Fejsal pošilja savdsko kraljevo družino v politično begunstvo

Kralj Savd se je moral odreči vsej svoji oblasti, vlado je prevzel njegov brat kot prestolonaslednik regent.

BEIRUT, Lib. — "Prestolonaslednik" Fejsal je že pokazal, da je postal pravi gospodar v Savdski Arabski. Je takoj povzemu oblasti naložil 7 glavnih sinov kralja Savda na letalo in jih poslal v tujino. To so tisti kraljevi sinovi, ki so mu delali največ preglavijo. Pravijo, da jim bo kmalu sledil tudi kralj sam. Kar bo še ostalo kraljevske družine, jo bo postavil pod policijsko nadzorstvo. Kot se vidi, Fejsal ne zaupa dosti svojim kraljevskim sorodnikom.

Fejsal je obenem tudi prevzel poveljstvo nad armado, postal sam sebi ministrski predsednik in si prilastil pravico, da podpisuje vse dekrete, ki jih je do sedaj podpisoval sam kralj.

V Džakarti trdijo, da nima toliko dolarjev, da bi lahko kupil to količino rizja. Indonezija bo torej morala še naprej prenašati lakota.

Indonezija se je končno osvobodila naše pomoči

DŽAKARTA, Indonez. — V Indonezijo je prispela zadnja pošiljka 40,000 ton ameriškega rizja, ki ga je tja poslala naša administracija na račun naših podpor. Od 1. 1950 naprej je naša dežela podprla Indonezijo z dobavom v vrednosti \$615 milijonov; sedaj je dobab konec, le nekaj malega v dobavah bombaža je še cdprto. V istem času so komunistične države dale Indoneziji \$639 milijonov kreditov, med njimi rdeča Kitajska samo za \$46 milijonov. Direktnih daril pa komunisti nočejo dajati.

Lanski predelek na riževih poljih je bil v Indoneziji precej slab, znašal je pod 10 milijonov ton. Sukarno bo torej moral uvoziti dober milijon ton, ako bo hotel preprečiti, da se sedanja lakota ne bo širila z Jave na druge otroke. Riž dobi lahko v Tajske in v Burmi, toda plačati ga bo moral in kupiti preko singapsurških posredovalcev.

SEATTLE, Wash. — Boeing Co. je za Narodno letalsko in vesoljsko agencijo (NASA) preuskusila možnost daljšega človekovega življenja v vesolju. Za 30 dni so 2. marca zaprili pet oseb v popolnoma izolirano celico ter to zapečatili. Tam so živel pod pogojem, kot bi živel v vesolju; ves čas so vdihavali isti zrak, ki je bil kemično prečiščevan, in uporabljali vodo, ki so jo čistili iz odpadkov. Hrano so pripravljali iz čisto izsušenih in zmrznenih jedi s tem, da so ji dodajali vodo.

Preskus je vodil dr. Eugene B. Konocci, direktor biotehnologije v raziskovanju človeka pri NASA. V celici so bili: 28 let star Roger Barnicki, poveljnik vojnega, Donald E. Robinson, 33 let star zdravnik v vojni mornarici, Ralwan Welker, Paul Trush in Warren Swenson, zadnji trije uslužbenci Boeing Co. Prvi trije so poročeni, zadnja dva pa ne.

Prvi deset dni je skupina živila ob hrani, kot je predvidena za astronauta, ki bosta v vesoljskem vozilu Gemini krožila koncem leta okoli Zemlje, preostale dni pa ob hrani, kot je predvidena za astronauta v vesoljski postaji. Glavna ovira začetku gradnje novega ameriškega nadzvočnega letala je vprašanje stroškov.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Čeprav še nihče ne ve, kdo bo plati stroške v znesku bilijona dolarjev za načrt novega nadzvočnega letala, ki bo letelo s hitrostjo 2,000 milj na uro, so strokovnjaki že z dušo in telekom pri izdelavi idejnih konceptov. Tako se bo glasilo poročilo, ki ga bo Federalna letalska agencija poslala ta teden predsedniku Johnsonu. Poročilo bo tudi omenjalo, da bosta pri načrtih sodelovali podjetja Boeing in Lockheed, ne bodo pa pritegnjeni strokovnjaki North American Aviation Corp.

