BUELOS AIRES, Arg. — Po daljši bolezni in počasnom ugašanju je umrla dne 28. decembra na domu svoje mlajše hčerce v San Justu v lepi starosti slovenska mati, trpinka in mučenica Frančiška Boštnar. Samo dva meseca je manjkal, da bi izpolnila 94 let. Pokojna se je rodila na Klancu pri Komendi v večstotletni domačiji Martanovi, kakor se je reklo po domače, danes je ta domačija razdeljana kot mnogo drugih. Poročila se je z Matijem Boštnarjem in se preselila v Jarše pri Mengšu. V zakonu se je rodilo 8 otrok, dva sinova in šest hčer, ki so razen pokojnega Janeza vsi tukaj v Argentini.

Zaradi težkih časov, gospodarske krize in številne družine ter drugih težav je bilo treba veliko pretpreti, a kajb temu sta se starša zavedala važnosti in poslala svoje otroke v srednjo šolo. Sin Janez je dosegel vsečilisce, kjer je študiral slavistiko. Med vojno je bil domobranski častnik in bil ubit od mine na meji, ko je dostikrat potoval na Gorenjsko in tako držal zvezo z Ljubljano. Tudi ostali so že med vojno zaradi slovenskega in katoliškega prepiranja bili preganjani bodisi od Nemcev, še bolj pa od domačih ljudi, zato so morali zapustiti domovino in oditi v neznan. Vsa družina se je znašla kakov toliko drugih v taboriščih v Avstriji, od koder so se leta 1954 preselili v Argentino. Hčerke so se kmalu poročile in ustvarile svoje domove, sin Matija pa je postal duhovnik in oče jih je umrl pred 18 leti.

Na mrtvaškem odu je ležala na domu hčerke Filice, kamor so začeli prihajati kropiti številni rojaki in se poslavljati od pokojne mame. Med kropilci je bilo dosti tukajšnjih domačinov. Na dan pogreba so krsto prenesli v stolnico v San Justo, kjer je bil pogrebna maša in so somaševali tamkajšnji škof msgr. Careras, msgr. A. Orehar in M. Bor-

CELOVEC, Kor. — Že neka let sem se zbero slovenski izobraženci v Sodalitetnem domu v Tinjah na Koroškem. Navadno zapisemo, da je to postal že neke vrste tradicija. These items amount to a great deal, especially at current prices even at wholesale.

One day early in December we set up the store in the Recreation hall. Wall counters and gift wrapping and mail wrapping departments were set up.

The following three days, volunteer hostesses lined up to be paired with a patient to assist him with selections. He or she (WACS, WAVES, NURSES) is permitted to select one gift for himself as well as his family, which included a bonus for baby...

Volunteers kept merchandise replaced. Some tallied the selections and kept records to see what is most popular to help with next year's selections.

All this shopping, filing,

packing, typing, mailing is done carefully and systematically in a total area of 75 by 100 feet.

Each day there are 160 volunteers to coordinate the shopping selections to the mail bags. Postal trucks come to the door as mail bags are filled.

It is your dollar, your support of these charitable service clubs and their fund-raising parties, raffles, etc. that contributes to this Christmas Gift Shoppe for our veterans.

3/4 cup sugar
1 Tablespoon lemon juice
2 eggs
1 teaspoon vanilla
3 dozen vanilla wafers
1 can cherry or blueberry pie filling

In a mixing bowl, combine cream cheese, sugar, lemon juice, eggs and vanilla. Beat at high speed 5 minutes. Line small tart pans with paper liners. Place 1 vanilla wafer, flat side down, in bottom of each paper cup. Top with 1 tablespoon cream cheese mixture. Bake at 350 degrees 15 minutes or until a thin crack appears on top of each tart. Cool. (Baked filling will appear to fall.) Drop 1 teaspoon pie filling on top of each tart. Yields 3 dozen.


