Husein svari Kongres pred omejilivo doba orožja ZDA Jordaniji

Kongres bi rad prodajo
orožja za protiletalsko
obrambo Jordaniji omejil
na polovico dogovorjene.

AMAN, Jord. — Jordanški kralj Husein se je zadnjic, ko je bil na obisku v ZDA, dogovoril o nakupu protiletalskega oružja za svoje oborožene sile v skupni vrednosti 350 milijonov dolarjev. Predvsem bi hotel imeti Husein 14 baterij protiletalskih Hawk raket, rakete Redeye in protiletalske topove.

Predno sme vlada ZDA prodati kaki tuji državi večjo kolikočino oružja, mora to sporočiti Kongresu, ki lahko pusti kupcijsko mirno veljati, lahko pa zahteva njene spremembe ali celo popolno odpoved.

Senatni odbor je mnenja, da je obseg prodaje oružja Jordaniji prevelik in zahteva njenovo omejitev na kvečjemu 6 baterij Hawk raket in sorazmerno zmanjšanje kolicin ostalega oružja, med njim 60 F-5 lovskih letal in večjega števila Vulkan protiletalskih topov.

Ko je zvedel Husein za naspričovanje svojemu nakupu oružja v Kongresu in za predlog za njegovo obsežno omejitev, je izjavil, da bo odpovedal sam vso kupcijo, če mu ZDA ne bodo dovolile nakupa vsega, o čemer se je dogovoril. Jordanija je veljala doslej za zanesljivo zaveznico ZDA na Srednjem vzhodu, skoraj vse svoje oružje je dobivala v zadnjih 15 letih iz ZDA. Državno tajništvo je izgovorilo v Kongresu kratek odmor, da bo skušalo spor rešiti v razgovoru s Huseinom, ki je sedaj na obisku v Iranu.

Grki in Turki se pogajajo o letalskem prometu

ATENE, Gr. — Zastopniki Grčije in Turčije so se sestali v torku tu na drugi del razgovorov o določitvi pravic do letalskega prostora nad Egejskim morjem. Spor med Grčijo in Turčijo zaradi Cipra in zaradi pravice do izkorisčanja rudneva bogastva pod Egejskim morjem se je namreč raztegnil tudi na zračni prostor.

Bilo je nevarno, da pride do letalskih sponarov, če se spor ne reši. Po posredovanju NATO so se ti razgovori začeli junija, pa bili prekinjeni do tega tedna.

Ciprski razgovori na Dunaju bili preloženi

DUNAJ, Avstr. — Včeraj bi se morali tu pod pokroviteljstvom Združenih narodov sestati zastopniki ciprskih Grkov in Turkov. Razgovorom bi moral predsedovati glavni tajnik ZN Kurt Waldheim.

Ker je egipto-izraelska kriza zahtevala udeležbo K. Waldheima pri svojem reševanju — ta je moral danes v Kairo — so bili razgovori ciprskih Grkov in Turkov odloženi.

Izraelska zahteva po direktnih razgovorih nova ovira sporazumu

Komaj je Egipt pristal na podaljšanje namestitev čet ZN na Sinaju, pa hoče Izrael direktne razgovore z Egiptom za sporazum.

KAIRO, Egipt. — V zadnjih minutah, ko je potekal čas čet ZN, ki stražijo premirje med Egiptom in Izraelom na Sinaju, se je predsednik Egipta Sadat odločil za podaljšanje te dobe. Kriza je prešla in za neno nadaljnje reševanje je obljubil glavni tajnik ZN Kurt Waldheim priti danes sem na razgovore s Sadatom. Egipt je podaljšal ZN čas za straženje premirja samo za tri mesece. S tem je pouparil svojo nepotrežljivost s počasnim tokom razgovorov.

Izraelski predsednik vlaže Yitzhak Rabin je v Jeruzalemu dejal nekaj po objavi egiptega pristanka na podaljšanje straženja čet ZN na Sinaju, da sporazum med Egiptom in Izraelom ne more biti dosežen brez direktnih razgovorov med obe. Ma. Ta potekajo sedaj preko ZDA, ki posredujejo.

