**Način prehrane se je v zadnjih 60 letih v ZDA močno spremenil**

V letih pred prvo svetovno vojno smo porabili na osebo še enkrat več moke, pa po vojno manj govedine kot zdaj.

CHICAGO, Ill. — Ko se v teh dneh jezimo na drago meso, ne pomislimo niti malo na to, da so ga naši predniki jedli veliko manj in da bi bilo nemara dosti cenejše, če bi ga tudi mi jedli le toliko, kot so ga oni. Pred dobroimi 60 leti je prišlo na osebo pri prehrani v ZDA letno 200 funtov muke, okoli 180 funtov krompirja, preko 50 funtov jabolka, pa le nekaj nad 50 funtov govedine in okoli 65 funtov sladkorja.

Sedaj použije povprečni Amerikanec na leto le nekaj nad 100 funtov muke v svoji hrani, nekaj več krompirja, pa zato okoli 120 funtov govedine, preko 100 funtov sladkorja, nad 40 funtov perutnine in precejšnje množine južnega sadja, zato pa zelo malo jabolka.

Sprememba hrane in načina prehrane ni mogla ostati brez vpliva na cene. Ljudje drugod po svetu, izjemo Argentine, jedo sorazmerno manj mesa in so ga jedli do pred nekaj leti še veliko manj, ker jim je bilo predrago. V zadnjih letih, ko se je živiljenjska raven v mnogih delželah zvišala, je porastla proračna mesa in s tem povpraševanje po njem. To je povzročilo dvig cen, h kateremu je v zadnjih mesecih doprineslo svoje tudi zmanjšanje vrednosti našega dolara. Preje smo mi kupovali meso v tujini in ga nam je ta naravnost ponujala v vsiljevala, sedaj ko je dolar za 20-25% manj vreden, ga hodijo k nam kupovat Japonci in zahodni Evropeji. Ti so do neke mere kriji, da so v zadnjem in tem mesecu porastle cene klavničini.


**Sovjetija povečala svoje vojne brodovje v Sredozemskem morju**

NAPOLI, It. — Sovjetska zveza je v zadnjih tednih povečala število svojih vojnih ladij v Sredozemskem morju na okoli 60 ladij in mu dodala tudi novo križarko vrste Kara, oborožene z raketami in obsegajoči 9,000 ton.

Z vključitvijo te vrste križark in križark razreda Kresta II ima ZSSR zdaj najmočnejše pomorske sile v Sredozemskem morju vse od leta 1970, ko je imela tam okoli 70 vojnih ladij tekom pomorskih vaj "Ocean".

Pomorski strokovnjaki vidijo v sedanjem sovjetskem vojnem brodovju v Sredozemskem morju višek napora adm. Sergeja S. Gorškova zgraditi in organizirati v tem morju sovjetsko pomorsko silo, ki bi bila sposobna učinkovito meriti svoje moći z ameriško Sesto floto, ki obvladuje Sredozemsko morje zadnjih 25 let.

**Urugvaj prikel mrilce ameriškega policeja**

MONTVEVIDEO, Urug. — Oblasti so prijete štiri osebe, ki so osušljene ujetja in umora ameriškega policijskega strokovnjaka Dan A. Mitrione-ja leta 1970. Peti udeležence ugrabitev in umora naj bi bil ubit v avtomobilski nesreči.

D. Mitrione, bivši policijski načelnik v Richmondu, Ind., je bil od Agencije za mednarodni razvoj poslan v Urugvaj. Tam so ga 31. julija 1970 ugrabili gverilci Tupamaro. Za njegovo izpuščitev so zahtevali ugrabitelji svobodo vseh političnih jenitnikov v Urugvaju. Ko je bila njihova zahteve odloknjena, so Mitrione-ja umorili in ga pustili v nekem zaparkiranem avtu ob cesti Montevidea.

Oblasti sedijo, da je bil moški 25 let stari Antonio Mas Mas, španski državljan, ki se je pridružil Tupamarom kot študent medicine v Montevideu.

Poleg njega so v zaporu se Henry Engler, Esteban Jorge Pereira in Rodolfo Woolf. Armando Blanco Katras, peti člen tolpe je že mrtev. Po podatkih oblasti je bil vodnik skupine Engler in on je dal ukaz za umor, ki ga je nato Mas Mas izvrnil.

Sorazmerno na prevzeme milje je bilo lani na naših cestah najmanj mrlivih, pa je to število — 56,300 — Klub temu presog je vse dodačen!

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Zvezda uporabljalec ameriških avtocest je objavila, da je bilo v letu 1972 na vseh 100 milijonov prevzetenih milj 4,5 mrlivih v prometnih nesrečah, to je manj kot kdajkoli prej.

Leta 1971 je bilo na 100 milijonov milj mrlivih 4,7, leta 1982

5,2, leta 1954 7,4 in leta 1936 celo 15,1.

Klub sorazmerno manjšemu številu nesreč v razmerju na prevozene milje je absolutno število mrlivih v prometnih nesrečah na ameriških cestah lani poraslo na 56,300 napram 54,700 v letu 1971.

Poleg smrtnih nesreč je bilo še preko dva milijona oseb v teh nesrečah delno po hobljenih, skupna škoda je bila preračunana v letu 1972 na 17,3 milijone dolarjev, leta prej pa na 15,8 milijonov.

Klub "najmanjšemu" sorazmernemu številu mrlivih na naših cestah, je številka 56,300 izredno visoka. To je ljudi že za celo srednje veliko mesto, ki bi ga bilo brez dvema mogoče zgraditi in moderno urediti s 17,3 milijoni dolarjev, ki smo jih izgubili v prometnih nesrečah v teku enega samega leta!

Prav na dan, ko sem se mudila za misijonsko zborovanje v Sarajevu, ga je zadela kap. Ostal je v težkem stanju, pridružila se je pljučnica in tako je v nedeljek zvečer okrog 9. ure odšel v novo živiljenje. Umrl je torek 5. marca.





### McCormack introduces state abortion legislation

State Representative Tim McCormack, D-18, Euclid, introduced legislation into the Ohio House of Representatives this week calling for the Congress of the United States to propose an amendment to the Constitution of the United States which would allow the individual states to regulate, control and prohibit abortions.

"This amendment is essential," stated McCormack, "for without this provision the individual states are stripped of all right to prohibit abortions or to effectively control the practice of abortions in the individual states."

"An amendment to the federal Constitution should be initiated when there is a clear need of the utmost importance to the welfare of the nation. While I hesitate ever to recommend amending our Constitu-

tion, in this situation I don't believe we have a choice. We must be able to pass legislation relative to the single most important concern of our society; this is the sanctity of human life."

"Under the recent U.S. Su-

preme Court decision, it is clear that the states are precluded from regulating abortions at any time up to the first trimester of pregnancy (12 weeks). In addition, it is apparent that abortions could be performed up to 12 weeks of pregnancy and beyond. I believe this to be a dangerous decision."

"The long term consequences of aborting human life forms will inevitably lead to a lessening of the value each of us places upon human life itself. At a time when there is growing violence and resultant carnage in America, I hardly think large scale aborting of human fetuses is a wise course of action."

"We should be concentrating all of our energies as a people upon raising the dignity and value of each human life in our society, not lessening that individual dignity."
