





## Policija streljala na črnce v Južni Rodeziji

Črni domačini v Južni Rodeziji zahtevajo več svobode in več pravic. Delavski štrajk črncev v Salisbury povzročil nemire in nastop belega vojaštva proti stavkujočim črncem.

SALISBURY, J. Rod. — Osrednje-afrška federacija, ki jo tvorijo Sev. in Juž Rodezija ter Njasa, postaja središče nemira v osrednji Afriki. Federacija je napol samoupravna dežela, ki pa je še vedno pod nadzorstvom britskega ministra za kolonije. Njena vlada, v kateri imajo večino pristaši Welenskega, skuša za vsako ceno federalno ohraniti in obdržati v njej vrhovno oblast belcev, čeprav ti ne predstavljajo v celoti niti petine prebivalstva.

Angleška kolonialna uprava spoznava, da so načrti in zahteve belcov črnim domačinom nesprejemljive. Vlada v Londonu je poslala v Federacijo R. A. Butlerja, ministra za Osrednje-afrške zadeve. Ta je začetkom tega tedna prišel sem. Tedaj so črnci začeli štrajk, ki ga je oklical Kongres afriških delavskih unij, za katerim pa stoji brez dvoma politična organizacija domačinov Afriška ljudska zveza.

Doba oblasti belcev se bliža koncu

Ko so tekmo stavke začeli črnci povzročiti izgredne in se tu in tam upirali ukazom policije, se oblastva poklicala na pomoč belo vojaštvo. Policija je dva dni zaporedoma streljala na črne štrajkarje, ko se niso marali pokoriti njenim ukazom. Pri tem je bilo 12 domačinov ranjenih, rekatere teže.

Delavska unija zahteva boljše delovne pogoje, pa tudi svoboščino v zborovanju. Afriška ljudska unija izjavila med tem, da je politična organizacija in da nima s štrajkom nobenega posla.

Napori belcev, da bi obdržali oblast v Osrednje-afrški federaciji, ne morejo uspeti. Če bo-

de beli gospodarji odlašali podelitev svobode domačinom predolgo, utegne priti do javne upora in gverilske vojne, kot je doživljala skoraj osem let Alžirija. V Londonu se tega zavedajo in skušajo bele koloniste v Rodezijah spraviti k pameti.

### Rusko poslaništvo v Washingtonu dober narocnik tiskovin

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Samo ena med tiskarnami v naši prestolici je dobila od sovjetskega poslanstva naročilo za \$240,000. Tiska sedaj propagandni material, ki ga poslanstvo pošilja po naši deželi kot pošto tretjega razreda. Material dobivajo tudi vse naše knjižnice, javne in zasebne.

Ker naša pošta ne dobi pri posiljkah tretjega razreda plačanih niti režijskih stroškov, podpiramo dejansko komunistično propagando po ovinku ameriški davkoplaca valci.

Sicer pa gremo komunistom na roko tudi v drugih zadevah. Tako so na primer kupili ruski komunisti samo v enem tednu 76,000 kopij naših patentov. Kopije patentov lahko kupi vsakdo, toda patentov ne sme rabiti. V Moskvi v tem vprašanju niso ravno preveč tankovestni, tako govorji skušnja.



**Army Passes Painful to Athletes:** As far as the Athletics are concerned, the Army can put its ball playing soldiers in the guard house over week-ends, instead of giving them passes.

For the second time this season, the A's lost to a soldier-pitcher when Mudcat Grant was credited with a 5 to 1 victory in Kansas City, May 6. The Cleveland right-hander appeared there through the courtesy of Fort Belvoir, Va., which gave him a week-end reprieve from his soldering duties.

Steve Barber, who hurles for the Orioles while on week-end passes from Fort Bragg, N.C., defeated the A's 5 to 1, April 15.

**First Pennant Winners Had Colorful Caps:** The Chicago White Stockings, winners of the National League's first pennant race in 1876, presented a colorful appearance, with each player wearing a cap of different color.

**Catchers Catching Little Louie:** Jim Pagliaroni's all-round catching has improved with his hitting this spring. The still youthful Red Sox catcher achieved considerable distinction in the May 6 double-header against the White Sox. He tossed out Luis Aparicio of the White Sox trying to steal second in each game.

