ZDA BOJKOTIRALE "PALESTINSKI DAN"

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Vlada ZDA je naročila vsem svojim diplomatskim zastopnikom, naj se ne udeležijo praznovanja "mednarodnega dneva solidarnosti s palestinskim ljudstvom" v okviru Združenih narodov preteklo sredo. ZDA se je v ZN pri tem na prizadevanje poslanika pri ZN Andrewha Younga pridružilo še okoli 20 drugih držav članic ZN.

"Palestinski dan" je bil določen na predlog arabskih držav ob podpori držav Tretjega sveta, ki jim je uspelo v preteklem juniju tudi ustanoviti posebni Palestinski odbor v ZN.

Podobno kot v glavnem stanu Združenih narodov v New Yorku so zastopniki ZDA bojkotirali "palestinski dan" tudi v Ženevi v Švicariji, kjer je del ustavnih agencij ZN, ter v Parizu, kjer je glavni stan UNESKO.

Odkrita beseda skrbi nekajere v Beli hiši

Izjava vodnika Carterjevega boja proti inflaciji Alfreda Kahna povzročajo nemir na borzah in skrbi v Beli hiši.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Nekateri glavni svetovalci predsednika Carterja v Beli hiši postajajo vzemirjeni zaradi odkritih izjav Alfreda Kahna, vodnika boja proti inflaciji. Kahnove izjave so včasih v nasprotju z vladno gospodarsko politiko, oziroma z njenimi razlagami položaja.

Ko so vsi drugi v zvezni vladi poudarjali in zagotavljali, da ni nevarnosti gospodarskega zastopa, je Kahn naravnost napovedoval ne le zastop, ampak pravo depresijo, če Carterjev program boja proti inflaciji ne bo uspel.

V Beli hiši pravijo, da je potrebno, da Kahn spozna, da njegove izjave povzročajo zaskrbljenost in nemir, celo pravo paniko na borzah.

Svetovalci Carterja v Beli hiši so prišli do zaključka, da bi bilo najboljše, da bi Alfred Kahn čim več molčal, gospodarsko in zlasti denarno politiko vlade pa razlagal po potrebi začuden tajnik Michael Blumenthal.

Iran prepovedal verske procesije

TEHERAN, Iran. — Vlada je prepovedala verske procesije v islamskem svetu mesecu v božnji, da bi verski vodniki te izrabili za hujskanje in nove demonstracije proti vladni šahovi Reze Pahlevija.

Islamski verski vodniki in šahovi politični nasprotniki še niso odstopili od svoje namere, da odstranijo šaha z vodstva Irana. Konservativni islamski vodniki so zagrizeni nasprotniki reform, ki jih šah uvaja zadnje dve desetletji po zgledu Zahoda, liberalnih in levicaških politik se borijo za konec šahove avtoritarne oblasti in vlade.

Zadnje vesti

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Predsednik Carter se bo danes razgovarjal s predsednikom egiptanske vlade Mustafa Khalilom, ki mu je prinesel osebno pismo predsednika Sadata, o stanju pogajanj med Egiptom in Izraelom. Pogajanja so običala in pričakujejo, da se bo predsednik Carter zavzel za njihovo pospešno nadaljevanje.

KAIRO, Egipt. — Predsednik Sadat ne bo šel prihodnji teden osebno v Oslo sprejet Nobelovo nagrado za mir, ki je bila pododeljena skupno njemu in predsedniku izraelske vlade Beginu za njun napor pri iskanju miru na Srednjem vzachu.

MANAGUA, Nik. — Predsednik republike Anastasio Somoza je pristal na to, da naj ljudsko glasovanje odloči o tem, ali bo ostal še dalje na čelu Nikaragve ali ne. Odklonil je zahtevo politične opozicije, da za čas ljudskega glasovanja zapusti deželo.

HONG KONG. — Ko lepaki na

zidovih Pekinga še vedno kritizirajo Mao Cetunga, izgleda, da trenutno ne bo v vodstvu LR Kitajske nobenih sprememb. Po vsem sodeč bo Hua Kuo-feng ostal še dalje predsednik vlade in načelnik Komunistične partije, toda obe dejansko vodil Teng Hsiaoping v njunih vsakdanjih poslih.

