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#### ZAVODI, DOMOVI IN DRUGE USTANOVE ZA OTROKE IN MLADOSTNIKE S POSEBNIMI POTREBAMI, SLOVENIJA, 2004


- ▶ V letu 2004 je bilo v Sloveniji:
- ▶ 8 zavodov za otroke in mladostnike s težjimi in težkimi motnjami v duševnem razvoju,
- ▶ 5 zavodov za slepe in slabovidne, gluhe in naglušne ter otroke in mladostnike z ovrarnimi pri gibanju,
- ▶ 11 zavodov za vedenjsko in osebnostno motene otroke in mladostnike ter
- ▶ 12 zavodov, domov in drugih ustanov za otroke in mladostnike z lažjimi in zmernimi motnjami v duševnem razvoju.
- ▶ V prvih je bivalo 837 otrok in mladostnikov, za katere je skrbelo 833 zaposlenih, v drugih je bilo vključenih 361 otrok in mladostnikov, za katere je skrbelo 229 zaposlenih, v tretjih je bivalo 405 otrok in mladostnikov, za katere je skrbelo 376 zaposlenih, v zadnjih pa je bivalo 304 otrok in mladostnikov, za katere je skrbelo 134 zaposlenih.

- ▶ In 2004 in Slovenia there were:
- ▶ 8 institutions for seriously and very seriously mentally handicapped children and youth,
- ▶ 5 institutions for blind and weak-sighted, deaf and partially deaf, and physically handicapped children and youth,
- ▶ 11 institutions for behaviourally and personally handicapped children and youth, and
- ▶ 12 institutions, child and youth homes and other establishments for slightly and moderately mentally handicapped children and youth.
- ▶ In the first group there were 837 children and youth and 833 employees were taking care of them. In the second group there were 361 children and youth and 229 employees were taking care of them. In the third group there were 405 children and youth and 376 employees and in the last group there were 304 slightly and moderately mentally handicapped children and youth and 134 employees were taking care of them.


Chart 1: Number of children and youth, placed in institutions, child and youth homes and other establishments for children and youth with special needs, Slovenia, 1995–2004




Chart 3: Children and youth in institutions for behaviourally and personally handicapped, as to the educational attainment of their parents, Slovenia, 2004

je statistično spremljanje otrok in mladostnikov s posebnimi potrebami, ki so v oskrbi zavodov, domov in drugih ustanov za otroke in mladostnike s posebnimi potrebami, ter zaposlenih v teh ustanovah.

### Enote opazovanja

so zavodi, domovi in druge ustanove za otroke in mladostnike z lažjimi, zmernimi, težjimi ali težkimi motnjami v duševnem in telesnem razvoju ter za gluhe in naglušne, slepe in slabovidne, za otroke in mladostnike z ovirami pri gibanju ter za vedenjsko in osebno-stno motene otroke in mladostnike.

### Vir podatkov

so letni statistični vprašalniki SOC-ZU, ŠOL-ZU in ŠOL-MVO, ki jih pošiljamo v izpolnjevanje zavodom, domovom in drugim ustanovam za vzgojo, izobraževanje, usposabljanje, delo in varstvo otrok in mladostnikov z lažjimi, zmernimi, težjimi in težkimi motnjami v duševnem in telesnem razvoju ter za vedenjsko in osebno-stno motene otroke in mladostnike. Zbrani podatki o opazovanih enotah se nanašajo na stanje 31. 12. tekočega leta.

### Definicije in pojasnila

**Otroci s posebnimi potrebami** so po Zakonu o usmerjanju otrok s posebnimi potrebami (Ur. I. RS, št. 54/2000) otroci z motnjami v duševnem razvoju, slepi in slabovidni otroci, gluhi in naglušni otroci, otroci z govorno-jezikovnimi motnjami, gibalno ovirani otroci, dolgotrajno

## METHODOLOGICAL EXPLANATIONS

### Purpose of the survey

is statistical monitoring of children and youth with special needs, placed in institutions, child and youth homes and other establishments for children and youth with special needs, and of employees in these institutions.