Strokovnjakom se s pripravami za načrt tako zelo mudi, ker so s podobnimi načrti pečajo tudi francoski in angleški izvedenci, ki trdijo, da so njihovi načrti dobili že konkretno obliko. Sicer ne bodo dosegli hitrosti 2,000 milj na uro, pa vendar bi bilo nerodno, ako bi bili prehitri Amerikance.

SOVJETSKA KOMUNISTIČNA PARTIJA SE JE ODLOČILA ZA OBRAĆUN S KITAJSKO

Pravda, uradno glasilo Komunistične partije Sovjetske zveze, je prinesla posebno izjavo, v kateri ostro oboja Kitajsko Komunistično partijo, njeni oblastnost, njene poskuse polasti se vodstva svetovnega komunizma in razbijanja njegove enotnosti.

Potovanje izven našega osončja

Dve glavni oviri: hitrost in prekratko življene.

Vsi dosedanji vesoljski podvigi, pa najsi gre za ameriške ali sovjetske, so pri vsej svoji veličastnosti še vedno skromen, zelo skromen začetek.

Cloveška fantazija nima mesta. Toda možnosti so omejene zaradi togih in nepremostljivih zakonov prirode, ki jih naša moč ne more spremeniti. Zastavlja se nam torej vprašanje, ali je cloveštvo usojeno, da v svojih kozmičnih streljenjih nikoli ne bo prestopilo meja sončnega sistema oziroma ali so sploh mogoči poleti proti daljnim zvezdam, proti drugim planetom in planetnim sistemom, na katerih je možno življene, podobno našemu?

Na poti proti daljnim planetnim sistemom izven našega osončja obstajata dve barieri, oziroma nepremostljivi oviri. — Prva je — "svetlobna", to je načelna in sicer zaradi tega, ker je načelno nemogoče izdelati zapletena in da bo terjala neraketo, ki bi letela s hitrostjo, večjo od hitrosti svetlobe (300,000 km v sekundi). Druga zapraka pa je tako imenovana "bariera življene", to se pravi let na neko zvezdu, nekaj stozmeroma kratko cloveško življene, torej tudi življene kozmonavta.

Tudi če si zamislimo, da bodo biologji in medicinski strokovnjaki v bodočnosti znatno poskušali življenjsko dobo ljudi, je kaj malo upanja, da jim bo uspelo ustvariti nesmrtnega kozmonavta, vesoljskega potnika, ki se ne bo staral. Iz tega bi se dalo sklepati, da je cloveštvu nekako prepovedana pot proti daljnijim zvezdam, od katerih potuje na našo zemljo svetloba cela tisočletja.

Zdi pa se, da daje znanost na to vprašanje kaj nepričakovani odgovor: relativnostna teorija (Einstein), ki so jo s sodobnimi preizkusili že preverili in potrdili, pravi, da poteka v vesolju leteli rakete čas počasnejši kot ljudem na zemlji. Ta počasnejši tok časa pa je tem večji, čim večja je hitrost raket. Če se torej hitrost raket priблиža svetlobni hitrosti, obstaja teoretična možnost, da raketa v enem dnevu — računano, seveda, po uri na raketi — odleti tudi na oddaljeno zvezdo izven našega osončja in se spet vrne. Toda — pri vrnitvi na zemljijo bo astronaut opazil, da je v teku njegovega dne minilo na Zemlji več kot sto let. Čeprav se zdi vse to absurdno, je vendar vse, kar smo omenili, popoloma v skladu z znanstvenimi dejstvi in je bilo vse že potrjeno z natančnimi poizkusami.

Kakšne pa so tehnične možnosti za to, da bi izdelali kozmične ladje, ki bi letele s hitrostjo, ki bi bila blizu svetlobni hitrosti? Kakšno gorivo bi prišlo v poštev pri takšnih ladjah? — Raketno gorivo, ki ga uporabljamo, v takšnem primeru ne pride v poštev. Njegova toplotna sposobnost je mnogo preslabla. Da bi dali s takšnim gorivom raketni težki eno tono, hitrost, ki bi se približala svetlobni hitrosti, bi potrebovali milijone ton goriva; samo po sebi je umevno, da je kaj takega nemogoče.

Toda cloveštvo še začenja osvajati osnovne energetske resurse, s katerimi razpolaga naša. Jadrsko gorivo, na primer ima približno milijonkrat večjo topotno moč kot jo ima navadno, sedaj uporabljenog pogonsko gorivo, vendar bi tudi to gorivo ne bilo dovolj. Toda, neznana moč antimaterije, kolikor bo kdaj prišla v poštev kot raketno gorivo, nam odpira nove možnosti. Proračuni kažejo, da bi zadostovali tri in pol tone antimaterije v raketni in že bi lahko tvegali potovanje na planete izven našega osončja.

