja in da bo zopet oživil, ko pride čas za to.

## SEN. JOHNSON IMENOVAN NA DRUGO MESTO NA LISTI

Sen. Lyndon B. Johnson, glavni tekmeč sen. Kennedy, je bil imenovan za podpredsedniškega kandidata demokratske stranke na predlog Kennedyja. — Lista Kennedy-Johnson je po sodbi poznavalcev političnih razmer v deželi najmočnejša, kar jih je bilo mogoče sestaviti.

LOS ANGELES, Calif. — Kljub napovedim, da bosta nemara izbrana za podpredsedniška kandidata sen. Symington ali pa guv. Freeman iz Minnesote, je sen. Kennedy izbral za svojega tovariša na demokratski volivnici svojega glavnega in najnevarenejšega tekmeča sen. Lyndona B. Johnsona. Ta je bil nato imenovan, ne da bi klicali države poimensko. Nekateri liberalni krogovi na severu so se imenovanju upirali, vendar za to niso dobili dosti opore. Največja opozicija proti Johnsonu je bila v delegaciji države Michigan, malo manjša v delegaciji Kalifornije.

Sedanji biseromašnik, tedaj župnik v Dobropoljah, je poskrbel pri kmetih prostora za štiri Gorenje. Tako smo se srečali in kmalu videli, da jih je ta fara sprejela precej več. Bili so tam tudi Štajerci in nekaj drugih študentov, med njimi tudi pesnik Balantič, ki sem ga večkrat srečeval na tistih dobropoljskih njivah s knjigo pod pazduho. Mnogo tistih znancev je že mrtvih, od mnogih je živ starček, ki nas je vzel, duhovni svetnik Anton Merkun.

Tedaj je bil še živahen človek. Večkrat nas je študente spraševal kaj iz zdgodovine, stresal iz rokava učenost iz latinščine in grščine, še v tisti starici sanskr se je spuščal. In ko sem, navdušen nad starimi ljudskimi pesmimi, večkrat zvečer zašel tja pod hrib Sv. Antona, kjer mi je stara ženica, ležec za pečo, pella starinske pesmi s skrhanim glasom, sem bil ves srečen, da sem mogel spet zapisati nekaj starega. Pa je potlej prav ta ženica polila moje navdušenje z besedami: Naj vede, gospod, tele pesmi sem zapela že večkrat gospodu župniku, ki so jih še v note dali.

Prišla je starost. Leta v begunstvu so tekla in duhovni svetnik Merkun pri župniku Rev. Jagru pri Mariji Vnebovzeti gleda nazaj v preteklost. Štiri in osemdeset let je dolga doba, toda zdi se mi, ko starček gleda nazaj na mladost in na zrelo leta, se vsa ta doba združi v eno. Nov pogled se odpre na preteklost, zakaj v pozni starosti je vse preteklo obisjano že z zarjo od one strani in prav ta zarja daje preteklosti poseben sijaj. Težka in lepa leta, vse je zlito v eno, zakaj brez božje volje še vrabec ne pada s streho.

**Dvojna mera**

Sovjetska vlada se je obrnila na predsednika Varnostnega sveta z zahtevo, naj sklice njegovo sejo za razpravo o "napadnih dejanh" Združenih držav. Povod za to zahtevo je dalo letalo RB-47, ki so ga sovjetski letalci 1. julija sestrelili nad visokim morjem izven svojega suverenega področja.

Nikita Hruščev je objavil, da je letalo letelo mimo Svetega rta na polotoku Koli v smeri proti Arhangelsku, ko so ga Rusi sestrelili. Po tem poročilo naj bi bilo ameriško letalo nad sovjetskim področjem in naj bi podobno kot nekdaj letala U-2 ogledovalo in fotografiralo sovjetsko ozemlje.

Ameriška vlada odločno zanika sovjetske trditve, trdi, da letalo ni bilo nikdar nad sovjetskim ozemljem ter nikdar manj kot 30 milj od njega. V Washingtonu trdijo, da je bilo ameriško letalo sestreljeno nad visokim morjem, zato so zahtevali v Moskvi pojasnilo in posvarili Sovjetijo, da bo imel vsak podoben napad na ameriška letala v bodoče "resne posledice".

Združene države so izjavile, da debato v Varnostnem svetu o sestrelitvi ameriškega letala in o njegovem "krštvitvi" sovjetske suverenosti prav rade sprejmejo, da bodo imele tako priložnost razkriti sovjetsko hinavčino, sovjetsko-dvojno mero v međunarodnih odnosih. Primerov za to jim brez dvoma ne bo manjkalo.