V Kairu so direktne razgovore odklonili in vidijo v Rabino zahtevi namerno novo oviro, ki naj bi prepričala sporazum, ko je ta že skoraj dosežen. Zastopnik vlade je izjavil, da posmeni to konec ameriškega posredovanja in polom poganj.

Ameriški državni tajnik H. Kissinger je v kratkem razgovoru z novinarji potem, ko je izročil izraelskemu poslaniku S. Dinitzu egiptski odgovor na zadnji izraelski predlog, dejal, da se obe strani zbljujeta. Predsednik Ford je med tem v sestovi skupini fantov Ameriške legije svaril, da je "razlika še vedno zelo resna" in da ameriško posredovanje "morda ne bo uspelo". Priporabil je, da to lahko privede do nove vojne na Srednjem vzhodu in z njo do novega arabskega oljnega bojkota.

ASTRONAVTI SE VRNILI: APOLLO PROGRAM KONČAN

Včeraj popoldne ob 5.18, točno, kot je bilo predvideno, je vesoljska ladja Apollo pristala na Tihem oceanu, okoli 6.2 milje od letalonosilke New Orleans, ki jo je tam čakala. V 45 minutah so bili astronauti na letalonosilki. Program Apollo, v okviru katerega so astronauti ponovno obiskali Luno, je zaključen.

HOUSTON, Teks. — Včeraj popoldne je poslednja vesoljska ladja Apollo v sedanjem programu po 10 dneh v vesolju srečno pristala z astronauti Staffordom, Slaytonom in Brandon na Tihem oceanu, 330 milj severozahodno od Havajev, kjer je pričakovala letalonosilka New Orleans. Morje je bilo dosti mirno, vreme ugodno, astronauti so pristali točno ob določenem času 5.18 popoldne in skoraj tudi tudi natančno na predvidenem kraju, le 6.2 milje od letalonosilke. Komaj 45 minut po pristanku je bila vesoljska ladja z astronauti že na krovu letalonosilke.

A. Solženicin:

Besede svarila Ameriki

Aleksander Solženicin, ki ga je v našo deželo povabil na obisk predsednik AFL-CIO George Meany, je na njemu v čast prirejenem banketu v Washingtonu, D.C., 30. junija 1975, imel govor, ki je vzbudil izredno zanimanje ne le v naši deželi, ampak po vsem svobodnem svetu. Ta govor označujejo za "Besede svarila Ameriki" in je zato prav, da ga Amerikanci, ki se resnično zanimajo za svojo domovino, za njeno ter svojo svobodo, poznojo. Tu ga prinašamo našim bralcem v slovenskem prevodu.

II.

Namen in smer mojega današnjega govora mi ne dovoljujeta, da bi rekel kač več o predrevolucionarni Rusiji. Hočem navesti za primer le nekaj števil, ki jih lahko sami čitate v "The Gulag Archipelago", Volume I, ki je bil tiskan v Združenih državah.

V soglasju s strokovnjaki najtočnejše, objektivne statistike v predrevolucionarni Rusiji — tekom 80 let pred revolucijo, v letih revolucionarnega gibanja, ko so bili poskuški napadov na življenje carjev — je bilo na leto obsojenih in usmrčenih okoli 17 ljudi.

Zloglasna španska inkvizicija je na svojem višku končala morda 10 oseb na mesec.

V "Archipelago" navajam knjigo, ki jo je izdal Chekhov leta 1920. Za leti 1918 in 1919 daje ponosno poročilo o revolucionarni dejavnosti, ki je brez sodbe usmrtila preko 1,000 ljudi na mesec.

V času viška Stalinovega terorja v letih 1937, 1938, bi dobili, če bi razdelili število usmrčenih s številom mesecev, preko 40,000 na mesec. To so številke: 17 na leto, 10 na mesec, preko 1,000 na mesec, preko 40,000 na mesec. To je, kako je napredovalo v Rusiji, kar se imenuje konservativizem.

Kaj je demokratičnemu Zahodu omogočilo ustvaritev zvez z Rusijo onih let in s to deželo, Sovjetsko zvezo? Celotna, združena demokracija sveta — Anglija, Francija, Združene države, Kanada, Avstralija in druge male države — je sklenila vojaško zvezo s Sovjetsko zvezo v letu 1941. Kako je to razložiti? Kako moremo to razumeti?