Pagliaroni has now pegged out the American League's base stealing leader three times during the first eight meetings of the Boston and Chicago clubs.

According to Aparicio, Elston Howard of the Yankees is the only catcher to throw him out three times in one season before. That was last year.

**Mantle Student of Sluggers:** Now that Ted Williams is gone, Ralph Terry, New York hurler, says no one in the American League today can discuss the fine points of hitting any more eloquently than Mickey Mantle.


The objectives of the campaign are:

## Reporting from Washington

**THREE BILLS PASSED BY HOUSE.** The House went back to work last week, following the Easter Recess, and passed three bills which had been considered and recommended by the House Committee on Interstate and Foreign Commerce. One proposal, H. R. 6949, will eliminate a loophole in the Natural Gas Act which now bars the Federal Power Commission from suspending proposed rate changes with respect to sales of natural gas destined ultimately for industrial use only. It would put such proposed changes on the same footing and other private individuals and groups may play a vital role.

The second bill, H. R. 8031, would authorize the Federal Communications Commission to require manufacturers of television sets to equip their sets to receive UHF signals (ultra high frequency, 70 channels) as well as the present 12 channels in the VHF (very high frequency) portion of the radio spectrum. The Committee feels that the use of more UHF channels will enable the American people to enjoy more and better television service. Because of the scarcity of UHF receivers and therefore the limited number of listeners, there are only 103 UHF stations in our country. Only about 16 per cent of the television sets in the United States are equipped to receive UHF signals at present. By requiring all new sets to be capable of receiving both VHF and UHF stations, the Committee hopes to encourage the growth of UHF stations. The Committee reported that an all-channel TV set will cost about \$25 more than a comparable VHF-only set. It also stressed the need for UHF stations to promote the development of educational television.

The third bill, H. R. 11040, is to bring into being a private rather than a government corporation, which would be the U.S. participant in a global satellite communications system. This is a system of the future to provide more effective radio

## From the Indian Tepee

Cleveland, Ohio — Although but five weeks of the playing season have elapsed, freshman manager Mel McGaha of the Cleveland Indians already has displayed facets of patience and courage that augur well for the Tribe.

Best example is the manner in which he has handled the club's center field situation caused by the trade last summer which sent Jim Piersall to Washington for Dick Donovan, Gene Green and Jim Mahoney.

He believed that his best candidate to replace Piersall was young Ty Cline whose two seasons in the Cleveland farm organization had been most impressive ones.

The ex-Clemson College star joined the Mobile club of the Class AA Southern Association in June of 1960 and hit .311 in 95 games. Last year, which was his first full year in organized ball, Cline batted .290 in 144 games at Salt Lake City of the Class AAA Pacific Coast League.

Even to think of replacing one of the American League's premier outfielders with such an inexperienced young player may have bothered some managers. But McGaha opened the 1962 spring exhibition season with Cline in center and used him more than any other player in the hope that the experience thus gained would help Cline.

Cline responded with an excellent spring, hitting in a manner to support his minor league batting mark and showing enough ability in the field to warrant his being in the 1962 opening day lineup at Boston.

However, Cline failed to get a hit in the club's first three games and actually appeared very tight at the plate. When the Indians met Washington in the fourth game of the season, McGaha decided to rest the young man for a few days.

However, when the Indians played the New York Yankees in a twin bill at Yankee Stadium, Cline was back in the lineup. He responded with a double in his initial time at bat and then started a batting barrage that has cemented his position on the roster.

Although he is not a powerful hitter, his first six hits were for extra bases, five doubles and one

home run. The Indians are 10-10 after 16 games and Cline is 10-10 in 16 games.

McGaha has done a good job with the Indians and has shown that he can handle the pressures of the big leagues.

Another youngster in whom McGaha has displayed great confidence has been outfielder Al Luplow, the ex-Michigan State athlete. McGaha gave Luplow the same opportunity as he did Cline to make the grade in spring training and Luplow came through impressively.

His improvement both at bat and in the field was most dramatic over his 1961 appearances in Tucson and when it became apparent that he was ready, Tribe General Manager Gabe Paul was able to bolster the club's pitching staff by sending Vic Power to Minnesota for Pete Ramos. This deal necessitated moving Tito Francona from left field to first base and Luplow filled in there very capably until he pulled a leg muscle last week. Currently his batting average in 15 games is .286 and he has three home runs.