Omenimo le, da so tako Kanadčani kot Amerikanci, ki stražijo v severnih predelih našega kontinenta svobodni svet pred nenadnim komunističnim napadom, ponovno videli sovjetska letala, ki so si ogledovala ne samo področja Sev. Ledenega morja, ampak letala tudi nad kanadskim koprom. V kolikor je javnosti znano, ni Kanada zaradi tega nikdar protestirala in kanadske ali ameriške letalske sile niso nikdar skušale teh sovjetskih letal sestreliti.

Sovjetske ribiške ladje se drže skoraj redno bližine ameriške obale v severnem Atlantiku. Pri svojem "ribolovu" so nekajkrat poškodovale telefonske in telegrafske kable, ki vežijo Evropo z Ameriko. Amerikancem se je zdelo vedenje teh ribiških ladij sumljivo, pa so poslali na eno izmed njih svoje mornarice. Ti so našli na ladji zelo malo rib, pač pa vrsto naprav, ki jih ribiške ladje ne vozijo običajno seboj. Sovjetska vlada je zaradi te "kršitve svobode morja" ostro protestirala v Washingtonu.

Letošnjo spomlad je sovjetska ladja Vega prav od blizu opazovala preskušanje ameriške atomske podmornice Washington, ki je opremljena s Polaris izstrelki. Naša vojna mornarica je sedaj objavila, da ima dokaze za vohunjenje te sovjetske ladje, vendar jo ni pri njenem poslu nihče oviral, nihče motil.

V Moskvi so izgleda mnenja, da je vse, kar store oni, v soščaju in v skladu z mednarodnimi zakoni in predpisi, pri tem pa označujejo popolne zakonite korake držav svobodnega sveta za nasilje, napadalnost, izzivanje, imperializem ali celo "mednarodno gangstrstvo".

## Reporting from Washington

**A DJOURNMENT — UNTIL AFTER CONVENTION.** — Until the Majority Leadership in the Congress decided rather suddenly last week that rather than wind up the 86th Congress and adjourn sine die (without day), Congress would adjourn only until after the two national political conventions. This is an unusual situation, and one hard for the observer to understand. I opposed the recess. Under the Legislative Reorganization Act, Congress is supposed to adjourn by July 31st. To have gotten away and finished its business by the first week of July would have meant a slightly shorter session, but necessary business could have been accomplished with foresight. The session in August, expected to last just a few weeks, will replace what was cut off, so from that point of view the post convention meeting is not out of line. But the fact that it is a post-convention session is what has some critics of the Washington scene concerned, for it is likely that political considerations will largely dictate the activities of the extra meeting. In addition there will also be a "hurry up" atmosphere about the proceedings and under such pressures in most instances very little good is accomplished.

There are matters left in mid-air at this time, and I hope some of them will receive fair consideration. If the post-convention session will accomplish worthwhile legislation in the public interest, and not demean the House and Senate with merely the harangues of partisan political propaganda then it will be time well spent. While I share the misgivings about this session which others have expressed, I will hope for the best and lend my efforts to the passage of sound legislation.

## SMALL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION'S LOAN RECORD

A study made by one of the outstanding members of the House, the Honorable William M. McCulloch of Ohio's 4th District, of the loan record of the Small Business Administration since its establish-

ment in 1953 gives one a deep sense of the value of this organization. Through May, 1960, there have been 19,223 business loans granted in the U. S. for a total of \$929,500,000 with SBA portion amounting to \$786,800,000, the remainder being put up by participating local private banks or institutions. During this same period there have been 9,108 disaster loans—made to owners of homes, businesses or charitable institutions damaged or destroyed by storms, floods or similar natural disasters—for a total of \$6,000,000. Of this amount, SBA loaned \$2,400,000, the remainder coming from local participating banks. In the State of Ohio, the total of SBA business loans has been \$74 for a total cash outlay of \$40,151,896. In the 22nd District there have been 9 loans totaling \$417,976.

## KING OF THAILAND SPEAKS TO CONGRESS

The King of Thailand addressed a joint meeting of the House and Senate last week and was given a tremendous ovation. He was truly delightful!

The King mentioned the good will existing between his country and the United States and stated that the time has come for even closer cooperation." He expressed deep appreciation for the aid given to his country under the Mutual Security Program and was acclaimed when he stated, "We are grateful for American aid, but we intend one day to do without it."

## VETERANS HOME LOAN PROGRAM EXTENDED

Congress has completed action on a bill to extend the Veterans' Home Loan Program to July 25, 1962. The program otherwise would have expired this year on July 25th. According to the Report of the Committee on Veterans Affairs, of the 14,330,000 World War II veterans, only 4,944,300 have used their entitlement benefits. Of this total, 4,657,100 were for homes, 228,400 were for business ventures; and 69,800 were for farms and farm equipment.