V naših laboratorijih smo se že zdavnaj naučili odkrivati an-telektrone, ki uhajajo iz radioaktivnih jeder. Veliko težje je bilo odkriti antiprotoni in anti-

Tako je glavni tajnik ZN U Tant povabil seboj ameriškega zastopnika pri ŽN Adlaija Stevensonja, da pojdet jutri skupaj v San Francisco na razgovore s tamkajšnjim županom in mestnimi očetji, če ne bi morata ti prevzeli računa za proslavo.

Naj bo že uspeh njune poti kakšen koli, že sama ta pot kaže, kako daleč so Združeni narodi v 20 letih prišli. Njihovo članstvo se je več kot podvojilo, da nimajo več sredstev za niti skromno proslavo 20-letnice svojega obstoja.

Gemini pred poletom

CAPE KENNEDY, Fla. — Po mesecih odlaganja je prišlo tako daleč, da bodo prihodnji torki poslali prvo vesoljsko vozilo Gemini na pot okoli Zemlje. Tokrat bo Gemini poletelo na pot brez astronavtov, prav tako še enkrat pozneje. Astronavta bosta poletela v novem vesoljskem vozilu na pot okoli Zemlje, če pojde vse po sreči, enkrat jeseni.

Vesoljsko vozilo Gemini, v katerem bosta dva astronavta skupaj poletela okoli Zemlje, je priprava na polet vesoljskega vozila Apollo, s katerim bodo ameriški astronavti skušali potovati na Luno enkrat koncem tega desetletja. Vesoljska ladja Gemini tehta okoli 7,000 funtov in jo bo na pot okoli Zemlje poigrala raketa Titan II., ki ima okoli 520,000 funtov potisne sile. Raketa Atlas, s katero so pošiljali v vesolje Mercury vesoljska vozila, ima le 362,000 funtov potisne sile.



Lunar Power Station

The moon can be harnessed to produce "dozens of trillions of kilowatts" of electricity for mankind, says a Nobel Prize-winner.

Soviet chemist Nikolai N. Semenov's suggestion is one of many proposals made amid increasing East-West cooperation in space research under the aegis of the United Nations. Adlai E. Stevenson, U.S. ambassador to the U.N., notes that the United States, Russia and some 60 other countries are working together in the field and that the U.N. and its agencies "are deeply involved in the exciting potentials of outer space."

One of the most exciting is down the sun's rays.

Semenov's theory, reported by the U.N. Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO).

By covering the lunar surface with conductors and photo-elements to collect energy from the sun, he says, the moon could be transformed into "a gigantic power station for the whole earth." Radio waves might then be used to transmit the power from the moon to our planet, he adds.

Although the moon is 16 times smaller than the earth, it receives as much solar energy as that which falls on the earth's continents. That's because the moon has no atmosphere to cut

Church Law
On Catholic Burial

Catholics in parishes of Lake and Geauga Counties and in the eastern section of Cuyahoga County have been alerted to the church law on Catholic burial.

In a letter to pastors in these areas, Msgr. Stanislaus B. Podbielski, diocesan Director of Catholic Cemeteries, calls attention to the fact that the Church regards the Catholic cemetery as God's acre and as the last resting place on earth.

"Restating the general law of the church," Msgr. Podbielski said, "Catholics must be buried in Catholic cemeteries."

A "preneers" sales campaign now under way for the sales of lots in a new cemetery in this area, in which Catholics are being told that it is permissible to be buried in a non-Catholic cemetery, has prompted the alert, Msgr. Podbielski said.

All Souls cemetery in Chardon was opened by Archbishop Edward F. Hoban in 1958, to meet the needs for Catholics in these areas.

"The Catholic cemetery is the extension of the Church into the next world," Msgr. Podbielski said, quoting from a pastoral letter issued in 1938. "Our dead belong to the church suffering and the Church triumphant and form one great communion with the church militant — all are baptized in the name of the Holy Trinity; all profess the same faith; all are temples of the Holy Ghost through sanctifying grace. All are brothers and members of Christ."

Msgr. Podbielski has issued the alert, he said to prevent any possible difficulties that may arise for purchasers of lots in other than Catholic cemeteries by Catholic families.