### Observation units

are institutions, child and youth homes and other establishments for slightly, moderately, seriously and very seriously mentally and physically handicapped children and youth, as well as for blind and weak-sighted, for deaf and partially deaf, for physically handicapped children and youth and for behaviourally and personally handicapped children and youth.

### Data source

are annual statistical questionnaires SOC-ZU, ŠOL-ZU and ŠOL-MVO, which are sent to the institutions, child and youth homes and other establishments for education, training, work and guardianship of slightly, moderately, seriously and very seriously mentally and physically handicapped children and youth and for behaviourally and personally disturbed children and youth. The data are collected for each observation unit as of 31 December in the current year.

### Coverage

is complete.

### Definitions and explanations

**Children with special needs** are according to the Act on Placement of Children with Special Needs (OJ RS, No. 54/2000) mentally handicapped children, blind and weak-sighted, deaf and partially deaf children, children with problems concerning speech, physically handicapped children,

**Zavodi za otroke in mladostnike s posebnimi potrebami usposabljujo** in izobražujejo otroke, mladostnike in mlajše polnoletne osebe, ki zaradi motenj v duševnem in/ali telesnem razvoju potrebujejo posebne oblike vzgoje, izobraževanja in usposabljanja (Ur. I. RS, št. 12/96).

**Stopnje usposabljanja otrok in mladostnikov v oddelkih za vzgojo in izobraževanje (DU) v okviru zavoda ali osnovne šole:** Na prvi stopnji je poudarek na razvijanju samostojnosti, govornih sposobnosti in osnov socialnega vedenja in ročnih spremnosti (z zaznavanjem, gibanjem in igro). Na **drugi stopnji** je poudarek na oblikovanju otrokove samostojnosti, poučenosti o okolju, sporazumevanju, govornem razvoju, razvijanju ročnih spremnosti, pridobivanju delovnih navad. Vzgoja in izobraževanje na **tretji stopnji** sta usmerjeni k orientaciji in stikom z okoljem, k oblikovanju delovnih navad, osvajaju tehnik, k navajanju za proizvodno delo v posebnih okoliščinah in k socialni povezanosti z okoljem.

### KOMENTAR

V letu 2004 je bilo v Sloveniji 8 zavodov za otroke in mladostnike s težjimi in težkimi motnjami v duševnem razvoju; v teh zavodih je bilo 837 otrok in mladostnikov, zanje pa je skrbelo 833 zaposlenih. V omenjenih zavodih so prevladovali mladostniki, stari 22 let in več (52,2 %), glede na dolžino bivanja v teh ustanovah pa so prevladovali otroci in mladostniki, ki so v njih bivali od 15 do 20 let (25,3 %).

Zavodov, domov in drugih ustanov za slepe in slabovidne, gluhe in naglušne ter za otroke in mladostnike z ovirami pri gibanju, v katerih otroci in mladostniki lahko tudi bivajo, je bilo v letu 2004 v Sloveniji 5. Otrok in mladostnikov v njihovi oskrbi je bilo 361. Od teh je bilo največ otrok in mladostnikov z ovirami pri gibanju (72,3 %) Sledili so jim gluhi in naglušni otroci in mladostniki (18,8 %) ter slepi in slabovidni otroci in mladostniki (8,9 %). V teh zavodih, domovih in drugih ustanovah so prevladovali otroci in mladostniki, stari 17 let (11,9 %) in do 10 let (11,4 %).

Zavodov, domov in drugih ustanov za otroke in mladostnike z lažjimi in zmernimi motnjami v duševnem razvoju je bilo v letu 2004 12, v njih pa so bivali in se izobraževali 304 otroci in mladostniki. Od teh jih je največ obiskovalo osnovno šolo (45,7 %), sledili so jim tisti, ki so bili vključeni v oddelke za delovno usposabljanje (28,0 %), 26,3 % pa jih je obiskovalo srednjo šolo. Skoraj polovica (49,3 %) vseh teh otrok in mladostnikov je bila stara od 15 do 18 let.

