**Lasallski glasovi in odmevi**

La Salle, Illinois, — V tukaj-dnehi kar dvakrat oropali. Prvišnjo okolico prihaja zadnja leta več in več raznih industrij, ki grade svoje delavnice. Mnoge družbe, ki so zadnja leta tu zgradile delavnice, pa iste povrčujejo, kar je znamenje, da tu uspevajo. Tvrda John Hobbs Division, ki je podružnica znane Stewart-Warner korporacije, gradi nadaljnno dodatno stavbo v bližnjem mestecu Spring Valley, ki je kakih dobre pet milij zapadno od nas. Tako poroča tamkajšnji župan William Savič. Hobbs delavnica in poslopja se nahajajo ob cesti št. 29, severno od mestnega vodovoda v Spring Valley. Posebno bolj drobne izdelke prevažajo danes večinoma vse z velikimi "trailerji", s katerimi dostavljajo naročila razpečevalcem in v trgovinam kar direktno in ni treba nobenega prekladanja s tovornih vlakov in od železnice zopet prevoz na naslove naročil. V sedanjem prometu vse to steje in se tega poslužujejo.

\* V NAKOMIS SO POKO-PALI zadnjega premogarja, ki se je pred 54 leti rešil iz strašne katastrofe, ki se je dogodila 13. novembra 1909 v Cherry premogokopu v tukajšnji sosednji vasi Cherry, ki je bila nekoč rudarska naseljina. Ta zadnji, ki se je tedaj rešil s skupino 21 premogarjev, ki so bili celih osem dni zasuti v rovu, je bil George Stimec. 259 rudarjev pa je pomrlo v tisti nesreči. Stimec, pravijo, da je bil edini še živi izmed tistih dosedaj. V Nakomisu so ga pokopali tik pred velikonočnimi prazniki.

\* VELIKONOČNE PRAZNIKE so vse kat. cerkve v našem mestu proslavile z lepimi obredi. Cerkve so bile polne vernikov. Cerkev sv. Roka je bila pri vseh mašah in službah božjih nabit polna. Duhanjnika pri cerkvi sv. Roka zaslužita vse priznanje za izborni cerkveno postrežbo vernikov. Ljudje to upoštevajo, zato so māstili vse službe božje številno obiskane.



Lumpe last year hit .301 for the Athletics and held the distinction of rapping out the most base-hits of any of the A's players.

Flame-Throwing Cheney Hottest in Cool Weather: Tom Cheney of the Senators, one of the hottest pitchers in the American League, says he is at his best in cool weather. — The flame-throwing righthander, who struck out 12 Tigers, May 1, in grabbing, a 4 to 1 victory — his fourth triumph of the season — would rather work in cool weather. That's a departure for pitchers, most of whom holler that they need hot weather to have their best stuff.

"I like pitching in cool weather," said Cheney. "A lot of times, on a hot day, you reach back for a little extra and it isn't there."

Rainers Copy Veeck Stunt With Exploding Scoreboard: The Seattle Rainers have unveiled an "exploding scoreboard" patterned after that of Chicago's White Sox.

The fireworks stunt, which salutes all Rainier home runs, proved a huge success to the opening-night crowd of 4,022 unsuspecting fans, April 23, but didn't make much of a hit with the visiting Denver Bears.

**ACT FOR INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT.** The Foreign Affairs Committee has begun its annual hearings on the Act for International Development for fiscal year 1964. Witnesses to date in open public hearings have included Secretaries Rusk and McNamara, General Lucius Clay and David Bell, Director of the Agency for International Development. Closed hearings concerning these overseas operations got underway immediately following the Easter recess and will continue well into the future.

The President requested a total of \$4.5 billion to carry out our programs of economic and military assistance throughout the free world. This is about \$420 million less than the budget estimate published in January. Readjustments have been made as a result of the reassessment of the program by the aid Agency under the new Administrator and the Clay Committee's general recommendations. Moreover, some funds were received from prior year programs and some fiscal year 1963 funds were withheld because the performance of several nations did not fully meet our expectations and criteria.

The figure of \$4.5 billion includes \$3.1 billion for economic assistance and \$1.4 billion for military aid. The Alliance for Progress represents \$650 million out of the \$3.1 billion requested. A closer breakdown reveals \$550 million for AID development loans and \$100 million for AID development grants. Other categories are as follows: (1) Supporting assistance—\$435 million, these funds are directly related to the maintenance of military forces by the recipient nations or other purposes of strategic significance. About half of these dollars are expected to be used in Viet-nam and Korea. (2) Contingency fund—\$300 million is requested to provide the U.S. with the flexibility to meet quickly certain unexpected political and security crises. (3) International Organizations—\$136 million is requested for funding U.S. voluntary contributions to eight international programs such as support of the UN, UNESCO, UNICEF, etc. Military assistance is the other major area

volumes, classrooms, science laboratories, a modern speech laboratory, refectories, and chapel. The high school section has its own auditorium, library, classroom building, refectory, dormitory buildings and chapel.

In the coming weeks each one of these categories of assistance as well as each recipient nation will be carefully reviewed and re-evaluated in the light of present circumstances for the purpose of preparing a program consistent with the overall security of the United States. There probably will be more cuts than have yet been examined.