"All Souls cemetery is located on the north side of Route 6, and is about 15 minutes driving time from SOM Center Road (Route 91) and within one half hour driving time of any parish in the two counties and any of the parishes in the eastern part of Cuyahoga County," Msgr. Podbielski said.

The cemetery superintendent pointed out that "in keeping with Archbishop Hoban's efforts to provide for all spiritual needs of those entrusted to his care, not only in living but in death, three new cemeteries have been developed during his episcopacy in the diocese. The new Holy Cross, 14609 Brookpark Road, also an extension of Calvary Cemetery, Cleveland, and Holy Cross in Akron, have been part of this development.

The new All Saints cemetery in Northfield, Ohio at Brandywine and Highland Roads, will open this summer to serve Catholic families of Southeast Cuyahoga County and the Northern part of Summit County. About 50 acres of the 290 acre Northfield site has been developed.

Aluminum Doors

"What should be used on four-year-old aluminum storm doors to keep them looking new and free from tarnish?

If the doors are plain, mill-finished aluminum, the finest steel wool, such as scouring pads, will restore the original brightness.

If the doors have an anodized finish, soap, water and a sponge will do the trick.

If the doors have a patina finish topped with a vinyl-acrylic coating, wash them with soap and water once or twice a year to remove dust.

Once cleaned bright, one of the several so-called aluminum cleaners and coatings on the market can be fairly effective on mill finishes if used preventively every so often.

CHERRY BLOSSOM FESTIVAL

Cherry Blossom time in the Nation's Capital is drawing near. The Festival is scheduled to take place from April 7 through April 12. This annual event, which brings millions of visitors to Washington, had its beginning some 52 years ago when Mrs. William Howard Taft planted the first Japanese Cherry Tree on March 27, 1912. Viscountess Chinda, wife of then Japanese Ambassador, planted a second tree as a token of friendship between the people of Japan and the United States. This ceremony marked the official acceptance of a gift of 2,000 Japanese Cherry Trees which were planted in the Tidal Basin and Potomac Park area.

The outstanding events this year will be the 3-hour parade and pageant following, which includes the crowning of the Queen on Saturday, April 11th. Spring is a delightful time to visit the nation's Capital City. The blossoms and spring flowers, grass and budding trees seem to officially ordain the most pleasant season of the year.

THE PRESIDENT'S POVERTY MESSAGE

Last week the President sent Congress his long delayed recommendations for combating poverty. The following day the House Committee on Education and Labor began hearings on the "omnibus" poverty package — H. R. 10440 — a complicated bill of 46 pages. An examination of this legislation indicates that the President has found no panacea for the poor. Indeed, he makes no such pretensions, but he declares his program will chart "an entirely new course of hope . . ."

Specifically, he makes recommendations with an estimated first year cost of almost \$1 billion. No cost estimates are available for subsequent years, and presumably it could be an astronomical amount. The key section of the bill would create a "Job Corps" for unemployed youths 16-21 years of age. This is not a new idea as it is virtually identical with the Youth Conservation Corps bill, which has been stymied in the House Rules Committee for the past year. It is also reminiscent of the Civilian Conservation Corps of the 1933 depression days. A Washington columnist last week commented that "the yearly cost of sending a young man to one of the new Job Corps

camps would be approximately double the cost of sending him to Harvard for a year". Cost estimates for the Job Corps range from \$10,000 to \$40,000 per enrollee. Another program would "train volunteers to work in combating poverty". This is similar to the previously proposed National Service Corps or Domestic Peace Corps, which so far has received little support in Congress. Other provisions of the bill would provide federal funds for anti-poverty programs developed by communities; provide loans and grants to rural families for undertakings that would permanently increase their income; and give financial aid to individuals who would hire the unemployed.

The whole program would be directed through the Office of Economic Opportunity, a new Federal Agency to be created by the bill. The Agency would be headed by a Director with considerable authority and funds. Very few restrictions would be imposed on his use of funds, as the bill is presently written.

Many of the programs to be administered by the Director would overlap with existing functions of the Department of H.E.W. and other agencies.

No one denies the need for a full-scale effort to overcome poverty in America. It can best be alleviated by education, retraining workers and putting men back to work. Existing programs, such as the Manpower Development and Training Act, Vocational Education Act, and the National Defense Education Act are obvious bases for Federal participation.