Census Bureau to Make  
Survey of Consumer  
Buying Plans

Special questions on consumer plans to purchase automobiles, air conditioners, clothes dryers, and hi-fi equipment, including radios and phonographs, will be asked in the July Current Population Survey, it was announced today by Director John E. Tharaldson of the Census Bureau's regional field office at Detroit, Mich.

The special questions are in addition to the regular inquiries on employment and unemployment which are asked each month of a sample of the population in the Current Population Survey. The information is being collected for the Federal Reserve Board for use in a national study of consumer buying plans.

The questions about air conditioners, clothes dryers, and hi-fi equipment cover present ownership and date of purchase of any of these items, as well as plans to purchase one in the next three to six months. For automobiles, information will be obtained not only on ownership and buying plans, but also on methods of financing, outstanding indebtedness on the car, and recent repair costs.

The Current Population Survey will be conducted locally and in 329 other areas of the country during the week of July 18. Information will be collected here by duly accredited interviewers.

Ohio Turnpike Breaks  
Record

A record-breaking flood of more than a quarter of a million vehicles travelled the Ohio Turnpike without a single serious accident during the four-day July Fourth holiday week end and resulted in toll collections of \$359,573, the Chairman of the Ohio Turnpike Commission, James W. Shocknessy, said today. Toll revenue on Saturday, July 2, was \$109,900, the highest ever realized on a single day since the turnpike was opened almost five years ago.

The safety aspect of the turnpike's big week end paralleled that of the Memorial Day week end on the toll road and was the more notable because of the heavier burden of traffic on the turnpike during the first four days of July, Shocknessy said. Although 253,964 vehicles used the turnpike in the four-day period there were only 23 accidents and of those only three involved personal injuries, none of which was serious.

## MISLEADING COMPARISONS


Much has been made of the fact that numbers of medicines cost less in other countries than here. And some people deduce that the American consumer is being exploited.

Actually, price comparisons between one country and another, no matter what the commodity or service in question, present an extremely difficult problem — the variables are enormous in number and complex in character. But one of the most important of those variables is measurable — wages. U.S. wage costs are at least three times those of Europe, and still higher than those of other regions. That's why, to take a simple example, a haircut costs only 42 cents in Dublin.

The pharmaceutical companies which produce the medicines pay American wages — not European or Asiatic wages. And these companies can't offset the labor cost differential by mechanization or other money-saving innovations. Obviously, the thinking of a biochemist in a research laboratory cannot be mechanized.

Moreover, a judgement based on prices alone is a fallacious and misleading one. A far more accurate indicator is the hours of labor it takes the average worker to earn enough to buy a given amount of a product. This comparison has been made in the case of an important and typical drug. It was found — based on 1959 retail prices — that it took West German, Canadian, Italian and Japanese workers much longer to earn the price than did the American workers. Only in France was the working time involved somewhat less than in the United States.

Our wage standards are the highest in the world. Our price levels must reflect that fact.

**Camperships for Crippled Children**

"Dave just sits and watches TV and my heart aches for him. There are no children for him to play with — they're either two-year olds or boys going off to play baseball or to Boy Scout camps."

"We are saving for his new braces which he'll need in the fall and he will have to have a new wheel chair soon, as his has been repaired three times. If there are any camperships or partial camperships still available, it would be wonderful; I might have to use his brace money otherwise, as I believe camp will be so important for him this year."

The anxious mother of a 13-year old boy, crippled from birth, but able to walk enough to enjoy a camping experience, wrote the appealing letter noted above to the Ohio Society for Crippled Children and Adults in Columbus, in regard to the two summer periods for crippled children at Camp Pittenger, near Tiffin, August 7 to September 2. Dave has been going to Camp Pittenger since 1955, but the added expense of a new one-floor home to make it easier for his parents to care for him, had taken the family's savings.

Throughout Ohio hundreds of crippled boys and girls, who would benefit by two weeks at Camp Pittenger, but who are not able to attend because parents of crippled children must spend extra money for medical care and needed appliances, are hoping for camperships. Usually provided through county crippled children's societies, Rotary, Kiwanis and Lions Service clubs, Business and Professional Women's Clubs, Federated women's clubs and other organizations and individual funds for payment of the camp fees are being received now at the Ohio Society office, 311 Kendall Place, Columbus.

"Crippled children's sessions at the Tiffin camp are planned as part of the rehabilitation process which must include recreational activities and an opportunity to develop social responsibilities, in addition to their parents' protective care," Walter B. Underwood, executive director, emphasizes.

Camp Pittenger, located on 30 acres of wooded land in the Sandusky River valley accommodates 100 children at each of the two periods. C. H. "Casey" Klipper, dean of boys' work leaders in Ohio, is di-

rector and counselors are provided on the basis of one for each four children.