Prvo pojasnilo, ki ga moremo nuditi, je, da morda pomeni, da so bile vse združene demokracije sveta preslabе za boj z eno samo Nemčijo, z enim Hitlerjem. Če je to slučaj, potem je to strašno slabo znamenje! To je strašno preštevilo za sedanji čas. Če vse te države skupaj niso mogle poraziti male Nemčije v času Hitlerja, kaj bodo storile danes, ko je nad polovico zemeljske obale poplavljeno s totalitarizmom?

Jaz ne maram sprejeti te razlage! Potem morda drugo pojasnilo: da je bil to enostavno napad panike, strahu državnikov dneva. Oni enostavno niso imeli dovolj zaupanja v sebe, niso imeli trdnosti duha in so v svojem zmęšanem stanju sklenili stopiti v zvez z sovjetskim totalitarizmom.

Ali končno: tretje pojasnilo pravi, da je bil to namerno načrt. Demokracija se ni marala braniti sama, hotela se je braniti s pomočjo drugega totalitarnega sistema, sovjetskega totalitarnega sistema. Jaz ne govorim sedaj o moralni evoluciji tega — o tem bom govoril kasneje — ampak samo v mejah splošnih računov. Kako kratkovidno je to? Kakšna samoprevara je to?

Mi imamo ruski pregovor: Ne kliči volka na pomoč proti psom. Če te psi napadajo, se bori proti psom. Bori se s psi in ne kliči volka na pomoč. Kajti, ko volkovi pridejo, bodo požrli ali pregnali pse, pa bodo raztrgali tudi tebe.

Svetovne demokracije bi lahko premagale totalitarne sisteme drugega za drugim, nemškega, nato sovjetskega. Namesto tega so okrepile sovjetski totalitarizem, so pomagale do nastanka tretjemu totalitarizmu, temu na Kitajskem — vse to je privedlo v današnji svetovni položaj.

Roosevelt je v Teheranu v eni svojih napitnic dal izjavno. Dejal je: "Jaz ne dvomim, da mi trije" — mislec Roosevelt, Churchill in Stalina — "vodimo naša ljudstva v soglasju z njihovimi željami, v soglasju z njihovimi cilji."

Kako naj mi to razložimo? Dobro, pustili bomo to zgodovinarjem. Mi smo tedaj poslušali in smo bili začuden.

Mi v ruhi vojski smo mislili, da, ko bomo dosegli Evropo in srečali Amerikance, jim bomo to povedali. Jaz sem bil med temi četami, ki so korakale proti Labi. Še nekaj dalj in jaz bi bil dosegel Labo in bi segel v roke predhodnici armade Združenih držav. Toda nekaj pred tem sem bil prijet in odveden v ječo in do mojega sestanka ni prišlo. Toda zdaj, s to veliko zakasnitvijo, sem tukaj, da vam povem kot prijatelj Združenih držav, kar smo kot prijatelji hoteli povedati tedaj, pa so našim vojakom preprečili, da bi vam to povedali na Labi.

Je še drug rусki pregovor: Sovražnik je, ki vedno so-

glaša, prijatelji vam bodo ugovarjali. Prav to je vzrok, da sem vam prišel to povedati, prijatelji moji!

Ne bom vam pripovedoval sladkih besedi. Položaj v svetu ni le nevaren, ni le grozeč, je naravnost uničujoč.

Nekaj, kar je nedoumljivo običajnemu človeškemu razumu, se dogaja. Mi, tam preko — brezmočno povprečno sovjetsko ljudstvo — nismo mogli razumeti leto za letom, desetletje za desetletjem, kaj se dogaja.

Anglija, Francija, Združene države — države, ki so bile zmagovalne v drugi svetovni vojni — zmagovalke diktirajo mir in one dobijo dobre pogoje, trdne pogoje in ustvarjajo položaj v soglasju s svojo filozofijo, s svojim pojmovanjem svobode, s svojo presojo narodnih koristi.