It appears that a new approach is also needed, dealing not with the symptoms of poverty alone, but an attack on the root causes. Too often existing welfare programs, public works and subsidies by-pass the people needing the help. Too often taxpayer funds are spent, under the guise of social needs, to boost bureaucracy or assist those who could help themselves or could be helped by private enterprise. These latest Administration proposals should be examined most carefully for their effectiveness and the possibility of overlapping and duplication because of the fact that various Federal agencies will have jurisdiction over the same type problems. Cost will also be an important factor. If substantial taxpayers' dollars are to be spent on poverty, we want to make sure they will be well spent. Otherwise, the result may be a spreading of poverty rather than a lessening of it.

Cleveland Zoo's Children's Farm To Visit The City

It's quite common for city folk to visit a farm but it's rather rare and uncommon for a farm to visit a city.

So it will be an exciting event for Severance Center when the Cleveland Zoo's Children's Farm lambs, goats, pigs, rabbits, and guinea pigs with their bleats, oinks, squeaks and such, make their debut at that shopping center from April 3rd to 10th inclusive.

Lawrence Albert, Managing Director of Severance Center, welcomed the opportunity to promote the Zoo as a "total community asset." "Of interest," he stated, "is the fact that nearly all eastern suburbanites have always supported the Cleveland Zoo at the pools, but apparently have not taken full advantage of the facility. We hope this preview and display will be of assistance in this area."

The Children's Farm animals will be exhibited at Severance Center from 11:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. daily, except Saturday and Sunday. On Saturday, April 4th exhibit hours will be 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., and on Sunday April 5th from 12 noon to 5:00 p.m. The exhibit will close at 1:00 p.m., Friday, April 10th.

The beautiful 860 foot long Mall Area of Severance Center will also become an exhibition center for some of the Cleveland Zoo's more exotic animals. Large photographs of Lions, Zebras, Giraffes, Bongo Antelopes, Monkeys, a Harbor Seal, a Hippopotamus, and a baby Orang-Utan will be on display among the greenery and flowers of the planter islands on the Mall.

TUCSON, Ariz. — Headaches such as presented to Cleveland Indians' Manager Birdie Tebbets by his right field situation are the kind welcomed by most major league pilots.

A group of seven candidates, each armed with imposing credentials, is battling here daily to impress the Tribe's manager that he rightfully should hold down the right field position. To date, the competition has been so even that no one appears to have the inside rail.

Veteran Al Smith, certain to receive consideration because of his experience plus the fact that he hits from the right side of the plate, has been handicapped by an abscessed tooth which caused him to miss several games. Nonetheless, Smith's big bat which is usually a hot stick in the early stages of the American League season will cause Tebbets to think seriously about him.

Al Luplow, who was the Indians' right fielder in 1962 but who was used sporadically last year because of injuries and a low batting average, is making a determined effort to impress Tebbets that the job should be his. Al has displayed his usual verve and bustle here.

Then there is veteran Wally Post, signed as a free agent last fall. Whether Post's bat still contains the dynamite it possessed when Post was blasting National League pitchers for the past decade is something that must be determined. While Wally has not yet hit for a high average here, he has belted three prodigious home runs.

Rookies Bob Chance and Chico Salmon who won batting titles in their respective leagues last season, have shown enough talent here to indicate that they too must be reckoned with.

Chance, who led the Eastern League in 1963 in batting (.343), homers (26) and runs batted in (114), has been among the team batting leaders in the spring exhibition games and there appears to be little doubt but that the youngster, who batted .288 for the Indians last September in his brief stay with the club, can fathom major league pitching.

Salmon, whose .325 with Denver last year, paced Pacific Coast League

hitters, appears to be a very versatile performer who can hold down just about any of his outfield positions as well as most of the infield berths. He has been particularly impressive in the field here, saving one game with a heroic diving catch.

Young Tommie Agee, slow to start in spring training, has been hitting sensationaly of recent games and it is possible that his late surge may earn him a spot on the roster if not a regular position.

Then, to further muddle the right field situation there is on hand veteran Tito Francona, the Indians' left fielder in 1963. The acquisition of Leon Wagner this winter placed Francona in jeopardy in so far as that post is concerned but Francona is here determined to prove that his .228 batting average of last year was a fluke. Tito does possess a .278 lifetime mark in the majors and despite his late start because of a hernia operation, the New Brighton, Pa. resident vows that he will be in the starting lineup.

A very complicated picture, it must be admitted, is the Tribe's right field picture but one which all managers would love to have. While he gives the subject plenty of thought, it's not one to keep Tebbets awake nights.