V zavodih za otroke in mladostnike z vedenjskimi in osebnostnimi motnjami je bivalo 405 otrok in mladostnikov; največ jih je bilo iz Ljubljane (13,3 %). Čas njihovega bivanja v omenjenih zavodih je različen, večina pa v njih ostane več kot 24 mesecev. V dom so bili sprejeti večinoma po odločbi centra za socialno delo (84,0 %). Največ otrok in mladostnikov v teh zavodih je starih od 14 do 18 let (68,4 %)

Sestava otrok in mladostnikov v teh zavodih glede na šolsko izobrazbo njihovih staršev je bila v letu 2004 taka: 18,5 % otrok in mladostnikov je imelo starše z nepopolno osnovno šolo, 30,6 % z osnovno izobrazbo,

children with long-term illnesses, children with a lack in some fields of education and training, and children with behavioural and personal disturbances who need special implementation of programmes of education and training and with additional professional help or special programmes of education and training.

**Institutions for children and youth with special needs** educate and train children, youth and young, disabled adults who, due to physical and/or mental handicap, require special forms of education and training (OJ RS No. 12/96).

**Levels of training children and youth in class units for training of children and youth with severe developmental difficulties within the institutions or elementary schools by level of training:** The goal at the **first level** is to develop independence, talking and basic social behaviour and manual skills. The goal at the **second level** is to form child's independence, learning about the environment, communication, talking, evolving manual skills and acquisition of working habits. Education and learning at the **third level** are aimed at orientation and contacts with the surrounding world, at evolving manual skills, assimilating techniques, accustoming to the manufacture work under specific conditions and social connection with the surrounding world.

### COMMENT

In 2004 there were 8 institutions for seriously and very seriously mentally handicapped children and youth in Slovenia. There were 837 children and youth in these institutions and 833 employees were taking care of them. Most people in these institutions were youth aged 22 and more (52.2%). As regards the length of stay in the institution, most of the children and youth stayed there between 15 and 20 years (25.3%).

In 2004, there were 5 institutions, child and youth homes and other establishments for blind and weak-sighted, for deaf and partially deaf and physically handicapped children and youth in which children and youth can also stay. They took care of 361 children and youth. Most of the children and youth were physically handicapped (72.3%), followed by deaf and partially deaf (18.8%), and blind and weak-sighted children and youth (8.9%). Most people in these institutions, child and youth homes and other establishments were children aged 17 years (11.9%) and up to 10 years (11.4%).

In 2004, 304 slightly and moderately handicapped children and youth lived and were educated in 12 institutions, child and youth homes and other establishments. Most of them (45.7%) were attending elementary school. They were followed by those attending class units for training of children and youth with severe developmental difficulties (28.0%), while 26.3% were in upper secondary school. Most children and youth (49.3%) were aged between 15 and 18 years.

In institutions for behaviourally and personally handicapped children and youth, there were 405 children and youth and most of them were from Ljubljana (13.3%). The duration of their staying is different, but most of them were there for more than 24 months. Children and youth were accepted by the institutions mostly by the order of the centre for social work (84.0%). Most children and youth in these institutions (68.4%) were aged between 14 and 18 years.

As regards the educational attainment of the parents of children and youth placed in such institutions in 2004, 18.5% did not complete elementary school, 30.6% had complete elementary school, 31.4% had

Deleži otrok in mladostnikov v zavodih za vedenjsko in osebnostno motene otroke in mladostnike glede na sestavo družine, iz katere prihajajo, so se v letu 2004 gibali takole: največ otrok in mladostnikov, 42,0 %, je pred odhodom v dom živilo samo z materjo, 35,6 % jih je živilo z obema staršema, 11,4 % samo z očetom, 6,4 % jih je bilo brez staršev, 4,7 % teh otrok in mladostnikov pa je bilo v rejništvu.

complete upper secondary vocational education, 12.3% had complete upper secondary technical or general education and 1.7% had complete short-term tertiary education or higher education (university or equivalent).

As regards their family structure in 2004, 42.0% of children and youth placed in institutions for behaviourally and personally handicapped children and youth had only the mother, 35.6% had both parents, 11.4% had only the father, 6.4% of children and youth were without parents and 4.7% were in fosterage.

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