CARACAS, Venez. — V nedeljo so v Venezueli predsedniške volitve. Volivci so razdeljeni in ni mogoče predvideti, kateri od kandidatov bo prevladal.

Jim Jones se pogajal s Sovjetsko zvezo

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Po izjavah svojih ožjih sodelavcev je Jim Jones vsaj dvakrat govoril s sovjetskim poslanikom v Georgetownu, kjer so mu obljubili dovoljenje za preselitev celotnega naselja Jonestown iz Gvajane v Sovjetsko zvezo.

V Nemčiji štrajkajo delavci v jeklarnah

Delavci v nemški jeklarski industriji skušajo s štrajkom doseči skrajšanje delovnega tedna na 35 ur.

BONN, ZRN. — Ta teden so začeli delavci v jeklarnah štrajk v podporo svoji zahtevi po skrajšanju delovnega tedna na 35 ur. Delavci so se odločili za to, ko so prišli do zaključka, da bo industrija morala odpustiti večje število delavstva, če bo ostala pri sedanjem delovnem tednu. Skrajšanje tega naj bi ohranilo delovna mesta tisočem jeklarjev.

Industrija se upira sprejemu zahteve po krajišem delovnem tednu trdeč, da bi s tem postali njeni izdelki toliko dražji, da bi mogli uspešno tekmovati z drugimi na tujih trgih.

Nesposobnost uspešnega tekmovanja bi vodila najno do zmanjšanja obratovanja in do večjega odpuščanja delavstva, pravijo vodniki jeklarske industrije v Zvezni republiki Nemčiji. Ta industrijska veja je že nekaj časa v težavah ne le v Nemčiji, ampak v vseh državah Skupnega trga.

Obe strani sta trdrovratni pri svojih stališčih in tako pričakujejo, da bo štrajk, prvi v zadnjih 50 letih, včetno dolg in bolec.

Potres v Mehiki

MEXICO CITY, Meh. — Preteklo sredo je doživeljalo glavno mesto Mehike šest močnih potresnih sulkov, ki so jih čutili tudi po vsem južnem delu države in so povzročili precej škode in ponekod pravi preplah med prebivalstvom.

Okoli 100 ljudi je bilo ranjenih, najmanj 8 pa mrtvih. Skoda je bila sorazmerno majhna, če upoštevamo, da je bil potres jačine 7.9 na Richterjevi skali.

BREŽNJEV VOLJAN PRITI V WASHINGTON

V Washingtonu pravijo, da je Brežnev pripravljen priti na razgovor s Carterjem tudi brez uspešnega končanja na SALT 2, ko postajajo trenaž med ZDA in ZSSR v raznih delih sveta vznemirljiva.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Sovjetski vodnik Leonid I. Brežnev je do nedavnega vztrajal na stališču, da pojde na obisk v ZDA le in samo tedaj, ko bodo pogajanja o omejitvi strateškega jeklskega orožja z ZDA uspešno končana in bo tekom svojega obiska v ZDA sporazum podpisal.

Pogajanja so se zavlekla dalj, kot so v Moskvini in tudi v Washingtonu pričakovali. V Beli hiši sedaj pravijo, da so dobili iz Moskve sporočilo, da je predsednik L. I. Brežnev pripravljen priti v ZDA na razgovor s predsednikom Carterjem, najraje v Washingtonu, tudi, če sporazum o SALT ne bi bil čisto gotov.

Nova trenja zaradi Kube in Irana

Državni tajnik C. R. Vance je govoril nedavno o izboljšanju odnosov ZDA s Sovjetsko zvezo, toda ti kljub temu niso posebno dobrni, ker se vedno znova pojavljajo vzroki za nova, povečana trenaž. Trenutno motijo odnos med ZDA in ZSSR zlasti nova MIG-23 jet letala na Kubi, nemiri v Iranu, ki jim pazljivo in v svojih skrbjo sledijo tako v Washingtonu kot v Moskvi, pogajanja med Izraelom in Egiptom, od katerih je Moskva izključena in jih zato skuša na vse možne načine izjavljivati, kuhanske čete kot sredstvo sovjetske politike v Afriki, zlasti možnost njihovega posega v Rodezijo in Južno Afriko. Vznenimljiv je tudi položaj v Jugovzhodni Evropi, tako v Jugoslaviji kot v sosednji Romuniji.