**FEED GRAIN LEGISLATION**

Among the bills passed by the House last week was H.R. 4997, to extend the Administration's very expensive Feed Grains Program for an additional year. It was stated that this program cost the taxpayers \$1.7 billion for 1961-62 and has been very ineffective in reducing the huge surplus of grain now in storage, which was one of its major objectives. The final vote was 200 to 196. I voted against the proposal, which was also strongly opposed by the American Farm Bureau Federation. This measure places powerful control in the hands of the Secretary of Agriculture and will, if approved by the Senate, further hamstring farm operations and impose stricter governmental controls. In addition, many of the Members of the House had urged that the bill not be considered until after the nationwide wheat referendum which is scheduled for May. If this had been done, it would have given the Congress an opportunity to witness, at first hand, just how the grain producers of this country feel about government restrictions on farm operations.

**AID FOR VETERANS' WIDOWS**

All widows of World War II veterans are reminded by the Veterans Administration of a GI benefit often overlooked. The widow of a veteran who has not remarried is eligible for a VA-guaranteed mortgage to buy a home on the same terms her husband might have had if he were living.

**Open House at Borromeo Seminary**

**AIMS AND PURPOSES**

Borromeo Seminary of Ohio is the newest accredited school in Ohio. It comprises two distinct and separated departments: the High School, and the College. Each of these has its own complete facilities.

The over-all purpose of the whole institution, High School and College, is to provide an opportunity for a liberal arts education. It is a school to prepare young men in the field of liberal arts in order that these young men thereafter will be able to take further specialized training for the Roman Catholic priesthood.

The students enrolled at Borromeo Seminary are drawn mainly from eight counties in the northeastern part of Ohio, namely, Cuyahoga, Lake, Lorain, Summit, Geauga, Medina, Wayne and Ashland Counties, which comprise the geographical area of the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland.

Students are trained in the schools of the institution for spiritual, educational and social work of diocesan priests in the Diocese of Cleveland.

Borromeo Seminary is primarily interested in the educational and spiritual development of men, with special emphasis both upon scholastic attainment and character. Another primary objective is the imparting to students of the knowledge necessary for the priestly ministry. The vocation to the priesthood calls for an outlook on life that is based on faith, as well as for certain extraordinary traits of character which must distinguish the priest from men of other professions. The program of Borromeo Seminary has been developed with a view to these requirements for moral and intellectual attainment. The seminary rule of life, with its spiritual exercises and its training and discipline, as well as the rigid scholastic proficiency required, aims at developing men with an excellent liberal arts education who will excel in virtue and leadership.

**HISTORICAL SKETCH**

The institution for the education of clergy for the Diocese of Cleveland dates back to 1848. In that year Bishop Armande Rappe, the first Bishop of the Diocese of Cleveland, started a seminary in his house. Since that time, with the exception of only a few years, there have been seminaries in the Diocese of Cleveland for the training of priests. Until 1953, however, there existed but one seminary in the



Director of Information, Agrow Seed Company**A FLOWER BED AGAINST A FENCE**

Not counting the unintentional mess in which tall and short plants are all mixed up, there are just two basic types of flower beds; those with the tallest plants at the center and those with the tallest plants at the back, normally against a fence, wall, or house. The first is called an "island" bed and is common in parks. Those in the second category are called "wall" beds and "corner" beds, well enough described by their names. The wall bed is probably the most useful type and certainly the most commonly used for home decorations.



In planning a wall bed you must think of both shape and size. Size is three-dimensional. There is the length of the bed along the fence or wall, the distance from the fence or wall to the front of the bed, and the height of the various plants in front — old-fashioned, but pretty 4 feet.

As for the shape of the bed, it's a matter of choice, but most landscape architects avoid straight lines or wall to the front of the bed, and with sharp corners and single straight rows of plants. They prefer a curved outline for the bed as a whole and "drifts" rather than uniform rows. A drift may be wider at one end than at the other and may overlap another drift slightly. Arrange the drifts as you please, only don't go too far in back may impose some grudging decisions if you want to go up over 3½ feet or so. Sunflowers, titianas, castor beans, and hollyhocks are all in the "over 5 feet" class, but the first three are rather coarse and the last does not give very solid cover. Still, if you have something that tall which you really want to cover up, use Sungold sunflower. Then around the 4-foot level are cleome and cosmos, both very easy to grow and not too weedy looking.

The length need not be our concern here. You can decide that without our help, on the basis of how much space you want to fill and how ambitious you feel about digging. The height of the bed at the back may impose some grudging decisions if you want to go up over 3½ feet or so. Sunflowers, titianas, castor beans, and hollyhocks are all in the "over 5 feet" class, but the first three are rather coarse and the last does not give very solid cover. Still, if you have something that tall which you really want to cover up, use Sungold sunflower. Then around the 4-foot level are cleome and cosmos, both very easy to grow and not too weedy looking.

How many different kinds of flowers should you put in the bed? Go as far as you like or keep it very simple. It is not absolutely necessary to have more than a single species. Cleome, for one, looks good all by itself. But, most tall flowers, and particularly the ones that are rather thin as well as tall, look leggy and unattractive near the ground. So, put comparatively low-growing flowers like dwarf marigolds or petunias in front. These look good all the way down to the ground, so that still lower flowers like sweet alyssum or portulaca are like white sidewalk tires. But, if you like sweet alyssum or portulaca or white sidewalk tires, for that matter — go ahead and enjoy yourself!