JEZA NA ROMUNIJO
V Moskvi so slabe volje, ker je Romunija odklonila povečanje svojih oboroženih sil v okviru

ru Varšavske zveze, kot je to Sovjetska zveza predložila na konferenci vodnikov Varšavske zveze pretekli teden.

Ta odklonitev in objava praznovanja 60-letnice romunske "osvoboditve", ki jo je odredil za danes predsednik Romunije Nicolae Ceausescu, sta baje sprožili poziv poslanikom Sovjetske zveze, Madžarske in Bolgarije v Bukarešti na "posvet domov".

V Moskvi ne marajo, da bi bil njihov zastopnik pri proslavi, na kateri bi se Romuni spomnili "osvoboditve". Besarabije ob koncu prve svetovne vojne, ki so jo moralib v koncu druge zvezna odstopiti Rusom.

Se manj veselja imajo v Budimpešti, da bi delali družbo Romunom, ko proslavljajo "osvoboditve". Transilvanije, kjer trdi, da živi še vedno okoli milijon in pol Madžarov. Transilvanija ali Erdeljska je bila stoletja del dežela krone sv. Stefana.

Tudi Bolgari so nejevoljni na Romune, niso jim pozabili, da so jim v drugi balkanski vojni vzel del Dobrudže in jo obdržali do današnjih dni.

Brežnev utrdil svojo položaj

Leonid I. Brežnev je v zadnjih dneh utrdil svoj položaj, ko je dosegel, da je bil v Politbiro Komunistične partije imenovan Konstantin Černenko, njegov dogoletni osebni varovanc, o katerem govorijo, da utegne postati naslednik Brežnjeve.

V Moskvi so se pohvalili z letošnjo žitno letino, ki je dala 135 milijonov ton žita, več kot kdajkoli prej, in presegla načrtovano količino, ko je bila lanska 17 milijonov ton podajo.

Japonska dobi novega predsednika vlade

Pri primarnih volitvah je nepričakovano bil izvoljen za predsednika vlade ne stranke njen dosedanjega glavnega tajnik Masayoshi Ohira, dolgoletni tekmelec predsednika vlade Takeo Fukude.

TOKIO, Jap. — Pri primarnih volitvah za vodstvo vladne liberalno-demokratske stranke je nepričakovano zmagal Masayoshi Ohira nad predsednikom vlade Takeo Fukudem. Ohira se je na skrivaj povezal z bivšim predsednikom vlade Tanako, ki je moral pred dvema leti odstopiti zaradi obtožbe sprejem podkupnine od ameriške letalske družbe Lockheed, pa ima še vedno veliko pristašev in podpornikov v vladni stranki.

Fukudem je po objavi izidov voliltev sprejel odločitev volivcev in izjavil, da bo prihodnji teden odstopil, ker je na Japonskem običaj, da je vodnik vladne stranke tudi predsednik vlade.

Ne pričakujejo, da bi Ohira v čemerkoli bistveno spremenil stališče in smeri sedanje vlade, četudi je v stranki nekaj bolj na razdelile preko celega leta 1979 v štiri stopnje.




Warmth found among New York Slovenians

In giant New York City, the Slovenes seem to have found a key for their way of keeping Slovene culture alive.

Widely sprinkled as they are throughout the paunch of the big city, threatening divisiveness through sheer hugeness, the Slovenes have been able to create an atmosphere of com-

nunity. I found this on the week-end of November 18th, when I was invited to present a paper on Slovene immigration before the League of Slovene Americans. I was an observer at their annual meeting in the morning, participated in the symposium in the afternoon, joined their social groups on two evenings, attended their cultural program on Sunday morning, and, finally, was pleasantly surprised by their citation they extended to me.

I found warmth, congeniality, and tolerance. It was all underlaid with a great deal of hard work, the kind that much of our present-day America has, regrettably, abandoned.

The annual meeting was concerned with positive, major activities, such as organizing American Slovene youth trips to the country of their parents. The symposium dealt with Slovene literature; and my presentation, which must have contained remarks with which all did not agree. Yet, I felt a freedom to dissent, if I wished.

In an age when our culture forces many layers of behavior upon the individual in order to make him conform to changing
